THE TWINS: After completing their homestand with a record of 3-2 (1-1 vs. Cleveland and 2-1 vs. Kansas City), Minnesota began its 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with a split of the first two games at Tampa Bay...this afternoon, they will play the three-game series finale against the Rays then travel to Seattle...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play the Mariners at T-Mobile Park for three games over the weekend...following that series, they will fly to Sacramento to play the A's for four games from Monday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins have won 17 of their last 21 games overall, including eight of their last 10 road games.

☞ Twins are 23-9 in their last 32 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

☞ On the season, the Twins rank fourth in the AL in run differential at +31 (216-185), trailing New York's +112 (304-192), Detroit's +83 (284-201) and Houston's +34 (225-191).

☞ Twins are 3-1 in rubber games this season...their three wins are April 2 at Chicago-AL, April 16 vs. New York-NL and May 4 at Boston...their one loss was April 6 vs. Houston.

TWINS TAKE GAME TWO IN TAMPA: The Twins beat the Rays last night at George M. Steinbrenner Field by a score of 4-2, evening the series at 1-1...Joe Ryan (5-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...Griffin Jax earned his 14th hold with 1.0 inning, striking out all three batters he faced...Jhoan Duran earned his ninth save with a scoreless ninth, pitching in his 200th career MLB game...the offense recorded seven hits, three from Carlos Correa, who doubled (9) and singled twice...Kody Clemens hit his fifth home run of the season and fourth in his last 11 games.

RAY MATTER: The Twins and Rays are playing the third of six games this season...their next series will be three games at Target Field, from July 4-6.

☞ Twins have homered in 13-straight games against the Rays, hitting 22 home runs in that span...it's Minnesota's longest streak against Tampa Bay.

☞ In his last 15 games against the Rays (since 2022), Carlos Correa is hitting .390 (23-for-59) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .610 slugging percentage and a 1.030 OPS...in 38 career games against the Rays, he has hit .299 (43-for-144) with an .858 OPS.

C4. EXP-LOS-IVE: Over his last 22 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .338 (27-for-80) with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .488 slugging percentage and an .845 OPS — Twins 16-6 in those games...in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .174 (15-for-86) with six doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .279 slugging percentage and a .513 OPS — Twins 9-16 in those games.

PARDON MY FRENCH: Ty France extended his hitting streak to six games last night, matching his season-long, previously done from April 26-May 1...during the streak, he has exactly one hit in each game (.250 average) and has driven in seven runs in those six...his career-long for a hitting streak is 14, done from May 3-17, 2023 with Seattle.

THE MISSILE: Kody Clemens has hit safely in each of his last eight games with an at-bat (career-high)...additionally, he has reached safely via hit, walk or HBP in a career-high 15-straight games, posting a .468 on-base percentage over those 15.

☞ Since May 11, he ranks third in baseball, behind Teoscar Hernández (100.0 mph) and Oneil Cruz (100.0) in average exit velocity at 99.5 mph (minimum of 200 pitches seen).

☞ Clemens has homered in four of five road series since joining the Twins on April 26 (except for CLE, April 28-May 1)...his five homers this season (all hit in 53 AB w/ MIN) tie his career high, done in 2022 (117 AB w/ DET) and 2024 (114 AB w/ PHI).

SERIES STUFF: Twins are looking to win their 11th series today...Minnesota is 10-6-1 in series play, going 6-2-1 at home and 4-4-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 9-2-1 in their last 12...their last series loss came April 28-May 1 at Cleveland, dropping three of four.

☞ Twins' last series win against the Rays came June 10-12, 2022 at Target Field, taking two of three...their last series win in Tampa came April 29-May 1, 2022 at Tropicana Field, taking two of three.

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: Misc. hitting numbers for Twins hitters:

☞ Twins are hitting .254 with runners on base, fifth-best in the AL and 10th-best in baseball.

☞ Twins are hitting .272 with runners in scoring position, third-best in baseball...second-best in baseball with RISP and two outs at .277.

☞ Twins are hitting .247 in one-run games, the second-best in the AL and fourth-best in baseball.

☞ Notable individuals with RISP and two outs: Brooks Lee is hitting .467, Kody Clemens is hitting .333, Willi Castro is hitting .364, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .353 and Ty France is hitting .321...among qualifiers, Lee ranks fourth in the AL and Castro ranks 15th.

☞ Ty France is hitting .389 with runners in scoring position, the fifth-highest in the AL.

AUTISM AWARENESS: The Twins and UnitedHealthcare will welcome close to 100 individuals with autism, along with their families, caregivers and educators, to the first-ever Autism Awareness Day event at Target Field today...participants will experience Target Field in an intentionally designed "test run" environment — including ticket screening, locating their section and seat numbers, ordering concessions, if desired, and a special tour — all in the comfort of an empty ballpark, before gathering in section 103 to watch the television broadcast of today's game in Tampa on the main videoboard.

☞ By empowering families and schools to become familiar with Target Field and the fan experience in a more comfortable setting — without the additional stressors associated with a typical home game crowd — parents, schools and individuals with special needs can build the familiarity and confidence needed to enjoy a large sporting event, such as a Twins home game.

THE MOR YOU NEAU: Twins.TV analyst Justin Morneau played 58 career games against the Rays, hitting .308 (68-for-221) with 15 doubles, two triples, 12 home runs, 40 RBI, a .557 slugging percentage and a .908 OPS...the OPS was his second-highest against any AL opponent (Oakland - .919).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1994, St. Paul native Dave Winfield recorded his 3,054th career hit to surpass former Twin Rod Carew and move into 15th place (now 23rd place) on the all-time list.

 ⚔ López is 2-3 in eight career starts against Tampa Bay, posting a 4.05 ERA (46.2 IP, 21 ER), with eight walks, 47 strikeouts and a .239 (43-for-180) opponent batting average.
 ⚔ Did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off victory vs. the Royals in his last start on May 23...allowed one run on seven hits in 5.2 innings, with no walks and five strikeouts.

LIFE OF PABLO: Last pitched on May 23 vs. Kansas City, opposite Noah Cameron; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off victory...allowed one run off seven hits, no walks and five strikeouts over 5.2 innings of work...sole run allowed came in the first inning on an RBI double from Cavan Biggio, scoring Jonathan India.

⚔ Marked his eighth-straight outing with five-or-more strikeouts, the fourth time in his career accomplishing such a streak, and first time since May 21-August 18, 2023 where he recorded a career-high 16 consecutive games with five-plus strikeouts.
 ⚔ Recorded season-high pitches thrown (102) as well as his highest single-game strikeout percentage since August 12, 2024 (72.5%)...allowed just two hard-hit balls for a rate of 10.5 percent, his lowest this season by far (next lowest, 4/25, 21.4 percent).

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 17 at Milwaukee, opposite Tobias Myers; earned the win in Minnesota's 7-0 victory...allowed two hits, two walks, six strikeouts and a .100 (2-for-20) opponent batting average over 6.0 quality innings...led the Twins to their third consecutive shutout win, the sixth time the team has recorded this feat in Twins/Senators (1901-) history, and the first time since July 5-7, 2004...also helped extend their scoreless streak to 33 innings, and their win streak to 13-straight games, the second longest winning streak in team history, behind the 1991 Twins who won 15 in a row from June 1-16.

⚔ Was his first time allowing no runs in an outing since August 18-30, 2024 where he threw 20.2 scoreless innings over three consecutive starts.

VS. TAMPA BAY: López is 2-3 in eight career starts against the Rays, posting a 4.05 ERA (46.2 IP, 21 ER) with eight walks and 47 strikeouts...has a .239 (43-for-180) opponent batting average.

⚔ Faced Tampa Bay twice in 2024, posting a 6.75 ERA (10.2 IP, 8 ER) with two walks, 12 strikeouts and a .304 (14-for-46) opponent batting average, his fifth highest among all opponents last season.

⚔ Last faced the Rays at Tropicana Field on September 5, 2024 where he earned the win in Minnesota's 4-3 victory, allowing three runs on seven hits, with one walk and nine strikeouts, and threw a career-high 98.6 mph 4-seamer.

ACE UP OUR SLEEVE: Since joining the Twins, López has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2023:

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 15-8 with a 3.80 ERA (213.0 IP, 90 ER), 10.35 K/9, 1.94 BB/9 and 0.93 HR/9 in 36 starts at home, compared to 17-12 with a 3.41 ERA (229.2 IP, 87 ER), 9.84 K/9, 2.16 BB/9 and 1.21 HR/9 in 39 road starts.

⚔ In his five starts on the road this season, López has gone 2-2, posting a 1.55 ERA (29.0 IP, 5 ER), with four walks and 26 strikeouts; compared to 1-2, 5.14 ERA (28.0 IP, 16 ER), with eight walks and 21 strikeouts in his previous five road starts to end the 2024 season from August 6-September 22, 2024.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through nine starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .267/.299/.356 in 101 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .158/.208/.239 in 96 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 24.1 compared to righties' 87.1 mph and 28.1 percent.

⚔ He has an all-time low 26.2 percent hard hit rate against right-handed batters, compared to an all-time high hard hit rate of 36.8 against left-handed batters.

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: In his career, with runners in scoring position, López has a .243 (181-for-744) opponent batting average...with a runner on third, he puts up a .220 (20-for-91) opponent batting average and with runners on second and third, he allows just a .182 (10-for-55) opponent batting average.

THE ARSENAL: López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 43% of the time, the highest of his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

⚔ Currently ranks in the 96th percentile for fastball run value and 93rd for breaking run value, compared to fifth percentile for offspeed run value.

⚔ Has a 7.1 extension, ranking in the 93rd percentile, and bottom four percent in max exit velocity at 116.5 mph.

⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sweepers, Pablo has the second lowest hard hit percentage at 12.5 percent (behind Ryan Yarbough, 8.3 percent), ranks fifth in slugging percentage (.111) and is tied for sixth in opponent batting average (.111)

⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 sinkers, López is first in put away percentage (57.1), fourth in opponent batting average (0.77) and fifth slugging percentage (.077).

WALK THIS WAY: Pablo's 4.4 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 92nd percentile...he ranks third on the Twins pitching staff behind Danny Coulombe (3.3) and Joe Ryan (3.7)...his walk rate is at an all-time career low, with his average in the previous seven years being six percent.

Ks FOR A GOOD CAUSE: This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund...with 54 strikeouts this season, he has donated \$54,000 so far.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - RHP ZEBBY MATTHEWS (2025: 0-1, 7.71 ERA // CAREER: 1-5, 6.85 ERA)

Right-hander Zebby Matthews is scheduled to start Thursday's series opener against the Mariners...last start came on May 24 vs. Kansas City...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 walk-off victory...allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and a career-high nine strikeouts in 4.0 innings...Matthews has never faced Seattle, they will become his 10th new opponent faced...he is 0-3 in five career starts on the road, posting a 4.84 ERA (22.1 IP, 12 ER), nine walks, 21 strikeouts and a .275 (25-for-91) opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, made his third career Opening Day start, became the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79).
- In 2024, recorded his 800th career strikeout on June 6 at New York-AL, fanning Gleyber Torres in the second inning.
- Tied career high and set 2024 season high with 14 strikeouts on June 23 at Oakland (6.0 IP)...also pitched 8.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and one walk during the start, earning the win in a 3-0 Twins victory.
