first game in Cleveland on Monday night, followed by four-straight losses — three in Cleveland
and one in Boston last nighttoday, the Twins will play the second of three at Fenway Park
and conclude the series tomorrow afternoonafter tomorrow's finale, the Twins will travel
home to eniov an off-day on Monday, followed by a six-game homestand against the Orioles
(3 games, May 6-8) and Giants (3 games, May 9-11).

The four the last 11 games, since April 22, the livins have a run differential of +19 (49-30)... they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

TWINS GIVE IT UP TO BOSTON: The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 6-1, making them 3-8 in series openers this season...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, two from Byron Buxton...Ryan Jeffers hit his second home run of the season, a 108.9 mph shot over the Green Monster... Twins left four men on base and went 0-for-1 with runners in scoring position.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the second of six games in 2025...the Twins are looking to snap a three-game losing streak to Boston and win for the first time since September 20, 2024 at Fenway Park...last time they lost four-straight to Boston came July 27, 2018-June 17, 2019 (also 4).

Byron Buxton has hit safely in seven-straight games against the Red Sox, going 11-for-29 (.379) with a 1.124 OPS in that span, including three home runs and five RBI.

Harrison Bader is 7-for-15 (.467) in four career games at Fenway Park.

Tevor Larnach is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with one home run, seven RBI and a .783 OPS in his last eight games against the Red Sox.

Royan Jeffers is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with four doubles, two home runs and a .966 OPS in his last eight games against the Red Sox.

PARDON MY FRENCH: Ty France is hitting .414 (12-for-29) with four doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS in his last seven games.

TOP JEFF: In his last 15 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with six doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, seven runs scored, seven walks, a .418 on-base percentage, a .565 slugging percentage and a .983 OPS...he is making his fourth start at designated hitter today, his last was April 26 vs. Los Angeles-AL...he is 2-for-7 with six walks, a .615 on-base percentage and .901 OPS as the DH.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis played in his fifth game on rehab assignment yesterday for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-for-4...in four games, he has gone 3-for-18 with one double, one RBI and four strikeouts...Royce has missed all 33 games with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.

TWINS MiLB MONTHLYS: Triple-A outfielder Carson McCusker and Low-A Fort Myers left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for April.

4 McCusker, 26, played in 24 games for the Saints, hitting .325 (27-for-83) with six doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, eight walks, a .398 on-base percentage, a .651 slugging percentage and a 1.048 OPS...he ranked tied for third in the International League in home runs and slugging percentage, fourth in RBI, fifth in total bases, sixth in OPS and eighth in batting average...the Sparks, Nevada native was signed by the Twins as an undrafted free agent in June of 2023.

Hill, 19, made three starts for the Mighty Mussels, going 0-0, 1.69 ERA (10.2 IP, 2 ER), with four walks, 21 strikeouts and a 0.84 WHIP fanning at least six batters in each outing the

Tree agent in June of 2023.

IT AIN'T OBER TIL IT'S OBER: Last pitched on April 22 at Progressive Field vs. the Guardians, opposite Gavin Williams...garnered his third win of the season in Minnesota's 11-1 victory...first win on the road since July 28, 2024...first time earning three consecutive wins since July 28-August 9, 2024... also recorded his fourth consecutive quality start, first time doing so since his 11-game quality start streak from June 16-August 20, 2024...allowed one run on eight hits in 7.2 innings, with no walks and two strikeouts...lone run allowed came off an RBI single from Jhonkensy Noel in the fifth, scoring Gabriel Arias.

- Recorded a career-high 10 groundouts...registered his first 1-2-3 first inning this season... recorded his most pitches (102) and strikes thrown (73) so far this season
 Surpassed 500 career innings pitched, becoming the 11th Twins pitcher to do in first 94 games.
 In his first outing of the season, Bailey allowed eight runs in 2.2 innings...in the five games place has been allowed into account runs in 2.0 innings... since, he has allowed just seven runs in 30.0 innings.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on April 22 at Target Field vs. the White Sox, opposite Davis Martin...garnered his second win of the season, first time earning back-to-back wins since August 3-9, 2024... also recorded his third consecutive quality start, first time doing so since his 11-game quality start streak from June 16 - August 20, 2024...allowed one run (1 ER) on eight hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...escaped two innings without allowing a run with runners in scoring position.

◆ Lone run allowed came off a sacrifice fly from Jacob Amaya, scoring Edgar Quero.

FACING BOSTON: Ober is 0-2 in three career starts against the Red Sox, posting a 1.59 ERA (17.0 IP, 3 ER), with two walks and 14 strikeouts...also has a .246 (16-for-65) opponent batting average.

This last start against Boston was June, 20, 2023 at Target Field, where he allowed three runs on eight hits (2 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts...the last time he pitched at Fenway Park was April 17, 2022 where he allowed two runs off four hits, with one walk and three strikeouts and was dealt the loss in a Twins 8-1 defeat

THE BEARDED NIGHTMARE: Went 4-6 in night games during the 2024 season, with a 4.78 ERA (96.0 IP, 51 ER), a .288 (51-for-354) opponent batting average and a .704 opponent OPS in 17 starts...so far this season, Bailey is 3-0 in night games, with a 2.25 ERA (20.0 IP, 5 ER), a .269 opponent batting average (21-for-78) and a .681 opponent OPS.

LEADING THE PACK: Since debuting with the Twins, Ober has started the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2021:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.78 ERA (247.2 IP, 104 ER), 9.30 K/9, 2.18 BB/9 and 1.56 HR/9 in 47 starts at home compared to 12-13 with a 3.79 ERA (256.2 IP, 108 ER), 8.88 K/9, 1.72 BB/9 and 1.23 HR/9 in 47 road starts.
