**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-4 through five games on their seven-game roadtrip, winning their first game in Cleveland on Monday night, followed by four-straight losses — three in Cleveland and one in Boston last night...today, the Twins will play the second of three at Fenway Park and conclude the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's finale, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Monday, followed by a six-game homestand against the Orioles (3 games, May 6-8) and Giants (3 games, May 9-11).  
✦ Over the last 11 games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +19 (49-30)... they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

**TWINS GIVE IT UP TO BOSTON:** The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 6-1, making them 3-8 in series openers this season...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, two from Byron Buxton...Ryan Jeffers hit his second home run of the season, a 108.9 mph shot over the Green Monster...Twins left four men on base and went 0-for-1 with runners in scoring position.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins and Red Sox are playing the second of six games in 2025...the Twins are looking to snap a three-game losing streak to Boston and win for the first time since September 20, 2024 at Fenway Park...last time they lost four-straight to Boston came July 27, 2018-June 17, 2019 (also 4).

- ✦ Byron Buxton has hit safely in seven-straight games against the Red Sox, going 11-for-29 (.379) with a 1.124 OPS in that span, including three home runs and five RBI.
- ✦ Harrison Bader is 7-for-15 (.467) in four career games at Fenway Park.
- ✦ Trevor Larnach is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with one home run, seven RBI and a .783 OPS in his last eight games against the Red Sox.
- ✦ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with four doubles, two home runs and a .966 OPS in his last eight games against the Red Sox.
- ✦ Christian Vázquez has hit safely in all four games at Fenway as an opponent, going 5-for-16 (.313)...he has hit safely in seven-straight starts vs. Boston.
- ✦ Ty France is hitting .296 (16-for-54) with 10 doubles and an .803 OPS in 12 career games at Fenway Park, hitting safely in 11 of 12 here...his 10 doubles at Fenway are his most in any opposing ballpark...overall, he has 15 career doubles against the Red Sox, his second-most against any opponent (LAA - 16).

**PARDON MY FRENCH:** Ty France is hitting .414 (12-for-29) with four doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS in his last seven games.

- ✦ France has a team-leading 18 RBI on the season...of those 18 RBI, 16 have come in his last 22 games, since April 9...since that date, the 16 RBI are tied with J.P. Crawford for fourth-most in the AL, trailing Cal Raleigh (20), Spencer Torkelson (19) and Alex Bregman (17).
- ✦ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 25 RISP at-bats, his .406 RISP average ranks fifth in the AL, trailing Aaron Judge (.560), Paul Goldschmidt (.448), J.P. Crawford (.407) and Ceddanne Rafaela (.407).
- ✦ He has posted a barrel percentage of 12.7% this season, up 5.4% from 2024 (7.3%), the 14th-best year-to-year increase in the AL.
- ✦ His MLB percentile rankings in a few categories: 90th in xBA (.301), 90th in K% (6.8%), 88th in xwOBA (.396) and 88th in xSLG (.550).

**FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX:** Over his last 17 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits nine times and is hitting .314 (22-for-70) with two doubles, two triples, four home runs, 11 RBI, 13 runs scored, a .571 slugging percentage and an .896 OPS in that span.

- ✦ His 10 multi-hit games on the season are tied for seventh-most in the AL.
- ✦ In his last seven road games, he is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with four RBI, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.006 OPS.

**TOP JEFF:** In his last 15 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with six doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, seven runs scored, seven walks, a .418 on-base percentage, a .565 slugging percentage and a .983 OPS...he is making his fourth start at designated hitter today, his last was April 26 vs. Los Angeles-AL...he is 2-for-7 with six walks, a .615 on-base percentage and .901 OPS as the DH.

**ROYCE ON REHAB:** Royce Lewis played in his fifth game on rehab assignment yesterday for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-for-4...in four games, he has gone 3-for-18 with one double, one RBI and four strikeouts...Royce has missed all 33 games with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.

**TWINS MiLB MONTHLYS:** Triple-A outfielder Carson McCusker and Low-A Fort Myers left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for April.

- ✦ McCusker, 26, played in 24 games for the Saints, hitting .325 (27-for-83) with six doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, eight walks, a .398 on-base percentage, a .651 slugging percentage and a 1.048 OPS...he ranked tied for third in the International League in home runs and slugging percentage, fourth in RBI, fifth in total bases, sixth in OPS and eighth in batting average...the Sparks, Nevada native was signed by the Twins as an undrafted free agent in June of 2023.
- ✦ Hill, 19, made three starts for the Mighty Mussels, going 0-0, 1.69 ERA (10.2 IP, 2 ER), with four walks, 21 strikeouts and a 0.84 WHIP, fanning at least six batters in each outing...the Grapevine, Texas native was selected by the Twins in the second round (69th overall) of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Grapevine High School...Hill is the club's 13th-best prospect according to MLB.com.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2011, Francisco Liriano threw the fifth no-hitter in Twins history and first no-hitter of the MLB season as the Twins beat the White Sox, 1-0...Jason Kubel's solo homer in the fourth inning off Edwin Jackson was the game's only run...Twins TV analyst Denard Span had one of the club's six hits in that game...in 2013, Justin Morneau recorded his 800th career RBI in a Twins 7-6 loss at Cleveland...Morneau finished his Twins career with 860 RBI which stands as the sixth most in club history.
