THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, winning just the second of three games at Tampa Bay earlier this week...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of three at Seattle and play through the weekend...following this series, Minnesota will travel to Sacramento to play the A's for four games from Monday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins have won 17 of their last 22 games overall, including eight of their last 11 road games.

☞ Twins are 23-10 in their last 33 games since April 22, tied with Detroit (23-11), Philadelphia (23-10) and St. Louis (23-10) for the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

TAMPA BRINGS HEAT, SHUTS DOWN TWINS: The Twins were shut out by the Rays at George M. Steinbrenner Field on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 5-0, their fourth time being shut out this season, second on the road (0-9, March 31 at CWS)...Pablo López (4-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...he allowed three of his four runs to score in the third inning, including two home runs from Brandon Lowe and Junior Caminero...the offense recorded just six hits (all singles) and went 0-for-8 with RISP...it marked their first series loss since April 28-May 1 at Cleveland.

RETURN OF THE MACK: The Twins have reinstated outfielder Byron Buxton from the 7-day Concussion Injured List...Buxton, who missed the last 10 games, sustained the injury on May 15 at Baltimore, colliding with shortstop Carlos Correa in short centerfield...Buxton has hit .261 (41-for-157) with five doubles, three triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 11 walks, eight stolen bases, 33 runs scored and an .834 OPS in 41 games for Minnesota this season, including .313 (15-for-48) with a 1.018 OPS in 13 games in May.

☞ To make room for Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned outfielder Carson McCusker to Triple-A St. Paul following Wednesday's game at Tampa Bay.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Twins are 17-7 in May, tied for the fourth-most wins in baseball for the month...the Twins are 97-70 all-time in May wins under Rocco Baldelli (since 2019), their highest of any month...below are Rocco's monthly records (left) and his year-by-year wins in May (right):

SOUNDS OF SEATTLE: The Twins went 5-2 against the Mariners last season, going 3-1 at Target Field, from May 6-9 and 2-1 at Seattle, from June 28-30...Minnesota won the season series for the first time since going 4-3 in 2022.

☞ Twins are 12-7 in their last 19 games against the Mariners.

☞ They won their final two games at T-Mobile Park last season...a win tonight would give the Twins their first three-game winning streak at Seattle since May 16-18, 2019 (also 3).

☞ Carlos Correa has 115 career hits and 115 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...his 115 hits are sixth-most among actives...Correa has 59 career hits at T-Mobile Park, his most in a visiting ballpark.

☞ Willi Castro is hitting .308 (8-for-26) in seven career games at T-Mobile Park.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .414 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .985 OPS in 17 career games vs. the Ms.

☞ Justin Topa pitched one season for the Mariners in 2023, going 5-4, 2.6 ERA (69.0 IP, 20 ER) in 75 games...75 games are tied for the fourth-most in Mariners history.

EMERALD CI-TY: Ty France played parts of five seasons with Seattle, from 2020-24, hitting .266 (557-for-2095) with 110 doubles, 60 home runs, 258 RBI and a .750 OPS in 561 games...he was acquired via trade by the Mariners on August 31, 2020 from San Diego with Andrés Muñoz, Luis Torrens and Taylor Trammell, in exchange for Austin Adams, Dan Altavilla and Austin Nola...he was named to the AL All-Star team in 2022...from 2021-23, he played in 450 games for the Mariners, tied with J.P. Crawford for team-lead...he was traded from Seattle to Cincinnati on July 29, 2024, in exchange for Andruw Salcedo.

☞ On T-Mobile Park's all-time list, France ranks tied for 13th in doubles (50), 15th in hits (271), tied for 15th in RBI (132) and 16th in runs scored (135)...also ranks first in HBP (41).

☞ France signed a one-year contract with the Twins on February 15.

PARDON MY FRENCH: Ty France extended his hitting streak to seven games on Wednesday, marking a season-high...during the streak, he has exactly one hit in each game (.259 average) and has driven in seven runs in those seven...his career-long for a hitting streak is 14, done from May 3-17, 2023 with Seattle.

☞ This season, France leads the Twins in both hits (49) and RBI (30).

☞ France is hitting .382 with runners in scoring position, the sixth-highest in the AL.

C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE: In six games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL, Carlos Correa is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with one double two home runs and a 1.081 OPS...over his last 23 games, since April 25, Correa is hitting .333 (28-for-84) with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .476 slugging percentage and an .828 OPS — Twins 16-7 in those games...in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .174 (15-for-86) with six doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .279 slugging percentage and a .513 OPS — Twins are 9-16 in those games.

THE ROCKET MISSILE: Kody Clemens has reached safely via hit, walk or HBP in a career-high 16-straight games...in that span, he has hit .349 (15-for-43) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 RBI, a .451 on-base percentage, a .767 slugging percentage and a 1.218 OPS.

☞ Clemens has homered in four of five road series since joining the Twins on April 26 (except for CLE, April 28-May 1)...his five homers this season (all hit in 53 AB w/ MIN) tie his career high, done in 2022 (117 AB w/ DET) and 2024 (114 AB w/ PHI).

- ⚡ Making third MLB start of the season and 12th of his career...first career start against the Mariners, making Seattle his 10th new opponent faced.
- ⚡ Last pitched on May 24 vs. the Royals, and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 walk-off victory; allowed two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings, with one walk and a career-high nine strikeouts.
- ⚡ Made seven starts at Triple-A St. Paul this year, going 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), nine walks and 38 strikeouts.
- ⚡ Looking to snap his five-game MLB losing streak (over 10 starts)...seeking first MLB win since August 13, 2024 vs. Kansas City, his major league debut.

LAST START: Last pitched on May 24 vs. Kansas City in his 2025 Target Field debut, opposite Michael Wacha...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 victory...allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and a career-high nine strikeouts in 4.0 innings...led the Twins to their third consecutive walk-off victory (in a span of four games), the first time the team has done so since August 15-18, 2021 (also 4-game span)...his two runs allowed came off a two-run RBI single from Maikel Garcia in the third, scoring Freddy Fermin and Vinnie Pasquantino.

- ⚡ Zebby is the only Twins player to have an active streak of five-or-more strikeouts in each of his last six games.
- ⚡ Recorded a single-game career-high whiff rate of 31.1 percent (14 whiffs on 45 swings), as well as a career-high hard-hit rate of 75 percent (six hard-hit balls).

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews struck out a career-high nine batters in his last outing, to total 57 strikeouts through in his first 11 career games, the fourth most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 11 games:

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 18 at Milwaukee, opposite Freddy Peralta, and took the loss in Minnesota's 2-5 defeat...allowed four runs on five hits, with three walks and five strikeouts in 3.0 innings...his four runs allowed came off two RBI singles from Sal Frelick in the second and third, and an RBI single from Isaac Collins in the third...struck out all three batters in the first...struck out two batters in the third before walking three in a row, followed by two RBI singles.

- ⚡ The loss snapped Minnesota's 13-game winning streak, and his second-inning run snapped the Twins' record 34-inning scoreless streak.

MINOR LEAGUE RECAP: Has seven starts for the Triple-A St. Paul Saints going 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), with nine walks and 38 strikeouts. At the time of recall to Minnesota:

- ⚡ Matthews held the third lowest ERA in the International League among pitchers with at least seven starts, behind Carlos Rodriguez (1.59) and Jacob Misiorowski (1.66).
- ⚡ Was also one of six pitchers in the International League with 32.0-plus innings to only allow one home run.
- ⚡ Had the lowest ERA among Saints pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched...also the lowest opponent batting average among Saints pitchers with at least 7.0 innings.

MEETING THE MARINERS: Matthews has never faced the Mariners or any Seattle batters at the major league level...they become his 10th new opponent faced in 12 career games.

- ⚡ Matthews and Mariners catcher Cal Raleigh are both from Cullowhee, NC, and attended the same high school, Smoky Mountain...Zebby was also coached by Cal's dad when he was younger.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Zebby has gone 1-2 with an 8.87 ERA (22.1 IP, 22 ER), six walks, 36 strikeouts and a .350 (36-for-103) opponent batting average in six career major league starts at home; compared to 0-3, 4.84 ERA (22.1 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks, 21 strikeouts and a .275 (25-for-91) opponent batting average in five career major league starts on the road.

- ⚡ In his single start on the road this season on May 18 against the Brewers, Matthews allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and five strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through his first 11 career major league starts, left-handed hitters have slashed .327/.391/.596 in 104 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties slashed .300/.344/.456 in 90 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.2 mph and a whiff rate of 24.0 compared to righties' 91.0 mph and 27.7 percent.

- ⚡ Hard-hit rate (MLB level): 36.8 percent vs. lefties, 44.3 percent vs. righties.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 53% of the time...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown:
