THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their seven-game roadtrip, going 1-3 at Cleveland, followed by a split of the first two games at Boston...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale at Fenway Park...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, followed by a six-game homestand against the Orioles (3 games, May 6-8) and Giants (3 games, May 9-11).

4 Over the last 12 games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +20 (53-33)... they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

5 Minnesota is 2-1 in rubber games this season, winning April 2 at Chicago-AL, losing April 6 vs. Houston and winning April 16 vs. New York-NL.

FENWAY IS FOR CLEMENS: The Twins beat the Red Sox yesterday at Fenway Park by a score of 4-3, marking their second one-run victory of the season (2-6)...Bailey Ober (4-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...Jhoan Duran pitched a scoreless ninth to earn his third save of the season...the offense recorded 10 hits, highlighted by a Kody Clemens two-run homer in the sixth inning... Byron Buxton reached base three times in five plate appearances, going 2-for-4 with a walk.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the third of six games in 2025...these two teams will meet next for a three-game series at Target Field from July 28-30.

Byron Buxton has hit safely in eight-straight games against the Red Sox, hitting .394 (13-for-33) with one double, three home runs, five RBI and a 1.126 OPS in that span.

Franco Larnach is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with one home run, eight RBI and a .731 OPS in his last nine games against the Red Sox.

Ryan Jefters is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with five doubles, two home runs and a 1.000 OPS in his last nine games against the Red Sox.

Christian Vazquez has hit safely in all five games at Fenway as an opponent, going 6-for-19 (.316)...he has hit safely in eight-straight starts vs. Boston.

BUCK NASTY: Over his last 18 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 10 times and is hitting .324 (24-for-74) with two doubles, two triples, four home runs, 11 RBI, 13 runs scored, a .568 slugging percentage and a .909 OPS in that span.

◆ His 11 multi-hit games on the season are tied for fourth-most in the AL.

◆ In his last eight road games, he is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with four RBI, a .588 slugging percentage and a 1.021 OPS.

YES, JEFF!: In his last 16 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with seven doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, seven runs scored, seven walks, a .424 on-base percentage, a .580 slugging percentage and a 1.004 OPS...he has raised his OPS 304 points over this 16-game stretch, from .492 to .796.

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): Twins are seeking their fifth series win today...they are 4-6-0 in series play, going 3-2-0 at home and 1-4-0 on the road...their four series wins are: March 31-April 2 at Chicago-AL (2 of 3), April 14-16 vs. New York-NL (2 of 3), April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (2 of 3) and April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL (3 of 3).

◆Minnesota's last series win over the Red Sox came May 3-5, 2024 at Target Field (2 of 3)... their last series win at Fenway came September 3-5, 2019 (2 of 3).

HARRI THE HITMAN: Harrison Bader has hit safely in a season-long seven consecutive games, the longest for a Twin this season, ...during the streak, he is hitting .440 (11-for-25) with two doubles, one RBI, two walks, a .481 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and a 1.001 OPS...the streak is tied for Bader's third-longest of his career, his best being an 11-game streak, from May 17 (G2)-31, 2022 with St. Louis.

WHAT'S LEFT: Today marks the fifth time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 1-3 against lefty starters, their win coming against Yusei Kikuchi (4/26 vs. LAA) and their three losses against Martin Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC) and Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL).

◆ The Twins are hitting .214 (47-for-220) with 15 doubles and three home runs (.613 OPS) against left-handed pitching this season, compared to .241 (218-for-906) with 45 doubles and 24 home runs (.689 OPS) against right-handed pitching.
◆ In their last nine games, Twins are slashing .344/.415/.505 (.920 OPS) against lefties.
◆ Byron Buxton is hitting .368 (7-for-19) with one home run, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS against lefties in 2025. he has seven hits in his last 11 at-bats vs. lefties.
◆ Carlos Correa is hitting .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles, one home run, a .625 slugging percentage and a 9.38 OPS against lefties this season.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Kyle DeBarge and Low-A Fort Myers left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
♣ DeBarge, 21, played in six games for the Kernels, hitting .304 (7-for-23) with one double, two home runs, eight RBI, five walks and a 1.037 OPS...the Lake Charles, Louisiana native was selected by the Twins in the Compensatory Round (loss of Sonny Gray), 33rd overall, in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Louisiana, Lafayette.
♣ Hill, 19, made the start on April 26, pitching 3.1 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed two walks, striking out eight of his 14 batters faced...the Grapevine, Texas native was selected by the Twins in the second round (69th overall) of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Grapevine High School...Hill is the club's 13th-best prospect according to MLB.com.

ANALYST ANALYSIS: Fenway Park related notes on Twins Radio and Twins.TV analysts Paul Molitor and Denard Span:

#Molitor was a career .323 (146-for-452) hitter in 106 games at Fenway...146 hits are his most of any park he considered an opposing ballpark...he hit safely in 24 straight games at Fenway from June 28, 1982-October 3, 1987 — the sixth longest streak ever in this park or an opposing player...the most hits he ever had off a single pitcher in his career was 33, against both Rogest Sclemens and Jack Morris.

#Span hit .349 (29-for-83) with 10 walks, a .426 on-base percentage and an .895 OPS in 24 career games at Fenway Park...he homered in back-to-back games here on April 28 and 29, 2018, going yard off David Price and Rick Porcello...it was one of three opposing ballparks where D-Span homered in back-to-back games, the others being Turner Field (2015) and Wrigley Field (2015).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2024, the Twins won the final game of their 12-game winning streak with a 3-1 victory over the Red Sox at Target Field...the next day Boston ended the streak with a 9-2 victory over Minnesota...it was tied for the club's second-longest winning streak in their history (also 1980), behind their 15-game streak from June 1-16, 1991.

LAST TIME OUT: Started in Cleveland on April 29 opposite Tanner Bibee...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off loss...allowed one run on four hits, including a solo homer, with one walk and two strikeouts...Bo Naylor's third-inning home run marked Paddack's 11th career start in which his lone run allowed came via a solo home run...76 pitches thrown are his fewest since he threw 46 in 2.1 innings in Game 2 of a June 16, 2024 doubleheader vs. the A's; is his lowest pitch count in an 4.0-or-more inning outing since May 25, 2024 vs. Texas (73 pitches in 5.0 IP).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his third loss of the season on April 24 vs. Chicago-AL, a 7.0-inning rainshortened game at Target Field opposite Shane Smith...allowed two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings, with four walks and five strikeouts...Twins were shut out 3-0, their third time being shut out this season – Paddack started each of the three games...four walks allowed tied his season and career high.

- ♥ Surrendered a home run to Lenyn Sosa off the first pitch of the second inning, the 17th time in his career and second time this season Paddack's allowed a homer on the first pitch of an at-bat (did so on 3/31/25 at Rate Field, Andrew Benintendi was the batter).
- ₱ Walked in a run in the fourth inning after loading the bases on two walks and a single with two outs...marked his first career bases-loaded walk and his 13th bases-loaded RBI allowed.
- ♣ Five strikeouts mark his third consecutive outing with five-or-more strikeouts, a streak Paddack had not yet accomplished in a Twins uniform...had five-or-more strikeouts in three consecu-tive outings seven times while playing for San Diego, including one five-game streak and four four-game streaks.

LET'S LEAVE THE PAST IN THE PAST: Since opening the season with a nine-run, three homer outing in Chicago, Paddack has posted a 3.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 8 ER) with 10 walks and 20 strikeouts in his last five starts...in that span, opponents are slashing .233/.301/.344 with one double and three home runs in 37 at-bats against Paddack...after going 3.0 innings and 4.1 innings in his first two starts, he's now pitched four consecutive 5.0-inning outings.

WIN IT RAINS, IT POURS: Paddack has not won a start in 10 consecutive outings, last earning the victory on June 10, 2024 vs. Colorado (6.1 lP, 6 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 6 K)... over his last 10 starts, he is 0-3 with a 5.68 ERA (44.1 lP, 28 ER), nine home runs allowed, a 1.49 WHIP and a 1.62 strikeout-to-walk

- ratio; Twins are 2-8 with a -20 run differential, three shutouts and three blown leads.

 Prior to his current streak, Paddack had never gone more than six outings without a win; was win-less in six straight from August 30, 2021-April 26, 2022 and five straight from May 14-
 - ◆ In 1989, the Twins lost each of Frank Viola's first seven starts of the season, the only other time in the team's history (1961-present) that Minnesota has lost a full-time starter's first six outings of the season.

FACING BOSTON: In two career starts against the Red Sox, is 1-1 with a 6.48 ERA (8.1 IP, 6 ER), two walks and six strikeouts...last faced Boston on May 3, 2024 at Target Field, earning the victory in Minnesota's 5-2 win; in 6.0 scoreless innings, allowed two hits and a walk, striking out six...gave up one extra-base hit, a first-inning double by Rafael Devers, compared to three RBI extra-base hits in his first start vs. Boston on August 23, 2019 as a Padre at Petco Park (L, 2.1 IP, 7 H, 1 HR, 6 ER, 1 BB, 0 K).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Is making his fourth road start of the season...since the start of 2024, is 1-3 with a 6.79 ERA (54.1 IP, 41 ER) over 11 road starts; Twins are 3-8...in that span, he is averaging 10.10 hits-per-nine innings pitched with a 2.28 strikeout-to-walk ratio; has allowed 11 home runs, a 279 (61-for-219) BAA and an .799 opponent OPS...in 12 home starts since the start of 2024, is 4-3 with a 3.67 ERA (61.1 IP, 25 ER), a 3.53 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .741 opponent OPS.

© In his career, Paddack is 11-14 with a 4.68 ERA (229.0 IP, 119 ER) over 46 road appearances (45 starts)...over that span, road opponents are slashing .247/.293/.445 with 42 home runs, 53 walks and 211 strikeouts against Paddack.

© Paddack is making his first career start at Fenway Park...the Red Sox are one of six American League teams he has yet to face on the road, including Tampa Bay. Toronto, Detroit, Seattle

PLATOON SPLITS: So far this season, left-handed hitters are batting .213 (10-for-47) with three home runs, seven walks, seven strikeouts and seven RBI against Paddack, while righties are batting .293 (17-for-58) with three home runs, seven walks, 15 strikeouts and 11 RBI...since the start of 2024, lefties are slashing .284/.339/.444 with ten home runs and 2.05 strikeouts-per-walk against Paddack, while righties are slashing .271/.313/.442 with 10 home runs and 3.88 strikeouts-per-walk.

- ♠ In a Twins uniform, Paddack has allowed a .288 BAA with 19 walks and 50 strikeouts against lefties and a .271 BAA with 19 walks and 79 strikeouts against righties.

 ♠ In eight career games facing the American League East, Paddack has allowed a .310 BAA with

 one home run, seven walks and 15 strikeouts to lefties, compared to a .321 BAA with six home runs, four walks and 18 strikeouts to righties.

THE ARSENAL: Through six starts in 2025, Paddack has a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here

- ♣ Paddack's fastball usage is up 8.8 percent from 2024 (42.9%), while his combined curveball and slider usage is down 8.1 percent (17.7% slider, 13.6% curve).
 ♣ His whiff rate is 19.2 percent...both his changeup (23.9) and slider (25.0) are inducing whiffs over 20 percent of the time...his 17.5 percent four seam whiff rate is down from 24.3 percent in 2024.
 ♣ Batters are hitting the ball hard 41.4 percent of the time with an average exit velocity of 88.1 mph against Paddack...the hardest hit ball off of him this season was Bo Naylor's 108.8 mph hame run in the second inning on 4/29, blookeasy Neell's season was Bo Naylor's 108.8 mph home run in the second inning on 4/29...Jhonkensy Noel's second-inning single on 4/29 had an exit velocity of 108.4 mph, the hardest non-homer hit off of Paddack this season; Cleveland's remaining two hits from that outing were both singles at 106.7 and 106.2 mph.
