THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4, going 1-3 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Boston...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game homestand with the first of three against the Orioles through Thursday afternoon...after this series, the Twins will host the Giants for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins are 2-2 this season following an off-day.
 ☞ Over the last 13 games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +21 (58-37)... they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

SUNDAY FUNDAY AT FENWAY: The Twins beat the Red Sox on Sunday afternoon at Fenway Park by a score of 5-4, scoring two runs in both the seventh and eighth inning...the win marked the club's fifth series win (5-6-0) and second on the road (2-4-0)...Chris Paddock was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts...Jhoan Duran recorded his fourth save (4th chance) with a scoreless ninth inning...the offense recorded nine hits, two apiece from Ryan Jeffers and Carlos Correa...Jeffers drove in two of the club's five runs...Byron Buxton hit his seventh home run of the season, a leadoff shot off Garret Crochet — 10th leadoff homer of Buck's career.

THE ROYCE ARE BACK IN TOWN: The Twins announced yesterday that they reinstated utility player Willi Castro from the 10-day Injured List and returned infielder Royce Lewis from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List.
 ☞ Castro, who was placed on the Injured List on April 24 with a right oblique strain, played in 18 games for Minnesota prior to sustaining the injury and hit .227 (15-for-66) with six doubles, one home run, five RBI, seven runs scored and three walks.
 ☞ Lewis played in six games on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul, going 4-for-23 with one double, one RBI and three runs scored...he has missed all 35 Twins games this season with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.
 ☞ To make room for Castro and Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned utility player Mickey Gasper and infielder Edouard Julien to St. Paul...Gasper played in seven games during his most recent stint with the Twins, hitting .250 (4-for-16) with one double, three RBI and four runs scored...Julien played in 29 games for the Twins, hitting .198 (18-for-91) with five doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, eight runs scored and 11 walks.

TWINS AND O's: The Twins went 0-6 against the Orioles last season, going 0-3 at Oriole Park from April 15-17 and 0-3 at Target Field from September 27-29...Minnesota has lost 10-straight vs. the Orioles, their longest losing streak to Baltimore since July 21 (G2), 1980-May 17, 1981, when they lost 12...it is their second-longest active losing streak to an opponent, trailing their 11-game losing streak to Atlanta.
 ☞ Minnesota is seeking its first win against the O's since July 1, 2023 at Camden Yards, a 1-0 defeat (Over over Bradish).
 ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with three doubles, one home run, two RBI, a .500 slugging percentage and an .889 OPS in 11 career games against Baltimore.

JEFF YEAH: Ryan Jeffers has posted a 49.3% hard hit percentage this season, which is up 15.5% from last season (33.8%)...it is the sixth-best improvement in baseball, trailing Bryce Turang (18.8%), Gavin Sheets (18.7%), Jorge Polanco (15.9%), Corbin Carroll (15.8%) and Eugenio Suárez (15.6%).
 ☞ He is hitting .379 (11-for-29) and a .724 slugging percentage on breaking pitches this season...his batting average ranks second in baseball (Jonathan Aranda - .409) and his slugging percentage ranks third (Kerry Carpenter - .813 and Aranda - .727).

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: In his last 17 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with seven doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, seven runs scored, seven walks, a .422 on-base percentage, a .564 slugging percentage and a .986 OPS...he has raised his OPS 304 points over this 17-game stretch, from .492 to .796...below are Jeffers ranks among AL catchers (min. 100 PA):

BUCK NASTY: Over his last 19 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 10 times and is hitting .316 (25-for-79) with two doubles, two triples, five home runs, 12 RBI, 14 runs scored, a .582 slugging percentage and a .916 OPS in that span.
 ☞ He has reached safely in each of his last 11 games, tied for sixth-longest of his career...his career-long for an on-base streak is 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023.
 ☞ His 12 multi-hit games on the season are tied for sixth-most in the AL.
 ☞ Buck enters today with 140 career home runs, needing one to tie Michael Cuddyer for 14th on the Twins all-time list...13th place is Joe Mauer with 143.

HARRI THE HITMAN: Harrison Bader has hit safely in a season-long eight consecutive games, the longest for a Twin this season...during the streak, he is hitting .429 (12-for-28) with three doubles, two RBI, three walks, a .484 on-base percentage, a .536 slugging percentage and a 1.020 OPS...the streak is tied for Bader's second-longest of his career, his best being an 11-game streak, from May 17 (G2)-31, 2022 with St. Louis.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Today marks the sixth time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 2-3 against lefty starters, their wins coming against Yusei Kikuchi (4/26 vs. LAA) and Garrett Crochet (Sunday at BOS), and their three losses against Martin Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC) and Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL).
 ☞ In their last 10 games, Twins are slashing .321/.394/.482 (.876 OPS) against lefties.
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with two home runs, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.091 OPS against lefties in 2025.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with two doubles, one home run, a .611 slugging percentage and a .944 OPS against lefties this season.

LIFE OF PABLO: Last pitched on April 30 at Progressive Park vs. the Guardians, opposite Luis Ortiz... allowed two runs on four hits, no walks and six strikeouts over 6.1 quality innings...threw 1-2-3 innings from 2nd-5th innings...was dealt his second loss of the season in Minnesota's 2-4 defeat. ☞ His two runs allowed came off a throwing error from López to first, scoring José Ramirez and a home run from Bo Naylor off Brock Stewart, scoring Carlos Santana, an inherited run.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on April 25 vs. the Angels at Target Field, opposite Kyle Hendricks...was López's first outing in the majors after coming off the IL...allowed two runs on five hits, two walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings...earned his second win of the season - and second in a row - in Minnesota's 11-4 victory...it was the team's first time this season scoring 10-plus runs in a game... seven marked the largest margin of victory for the Twins this season. ☞ López's two runs came off an RBI single from Jo Adell, scoring Nolan Scahnuel in the second and an RBI single from Mike Trout, scoring Jorge Soler.

CLEAN BILL OF HEALTH: Pitched on April 19 for the Triple-A St. Paul Saints on a rehab assignment against the Iowa Cubs at Principal Park...allowed one run off three hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...took the loss in St. Paul's 0-1 defeat. ☞ Until this season, López had not missed a major league game in three years, pitching 32 games in 2022, 2023 and 2024. ☞ His last appearance in the minors was in 2021 when he was on rehabilitation assignment with the Triple-A Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp.

OPPOSITE THE O'S: In four career starts against Baltimore, López is 2-1, posting a 1.59 ERA (2.22 IP, 4 ER), with six walks and 28 strikeouts...allowed four runs off 13 hits (3 HR). ☞ Went 0-1 in two starts against the Orioles in 2024, posting a 2.31 ERA (11.2 IP, 3 ER), with three walks and 15 strikeouts...his last outing against the team was September 27, 2024 at Target Field where he allowed three runs off eight hits (2 HR), with three walks and 15 strikeouts. ☞ Has allowed his lowest opponent batting average (.159) and lowest ERA (1.59) to the Orioles among teams he has faced at least twice, and second lowest all-time, behind only the Marlins (.136 BAA, 1.29 ERA) whom he has faced just once. ☞ Has allowed one home run in each of his last three starts against the O's.

ACE UP OUR SLEEVE: Since joining the Twins, López has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2023:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 14-8 with a 3.85 ERA (196.1 IP, 84 ER), 10.22 K/9, 1.97 BB/9 and 0.96 HR/9 in 33 starts at home, compared to 16-12 with a 3.50 ERA (223.2 IP, 87 ER), 9.86 K/9, 2.13 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 in 38 road starts. ☞ In his last five starts at home, dating back to August 24, 2024, López has gone 4-1, posting a 1.11 ERA (32.1 IP, 4 ER), with seven walks and 36 strikeouts; compared to 1-3, 4.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 12 ER), with three walks and 23 strikeouts in his last five road starts. ☞ Pablo is 0-1 in a single start against Baltimore at Target Field, allowing two runs on six hits, with three walks and eight strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through five starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .286/.310/.429 in 56 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .154/.185/.192 in 52 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 88.5 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 41.3 compared to righties' 87.1 mph and 25.0 percent. ☞ Has a whiff rate of 19.8 and put-away percentage of 18.2 vs. lefties; compared to 27.2 percent and 19.3 percent against righties. ☞ His 41.3% hard hit rate against lefties is significantly higher than in previous years, his average from 2018-2024 was 32.8%; while his 25.0% hard hit rate against lefties is significantly lower than in previous years, with the average being 35.9%.

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: With runners in scoring position, López has a .245 (178-for-727) opponent batting average...with a runner on third, he puts up a .211 (19-for-90) BAA and with runners on second and third, he allows just a .185 (10-for-54) BAA.

THE ARSENAL: López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 40% of the time...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

☞ Currently ranks in the 92nd percentile for breaking run value and 89th for fastball run value; compared to seventh percentile for offspeed run value. ☞ Ranks in the 91st percentile for extension, 95th for BB % and 90th for chase %.

PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT: Pablo historically pitches better the higher his pitch count is...when on pitch 101+, he allows just a .194 (7-for-36) opponent batting average, with five walks, 13 strikeouts and no home runs...on pitch 76-100, he has a .231 (150-for-650) BAA, with 47 walks, 181 strikeouts and 16 home runs...compared to pitch 1-25 where he allows a .262 (237-for-905) BAA, 54 walks, 230 strikeouts and 40 home runs.

Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE: This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, made his third career Opening Day start, became the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79).
- In 2024, recorded his 800th career strikeout on June 6 at New York-AL, fanning Gleyber Torres in the second inning.
- Tied career high and set 2024 season high with 14 strikeouts on June 23 at Oakland (6.0 IP)...also pitched 8.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and one walk during the start, earning the win in a 3-0 Twins victory.
- Earned 50th career win in 150th career start on August 12, 2024 vs. Kansas City, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts.
- 2023 recipient of Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" Award and Carl R. Pohlad Outstanding Community Service Award.
- Won both 2023 Postseason starts, allowing one run in 12.2 total innings and helping Twins snap 18-game Postseason losing streak with a G1 win in the ALWCWS vs. Toronto.
- In 2023, earned first All-Star selection and finished seventh in AL Cy Young Award voting after posting career highs in innings (194.0) and strikeouts (234).
- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as No. 2 starter for Miami.
