THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (1-3 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Boston), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a win over the Orioles last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three against the Orioles and finish the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, the Twins will host the Giants for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Over the last 14 games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +29 (67-38)... they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

TWINS PUT THE 'O' IN OFFENSE: The Twins beat the Orioles last night at Target Field by a score of 9-1, scoring five runs in the third inning and four in the seventh...Pablo López (3-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and 11 strikeouts (18 total batters faced) — 10th career double-digit strikeout total and three short of career-high...Twins pitchers struck out 17 Orioles, setting a season-high...the offense recorded 10 hits and were led by Carlos Correa, who went 3-for-4 with three RBI...Byron Buxton went 2-for-4 with a double, a home run and four RBI...last night's victory made the Twins 4-1 in their last five series openers after starting the season 0-7 in such instances.

BIRD'S EYE VIEW: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the second of six games this season...last night's win snapped a 10-game losing streak to Baltimore, beating the Orioles for the first time since July 1, 2023 at Camden Yards, a 1-0 defeat (Ober over Bradish).
 ☞ Prior to last night's nine-run output, the Twins had scored 22 total runs in their previous 11 games vs. Baltimore (2.0 R/G).
 ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with three doubles, one home run, two RBI, a .472 slugging percentage and an .847 OPS in 12 career games against Baltimore...he has reached safely via hit, walk or HBP in 11 of those 12.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .297 (33-for-111) with seven doubles, six home runs, 21 RBI, eight walks, a .355 on-base percentage, a .523 slugging percentage and an .877 OPS in his last 30 games vs. the Orioles (since May of 2017).

ALSO: Over the 19 games, he has raised his batting average 80 points, from .153 to .233.

JEFFIN' A: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.009 OPS in his last 12 games.
 ☞ He has posted a 48.7% hard hit percentage this season, which is up 14.9% from last season (33.8%)...it is the fourth-best improvement in baseball, trailing Gavin Sheets (18.7%), Bryce Turang (17.9%) and Corbin Carroll (15.7%).
 ☞ He is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with a .677 slugging percentage on breaking pitches this season...his batting average ranks fourth in baseball and his slugging percentage ranks seventh.

BUCK NASTY: Over his last 20 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 11 times and is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with three doubles, two triples, six home runs, 16 RBI, 16 runs scored, a .627 slugging percentage and a .967 OPS in that span.
 ☞ He has reached safely in each of his last 12 games, sixth-longest of his career...his career-long for an on-base streak is 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023.
 ☞ His 13 multi-hit games on the season are tied for fourth-most in the AL.

BYE BYE BYRON: Byron Buxton hit his team-leading eighth home run of the season last night...eight home runs are tied for 10th-most in the AL...he has homered in two-straight...his career-long for a homer streak is three, done three times (2022 and twice in 2020)...last night's homer was the 141st of his career, tying Michael Cuddyer for 14th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

MAJ-'O'-RITY RULES: Twins are seeking their sixth series win today...they are 5-6-0 in series play, going 3-2-0 at home and 2-4-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 4-2-0 in their last six.
 ☞ Minnesota's last series win over Baltimore came June 30-July 2, 2023 (2 of 3) at Camden Yards...their last series win over the Orioles at Target Field came July 1-3, 2022 (2 of 3).

LEADERS IN THE COMMUNITY: Twins began their week of service today with a food packing event at Target Field...earlier this afternoon, Twins players, coaches (and significant others), clubhouse personnel and front office staff joined local nonprofit Every Meal to pack meal kits for kids and families in the Twin Cities metro area...believed to be MLB's first-ever coordinated effort of its kind across an entire organization when it debuted in 2022, the Minnesota Twins Week of Service involves players, coaches, clubhouse personnel and front office staff from the Twins and each of Minnesota's minor league affiliates — including the organization's Florida Complex and Dominican Republic Baseball Academy — volunteering in their respective local communities with partners of their choosing; the Twins will also make a donation to a nonprofit of each affiliate's choice.
 ☞ Tomorrow, players, coaches and staff from the Twins' Triple-A affiliate, the St. Paul Saints, will partner with Playworks Minnesota to visit Benjamin E. Mays IB World School, an elementary school in St. Paul, during their recess time and facilitate inclusive, educational and fun play...a partner of the Saints and the Twins Community Fund, Playworks focuses on the life skills and life lessons kids can learn through play.
 ☞ Also tomorrow, in partnership with the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board and the St. Paul Parks and Recreation Commission, the Minnesota Twins Community Fund will host its annual Nike RBI Glove Giveaway, in which Twins players and staff distribute thousands of free gloves to young athletes...this year's events will take place from 4-5 pm at Bryant Park in Minneapolis (with Twins players and a cookout) and at Rice and Arlington Field in St. Paul.

LAST START: Last pitched on May 1 against the Guardians at Progressive Field, opposite Ben Lively...did not factor into Minnesota's 3-4 defeat...allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR), with a career-high five walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...permitted an RBI single from Kyle Manzardo in the first, scoring Gabriel Arias who walked with one out, and a solo homer from Jhonkensy Noel in the fourth.

⚡ Has allowed a home run in each of his last five outings, the longest streak of his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on April 26 vs. the Angels at Target Field, opposite Yusei Kikuchi...notched the win in Minnesota's 5-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and a season-high seven strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work...only run allowed was a solo homer from Zach Neto in the third inning...after Neto's homer, Woods Richardson went on to retire eight-straight batters in the through the sixth inning.

⚡ Fanned Nolan Schanuel in the fourth inning for his 150th career strikeout.

HERE TO STAY: Since April 13, 2024, Simeon Woods Richardson is third on the Twins staff in starts (33) trailing Bailey Ober (36) and Pablo López (35)...when the Twins optioned Louis Varland to Triple-A St. Paul on April 21, 2024, SWR replaced him as the number five starter and has claimed the spot ever since...here are some of his numbers since joining the Twins' starting rotation compared to other starters:

ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT: Is facing the Baltimore Orioles for the first time in his career...marks his second new opponent faced this season (also, Los Angeles-AL)...is 6-4 when facing an opponent for the first time and 2-1 when facing opponents for the first time at Target Field.

⚡ SWR has posted a 6.43 ERA (14.0 IP, 10 ER), with five walks and 10 strikeouts in three career starts against American League East opponents...AL East batters are hitting .310 (18-for-58) against him...both his ERA and BAA against the AL East are his second-highest against any division, behind the National League East (seven games/five starts, 6.59 ERA, .313 BAA).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Woods Richardson has gone 3-2 with a 4.25 ERA (78.1 IP, 37 ER), 9.08 K/9, 3.22 BB/9 and 1.15 HR/9 in 16 games (15 starts) at home compared to 4-6 with a 4.31 ERA (94.0 IP, 45 ER), 7.28 K/9, 3.45 BB/9 and 1.24 HR/9 in 20 road games (19 starts).

⚡ SWR is 2-1 in his last five outings at home, posting a 5.68 ERA (19.0 IP, 12 R), with seven walks and 20 strikeouts; compared to 0-2, a 4.63 ERA (23.1 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 24 strikeouts in his last five outings on the road.

⚡ He is 2-0, posting a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), with no walks and 12 strikeouts in two starts so far this season at Target Field...opponents are hitting .225 (9-for-40) against SWR at Target Field.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through six games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .333/.386/.529 in 51 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .226/.314/.403 in 62 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.9 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 46.3 compared to righties' 92.7 mph and 51.2 percent.

⚡ Has a whiff rate of 23.8 percent and put-away percentage of 16.7 against lefties vs. 25.8 percent and 17.2 percent vs. righties.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

⚡ He currently ranks in baseball's third percentile for barrel percentage, the fifth percentile for max exit velocity, sixth percentile for xSLG and the 10th percentile for hard hit percentage.

FASTBALL FIASCO: Through Woods Richardson's five starts this season, opponents are hitting his 4-seam fastball more often than in previous seasons with a higher slugging percentage, hard hit percentage and average exit velocity...here are some of his four-seam fastball numbers since his major league debut in 2022:

⚡ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 4-seam fastballs this season, SWR's 63.2 percent hard hit rate is tied with Ryan Pepiot for the highest in baseball.

BETTER AHEAD: SWR historically pitches better when he is ahead in the count...in his career, he has 83 strikeouts and a .192 opponent batting average, .300 slugging percentage and .493 OPS when he is ahead, vs. 34 strikeouts and a .328 opponent batting average, .538 slugging percentage and 1.034 OPS when he is behind.

NIGHTMARES In 18 career night games (17 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 5.01 ERA and a .263 opponent batting average, .416 slugging percentage, with 34 walks, 67 strikeouts and 11 home runs; compared to a 3.61 ERA, .241 opponent batting average, .391 slugging percentage with 30 walks, 88 strikeouts and 12 home runs in 18 day games (17 starts)...so far this season, SWR is 0-2 in night games, posting a 5.79 ERA (14.0 IP, 9 ER), with six walks and 14 strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 2-2, 2.93 ERA // CAREER: 35-28, 3.84 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is set to start tomorrow's series finale vs. the Orioles...last started on May 2 against Boston...did not factor into Minnesota's 1-6 defeat...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...he is 0-1 in three career starts against Baltimore, posting a 4.50 ERA (16.0 IP, 8 ER), with four walks and 20 strikeouts...has allowed a .213 (13-for-61) opponent batting average...Ryan is 1-1 in three starts at home so far this season, allowing five runs on 12 hits (2.65 ERA), with three walks and 25 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, pitched a career-high 147.0 professional innings (MiLB and MLB).
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
