**THE TWINS:** After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (1-3 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Boston), the Twins began their six-game homestand with consecutive wins over the Orioles the last two nights...today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Orioles...tomorrow night, the Twins will begin a three-game weekend series against the Giants.  
 ☞ Twins are 10-5 in their last 15 games.  
 ☞ Over the last 15 games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +32 (72-40)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.  
 ☞ Twins are seeking their first five-game winning streak since July 31-August 5, 2024 (also 5).

**TWINS TAKE GAME 2 OVER O's:** The Twins beat the Orioles last night at Target Field by a score of 5-2...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout...Danny Coulombe (1.0 IP), Louis Varland (0.1 IP), Brock Stewart (1.0 IP), Griffin Jax (1.0 IP) and Joao Duran (1.0 IP) combined for 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, highlighted by Byron Buxton, who went 2-for-4 with a home run and three RBI.

**BIRD'S EYE VIEW:** The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the third of six games this season...these two will meet for three games next week at Camden Yards, from Tuesday-Thursday.

☞ Twins seeking their first three-game winning streak against the O's since March 31, 2018-May 31, 2021, when they won 16-straight over Baltimore.

☞ Twins have scored 14 runs in these two games against the Orioles after scoring 22 runs in their previous 11 games against Baltimore, entering this series.

☞ Christian Vázquez has 76 career hits and 20 doubles in 88 career games vs. the Orioles, both his most against any opponent.

**BULLSEYE:** Twins are 9-1 in their last 10 home games...in those 10 games, they have posted a run differential of +33 (55-22)...during the 10 games, Twins batters are hitting .289 (93-for-322) with 10 home runs and 5.5 runs-per-game...meanwhile, Twins pitchers have posted a 2.22 ERA (89.0 IP, 22 ER) with a .222 opponent batting average and a 10.7 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio.

☞ The last time the Twins had nine wins in a 10-game span at home was in September of 2020.

**BUCK TRUCK, FULL STEAM:** Over his last 21 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 12 times and is hitting .333 (29-for-87) with three doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 17 runs scored, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.003 OPS in that span.

☞ He has reached safely in each of his last 13 games, sixth-longest of his career...his career-long for an on-base streak is 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023.

☞ His 14 multi-hit games on the season are tied for sixth-most in baseball.

**BYE BYE BYRON:** Byron Buxton hit his team-leading ninth home run of the season last night...nine home runs are tied for fifth-most in the AL...he has homered in three-straight...it matches his career-long for a homer streak, done three times previously (2022 and twice in 2020)...last night's homer was the 142nd of his career, passing Michael Cuddyer and moving into 14th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

**HARRI THE HITMAN:** Harrison Bader has hit safely in a season-long nine consecutive games, the longest for a Twin this season...during the streak, he is hitting .448 (13-for-29) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, three walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.155 OPS...the streak is Bader's second-longest of his career, his best being an 11-game streak, from May 17 (G2)-31, 2022 with St. Louis.

**SWEEPING SUCCESS:** Minnesota is seeking its second sweep of the season today...the other came April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field...Twins recorded five sweeps all of 2024.

☞ Their last sweep of the Orioles came in three games at Target Field from May 24-26, 2021.

☞ The Twins have twice this season entered a series finale with a chance to sweep...first time was a loss in game three against Chicago-AL on April 24 and the other was the win on April 27 mentioned above.

**FOR THE COMMUNITY:** Twins began their Week of Service yesterday with a food packing event at Target Field...a few details on today's events:

☞ Players, coaches and staff from Triple-A St. Paul, will partner with Playworks Minnesota to visit Benjamin E. Mays IB World School, an elementary school in St. Paul, during their recess time and facilitate inclusive, educational and fun play...a partner of the Saints and the Twins Community Fund, Playworks focuses on the life skills and life lessons kids can learn through play.

☞ In partnership with the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board and the St. Paul Parks and Recreation Commission, the Minnesota Twins Community Fund will host its annual Nike RBI Glove Giveaway, in which Twins players and staff distribute 3,000 free gloves to young athletes...Tommy Watkins, Royce Lewis and Bailey Ober are scheduled to attend...this year's events will take place from 4-5 pm at Bryant Park in Minneapolis (with Twins players and a cookout) and at Rice and Arlington Field in St. Paul.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1984, Twins rookie Kirby Puckett hit four singles in his first major league game, becoming the ninth player in history to collect four hits in his first nine-inning game...the Twins ended up winning 5-0 over the Angels, getting a homer from current Twins.TV analyst Tim Laudner.

- ☞ Making eighth start of the season and 96th career start...fourth start against the Orioles.
- ☞ Ober is 1-1 in three career starts against Baltimore, posting a 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER), with three walks, 17 strikeouts and a .175 (11-for-63) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Looks to earn his fifth consecutive win today...would be the first time in his career he would have a five-plus win streak.

**IT AIN'T OBER TIL IT'S OBER:** Last pitched on May 3 at vs. the Red Sox, opposite Hunter Dobbins...earned his fourth win of the season in Minnesota's 4-3 victory...first time earning four consecutive wins since July 28-August 9, 2024, and fifth time in his career...also recorded his fifth consecutive quality start, first time doing so since his career-best 11-game quality start streak from June 16-August 20, 2024...allowed one run on seven hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...lone run allowed came off an RBI single from Rafael Devers in the third, scoring Jarren Duran.

- ☞ First time in his career Ober has allowed seven-plus hits in three consecutive starts.
- ☞ In his first outing of the season, Bailey allowed eight runs in 2.2 innings...in the six games since, he has allowed eight runs in 36.0 innings.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on April 22 at Progressive Field vs. the Guardians, opposite Gavin Williams...garnered his third win of the season in Minnesota's 11-1 victory...first win on the road since July 28, 2024...allowed one run on eight hits in his season-high 7.2 innings, with no walks and two strikeouts...lone run allowed came off an RBI single from Jhonkensy Noel in the fifth, scoring Gabriel Arias.

- ☞ Recorded a career-high 10 groundouts...registered his first 1-2-3 first inning this season...recorded his most pitches (102) and strikes thrown (73) so far this season.
- ☞ Surpassed 500 career innings pitched, becoming the 11th Twins pitcher to do in his first 94 games.

**OPPOSITE THE ORIOLES:** Ober is 1-1 in three career starts against Baltimore, posting a 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER), with three walks and 17 strikeouts...has a .175 (11-for-63) opponent batting average...this is his third lowest batting average among opponents he has faced at least three times, behind the Toronto Blue Jays (.160) and the Athletics (.174).

- ☞ Faced Baltimore one time in 2024 where he was dealt the loss at Target Field in Minnesota's 2-6 defeat on September 29...allowed three runs (1 HR) on five hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
- ☞ Ober is 4-7 in 14 career starts against American League East opponents, posting a 2.54 ERA (78.0 IP, 22 ER), with 18 walks, 80 strikeouts, a .194 (55-for-283) opponent batting average and a .570 OPS...his ERA, BAA and OPS are his lowest among all divisions.

**LEADING THE PACK:** Since debuting with the Twins, Ober has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2021:

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.87 ERA (249.0 IP, 107 ER), 9.33 K/9, 2.20 BB/9 and 1.63 HR/9 in 48 games (47 starts) at home compared to 13-14 with a 3.80 ERA (265.1 IP, 112 ER), 8.85 K/9, 1.70 BB/9 and 1.26 HR/9 in 49 road starts.

- ☞ Ober is 2-0 in three starts at home so far this season, posting a 2.76 ERA (16.1 IP, 5 ER), with three walks and 16 strikeouts...has a .258 (16-for-62) opponent batting average.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through seven starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .299/.333/.403 in 77 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .266/.306/.468 in 79 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.3 mph and a whiff rate of 18.9 compared to righties' 92.0 mph and 30.1 percent.

- ☞ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at an all-time low 25.8 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 56.7 percent.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 38% of the time...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He currently ranks seventh in baseball for extension...ranks in the bottom two percent for max exit velocity at 116.6.
- ☞ His 4-seamer and slider strikeout percentages are at all-time lows, at 12.5 percent and 13.9 percent respectively.

**THRILL OF THE CHASE:** Per Baseball Savant, Ober owns a 34.3 chase percentage this season, ranking in the 90th percentile...ranks fourth on the Twins pitching staff, behind Griffin Jax (42.2), Danny Coulombe (39.4) and Louis Varland (35.8).

**UNDER PRESSURE:** This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .250 (7-for-28), with two home runs, three walks and seven strikeouts; with runners in scoring position and two outs, opponents are hitting .071 (1-for-14) with two walks and three strikeouts.

**FIXING THE FASTBALL:** Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through seven starts this season, Ober has substantially lowered hard hit percentage and slugging percentage...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:

**CAREER NOTES**

- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and third in career.
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeout totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
