**THE TWINS:** Began their six-game homestand with a three-game sweep of the Orioles from Tuesday-Thursday...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Giants and complete the series on Sunday afternoon.  
 ☞ Twins have gone just 2-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16) and 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20).

**TWINS COMPLETE SWEEP OVER OS:** The Twins beat the Orioles yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-2 at Target Field, completing their second sweep of the season...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...Cole Sands (1.0 IP), Justin Topa (1.0 IP), Griffin Jax (1.0 IP) and Jhoan Duran (1.0 IP) combined for 4.0 scoreless innings, with two hits, no walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded just five hits, three coming from Ty France, who drove in two runs...Trevor Larnach hit his fifth home run of the season.

**CATCH (APRIL) 22:** Twins are 11-5 in their last 16 games since April 22...since that date, only Kansas City (14-2) and Detroit (11-4) have won as many games in all of baseball.  
 ☞ Over the last 16 games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +35 (77-42)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.  
 ☞ Last season, the Twins started 7-13 through April 21, then went 63-40 in their next 103 games (through August 17), the most wins in baseball in that span.

**FIVE ON IT:** The Twins enter tonight's game with a five-game winning streak, their last loss coming last Friday at Boston, a 6-1 defeat...their last five-game winning streak came July 31-August 5, 2024...their last six-game winning streak came June 12-18, 2024 (also 6).

**MY GIANT:** The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this week...the Twins are 11-13 all-time against San Francisco, going 4-2 at Target Field, 6-9 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome...dating back to June of 2017, the Twins have won seven of their last 12 over the Giants.  
 ☞ The last time these two teams met was for three games at Oracle Park, from July 12-14, 2024, as the Giants took games one and three.  
 ☞ The last time these two played at Target Field was from May 22-24, 2023 as the Twins won just the third of three games.  
 ☞ The 24 games played against the Giants are tied for the Twins' second-fewest in their history (since 1961) with Washington and Colorado, trailing Miami (22).  
 ☞ Carlos Correa has hit safely in six-straight games against the Giants...in 15 career games vs. San Francisco, he is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with three doubles, one home run, eight RBI and an .808 OPS.  
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with two home runs and a .942 OPS in eight career games vs. SF.  
 ☞ Trevor Larnach is 4-for-8 (.500) in three career games against the Giants.

**BUCK NATIONAL:** Byron Buxton is 9-for-22 (.409) in his last five IL games...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play:

**BULLSEYE:** Twins are 12-6 through 18 home games this season, including a record of 10-1 in their last 11 here...their one loss was a 3-0 defeat by the White Sox on April 24...in those 11 games, they have posted a run differential of +36 (60-24).  
 ☞ The last time the Twins had 10 wins in an 11-game span at home was in September of 2020...it was also the last time they had 11 home wins in a 12-game span.

**BUCK TRUCK, FULL STEAM:** Over his last 22 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 12 times and is hitting .326 (29-for-89) with three doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 19 runs scored, a .640 slugging percentage and a .995 OPS in that span.  
 ☞ He has reached safely in each of his last 14 games tied for fifth-longest of his career...his career-long for an on-base streak is 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023.  
 ☞ His 14 multi-hit games on the season are tied for sixth-most in baseball.

**TOP JEFF:** Ryan Jeffers is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .375 on-base percentage, a .545 slugging percentage and a .920 OPS in his last 13 games.  
 ☞ He has posted a 46.8% hard hit percentage this season, which is up 13.0% from last season (33.8%)...it is the six-best improvement in baseball, trailing Gavin Sheets (18.3%), Brice Turang (17.9%), Corbin Carroll (15.8%), Eugenio Suárez (14.4%) and George Springer (14.0%).  
 ☞ He is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with a .656 slugging percentage on breaking pitches this season...his batting average ranks sixth in baseball and his slugging percentage ranks 10th.

**HARRI THE HITMAN:** Harrison Bader went 0-for-1 with two walks yesterday, snapping his hitting streak at nine games, the second longest of his career...in his last 10 games, he is hitting .433 (13-for-30) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, four walks, a .514 on-base percentage, a .633 slugging percentage and a 1.148 OPS.  
 ☞ He has posted a .724 slugging percentage against breaking pitches this season, fourth-highest in baseball, trailing Shohei Ohtani (.739), Ryan O'Hearn (.731) and Jonathan Aranda (.731).

**IMPRESSIVE 'PENMANSHIP:** The Twins bullpen completed the three-game series against Baltimore pitching 12.1 scoreless innings...over the three games they allowed eight hits, walked two and struck out 17 (12.4 K/9.0 IP).  
 ☞ In their last 17 games, since April 20, they have gone 4-3, 2.80 ERA (54.2 IP, 17 ER) with six saves (7 opps), 15 walks, 68 strikeouts and a .218 opponent batting average...in 21 games prior to April 20, they were 3-8, 3.83 ERA (82.1 IP, 35 ER) with 29 walks, 81 strikeouts and a .229 opponent batting average, including five blown saves.

- ⚔ Making his eighth start of the season and 90th of his career (93rd appearance)...did not factor into the decision of his last start on May 4 at Boston (5.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 2 BB, 2 K).
- ⚔ Last winning decision came on June 10, 2024 vs. Colorado, 11 starts ago.
- ⚔ Is 1-1 in eight career starts against San Francisco, posting a 3.53 ERA (35.2 IP, 14 ER) with seven homers, five walks and 44 strikeouts...has never faced the Giants at Target Field.
- ⚔ In three home starts this season, Paddack is 0-2 with a 3.86 ERA (14.0 IP, 6 ER), one home run, eight walks and 12 strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision of his last start on May 4 at Fenway Park opposite Garrett Crochet; Twins won the game 5-4, their first victory in a game that Paddack started since July 8, 2024 at Chicago-AL...allowed three runs on five hits over 5.0 innings of work, with two walks and two strikeouts...retired the final eight batters he faced in order, from the third-fifth inning.

- ⚔ Walked Alex Bregman to lead off the third inning, who later scored on a Romy González sacrifice fly...was the seventh time this season that a runner has scored after being walked by Paddack (3x on 3/31, 1x on 4/6, 4/12, 4/24, 5/4).
- ⚔ Marked his fifth-straight 5.0-inning outing, the fifth time in his career with such a streak...career-high nine-straight 5.0-plus inning outings was accomplished between April 16-May 30, 2024, the only other time he's done so with the Twins.
- ⚔ Has now gone 11-straight starts without a winning decision, dating back to his no-decision on June 16, 2024 (Game 2) vs. the Athletics...in that span, is 0-3 with a 5.66 ERA (49.1 IP, 31 ER), nine home runs, 23 walks and 36 strikeouts; his run support average is 3.83 while the Twins have gone 3-8.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started in Cleveland on April 29 opposite Tanner Bibee...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off loss...allowed one run on four hits, including a solo homer, with one walk and two strikeouts...Bo Naylor's third-inning home run marked Paddack's 11th career start in which his lone run allowed came via a solo home run...76 pitches marks his lowest pitch count in a 4.0-plus inning outing since May 25, 2024 vs. Texas (73 pitches in 5.0 IP).

**FACING THE GIANTS:** Is facing the San Francisco Giants for the ninth time in his career...is 1-1 with a 3.53 ERA (35.2 IP, 14 ER), seven home runs, five walks and 44 strikeouts...since joining the Twins, his only outing against the Giants came on July 14, 2024 at Oracle Park; allowed two runs, one earned, on five hits over 5.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 walk-off loss.

- ⚔ Since 2019, Giants batters are hitting .266 (37-for-139) against Paddack, with a .292 on-base percentage and a .774 OPS...on balls put in play, they are hitting .341.

**WELL HELLO, OLD FOE:** The former San Diego Padre is facing the National League West for the sixth time (fifth start) since becoming a Twin in 2022 and the 31st time in his career...here are some of his numbers against the NL West with San Diego, Minnesota and overall in his career:

**ALSO:** Among Twins pitchers with at least three starts against the NL West since 2022, Paddack's 2.35 ERA and 8.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio trail only Chris Archer (1.38 ERA, 11.00 K/BB)...among such pitchers, his 1.22 WHIP ranks sixth while his one home run allowed is tied for the best with Dylan Bundy (3 starts) and Simeon Woods Richardson (3 starts).

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Is making his fourth home start of the season...is 0-2 with a 3.86 ERA (14.0 IP, 6 ER), one home run, eight walks and 12 strikeouts at Target Field, compared to 0-1 with a 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP, 14 ER), five home runs, eight walks and 12 strikeouts on the road...since joining the Twins in 2022, is 4-4 with a 4.18 ERA (75.1 IP, 35 ER) over 17 appearances at home (15 starts)...in that span, is averaging 10.51 hits-per-nine innings with a 1.42 WHIP at Target Field, compared to 9.54 H/9 and a 1.35 WHIP in 15 road appearances (14 starts).

- ⚔ In his career, Paddack is 16-13 with a 4.22 ERA (222.0 IP, 104 ER) over 45 home appearances (43 starts)...over that span, visiting batters are slashing .257/.298/.418 with 31 home runs, 50 walks and 228 strikeouts against Paddack.
- ⚔ Paddack is making his first career start against the Giants at Target Field...while with San Diego, he was decision-less in two home starts against San Francisco, posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts; the Padres went 2-0 in Paddack's starts at Petco Park.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** So far this season, left-handed hitters are batting .218 (12-for-55) with three home runs, eight walks, seven strikeouts and seven RBI against Paddack, while righties are batting .294 (20-for-68) with three home runs, eight walks, 17 strikeouts and 14 RBI...since joining the Twins in 2022, lefties are slashing .287/.337/.449 with 11 home runs and 2.50 strikeouts-per-walk against Paddack, while righties are slashing .272/.309/.419 with 10 home runs and 4.05 strikeouts-per-walk.

- ⚔ In 30 career games facing the National League West, Paddack has allowed a .246 BAA (75-for-205) with 12 home runs, 19 walks and 73 strikeouts to lefties, compared to a .273 BAA (66-for-242) with nine home runs, seven walks and 76 strikeouts to righties.
- ⚔ San Francisco's left-handed hitters have slashed .291/.317/.570 with five home runs against Paddack, while righties have slashed .233/.258/.367 with two home runs against him.

**THE ARSENAL:** So far in 2025, Paddack has relied on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

- ⚔ Paddack has a 29.6 percent chase rate (MLB's 64th percentile), a 19.3 percent whiff rate (13th percentile), a 16.6 percent strikeout rate (15th percentile) and an 11.0 percent walk rate (27th percentile).
- ⚔ Batters are barreling the ball 10.5 percent of the time and hitting the ball hard 43.8 percent of the time with an average exit velocity of 90.6 mph...the hardest ball hit off Paddack this season was Bo Naylor's 108.8 mph home run on April 29 (395 feet).
- ⚔ Paddack has not thrown a pitch over 96.0 mph since April 18 at Atlanta...his fastest pitch since was a 95.7 mph four-seamer (ball) to Rafael Devers on May 4 at Fenway...of his 94 pitches thrown on May 4, two were above 95.0 mph (95.5 and 95.7) and ten were between 94.0-94.9 mph; his fastest non-pitch thrown that wasn't a four-seamer was a 89.5 mph slider (ball) to Rafael Devers in the first inning.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 2-2, 2.93 ERA // CAREER: 35-28, 3.84 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is set to start tomorrow evening's game against the Giants at Target Field...Ryan missed his originally scheduled start on May 8 vs. Baltimore due to an illness...last outing came on May 2 at Fenway Park in Boston; did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-1 loss, allowing one run on four hits (1 HR), with one walk and eight strikeouts...in three home starts this season, is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (17.0 IP, 5 ER), three walks and 25 strikeouts...is 2-1 with a 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER), eight walks and 18 strikeouts in three career starts against San Francisco.
