**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2 on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay, followed by a win last night in Seattle...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three at Seattle through tomorrow...following tomorrow afternoon's finale, the Twins will travel to Sacramento to play the A's for four games from Monday-Thursday.  
 ☞ The Twins have won 18 of their last 23 games overall, including nine of their last 12 road games.  
 ☞ Twins are 24-10 in their last 34 games since April 22, tied with Detroit (24-11), for the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

**GOODNIGHT, SLEEP WELL IN SEATTLE:** The Twins beat the Mariners last night at T-Mobile Park by a score of 12-6 in 10 innings, making them 3-3 in extra-innings...they scored three runs in the ninth inning, marking their first win this season when trailing after eight (1-20)...they scored six runs in the top of the 10th inning, their most runs in an extra frame since scoring seven in the top of the 10th inning on June 9, 2024 at Pittsburgh...also became the only MLB team in the modern era to be down by three-plus runs with two outs in the ninth inning and end up winning but six-plus runs (*OptaStats*)...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits in a career-high 7.0 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts...all four runs off Matthews crossed in the first inning on four of the first five batters — a three-run homer by Cal Raleigh and a solo home run by Randy Arozarena...the offense recorded 14 hits, four from Trevor Larnach, who hit his eighth home run of the season and drove in four runs, both his hits and RBI tied single-game career-highs...Willi Castro recorded his second career multi-homer (3, 4) game of the season...first Twin to homer twice from the nine-hole since Michael A. Taylor on August 24, 2023 vs. Texas.

**MARINER MOOSE** 🐻 **MINNESOTA MOOSE:** The Twins have returned outfielder Matt Wallner from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Wallner, who has missed the club's last 38 games with a left hamstring strain, played in six games with Triple-A St. Paul on rehab assignment, hitting .320 (8-for-25) with one double, five home runs, 13 RBI, two walks and a 1.330 OPS...prior to landing on the Injured List, Wallner hit .263 (15-for-57) with five doubles, two triples, one home run, three RBI, nine walks, seven runs scored and an .847 OPS in 18 games for the Twins this season...to make room for Wallner on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder DaShawn Keirsej Jr. to Triple-A St. Paul...Keirsej Jr. played in 45 games for the Twins this season, going 7-for-64 (.109) with one home run, four RBI, six runs scored and five stolen bases.

**MAY-NNESOTA:** Twins are 18-7 in May, tied for the third-most wins in baseball for the month with St. Louis (18-8), and trailing Detroit (19-8) and Philadelphia (19-8)...the Twins are 98-70 all-time in May wins under Rocco Baldelli (since 2019), their highest of any month...below are Rocco's monthly records (left) and his year-by-year wins in May (right):

**PIKE PLACE PUNCH:** The Twins and Mariners are playing the second of seven meetings this season...after this series, they will host the Ms for four games at Target Field, from June 23-26.

- ☞ Twins are 13-7 in their last 20 games against the Mariners.
- ☞ They won their final two games at T-Mobile Park last season...with last night's win and a win tonight, that would give the Twins their first four-game winning streak at Seattle since winning five-straight, from April 25, 2015-May 29, 2016.
- ☞ Carlos Correa has 116 career hits and 116 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...his 116 hits are sixth-most among actives...Correa has 60 career hits at T-Mobile Park, his most in a visiting ballpark.
- ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .345 (10-for-29) in eight career games at T-Mobile Park.
- ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .397 on-base percentage, a .556 slugging percentage and a .952 OPS in 18 career games vs. the Ms.
- ☞ Justin Topp pitched one season for the Mariners in 2023, going 5-4, 2.61 ERA (69.0 IP, 20 ER) in 75 games...75 games are tied for the fourth-most in Mariners history.
- ☞ Notables lifetime vs. Bryce Miller: Matt Wallner is 2-for-3 with two solo home runs...Byron Buxton is 1-for-2 with a double...Harrison Bader is 2-for-6...Christian Vazquez is 1-for-2 with a solo home run.

**SERIES STUFF:** Twins are looking to win their 11th series of the season today...Minnesota is 10-7-1 in series play, going 6-2-1 at home and 4-5-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 9-3-1 in their last 13.

☞ Twins have won two-straight series against the Ms, both coming in 2024...their last series loss to the Mariners was July 24-26, 2023...their last series loss in this ballpark was June 14-16, 2021.

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** Over his last 17 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, nine RBI, 11 runs scored with a .576 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS.  
 ☞ In that same 17-game span, he is hitting .353 (18-for-51) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs and a 1.047 OPS against right-handed pitching.

**24 FOR 24 FOR C4:** Over his last 24 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .330 (29-for-88) with three doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .500 slugging percentage and an .855 OPS — Twins 17-7 in those games...in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .174 (15-for-86) with six doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .279 slugging percentage and a .513 OPS — Twins went 9-16 in those games.  
 ☞ In seven games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL, Correa is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with one double, three home runs, five RBI and a 1.135 OPS.

- ⚔ Making 12th start of the season and 100th career start...sixth start against the Mariners.
- ⚔ Ober is 2-0 in five career starts against Seattle, posting a 3.46 ERA (26.0 IP, 10 ER), with six walks, 31 strikeouts and a .191 (17-for-89) opponent batting average.
- ⚔ Looking to earn his fifth consecutive win today...would be the first time in his career he would have a five-plus win streak.

**IT AIN'T OVER TIL IT'S OVER:** Last pitched on May 25 against the Royals, opposite Kris Bubic and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 1-2 defeat...allowed one run on seven hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 6.2 quality innings...his one run allowed came off an RBI double in the seventh inning from Freddy Fermin, scoring Drew Waters...recorded his second career balk with two outs and a runner on first in the first inning.

⚔ Ober holds the second-best winning percentage (.800) in the American League among qualified pitchers, behind only the New York Yankees' Max Fried who is 7-1 (.875) in 12 starts so far this season.

**DON'T RAIN ON OUR PARADE:** Pitched on May 19 against the Guardians, opposite Logan Allen...Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 victory...allowed one run on three hits, with no walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work before the game was suspended due to rain...when the game resumed on May 21, Joe Ryan came into the game in relief...Ober's one run allowed came off an RBI double in the first inning from Kyle Manzardo, scoring Angel Martinez.

⚔ Marked the third suspended game in Target Field history, also May 25 2010 vs. New York-AL (0-1 loss) and May 11, 2022 vs. Houston (0-5 loss).

⚔ Was Bailey's shortest outing since his 2025 season debut where he pitched 2.2 innings...was only the fifth time in his career he has pitched 3.0-or-less innings in a game.

**VS. THE M'S:** Ober is 2-0 in five career starts against Seattle, posting a 3.46 ERA (26.0 IP, 10 ER) with six walks and 31 strikeouts...faced the Mariners twice in 2024, posting a 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER) with four walks, 16 strikeouts and a .139 (5-for-36) opponent batting average.

⚔ His career .191 opponent batting average is his third lowest among teams he has faced at least three times, behind the Toronto Blue Jays (.160) and the Athletics (.174).

⚔ Bailey is 7-0 in 16 career regular season starts against American League West division opponents, posting a 3.27 ERA (88.0 IP, 32 ER), 10.02 K/9, 2.35 BB/9 and 1.43 HR/9.

**THE BEARDED NIGHTMARE:** So far this season, Bailey is 3-0 in night games, with a 2.35 ERA (23.0 IP, 6 ER), a .267 (24-for-90) opponent batting average, a .389 slugging percentage and a .280 opponent OBP...is 1-1, 4.11 ERA (35.0 IP, 16 ER) with 12 walks, 30 strikeouts and a .280 (40-for-143) opponent batting average in seven daytime starts this season, including 1-0, 2.23 ERA (32.1 IP, 8 ER) in his last six day starts since April 5 (Twins 4-2 in those games).

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.75 ERA (263.2 IP, 110 ER), 9.22 K/9, 2.15 BB/9 and 1.54 HR/9 in 51 games (50 starts) at home compared to 13-14 with a 3.83 ERA (270.0 IP, 115 ER), 8.80 K/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.27 HR/9 in 50 road starts.

⚔ Ober is 2-1 in five starts on the road so far this season, posting a 4.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks, three home runs, 18 strikeouts and a .270 (30-for-111) opponent batting average.

⚔ Bailey is 1-0 in three career starts against the Mariners on the road, posting a 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER), with three walks and 20 strikeouts.

⚔ His 2.25 ERA at T-Mobile Park is his second lowest among ballparks he has pitched in at least twice, behind only Fenway Park (0.53)

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through 11 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .277/.306/.387 in 119 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .272/.325/.474 in 126 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 21.0 compared to righties' 92.2 mph and 29.6 percent.

⚔ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at his lowest since 2022, 28.3 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 51.1 percent.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 37% of the time...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

⚔ His 7.5 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 99th percentile...ranks in the bottom four percentile for max exit velocity at 116.6.

⚔ His slider strikeout percentage is at an all-time low of 10.2 percent, while his sweeper is at an all-time high of 40.0 percent.

⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 changeups, Bailey ranks third in hard hit percentage (22.4) and fifth in strikeout percentage (30.7).

**THRILL OF THE CHASE:** Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 35.3 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 94th percentile; ranks second on the Twins pitching staff, behind Griffin Jax (40.0).

**UNDER PRESSURE:** This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .208 (10-for-48) with three home runs, three walks and 16 strikeouts; with runners in scoring position and two outs, opponents are hitting .125 (3-for-24) with one home run, two walks and eight strikeouts.

**FIXING THE FASTBALL:** Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through 10 starts this season, Ober has lowered hard hit percentage, slugging percentage and opponent batting average...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - CHRIS PADDACK (2025: 2-5, 3.92 ERA // CAREER: 29-29, 4.32 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Paddack is set to start tomorrow's series finale in Seattle...last started on May 26 at Tampa Bay, taking the loss after allowing two runs on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings...he is 4-1 in five career starts against the Mariners, posting a 2.45 ERA (29.1 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks, 35 strikeouts and a .196 (21-for-107) opponent batting average...in six starts on the road so far this season, Paddack is 1-2 with a 4.70 ERA (30.2 IP, 16 ER), nine walks, 20 strikeouts and a .232 (26-for-112) opponent batting average.
