THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay, followed by a split of the first two games in Seattle...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the three-game series finale at T-Mobile Park...following today's game, the Twins will travel to Sacramento to play the A's for four games from Monday-Thursday.
 ☞ The Twins have won 18 of their last 24 games overall, including nine of their last 13 road games.
 ☞ Twins are 24-11 in their last 35 games since April 22, tied with Detroit (24-12) and St. Louis (24-11), for the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.
 ☞ Twins are 3-2 in rubber games this season...their three wins were April 2 at Chicago-AL, April 16 vs. New York-NL and May 4 at Boston...their two losses were April 6 vs. Houston and May 28 at Tampa Bay.

SEATTLE FLIPS THE SCRIPT ON TWINS: The Twins lost to the Mariners last night at T-Mobile Park by a score of 5-4 in 11 innings, making them 3-4 in extras this season and 7-8 in one-run games...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the Twins tied a season-high using eight pitchers...the offense recorded 11 hits, went 4-for-19 with runners in scoring position and left 13 men on base...Matt Wallner made his return from the IL and homered in his first plate appearance, recording two RBI...Willi Castro finished with three hits and a walk.

TWINS AND MS: The Twins and Mariners are playing the third of seven meetings this season...after this series, they will host the Ms for four games at Target Field, from June 23-26.
 ☞ Twins are 13-8 in their last 21 games against the Mariners.
 ☞ Carlos Correa has 117 career hits and 117 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...his 117 hits are sixth-most among actives...Correa has 61 career hits at T-Mobile Park, his most in a visiting ballpark.
 ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .394 (13-for-33) in nine career games at T-Mobile Park.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a 400 on-base percentage, a .554 slugging percentage and a .954 OPS in 19 career games vs. the Ms.

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starting staff has gone 16-8, 2.79 ERA (248.2 IP, 77 ER) with opponents hitting .231 in their last 47 games since April 8...below are their MLB ranks since that date:

SO MANY TREVORS AROUND HERE: Over his last 18 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .306 (22-for-72) with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI, 11 runs scored with a .542 slugging percentage and an .884 OPS.
 ☞ In that same 18-game span, he is hitting .339 (19-for-56) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, nine RBI and a .990 OPS against right-handed pitching.

NOT AT THE TABLE CARLOS: Over his last 25 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (30-for-90) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .511 slugging percentage and an .876 OPS — Twins 17-8 in those games...in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .174 (15-for-86) with six doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .279 slugging percentage and a .513 OPS — Twins went 9-16 in those games.
 ☞ In eight games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL, Correa is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with two doubles, three home runs, five RBI and a 1.183 OPS.

MAJORITY RULES: Twins are looking to win their 11th series of the season today...Minnesota is 10-7-1 in series play, going 6-2-1 at home and 4-5-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 9-3-1 in their last 13.
 ☞ Twins have won two-straight series against the Ms, both coming in 2024...their last series loss to the Mariners was July 24-26, 2023...their last series loss in this ballpark was June 14-16, 2021.

WILLMATIC: In his last 12 games, Willi Castro is hitting .351 (13-for-37) with three doubles, three home runs, five RBI, six walks, nine runs scored, two stolen bases, a .455 on-base percentage, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.130 OPS...over his last two games, he has reached base safely eight times in 10 plate appearances (5 hits, 3 walks).

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Marco Raya and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Jose Olivares as co-minor league Pitchers of the Week, while Double-A Wichita outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez earns minor league Player of the Week.
 ☞ Raya, 22, made two starts for the Saints, posting a 3.52 ERA (7.2 IP, 3 ER) with no walks and 14 strikeouts, allowing just two hits...the Laredo, Texas native was drafted by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of United South High School.
 ☞ Olivares, 22, made a start for the Kernels on Wednesday vs. Lake County, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and a season-high seven strikeouts...the Altagrafia de Orituco, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins in January of 2021.
 ☞ Gonzalez, 21, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .375 (9-for-24) with two doubles, two triples and a 1.069 OPS, including a four-hit game on Wednesday vs. Tulsa...Gonzalez was one of the four players acquired by the Twins in a trade with Seattle, in exchange for Jorge Polanco in January of 2024.

- ⚡ Making his 12th start of the season and the 94th of his career (97th appearance)...took the loss in his last start on May 26 at Tampa Bay (5.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- ⚡ In five career starts against Seattle, is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (29.1 IP, 8 ER), three home runs, seven walks and 35 strikeouts...is facing the Mariners in Seattle for the first time in his career.
- ⚡ Is 1-2 with a 4.70 ERA (30.2 IP, 16 ER), five home runs, nine walks and 20 strikeouts in six road starts this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss on May 26 at Tampa Bay opposite Zack Littell, a 7-2 Twins defeat...allowed two runs on five hits, walking none and striking out five over 5.1 innings...faced three batters over the minimum through his first five innings of work...with one out in the sixth, allowed a single and a double; both runners scored on Jonathan Aranda's home run, hit off Brock Stewart in relief.

- ⚡ So far this season, relief pitchers have inherited 10 runners from Paddack, five of which have scored...at the close of play on May 26, both totals led the Twins' pitching staff.
- ⚡ His 71.1 percent strike rate was his highest in a start this season and his highest since May 19, 2024 at Cleveland, when 72 of his 100 pitches (72.0%) thrown were strikes.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on May 21 vs. Cleveland opposite Gavin Williams, a 5-1 Twins defeat...allowed two runs on a season-high-tying seven hits, walking two and striking out two over 5.1 innings...retired eight-straight batters in first-third innings after giving up a leadoff double to Steven Kwan...stranded runners at third base in the first, fourth and fifth innings...Twins led 1-0 when he exited the game with the bases loaded in the sixth; his two runs allowed came retroactively from a walk and sacrifice fly allowed by reliever Louis Varland.

- ⚡ Both batters he walked came around to score in the sixth inning...marked the eighth and ninth time this season that a runner has scored after being walked by Paddack (also 3x on 3/31, 1x on 4/6, 4/12, 4/24, 5/4).
- ⚡ In 15 career games allowing seven-or-more hits, Paddack is 3-10...six of those games were with the Twins; Minnesota is 2-4, their two wins coming on April 27 and May 8, 2024.

RIDING WITH THE SHERIFF: After starting the season with a combined 7.1 innings in two outings, Paddack has gone 5.0-or-more innings in a career-high-tying nine consecutive starts, since April 12 vs. Detroit (also did so from April 16-May 30, 2024)...below are some of his numbers after his first two starts, from March 27 to April 11, compared to his numbers since April 12, including his rank among Twins starters in parenthesis:

FACING SEATTLE: In five career starts against Seattle, all at home, Paddack is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (29.1 IP, 8 ER), three home runs, seven walks and 35 strikeouts...Seattle batters have slashed .196/.250/.299 in 107 at-bats against Paddack...one start against the Mariners as a Twin came on May 8, 2024, when he allowed one run on eight hits (1 HR), while walking one and striking out 10 over 5.1 innings.

- ⚡ Of the 10 teams that Paddack has faced four-or-more times in his career, his opponent batting average and .549 opponent OPS against Seattle is the lowest...his 5.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio is tied with the Brewers for his fourth-best.

GO WEST: Is facing the American League West for the 18th time in his career and the ninth time in a Twins uniform...has faced the A's six times, Seattle five times, Texas three times, Houston twice and Los Angeles-AL twice (entered the game on 9/24/2023 vs. LAA but did not throw a pitch before the game was delayed by rain)...in his career, is 6-2 with a 4.98 ERA (81.1 IP, 45 ER), 11 home runs, 20 walks and 73 strikeouts against the AL West...since joining the Twins, is 2-0 with a 7.04 ERA (30.2 IP, 24 ER), six home runs, nine walks and 28 strikeouts against the AL West; Minnesota has gone 7-2 in those games.

- ⚡ This afternoon's game marks his second start against the AL West this season, also April 6 vs. Houston (ND, 4.0 IP, 3 ER, 2 BB, 2 K).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In six road starts this season, is 1-2 with a 4.70 ERA (30.2 IP, 16 ER), five home runs, nine walks and 20 strikeouts, compared to 1-3 with a 3.04 ERA (26.2 P, 9 ER), two home runs, 10 walks and 20 strikeouts in five starts at Target Field...since joining the Twins in 2022, is 4-5 with a 5.19 ERA (85.0 IP, 49 ER) over 17 appearances (16 starts) on the road...in that span, is averaging 9.00 hits-per-nine innings with a 1.26 WHIP and a 2.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio in away games.

- ⚡ In his career, Paddack is 12-15 with a 4.53 ERA (246.1 IP, 124 ER), with 56 walks and 221 strikeouts over 49 appearances (48 starts) on the road.
- ⚡ Has never faced Seattle on the road...in four career starts in American League West ballparks, Paddack is 1-1 with a 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP, 14 ER), one home run, six walks and 14 strikeouts.

PLATOON SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters are batting .220 (24-for-109) with three home runs, 10 walks, 15 strikeouts and seven RBI against Paddack, while righties are batting .252 (26-for-103) with four home runs, nine walks, 25 strikeouts and 15 RBI...in his career, lefties are slashing .242/.290/.410 with 36 home runs and 3.28 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Paddack, while righties are slashing .258/.296/.436 with 38 home runs and 5.47 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ⚡ Seattle's left-handed hitters are slashing .160/.173/.220 with one home run, four RBI, one walk and 16 strikeouts against Paddack, while Seattle's righties are slashing .228/.313/.368 with two home runs, three RBI, six walks and 19 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In 2025, Paddack has relied on a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

- ⚡ With 960 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has a 16.8 percent strikeout rate and an 8.0 percent walk rate...batters are chasing 31.6 percent of his pitches, whiffing 20.5 percent of the time and hitting the ball hard 44.4 percent of the time.
- ⚡ Introduced a sinker to his repertoire on May 21 vs. Cleveland...so far, has induced two whiffs on his sinker and both outs recorded were in the air...velocity has ranged from 92.1-94.6 mph.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 5-2, 2.57 ERA // CAREER: 38-28, 3.76 ERA)
