THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay last week and 1-2 at Seattle over the weekend...tonight, they will begin a four-game series in Sacramento against the Athletics for the first time, playing three night games at Sutter Health Park and a day game on Thursday.
 ☞ The Twins have won nine of their last 13 road games.
 ☞ Twins are 24-12 in their last 36 games since April 22, tied with St. Louis (24-12), for the second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Detroit (25-12)...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

TWINS COWBOY UP IN SEATTLE, BUT GET WALKED-OFF: The Twins lost to the Mariners yesterday afternoon at T-Mobile Park by a score of 2-1, tying the game at 1-1 in the top of the ninth inning...they were walked-off in the bottom of the ninth, their second consecutive walk-off defeat...Chris Paddock was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in a career-high-tying 8.0 innings pitched, with one walk and 10 strikeouts – one short of his career-high and fourth time in career to record double-digit strikeout totals...the offense recorded six hits, two apiece from Ty France and Trevor Larnach...their only run scored came on a Harrison Bader sacrifice fly.

PEAK ATHLETICISM: The Twins went 6-1 against the Athletics last season, going 4-0 at Target Field, from June 13-16 and 2-1 at the Coliseum, from June 21-23...they outscored the A's 44-24...their 6.3 runs-per-game were their third-most against any opponent in 2024, trailing 8.3 vs. the Angels and 6.5 vs. the White Sox...they won the season series for the third consecutive season (5-1 in 2022 and 5-1 in 2023).

☞ Last season, the Twins closed down their history at the Coliseum with consecutive wins on June 22 and 23 with pitching performances from Bailey Ober (CG w/ 10 K) and Pablo López (8.0 IP, 14 K, 2 H).
 ☞ Twins are 12-2 in their last 14 vs. the A's and 16-3 in their last 19, dating back to May of 2022.

STRAIGHT A'S: Notable individuals vs. the Athletics:

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with two doubles, one home run, two walks and an .822 OPS in nine career games against the Athletics.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .337 (35-for-104) with seven doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, a .548 slugging percentage and a .948 OPS in his last 26 games vs. the Athletics...Correa had 56 hits in 64 career games at the Coliseum, his second-most hits of any opposing ballpark (T-Mobile Park - 61).
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .421 (8-for-19) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, six RBI, a .789 slugging percentage and a 1.239 OPS in his last six games against the A's.
 ☞ Harrison Bader is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBI, a .563 slugging percentage and a .945 OPS in nine career games against the A's.
 ☞ Royce Lewis has hit safely in 10 of 11 career games against the A's...in those 11, he is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with four doubles, four home runs and a 1.132 OPS.
 ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with four doubles, one home run and a .982 OPS in his last nine career games vs. the A's.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: The Twins have gone 6-0 against California teams this season, going 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL, from April 25-27 and 3-0 vs. San Francisco, from May 9-11...last season they went 14-8 against California, going 5-1 vs. LAA, 1-2 vs. LAD, 6-1 vs. OAK, 1-2 vs. SD and 1-2 vs. SF...later this season, the Twins will play at the Dodgers (3 G, July 21-23), host the A's (3 G, August 19-21), host the Padres (3 G, August 29-31), and play in Anaheim (3 G, September 8-10).

☞ Five Twins on the 26-man roster are California natives: Ty France is from Downey, Trevor Larnach is from Walnut Creek, Brooks Lee is from San Luis Obispo, Royce Lewis is from Aliso Viejo and Joe Ryan is from San Francisco.

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starting staff has gone 16-8, 2.74 ERA (256.2 IP, 78 ER) with opponents hitting .229 and 17 quality starts in their last 48 games since April 8...below are their MLB ranks since that date:

EMPLOYEE NUMBER NINE: Over his last 19 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .316 (24-for-76) with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI, 11 runs scored with a .539 slugging percentage and an .889 OPS.
 ☞ In that same 19-game span, he is hitting .350 (21-for-60) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, nine RBI and a .991 OPS against right-handed pitching.

READY AND WILLING: In his last 13 games, Willi Castro is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with three doubles, three home runs, five RBI, six walks, nine runs scored, two stolen bases, a .417 on-base percentage, a .610 slugging percentage and a 1.026 OPS...he finished the three-game series in Seattle with five hits in 11 at-bats (.455) with one double, two home runs, three RBI, three walks, a .571 on-base percentage and a 1.662 OPS.

MY NAME IS MATT WALLNER AND I AM FROM MINNESOTA: In two games since returning from the 10-day IL (left hamstring strain), Matt Wallner has reached base safely five times (2 hits, 2 HBP, 1 walk) in nine plate appearances...in his last 12 games, dating back to April 6, Wallner is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, four RBI, three hit-by-pitch, five walks, a .457 on-base percentage, a .605 slugging percentage and a 1.062 OPS.

LOU GEHRIG DAY: Major League Baseball, in coordination with all 30 MLB Clubs and various partners, is celebrating the fifth annual Lou Gehrig Day and raising awareness for ALS (Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis), otherwise known as Lou Gehrig's Disease...on this special day, held annually on June 2, "4" decals designed in Yankee uniform color & font will be worn on all player, manager and coach uniforms...also, red "4-ALS" wristbands will be available to be worn in-game...in addition, commemorative base jewels and lineup cards will be used during games...the Twins (also celebrating again today) and Mariners recognized the day yesterday since the Mariners have today off.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1986, Rod Carew announced his retirement from baseball at the age of 40...Carew retired with a .328 career batting average, compiled over 19 major league seasons...he was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1991...in 2023, former Minnesota pitcher Bartolo Colón officially announced his retirement...Big Sexy made 15 starts for the Twins in 2017, going 5-6, 5.18 ERA (80.0 IP, 46 ER), including a complete game on August 4, 2017 vs. Texas at the age of 44.

- ☞ Making his 12th appearance (11th start) of the season...earned the win in his last start at Tampa Bay, allowing one run on five hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts in Minnesota's 4-2 victory.
- ☞ Is facing the Athletics for the third time in his career and the second time on the road...in two starts, is 1-0 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, four walks and 12 strikeouts.
- ☞ In six road starts this season, is 3-1 with a 2.31 ERA (35.0 IP, 9 ER) four walks and 36 strikeouts.
- ☞ With at least three strikeouts tonight, Ryan will become the 17th pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to reach 600 career strikeouts; currently trails Eddie Guardado (610) for the 16th most strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Started on May 27 at Tampa Bay opposite Taj Bradley...earned the win, his fifth of the season and his fourth consecutive winning decision, in Minnesota's 4-2 victory...allowed one run on five hits with one walk and five strikeouts over 6.0 quality innings...recorded his second balk of the season and the third of his career in the first inning...lone runner to touch home plate was Brandon Lowe, who doubled to lead off the fourth inning and later scored on Jonathan Aranda's base hit... Ryan retired the final seven batters he faced in order from the fourth-sixth innings.

- ☞ Marked his tenth consecutive game allowing an extra-base hit, the third longest streak in his career; did so in 24-straight games in 2023-24 and 12-straight games in 2022 and 2024.
- ☞ With this start, he became the first pitcher in Twins history to allow six-or-fewer earned runs, six-or-fewer walks, 20-or-fewer hits and 40-or-more strikeouts in a span of six outings.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his first career relief appearance on May 11 vs. Cleveland, starting the resumption of May 19's rain-suspended game, which lasted three innings before being halted; the Twins led 2-1 at the time of resumption and won the game in walk-off fashion in the ninth...Ryan did not factor into the game's decision, pitching the fourth-eighth innings (5.0 IP), and allowing three runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts...surrendered a solo home run to Carlos Santana in the fourth inning, Ryan's eighth of the year...was removed in the top of the ninth after giving up a double and a walk with no outs; both runners scored with Joao Duran on the mound.

- ☞ Marked the second time this season and the fourth time since July 12, 2024 that he's walked two-or-more batters.

FACING THE ATHLETICS: In two career starts against the A's, one at home and one on the road, Ryan is 1-0 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, four walks and 12 strikeouts...last faced the A's on June 13, 2024 at Target Field, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts over 7.0 innings...the Athletics have gone 8-for-43 (.186) with a .265 on-base percentage and a .614 OPS against Ryan.

- ☞ In 19 career starts against the American League West, is 6-8 with a 4.75 ERA (100.1 IP, 53 ER), 20 home runs, 33 walks and 128 strikeouts; Twins are 9-10.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': Following his outing on May 10 vs. the Giants, the San Francisco native is 6-3 in 12 career starts against California teams with a 4.68 ERA (67.1 IP, 35 ER), nine home runs, 20 walks and 83 strikeouts (LAD-1, SD-1, A's- 2, SF-4, LAA-4)...here is how he ranks among Twins pitchers with at least five starts against California teams since 2021:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his seventh road appearance of the year...is 3-1 with a 2.31 ERA (35.0 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, four walks and 36 strikeouts in five road starts, compared to 2-1 with a 2.89 ERA (28.0 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, five walks and 36 strikeouts in five home appearances (4 starts)...in his career, is 17-15 in 47 starts away from Target Field, with a 3.90 ERA (258.2 IP, 112 ER), a 1.09 WHIP and a 4.98 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ☞ In his six road starts this season, opposing batters are slashing .205/.257/.346 in 127 at-bats.
- ☞ Has one career road start against the Athletics, on July 16, 2023...allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR) over 5.1 innings, with three walks and seven strikeouts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .220/.267/.358 with six doubles, three home runs, four walks and 24 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .164/.224/.336 with five doubles, five home runs, five walks and 48 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .208/.268/.361 with 66 walks and 233 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .230/.275/.439 with 52 walks and 364 strikeouts.

- ☞ A's left-handed hitters are 4-for-20 (.200) with one home run, two RBI, three walks and four strikeouts against Ryan, while A's right-handed hitters are 4-for-23 (.174) with one home run, three RBI, one walk and eight strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through 11 appearances (10 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ With 982 pitches thrown this season, Ryan's chase rate is 24.8 percent and his whiff rate is 28.3 percent...his fastball run value of 12 ranks in baseball's 99th percentile...his walk rate is 3.7 percent, which ranks in baseball's 96th percentile, and his strikeout rate is 29.8 percent, which ranks in baseball's 87th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.4 mph while his hard hit rate is 41.6 percent.
- ☞ Prior to his outing on May 19 vs. Cleveland, Ryan had not utilized his curveball since September 30, 2022; did not throw a curve on May 27 at Tampa Bay...has thrown a total of 200 curves in his career with an average speed of 74.6 mph; his curveball has yielded a 23.1 percent
