THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5, going 0-3 at Houston last weekend and 1-2 at Cincinnati during the week...tonight, Minnesota will begin a seven-game homestand with the first of three against the Brewers through the weekend...following this series, the Twins will host the Mariners for four games from Monday-Thursday.
 Despite going just 3-10 in their last 13 games, the Twins have gone 30-22 in 52 games since April 22, fourth-most wins in the AL since that date and tied for the most wins in baseball.

NEEDED THAT: The Twins beat the Reds yesterday afternoon at Great American Ball Park by a score of 12-5, avoiding the three-game sweep...it marked their first time scoring double-digit runs since June 3 at the Athletics (10) and their most since scoring 12 on May 30 at Seattle...Chris Paddack (3-6) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, while being supported by a season-high nine runs (10 runs of support in previous 6 starts combined)...the offense recorded 17 hits, one short of their season-high (18 on 5/17 at MIL)...Byron Buxton and Carlos Correa each had three hits with two of Buck's being home runs...Ryan Jeffers (5) and Kody Clemens (7) each added home runs.

NATIONAL GO LIKE A PRO: Twins have gone 8-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18) and 1-2 at Cincinnati...Twins are 5-3 vs. NL teams after starting the season 2-7...their next series against an NL opponent will be three games in Miami at the end of their next roadtrip (July 1-3).

NATIONAL TREASURE: In his last 11 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with two doubles, two triples, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.164 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

WINNER GETS PAUL MOLITOR: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the fourth of six games this season...these two teams played a three-game series at American Family Field from May 16-18 as the Twins took the first two games...the two wins were victories number 12 and 13 of a 13-game winning streak...it was also part of a club record 34-straight scoreless innings; Brewers snapped the streak in the second inning of game three on a second inning single by Sal Frelick off Zebby Matthews.

Notable offensive numbers over the three-game series in May: Kody Clemens went 6-for-13 (.462) with a double and a home run...Ryan Jeffers went 6-for-14 (.429) with a double and a home run...Trevor Larnach went 4-for-12 (.333) with a double and a triple...Christian Vázquez went 4-for-13 (.308) with a double.

Since 2020, the Twins have hit 36 home runs in 27 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent.

Willi Castro is a career .381 (16-for-42) hitter with three doubles, two triples, five RBI, eight runs scored and a .973 OPS in 15 games against the Brewers.

Harrison Bader has 53 career hits against the Brewers (75 games), his second-most against any opponent (66 vs. CHC).

Byron Buxton has eight home runs and 16 RBI in 31 career games against the Brewers — both his most against any National League team...he missed the last series at Milwaukee going through concussion protocols.

HOME SECURITY: The Twins are returning home after a six-game roadtrip (1-5)...their last homestand was June 6-12, going 2-4 (1-2 vs. Texas and 1-2 vs. Toronto)...Twins have gone 20-12 at home this season, compared to 17-25 on the road...since April 15, they have a .720 winning percentage (18-7) at home, second-highest in baseball since that date, trailing only Houston (.742, 23-8).

Byron Buxton has a 1.000 OPS in 25 home games this season, sixth-highest in baseball (minimum of 100 plate appearances).

WILLI WORLD: In his last 29 games, Willi Castro is hitting .354 (34-for-96) with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 14 walks, 21 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .446 on-base percentage, a .615 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS...below are his first 25 games compared to his last 29 games this season:

SIMP-LEE THE BEST: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 18-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was by Brian Dozier, who hit in 24-straight from September 22, 2017-April 23, 2018 — covering two seasons...the last by a Twin as long in a single season was also Dozier for 24 games, from August 27-September 22, 2016...the longest streak in baseball this season was 22 by Bobby Witt Jr., from April 8-May 1.

Ken Landreaux holds the club record for a hitting streak at 31, done April 23-May 30, 1980...full list of Twins hitting streaks can be found on page 274 of the media guide.
 During the current streak, Lee is hitting .338 (24-for-71) with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and an .872 OPS.

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 34 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .318 (41-for-129) with five doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 33 RBI, 17 walks, a .393 on-base percentage, a .620 slugging percentage and a 1.013 OPS.

His leadoff home run yesterday was the 12th of his career, tying Dan Gladden (12) for fifth-most in Twins history (since 1961)...the top four in front of Gladden are: Brian Dozier - 28, Jacque Jones - 20, Max Kepler - 15 and Chuck Knoblauch - 14.

Buck is hitting .305 (32-for-105) with five doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 29 RBI, 21 runs scored and a 1.035 OPS in 29 starts from the leadoff spot this season.

CHILDREN OF THE CORN: High-A Cedar Rapids beat Beloit last night by a score of 2-0, clinching the Midwest League West Division first half title and a spot in the 2025 Postseason...they are Postseason bound for the 11th time in 12 years as a Twins affiliate.

LAST TIME OUT: Last started on June 14 in Houston opposite Hunter Brown but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 walk-off loss...allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts over 7.0 quality innings...two hits ties his season-low, also done on April 9, May 10 and May 16...both runs allowed came in the third, when Brendan Rodgers singled with one out and scored on Yanier Diaz's home run...retired 12-straight batters from the third-seventh inning...struck out the first batter faced in five of his seven innings pitched.

- ☞ Marked his third outing of 7.0-or-more innings...is tied with Chris Paddock for the team lead.
- ☞ Has struck out five-or-more batters in 11 games this season (tied for the 11th most in baseball).
- ☞ Marked his 13th consecutive game allowing an extra-base hit, the second-longest streak in his career; did so in 24-straight games in 2023-24.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started on June 8 against Toronto at Target Field opposite Bowden Francis...earned his third-straight win and seventh of the season in Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed three runs (2 ER) on four hits, with three walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings...runs scored came on a second-inning RBI double by Alan Roden and back-to-back RBI hits, a single by Alejandro Kirk and a double by George Springer, in the third inning.

- ☞ Walked Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in the first inning, the fifth time this season Ryan's walked a batter in the opening frame; did so just twice in 2024.
- ☞ Marked the 13th time in his career that he's given up three-or-more walks in an outing...allowed three-or-more runs and walks in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career.

BORDER BATTLE: In three career starts against the Brewers, is 1-0 with a 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, three walks and 18 strikeouts...has faced Milwaukee twice at Target Field and once at American Family Field...marks his second start against the Brewers this season; pitched in Milwaukee on May 16, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits, one walk and nine strikeouts...pitched innings 16.0-21.0 of Minnesota's record 34.0-inning scoreless streak from May 14-May 17.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: In five Interleague starts this season, is 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, four walks and 34 strikeouts...in 24 career Interleague starts, is 8-9 with a 5.28 ERA (124.1 IP, 73 ER), 30 home runs, a 1.21 WHIP and a 4.67 strikeout-to-walk ratio...in that span, National League opponents are slashing .249/.302/.506 in 486 at-bats against Ryan.

- ☞ Is facing the National League Central for the third time this season and the 12th time in his career...is 3-4 with a 3.99 ERA (56.1 IP, 25 ER), a .208 (43-for-207) opponent batting average and a 5.67 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 11 career starts; the Twins are 4-7...Ryan has allowed a home run in seven of his 11 career starts against the NL Central.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In six appearances (5 starts) at Target Field this season, is 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (33.0 IP, 11 ER), four home runs, eight walks and 42 strikeouts, compared to 4-1 with a 2.87 ERA (47.0 IP, 15 ER), six home runs, nine walks and 47 strikeouts over eight road starts...in his career, is 22-13 with a 3.64 ERA (279.2 IP, 113 ER), 39 home runs, a 1.01 WHIP and a 4.98 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ☞ In his six home games this season, opposing batters are slashing .179/.244/.342 in 117 at-bats...his 0.88 WHIP at home ranks 10th in baseball.
- ☞ In two career starts against Milwaukee at Target Field, is 0-0 with a 3.97 ERA (11.1 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, two walks and nine strikeouts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .213/.275/.370 with eight doubles, four home runs, seven walks and 28 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .174/.244/.329 with seven doubles, six home runs, 10 walks and 61 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .207/.269/.363 with 69 walks and 237 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .229/.275/.434 with 57 walks and 377 strikeouts.

- ☞ Milwaukee's left-handed hitters are batting .148 (4-for-27) with one home run, one RBI, two walks, five strikeouts and a .493 OPS against Ryan, while right-handed hitters are 7-for-35 (.200) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, one walk, 13 strikeouts and a .594 OPS against Ryan.

THE ARSENAL: Through 14 appearances (13 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ This season (1264 pitches), his chase rate is 25.4 percent and his whiff rate is 27.4 percent...his fastball run value of 11 ranks in baseball's 98th percentile...his 5.4 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 87th percentile, and his 28.3 percent strikeout rate ranks in baseball's 84th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.0 mph while his hard-hit rate is 40.0 percent.
- ☞ Relies primarily on his four-seam fastball as his strikeout pitch...on 675 four-seamers thrown this season, has a 31.9 percent strikeout rate and a 27.9 percent whiff rate...both are career-highs through his first 14 games of the season, and are up from a 30.5 percent strikeout rate and a 25.5 percent whiff rate through 14 games in 2024 (626 four-seam FB)...31.9 percent

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2025: 2-3, 5.13 ERA // CAREER: 7-9, 4.53 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start tomorrow afternoon's game against the Brewers at Target Field...last pitched on June 15 in Houston but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off loss; threw just 53 pitches over 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed one hit and one walk while striking out four...is facing Milwaukee for the first time in his career...in 12 career Interleague appearances (10 starts), is 2-4 with a 5.30 ERA (52.2 IP, 31 ER), seven home runs, 21 walks and 48 strikeouts.
