THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (0-3 at Houston and 1-2 at Cincinnati), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a loss to the Brewers last night...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of three against the Brewers through tomorrow...following this series, the Twins will host the Mariners for four games from Monday-Thursday.

"MIS"-ERABLE FRIDAY NIGHT FOR TWINS: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night at Target Field by a score of 17-6, their runs allowed and 19 hits allowed marked season-highs...Joe Ryan (7-3) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing three runs on three hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with three walks and seven strikeouts...Brewers starter Jacob Misiorowski held the Twins hitless until a Matt Wallner two-run homer with nobody out in the seventh inning...it marked Wally's sixth home run of the season.

☞ The defeat marked Minnesota's fifth consecutive loss in a series opener and third-straight at home.

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins have gone 8-11 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19) and 0-1 vs. Milwaukee...Twins are 5-4 vs. NL teams after starting the season 2-7...their next series against an NL opponent will be three games in Miami at the end of their next roadtrip (July 1-3).

NATIONAL TREASURE: In his last 12 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with two doubles, two triples, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.129 OPS...below are Buxton's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

WINNER GETS MOLITOR: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the fifth of six games this season...Minnesota has to win today and tomorrow to secure the season-series over Milwaukee, which would mark the first time since going 4-2 in 2021.

☞ Since 2020, the Twins have hit 37 home runs in 28 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent.

☞ Willi Castro is a career .370 (17-for-46) hitter with three doubles, two triples, five RBI, nine runs scored and a .934 OPS in 16 games against the Brewers.

☞ Harrison Bader has 53 career hits against the Brewers (76 games), his second-most against any opponent (66 vs. CHC).

☞ Byron Buxton has eight home runs and 16 RBI in 32 career games against the Brewers — both his most against any National League team.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: The Twins have gone 20-13 at home this season, compared to 17-25 on the road...since April 15, they have a .692 winning percentage (18-8) at home, third-highest in baseball since that date, trailing only Houston (.742, 23-8) and New York-NL (.710, 22-9). ☞ Byron Buxton has a .985 OPS in 26 home games this season, sixth-highest in baseball (minimum of 100 plate appearances).

STRICT-LEE BUSINESS: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 19-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was by Brian Dozier, who hit in 24-straight from September 22, 2017-April 23, 2018 — covering two seasons...the last by a Twin as long in a single season was also Dozier for 24 games, from August 27-September 22, 2016...the longest streak in baseball this season was 22 by Bobby Witt Jr., from April 8-May 1, ☞ Ken Landreaux holds the club record for a hitting streak at 31, done April 23-May 30, 1980.

☞ A hit today and it will become the 15th time 14th different player in club history with a streak of 20-plus...full list on page 2/4 of the Twins media guide.

☞ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .333 (25-for-75) with three doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI and an .852 OPS.

☞ During streak, Lee has hit .326 (14-for-43) from the left side of the plate and .344 (11-for-32) from the right side.

BUCK SHOTS: Over his last 35 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .313 (41-for-131) with five doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 33 RBI, 18 walks, a .392 on-base percentage, a .611 slugging percentage and a 1.003 OPS.

☞ Buxton is hitting .299 (32-for-107) with five doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 29 RBI, 22 runs scored and a 1.021 OPS in 30 starts from the leadoff spot this season.

THE LEFTORIUM: Today marks the 15th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-9 against lefty starters...they lost their last five games started by left-handers: May 25 vs. Kansas City (Kris Bubic), June 12 vs. Texas (Patrick Corbin), June 15 at Houston (Brandon Walter), June 17 at Cincinnati (Andrew Abbott) and June 18 at Cincinnati (Nick Lodolo)...their last win was on May 23 vs. Kansas City, a game started by Noah Cameron.

☞ Buxton is slashing .326/.388/.698 (1.085 OPS) against left-handed pitchers this season...in his last 19 games vs. lefties, he is slashing .400/.463/.857 (1.321 OPS).

☞ Castro is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with a .590 slugging percentage and a .959 OPS against lefties this season...over his last 14 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .481 (13-for-27) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs and a 1.496 OPS.

CASTROWORLD: In his last 30 games, Willi Castro is hitting .350 (35-for-100) with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 14 walks, 22 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .440 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.040 OPS...below are his first 25 games compared to his last 30 games this season:

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: Twins are looking to avoid losing their 13th series of the season today...Minnesota is 11-12-1 in series play, going 6-4-1 at home and 5-8-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 1-6-0 since May 26.

☞ Twins last series loss to the Brewers was a two-game sweep at Target Field, from July 21-21, 2024...Minnesota needs a win today and tomorrow to secure two series wins in one season against Milwaukee for the first time since 2021.

- ☞ Making his 11th appearance of the season (10th start) and 41st career appearance (39th start)... first career start against Milwaukee.
- ☞ Did not factor into Minnesota's 1-2, 10-inning loss in his last start on June 15 at Houston...threw 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit with one walk and four strikeouts.
- ☞ The Brewers become his 23rd new opponent faced...he is 6-4 when facing opponents for the first time, and 2-1 when facing opponents for the first time at home.
- ☞ Seeking first major league win since April 26 vs. Los Angeles-AL (5 starts).

LAST START: Last pitched on June 15 vs. Houston, opposite Brandon Walter, did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off defeat...threw 5.0 scoreless innings, and allowed just one hit with one walk and four strikeouts...marked his fourth career scoreless start...retired his first 13-straight batters, throwing a perfect 4.0 innings before allowing his sole hit, a single to Jake Meyers in the fifth...also allowed just one hit for the second time in his career (also, May 6, 2024 vs. Seattle).

- ☞ Marked his second lowest number of pitches thrown in his career, behind September 25, 2024, his shortest career outing, when he threw 35 pitches in 1.0 inning plus two batters in the second (12 total batters), including a double to current teammate Jonah Bride.
- ☞ SWR is the first Twins starter to allow just one hit in a game so far this season...also marked the Twins' seventh scoreless start of the season, and first since Pablo López had 6.0 scoreless innings on May 17.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on June 10 vs. Texas, opposite Tyler Mahle, taking his third loss of the season in Minnesota's 16-4 defeat...allowed a season-high seven runs (6 ER) on eight hits, with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...threw three scoreless innings before allowing an RBI double to Adolis Garcia, scoring Jake Burger (unearned) and an RBI single to Kyle Higashioka in the fourth, followed by a two-run RBI single to Josh Jung in the fifth...then permitted a double to Garcia before being replaced by Justin Topa who subsequently allowed a two-run RBI double to Higashioka, both runs retroactively charged to Woods Richardson.

- ☞ Threw a wild pitch in the fourth and fifth innings...first career game with two wild pitches.
- ☞ Was his first time with zero home runs allowed in a major league game since first start of 2025 on April 1 at Chicago-AL...snapped career-long streak of seven-straight games with a homer... was one of just five pitchers to have such a streak in 2025.

A NEW RIVALRY IS BREWING: Woods Richardson is facing the Milwaukee Brewers for the first time in his career...this is his third new opponent faced this season (also, Baltimore and Los Angeles-AL).

- ☞ SWR is 6-4 when facing opponents for the first time, and 2-1 when facing opponents for the first time at home.
- ☞ He is 2-4 in 12 career Interleague appearances (10 starts), posting a 5.30 ERA (52.2 IP, 31 ER) with 21 walks, 48 strikeouts and a .295 (62-for-210) opponent batting average.

HOME SWEET HOME: In his career, Woods Richardson has gone 3-3 with a 4.62 ERA (87.2 IP, 45 ER), 8.62 K/9, 3.29 BB/9 and 1.13 HR/9 in 18 games (17 starts) at home compared to 4-6 with a 4.46 ERA (103.0 IP, 51 ER), 7.34 K/9, 3.41 BB/9 and 1.31 HR/9 in 22 road games (21 starts).

- ☞ SWR is 2-1 in four starts at home this season, posting a 4.58 ERA (19.2 IP, 10 ER) with four walks and 17 strikeouts; compared to 0-2, 5.53 ERA (27.2 IP, 17 ER), 14 walks and 26 strikeouts in six appearances (5 starts) on the road.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 10 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .333/.400/.524 in 84 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .240/.307/.404 in 104 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.9 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 40.0 compared to righties' 93.0 mph and 53.1 percent.

- ☞ His whiff rate is at an all-time high of 24.0 percent (lefties, 22.0 percent; righties, 25.3 percent)... compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He currently ranks in baseball's third percentile in barrel percentage (13.7), eighth percentile in max exit velocity (115.3) and ninth percentile in GB% (32.2).
- ☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 4-seam fastballs this season, SWR's 60.3 percent hard hit rate is the second highest in baseball, behind Atlanta's AJ Smith-Shawver (63.9).
- ☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 curveballs, Simeon has the second lowest whiff rate (13.3) and is the only player to have a 0.0 strikeout rate and put away percentage.

MAKE MY DAY: In 20 career day games (19 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 3.83 ERA and a .243 opponent batting average, .395 slugging percentage, with 33 walks, 96 strikeouts and 14 home runs; compared to a 5.28 ERA, .269 opponent batting average, .422 slugging percentage with 38 walks, 72 strikeouts and 12 home runs in 20 night games (19 starts).

- ☞ So far this season, SWR is 2-0 in five daytime starts, posting a 3.75 ERA (24.0 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts; compared to 0-3 (23.1 IP, 17 ER), 10 walks and 19 strikeouts in five nighttime appearances (4 starts).

FASTBALL FIASCO: Through Woods Richardson's 10 major league appearances this season, opponents are hitting his 4-seam fastball more often than in previous seasons with a higher slugging percentage, hard hit percentage and average exit velocity...here are some of his four-seam fastball numbers since his major league debut in 2022:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DAVID FESTA (2025: 1-1, 4.78 ERA // CAREER: 3-7, 4.86 ERA)

Right-hander David Festa is set to start tomorrow's series finale vs. Milwaukee...last started on June 17 at Cincinnati, and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-6 defeat...allowed four runs (2 earned) off two hits, with three walks, one hit batter and four strikeouts in 3.2 innings...has never faced the Brewers, they become his 17th new opponent faced...he is 1-0 in four starts this season at home, posting a 1.89 ERA (19.0 IP, 4 ER) with seven walks, 19 strikeouts and a .217 (15-for-69) opponent batting average.
