THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (0-3 at Houston and 1-2 at Cincinnati), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with consecutive losses to the Brewers on Friday night and Saturday afternoon...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Brewers...tomorrow night, the Twins will welcome the Mariners for four games from Monday-Thursday.

BEER BATTERED: The Twins were shut out by the Brewers yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-0, suffering their fifth shutout loss this season and third at home (0-4 on 4/12 vs. DET & 0-3 on 4/24 vs. CWS)...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs (3 earned) on four hits in a season-high 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded four hits, just one going for extra-bases, a Carlos Correa double, his 14th of the season...Brooks Lee went 0-for-4, snapping his hitting streak at 19 games.

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins have gone 8-12 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19) and 0-2 vs. Milwaukee...Twins are 5-5 vs. NL teams after starting the season 2-7...their next series against an NL opponent will be three games in Miami at the end of their next roadtrip (July 1-3).

NATIONAL TREASURE: In his last 13 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with two doubles, two triples, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.114 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

THIS ONE IS FOR ALL THE MOLITORS: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the sixth and final time this season.

- ☞ Since 2020, the Twins have hit 37 home runs in 29 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent.
☞ Willi Castro is a career .340 (17-for-50) hitter with three doubles, two triples, five RBI, nine runs scored and an .862 OPS in 17 games against the Brewers.
☞ Harrison Bader has 54 career hits against the Brewers (77 games), his second-most against any opponent (66 vs. CHC).
☞ Byron Buxton has eight home runs and 16 RBI in 33 career games against the Brewers — both his most against any National League team.

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins have gone 20-14 at home this season, compared to 17-25 on the road...since April 15, they have a .667 winning percentage (18-9) at home, fourth-highest in baseball since that date, trailing only Houston (.742, 23-8), New York-NL (.710, 22-9) and Chicago-NL (.677, 21-10).

☞ Byron Buxton has a .981 OPS in 27 home games this season, seventh-highest in baseball (minimum of 100 plate appearances).

WILLMATIC: In his last 31 games, Willi Castro is hitting .337 (35-for-104) with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 14 walks, 22 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .425 on-base percentage, a .577 slugging percentage and a 1.002 OPS...below are his first 25 games compared to his last 31 games this season:

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fourth time this season...the other three were in three games at St. Louis to open 2025, from March 27-30, three games from April 18-20 at Atlanta and three games at Houston from June 13-15...other than those three sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep three times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto and June 19 at Cincinnati.

☞ The last time the Twins were swept by the Brewers was in two games at Target Field, from July 20-21, 2024...last time they were swept in three games by the Brewers came July 2-4, 2018 at American Family Field...last time the Twins were swept in Minnesota was July 8-10, 1988 at the Metrodome.

THAT CLOSES THE BOOK ON BROOKS: Brooks Lee went 0-for-4 yesterday, snapping his hitting streak at 19 games...during the streak, Lee hit .333 (25-for-75) with three doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI and an .852 OPS...during the streak, he hit .326 (14-for-43) from the left side of the plate and .344 (11-for-32) from the right side.

DAYS GONE BYRON: Over his last 36 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .313 (42-for-134) with five doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 33 RBI, 19 walks, a .395 on-base percentage, a .604 slugging percentage and a .999 OPS.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul infielder Edouard Julien and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher John Klein have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

- ☞ Julien played in six games for the Saints, hitting .381 (8-for-21) with three home runs, six RBI, five walks, five runs scored, a .536 on-base percentage, an .810 slugging percentage and a 1.345 OPS.
☞ Klein, 23, made the start for the Wind Surge on Thursday, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...the Brooklyn Park, MN native was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in August of 2022.

YOU CAN'T HANDLE THE PLOUFFE: Twins.TV analyst Trevor Plouffe hit nine home runs in Interleague Play during the 2012 season, in 12 games played...those nine homers are tied with Mitch Garver (2019) for third-most in club history, trailing Byron Buxton (10 in 2024) and Michael A. Taylor (10 in 2023)...two of those nine home runs were against the Brewers on June 15 — both off Yovani Gallardo.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2023, Joe Ryan threw his first and only complete-game shutout in a Twins 6-0 victory over the Red Sox at Target Field...Ryan threw 112 pitches, allowing three hits with no walks and nine strikeouts...Correa homered and Buxton homered twice.

- Is facing the Brewers for the first time in his career...in nine career Interleague starts, is 2-3 with a 4.00 ERA (45.0 IP, 20 ER), four home runs, 17 walks and 55 strikeouts.
- Is making his fifth appearance at Target Field this season...is 1-0 with a 1.89 ERA (19.0 IP, 4 ER), one home run, seven walks and 19 strikeouts...Twins are 3-1.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on June 1 in Cincinnati opposite Andrew Abbott but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 loss...allowed four run (2 earned) on two hits, with three walks and four strikeouts over 3.2 innings...retired first eight batters faced and carried a no-hitter into the fourth inning, the longest no-hit bid of his major league career...both hits allowed - a double by Will Benson and a single by Jake Fraley - came with two outs in the fourth inning and both drove in two runs...runs scored on Fraley's single were unearned after a passed ball on a third strike to Spencer Steer continued the inning...Festa plunked Matt McLain, his third hit batter of the season and fifth of his career, before giving way to Danny Coulombe in relief.

Marked the fourth time this season he has not allowed a run in the first three innings, then been unable to work into or finish the fifth inning.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started on June 11 vs. the Rangers at Target Field, opposite Jack Leiter...earned the win, his first of the season, in Minnesota's 6-2 victory...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts over a major league career-high-tying 6.0 innings...marked the second quality start of his career...surrendered a home run to Marcus Semien to start the second inning, Festa's fifth career home run allowed to the first batter of an inning...Jonah Heim hit a one-out ground-rule double in the third and scored on a double by Josh Smith...picked off Evan Carter in the fourth inning, who was tagged out in a rundown, the second pick off/pitcher caught stealing of Festa's career (first came on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL).

The win marked his first since August 5, 2024...in that span, had eight no decisions and five losses, including four-straight from August 23-September 9, 2024.

Snapped a professional career-high streak of seven straight starts with five-or-more strikeouts.

SLIM REAPER STRIKES: No pitcher in Minnesota Twins history (1961-present) has recorded more strikeouts than Festa (106) through their first 20 career games...the next closest is Joe Ryan with 103 strikeouts...below are some of Festa's numbers compared to Twins pitchers with 100-or-more strikeouts through the first 20 games of their major league career:

ADDITIONALLY: Of the 79 major league pitchers who have recorded 106-or-more strikeouts in their first 20 career games since 2000, only four, including Festa, have done so in 91.0-or-fewer innings.

FACING MILWAUKEE: Is due to face the Brewers for the first time in his career...in 10 career Interleague appearances (nine starts), is 2-3 with a 4.00 ERA (45.0 IP, 20 ER), four home runs, 17 walks and 55 strikeouts...is facing the National League for the third time this season, also April 16 vs. the Mets and June 17 in Cincinnati...in four career starts against the NL Central (2x CIN, 1x CHC and STL), is 1-1 with a 3.94 ERA (16.0 IP, 7 ER), 10 walks and 22 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In four starts at Target Field this season, is 1-0 with a 1.89 ERA (19.0 IP, 4 ER), one home run, seven walks and 19 strikeouts, compared to 0-1 with a 12.27 ERA (7.1 IP, 10 ER), three home runs, five walks and 10 strikeouts in two road starts...in 12 career appearances (11 starts) at home, is 1-4 with a 4.56 ERA (53.1 IP, 27 ER), eight home runs, 22 walks and 60 strikeouts; Twins are 5-7.

In six career Interleague home games (5 starts), is 0-2 with a 3.76 ERA (26.1 IP, 11 ER), two home runs, 10 walks and 34 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties are hitting .213 (10-for-47) with four doubles, one home run, seven walks, 12 strikeouts and a .701 OPS against Festa, while righties are hitting .245 (13-for-53) with one double, three home runs, five walks, 17 strikeouts and a .756 OPS...in his career, lefties are slashing .228/.321/.395 in 167 at-bats, with five home runs, 19 walks and 49 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .255/.317/.451 in 184 at-bats, with eight home runs, 15 walks and 56 strikeouts.

Lefties in the NL Central are 5-for-30 (.167) with three doubles, six RBI, five walks and 12 strikeouts against Festa, while righties are 5-for-28 (.179) with one double, one triple, three RBI, five walks and 10 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Here is Festa's pitch usage and results at the MLB level so far in 2025, per Baseball Savant:

So far this year (471 pitches), Festa has a 26.5 percent chase rate, a 27.4 percent whiff rate, a 45.1 percent hard-hit rate and an average exit velocity of 92.1 mph...batters are striking out 25.2 percent of the time and walking 10.4 percent of the time.

Three of his four strikeouts recorded in his last outing on June 17 and 15 of his 29 strikeouts at the major league level have come via his changeup...with 147 changeups thrown so far this season, he is inducing whiffs 44.3 percent of the time with a strikeout rate of 40.5%...his changeup strikeout rate ranks seventh among pitchers with 100-or-more changeups thrown this season (teammate Griffin Jax ranks 2nd with a 57.5 changeup K%)...in 2024, he threw 308 changeups with a whiff rate of 39.4 percent and a strikeout rate of 32.2 percent.

- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month in May 2025 after going 0-0 with a 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER) and a 9.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio in three starts with Triple-A St. Paul.
- Began 2025 with Triple-A St. Paul as the Saints' Opening Day starter; earned the win while allowing three hits in 5.0 scoreless innings, with no walks and four strikeouts.
- In 2024, started 13 games (14 appearances) for the Twins, going 2-6 with a 4.80 ERA (64.1 IP, 35 ER), 23 walks and 77 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut June 27, 2024 at Arizona and earned the win in Minnesota's 13-6 victory, allowing five runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings with one walk and two strikeouts.
- In 2024, started 14 games for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-2 with a 3.77 ERA (59.2 IP, 25 ER), 24 walks and 87 strikeouts.
- In 2024, was twice named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week - on May 5 and June 16, both following 10-strikeout starts for St. Paul.
- Was a non-roster invite to Minnesota's 2024 Spring Training in Fort Myers and made one appearance, logging a scoreless 1.0 innings (1 H, 1 SO).
- Entering 2024, was ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 4 prospect (No. 1 pitcher) in Minnesota's organization.
- In 2023, made 24 appearances (22 starts) between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combining to go 4-4 with a 4.19 ERA (92.1 IP, 43 ER), 42 walks, 119 strikeouts and a 1.39 WHIP.
