THE TWINS: Have gone 0-3 through three games on their seven-game homestand, getting swept by the Brewers over the weekend...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the first of four against the Mariners through Thursday afternoon...after this homestand, the Twins will travel to Detroit for a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the Tigers (June 27-29) and three against the Miami Marlins (July 1-3).

TWINS FIGHT BACK BUT RUN OUT OF INNINGS: The Twins lost to the Brewers yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-8, suffering their fourth sweep of the season, first at Target Field and first against the Brewers in three games in Minnesota since July 8-10, 1988 at the Metrodome...Danny Coulombe was the Opener, allowing one run on two hits in 1.0 inning pitched...David Festa was the bulk pitcher, allowing eight runs on 12 hits (2 home runs), in 4.2 innings, with three walks and three strikeouts...Minnesota closed a 9-3 gap by scoring five runs between innings 6-8 and finished with a season-high tying 18 hits...Brooks Lee (career-high) and Carlos Correa (season-high) each had four hits...Byron Buxton hit two homers (16, 17), while Ryan Jeffers (6) and Ty France (6) also both went deep.

ONE-NOTHING: Byron Buxton hit his 13th career leadoff home run yesterday afternoon and his third in his last five games (Wednesday at Cincinnati, Thursday at Cincinnati and Sunday vs. Milwaukee)...he has four leadoff home runs on the season, tied for fifth-most in baseball...yesterday's leadoff homer passed Dan Gladden and moved him into sole possession of fifth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

GEORGIA ON HIS MIND: Major League Baseball revealed updated voting totals earlier today and Byron Buxton currently ranks 10th among AL outfielders with 505,791 votes...the 2025 PRO SPIRIT MLB All-Star Ballot, which is available exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App, will be accessible until the voting period for Phase I concludes this Thursday at 12:00 pm (ET)...on Thursday, the top two vote-getters at each position (and the top 6 outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6:00 pm (ET), and they will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who makes the All-Star teams and starts for each league...below are the voting totals for AL outfielders:

DAYS GONE BYRON: Over his last 37 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .324 (45-for-139) with five doubles, two triples, 12 home runs, 35 RBI, 20 walks, a .405 on-base percentage, a .647 slugging percentage and a 1.052 OPS — Twins are 21-16 in those games.

Vs.: The Twins and Mariners are playing the fourth of seven meetings this season...the last time Minnesota hosted Seattle was for four games from May 6-9, 2024, as the Twins won three times. Carlos Correa has 117 career hits and 118 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...his 117 hits are sixth-most among actives.

Ryan Jeffers is hitting .300 (18-for-60) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .377 on-base percentage, a .517 slugging percentage and an .893 OPS in 20 career games vs. the Ms.
Byron Buxton has a 1.005 OPS (.352 OBP / .653 SLG) in his last 23 games against Seattle...in that span, he has 10 home runs and 28 RBI.
Ty France is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with a .921 OPS in six career games against the Mariners.
Over his last five games against the Ms, Trevor Larnach is hitting .435 (10-for-23) with two home runs, eight RBI, a .739 slugging percentage and a 1.197 OPS...last series against Seattle, he had seven hits in 16 at-bats, including five RBI.

ALL ALONG THE MUST-WATCHTOWER: The Twins and Mariners played a three-game series at T-Mobile Park, from May 30-June 1 as the Twins won game one and lost games two and three.

In game one of that series the Twins were down to their final out in the ninth inning and tied the game, forcing extras and eventually scored six runs in the 10th inning, winning 12-6...Trevor Larnach had four hits and four RBI in the game.
In game two, the Twins tied the game at 4-4 in the ninth inning on a Larnach single...Twins lost in the bottom of the 11th on a Cole Young fielder's choice groundball — a ball that traveled half-way up the first base line at 69.9 mph exit velo.
In game three, the Twins trailed 1-0 and tied the game in the top of the ninth on a Harrison Bader sac fly...they lost in the bottom half on a Randy Arozarena single to centerfield.

THE BOOK ON BROOKS: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 20 of his last 21 games with an at-bat...Lee snapped his hitting streak at 19 games on Saturday afternoon, going 0-for-4 against Milwaukee...the last time the Twins played the Mariners, Lee was on games two, three and four of that 19-game hitting streak...in those last 21 games, he is hitting .345 (29-for-84) with three doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and an .856 OPS.

SMALL MARGINS: The Twins have gone 7-14 in one-run games this season, dropping each of their last eight: one at Kansas City (May 25), two in Seattle (May 31 & June 1), one vs. Toronto (June 7), two at Houston (Saturday and Sunday), June 17 at Cincinnati and yesterday vs. Milwaukee...their last one-run win was on May 24 vs. Kansas City, a 5-4 victory at Target Field...they went 22-20 in one-run games in 2024.

MINOR MOVES: Twins claimed right-handed pitcher Connor Gillispie from Miami this afternoon and optioned him to Triple-A St. Paul...Gillispie started six games for the Marlins this season, going 0-3, 8.65 ERA (26.0 IP, 25 ER)...the Twins 40-man roster is now at 40.

WHERE IT'S AT: The Twins today announced that multi-platinum country artist Dustin Lynch will perform a postgame concert, presented by TickPick, following the Friday, August 15 Twins-Tigers games...admission to the concert is free with a ticket for that night's 7:10 pm game (available at twins.com/tickets); additionally, a pair of special VIP ticket packages — both including admission to the game and exclusive postgame field access near the stage, while one also comes with a free Twins-branded denim shirt — are available now only at twins.com/DustinLynch.

- ⚔ Ober is 2-0 in six career starts against the Mariners, posting a 3.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks, 35 strikeouts and a .215 (23-for-107) opponent batting average.
- ⚔ Took his fourth loss of the season (and third consecutive loss) in Minnesota's 2-4 defeat in his last start on June 18 at Cincinnati...allowed four runs off nine hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts in a 5.2-inning complete game.

OVER OBER TOO SOON: Last pitched on June 18 at Cincinnati, opposite Nick Lodolo, taking the loss in Minnesota's 2-4 defeat, his fourth loss of the season and third consecutive loss; is the second time in his career he has been dealt three consecutive losses (also, 9/24/24-3/30/25)...allowed four runs on a season-high nine hits (1 HR), no walks and five strikeouts in a 5.2-inning, rain-shortened complete game, becoming his second career complete game...permitted a two-run homer to Spencer Steer in the first, an RBI single to Matt McLain in the second and an RBI single to Will Benson in the third.

⚔ The 5.2-inning complete game is the shortest complete game recorded in Twins history since Bob Tewksbury threw a 5.0-inning complete game on June 18, 1998, exactly 27 years prior (W, 4-1).

⚔ Ober retired nine of his last ten batters faced in the third through fifth before the game was delayed and ultimately called due to weather.

⚔ Is the fifth time in his career he has allowed a home run in four consecutive games, and first since September 13, 2024-April 5, 2025.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on June 12 vs. the Rangers, opposite Patrick Corbin, taking the loss in Minnesota's 3-16 defeat, his third loss of the season and second consecutive loss, first time being dealt losses in consecutive starts since September 24-29, 2024...allowed seven runs on six hits, including a career-high four home runs, with a career-high six walks and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings...allowed a leadoff home run to Josh Smith in the first...then a solo shot to Jake Burger, followed by an RBI single to Kyle Higashioka and a three-run homer to Wyatt Langford all in the second...in the top of the fifth gave up a home run to Evan Carter, followed by a groundout and two walks before being replaced by Cole Sands.

⚔ Allowed his second career leadoff home run to Josh Smith (also, May 11, 2023 vs. San Diego, to Fernando Tatis Jr.).

⚔ Allowed four home runs in a single game for the first time in his career and had back-to-back multi-home run starts for the third time in his career, and first since July 23-29, 2023.

⚔ Ober is the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to allow four-plus home runs and six-plus walks in a single game.

⚔ Recorded his third career balk and second of the season (also, May 25), which marks the Twins' seventh balk of the season, tying the Arizona Diamondbacks for most in the majors.

KING OF THE SEA: Ober is 2-0 in six career starts against Seattle, posting a 3.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks, 35 strikeouts and a .215 (23-for-107) opponent batting average...last faced the Mariners on May 31 in his 100th career start, where he did not factor into Minnesota's 4-5 defeat, allowing two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings.

⚔ Last faced the Mariners at Target Field on May 7, 2024 where he did not factor into Minnesota's 6-10 defeat...allowed two runs on three hits, one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

⚔ Holds a career 10.5 K/9, his highest among opponents he has faced at least four times...also the only team he has faced four-plus times and never recorded a loss.

⚔ Bailey is 7-1 in 18 career regular season starts against American League West division opponents, posting a 3.82 ERA (96.2 IP, 41 ER), 9.78 K/9, 2.79 BB/9 and 1.77 HR/9.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-11 with a 3.99 ERA (275.1 IP, 122 ER), 9.05 K/9, 2.29 BB/9 and 1.67 HR/9 in 53 games (52 starts) at home compared to 13-15 with a 3.89 ERA (279.2 IP, 121 ER), 8.79 K/9, 1.74 BB/9 and 1.29 HR/9 in 52 road starts.

⚔ Ober is 2-2 in eight starts at home so far this season, posting a 4.22 ERA (42.2 IP, 20 ER) with 12 walks, nine home runs, 35 strikeouts and a .268 (45-for-168) opponent batting average.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 15 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .267/.306/.429 in 161 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .292/.348/.528 in 161 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.6 mph and a whiff rate of 21.9 compared to righties' 92.2 mph and 28.2 percent.

⚔ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its lowest since 2022, 28.4 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 53.9 percent.
