THE TWINS: Have gone 0-4 through four games on their seven-game homestand, getting swept by the Brewers over the weekend, followed by a loss to the Mariners last night... tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of four against Seattle through Thursday afternoon... after this series, the Twins will travel to Detroit for a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the Tigers, from June 27-29, an off day on June 30, and three against the Miami Marlins, from July 1-3.

SIX-RUN THIRD BEATS BAILEY, TWINS: The Twins lost to the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of 11-2, suffering their sixth loss of seven runs-or-more in their last 13 games... Bailey Ober (4-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs on seven hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts... he allowed a six-run third inning, highlighted by home runs from Julio Rodriguez (2-run) and Luke Raley (3-run)... the offense recorded seven hits, two apiece from Brooks Lee, Trevor Larnach and Carlos Correa... Larnach and Correa provided the only scoring for Minnesota, each hitting a solo home run, in back-to-back fashion in the sixth inning.

SEATTLE SOUNDS: The Twins and Mariners are playing the fifth of seven meetings this season... Twins need to win all three of the remaining games this series to secure the season series for the second consecutive season (5-2 in 2024).

- Carlos Correa has 119 career hits and 119 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent... his 119 hits are sixth-most among actives.
- Ryan Jeffers is hitting .300 (18-for-60) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .377 on-base percentage, a .517 slugging percentage and an .893 OPS in 20 career games vs. the Ms.
- Byron Buxton has a .966 OPS (.339 OBP / .626 SLG) in his last 24 games against Seattle... in that span, he has 10 home runs and 28 RBI.
- Ty France is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with an .891 OPS in seven career games against the Mariners... he has five hits in 14 at-bats against Seattle this season.
- Over his last six games against the M's, Trevor Larnach is hitting .462 (12-for-26) with three home runs, nine RBI, a .500 on-base percentage, an .846 slugging percentage and a 1.346 OPS... this season, he has nine hits in 19 at-bats against Seattle pitching.

GETTING OFFENSIVE: Minnesota enters today with 98 runs scored this month, second-most in the AL and fifth-most in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (115), Arizona (113), Los Angeles -NL (102) and St. Louis (102)... additionally, they rank fifth in baseball in on-base percentage (.330) and 11th in batting average (.253) for the month... below are the offensive monthly totals:

DAYS GONE BYRON: Over his last 38 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .315 (45-for-143) with five doubles, two triples, 12 home runs, 35 RBI, 20 walks, a .395 on-base percentage, a .629 slugging percentage and a 1.025 OPS... Twins are 21-17 in those games.

- Buck is on pace for 35 home runs, 97 RBI, 95 runs scored and 27 stolen bases.
- He has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games.
- He is slashing .288/.382/.635 (1.017 OPS) in 29 home games this season... in his last seven games at Target Field, he is slashing .435/.536/.913 (1.449 OPS) with three home runs.
- His 2025 MLB percentile rankings: 96th in batting run value (18), 94th in hard hit percentage (54.5), 92nd in barrel percentage (15.8), 90th in bat speed (75.2), 85th in average exit velocity (91.9) and 85th in xSLG (.517).

LEADING MAN: Byron Buxton hit his 13th career leadoff home run on Sunday afternoon and now has three in his last six games (Wednesday at Cincinnati, Thursday at Cincinnati and Sunday vs. Milwaukee)... he has four leadoff home runs on the season, tied for fifth-most in baseball... Sunday's leadoff homer passed Dan Gladden and moved him into sole possession of fifth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961).

WE'RE TALKING LEE: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 21 of his last 22 games with an at-bat... in those last 22 games, he is hitting .352 (31-for-88) with three doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and an .862 OPS.

- Over those 22 games, he is slashing .323/.357/.462 (.819 OPS) as a left-handed batter... as a right-handed batter he is .280/.294/.340 (.634 OPS).

TREVOLOUTION: Over his last 19 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .301 (22-for-73) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .521 slugging percentage and an .879 OPS.

CARLOS COR-RAKING: Carlos Correa is hitting .500 (10-for-20) with one double, one home run, three RBI, two walks, a .545 on-base percentage, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.245 OPS in his last five games.

- In 25 June games in 2024, Correa hit .388 (38-for-98) with five home runs, 21 RBI and a 1.023 OPS.
- His career .305 June batting average and .926 June OPS are both the highest of any month in his career.

BREAKING BAD GOOD: Twins have posted a .420 slugging percentage off breaking pitches this season, second-best in baseball, trailing Boston (.454)... additionally, they rank fourth in baseball in wOBA vs. breaking pitches at .306 (league average .282).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1964, the Twins signed future MLB Hall of Famer Rod Carew.

- ⚡ Last pitched on June 19 in Cincinnati and earned his third win of the season in Minnesota's 12-5 victory...allowed four runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts over 5.0 innings.
- ⚡ Is facing Seattle for the seventh time in his career and the second time this season...in six career starts, is 4-1 with a 2.17 ERA (37.1 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, eight walks and 45 strikeouts.
- ⚡ Is making his seventh home start of the season...is 1-3 with a 3.03 ERA (32.3 IP, 11 ER), three home runs, 12 walks and 22 strikeouts; Twins are 1-5.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on June 19 in Cincinnati opposite Nick Martinez...earned his third win of the season in Minnesota's 12-5 victory...allowed four runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...two runs scored in the first inning on an RBI single by Tyler Stephenson and an RBI double by Spencer Steer...Gavin Lux's two-run home run in the third inning scored the latter two runs.

- ⚡ Marked his third consecutive start with a run allowed in the first inning...his 6.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 10 ER) in the first inning is the 22nd highest among pitchers with 10-or-more first-inning appearances this season.
- ⚡ Marked the fourth consecutive start in which he was not been removed from the game in the middle of an inning...is one start away from his season and career-high streak of five-straight starts, done between April 12-May 4, 2025 and September 11, 2019-August 3, 2020.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on June 13 in Houston, opposite Colton Gordon, in Minnesota's 10-3 defeat...allowed a career-high-tying nine runs (8 ER) on a career-high-tying 12 hits (1 HR), with one walk and one strikeout over 4.0 innings...faced eight batters in a three-run first inning, allowing three singles, a double and a walk...caught Jose Altuve stealing third base in the second inning, Paddack's first career pitcher caught stealing...Altuve hit a solo home run to start the fourth inning, the ninth run of Paddack's outing.

- ⚡ Marked the third time in Paddack's career allowing a single, a double, a triple and a home run in the same game...previously did so on May 31, 2021 at Chicago-NL (4.1 IP) and July 16, 2021 at Washington (5.0 IP)
- ⚡ Snapped his career-high 12-start streak of allowing three-or-fewer earned runs and an 11-start streak of pitching 5.0-or-more innings.

FACING SEATTLE: In six career starts against Seattle, including five at home (1 at Target Field), is 4-1 with a 2.17 ERA (37.1 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, eight walks and 45 strikeouts...last faced the Mariners earlier this month on June 1 in Seattle...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with one walk and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts over a career-high-tying 8.0 innings and did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 2-1 walk-off loss.

- ⚡ His opponent batting average when facing Seattle is .185 (25-for-135) with a .234 on-base percentage and a .296 slugging percentage...his strikeout-to-walk ratio is 5.63.

GO WEST: Is facing the American League West for the 20th time in his career (19th start) and the 11th time in a Twins uniform...has faced the A's six times, Seattle six times, Texas three times, Houston three times and Los Angeles-AL once...in his career, is 6-3 with a 5.21 ERA (93.1 IP, 54 ER), 13 home runs, 22 walks and 84 strikeouts against the AL West...since joining the Twins, is 2-1 with a 6.96 ERA (42.2 IP, 33 ER), eight home runs, 11 walks and 39 strikeouts against the AL West; Minnesota is 7-4.

- ⚡ Today's game marks his fourth start against the AL West this season, also April 6 vs. Houston (ND, 4.0 IP, 3 ER, 2 BB, 2 K), June 1 at Seattle (ND, 8.0 IP, 1 ER, 1 BB, 10 K) and June 13 at Houston (4.0 IP, 8 ER, 1 BB, 1 K).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In six home starts this season, is 1-3 with a 3.03 ERA (32.3 IP, 11 ER), three home runs, 12 walks and 22 strikeouts, compared to 2-3 with a 5.48 ERA (47.2 IP, 29 ER), eight home runs, 11 walks and 34 strikeouts in nine road starts...since joining the Twins in 2022, is 5-5 with a 3.83 ERA (94.0 IP, 40 ER), 12 home runs, 23 walks and 87 strikeouts in 19 games (18 starts) at home.

- ⚡ This season, Paddack has a .230 (28-for-122) opponent batting average at home, with a .612 OPS and a 1.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- ⚡ In five career home starts against Seattle, is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (29.1 IP, 8 ER), three home runs, seven walks and 35 strikeouts...earned the win in his lone home start vs. Seattle as a Twin on May 8, 2024; allowed one run on eight hits (1 HR), with one walk and 10 strikeouts in 5.1 innings.

PLATOON SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters are batting .235 (36-for-153) with six home runs, 15 RBI, 11 walks and 24 strikeouts against Paddack, while righties are batting .263 (40-for-152) with five home runs, 23 RBI, 12 walks and 32 strikeouts...in his career, lefties are slashing .244/.290/.417 with 39 home runs and a 3.37 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties are slashing .259/.297/.436 with 39 home runs and a 5.28 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ⚡ Seattle's lefties are hitting .171 (12-for-70) with two home runs, five RBI, one walk and 21 strikeouts against Paddack, while righties are hitting .200 (13-for-65) with two home runs, three RBI, seven walks and 24 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In 2025, Paddack has relied on a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

- ⚡ With 1323 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has a 16.7 percent strikeout rate and a 6.8 percent walk rate...batters are chasing 32.5 percent of the time, which is baseball's 88th percentile, whiffing 20.7 percent of the time and hitting the ball hard 43.0 percent of the time.
- ⚡ In his last outing, Paddack induced 5 whiffs for a 15.0 percent whiff rate, his second and third lowest marks of the season, respectively...his average pitch velocity of 86.4 mph was his lowest of the season...he threw 35 four-seam fastballs, his third-lowest in a start this season, with an average velocity of 91.4 mph, his lowest velocity of the year.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 7-3, 3.06 ERA // CAREER: 40-29, 3.79 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is set to start tomorrow night's game against Seattle at Target Field...took the loss in his last outing on June 20 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field, a 17-6 Twins defeat; allowed three runs on three hits, with three walks and seven strikeouts over 5.1 innings pitched...in four career starts against the Mariners, including two at Target Field, is 0-3 with a 5.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 11 ER), five home runs, seven walks and 24 strikeouts...in seven home appearances (6 starts) this season, is 3-2 with a 3.29 ERA (38.1 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, 11 walks and 49 strikeouts.
