THE TWINS: Have gone 0-5 through five games on their seven-game homestand, getting swept by the Brewers over the weekend, followed by consecutive losses to the Mariners over the last two nights...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the third of four against Seattle through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game the Twins will travel to Detroit for a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the Tigers this weekend, followed by an off-day on Monday, then three against the Miami Marlins from next Tuesday-Thursday.

TWINS FIGHT BACK AGAIN, BUT CAN'T FINISH JOB: The Twins lost to the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of 6-5, dropping their fifth-straight...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs (4 earned) on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched — all five runs coming in the third inning...Minnesota answered with five runs of their own, one in the third and four in the fourth...Jhoan Duran (4-3) was issued the loss, allowing one hit, one walk with two hit batters, allowing the winning run to score on a Julio Rodríguez sac fly...the offense recorded eight hits, highlighted by Ryan Jeffers who went 1-for-4 with a two-run double (15th) in the fourth inning.

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE: The Twins are playing their 80th game today...after tomorrow afternoon's game, it will mark the exact halfway point of the season...below are how the hitting (above) and pitching (below) numbers have compared through 81 games since 2021:

SEATTLE SOUNDS: The Twins and Mariners are playing the sixth of seven meetings this season...Twins have lost four-straight to the Mariners for the first time since April 10-June 15, 2021...last time they lost five-straight was April 7-May 28, 2018.

- ☞ Carlos Correa has 120 career hits and 120 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...his 120 hits are sixth-most among actives.
- ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .297 (19-for-64) with five doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, a .370 on-base percentage, a .516 slugging percentage and an .885 OPS in 21 career games vs. the M's.
- ☞ Byron Buxton has a .948 OPS (.336 OBP / .612 SLG) in his last 25 games against Seattle...in that span, he has 10 home runs and 28 RBI.
- ☞ Ty France is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with a .756 OPS in eight career games against the Mariners.
- ☞ Trevor Larnach has hit safely in seven-straight games against the Mariners...in those seven, he is hitting .448 (13-for-29) with three home runs, nine RBI, a .500 on-base percentage, an .828 slugging percentage and a 1.328 OPS...this season, he has 10 hits in 22 at-bats against Seattle pitching.
- ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with a 1.135 OPS in his last nine games against the Mariners...this season he has reached base eight times in 16 plate appearances vs. Seattle pitching.
- ☞ Castro, Correa, Wallner and Larnach all have home runs against Seattle starter George Kirby...Wallner has three hits in five at-bats.

ONE RUN, NO FUN: The Twins have gone 7-15 in one-run games this season, dropping each of their last nine: one at Kansas City (May 25), two in Seattle (May 31 & June 1), one vs. Toronto (June 7), two at Houston (June 14 & 15), one at Cincinnati (June 17), one vs. Milwaukee (June 22) and last night vs. Seattle...their last one-run win was on May 24 vs. Kansas City, a 5-4 victory at Target Field...they went 22-20 in one-run games in 2024.

☞ Three of the five games between the Twins and Mariners this season have been decided by one run, with the Mariners winning all three.

BUCK YEA: Over his last 39 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .313 (46-for-147) with five doubles, two triples, 12 home runs, 35 RBI, 20 walks, a .392 on-base percentage, a .619 slugging percentage and a 1.011 OPS.

- ☞ He has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games.
 - ☞ He is slashing .287/.378/.620 (.998 OPS) in 30 home games this season...in his last eight games at Target Field, he is slashing .407/.500/.815 (1.315 OPS) with three home runs.
 - ☞ His 2025 MLB percentile rankings: 95th in batting run value (18), 96th in hard hit percentage (54.5), 92nd in barrel percentage (15.6), 89th in bat speed (75.1), 85th in average exit velocity (91.8) and 83rd in xSLG (.511).
- THE BOOK ON BROOKS:** Brooks Lee has hit safely in 22 of his last 23 games with an at-bat...in those last 23 games, he is hitting .348 (32-for-92) with three doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI and an .847 OPS.
- ☞ Over those 23 games, he is slashing .319/.351/.449 (.801 OPS) as a left-handed batter...as a right-handed batter he is .288/.302/.346 (.648 OPS).

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Over his last 20 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .303 (23-for-76) with five doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .526 slugging percentage and an .891 OPS.

☞ In that span, against right-handed pitching, he is hitting .339 (21-for-62) with five doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .565 slugging percentage and a .956 OPS.

CARLOS COR-RAKING: Carlos Correa is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with one double, one home run, three RBI, two walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.125 OPS in his last six games.

☞ In 25 June games in 2024, Correa hit .388 (38-for-98) with five home runs, 21 RBI and a 1.023 OPS.

☞ His career .305 June batting average and .924 June OPS are both the highest of any month in his career.

- ☞ Making his 16th appearance (15th start) of the season and the 100th appearance (99th start) of his career.
- ☞ Took the loss in his last start on June 20 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field, a 17-6 Twins defeat... allowed three runs on three hits, with three walks and seven strikeouts over 5.1 innings...did not allow a hit until the fifth inning.
- ☞ Is facing Seattle for the fifth time in his career, is 0-3 with a 5.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 11 ER), five home runs, seven walks and 24 strikeouts...has two career starts vs. the Mariners at Target Field.
- ☞ In seven home appearances (six starts) this season, is 3-2 with a 3.29 ERA (38.1 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, 11 walks and 49 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on June 20 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field opposite Jacob Misiorowski... took his third loss of the season in Minnesota's 17-6 defeat... allowed three runs on three hits, with three walks and seven strikeouts over 5.1 innings...walked Jackson Chourio to start the fourth inning, who stole second base and scored on William Contreras's one-out sacrifice fly...first hit allowed was a single by Rhys Hoskins to start the fifth inning...exited the game in the sixth after Sal Frelick singled with one out and scored on Chourio's double; Chourio scored on Christian Yelich's single with Danny Coulombe pitching in relief.

- ☞ Has struck out five-or-more batters in 12 games this season (tied for the 12th most in baseball), including in three-straight since June 8 vs. Toronto.
- ☞ Marked his 14th consecutive game allowing an extra-base hit, the second-longest streak in his career; did so in 24-straight games in 2023-24.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started on June 14 in Houston opposite Hunter Brown but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 walk-off loss...allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts over 7.0 quality innings...marked the third time this season he's pitched 7.0-or-more innings...two hits tied his season-low, also done on April 9, May 10 and May 16...both runs allowed came in the third, when Brendan Rodgers singled with one out and scored on Yanier Diaz's home run...retired 12-straight batters from the third-seventh inning...struck out the first batter faced in five of his seven innings pitched.

FACING SEATTLE: In four career starts against the Mariners, is 0-3 with a 5.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 11 ER), five home runs, seven walks and 24 strikeouts...last faced Seattle on June 30, 2024 at T-Mobile Park but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-3 win; allowed two runs (1 ER) on six hits, with no walks and 10 strikeouts over 5.2 innings...gave up a home run in each of his first three starts against the Mariners, including two two-homer games on June 14, 2022 in Seattle and July 26, 2023 at Target Field.

- ☞ Seattle hitters are slashing .263/.349/.539 in 79 at-bats against Ryan...they've recorded five-or-more hits in all but the first of Ryan's starts (two hits on April 8, 2022 at Target Field).

THE BEST OF THE WEST: Is facing the American League West for the fifth time this season, going 2-1 with a 3.75 ERA (24.0 IP, 10 ER), four home runs, six walks and 28 strikeouts; faced Houston twice and the Angels and Athletics once apiece...in that span, the division is batting .195 (17-for-87) with a .278 on-base percentage and a .379 slugging percentage...in 21 career starts against the AL West, is 7-8 with a 4.73 ERA (112.1 IP, 59 ER), 22 home runs, 38 walks and 139 strikeouts...in that span, the division is batting .229 with a .306 on-base percentage and a .444 slugging percentage.

- ☞ His 3.66 strikeout-to-walk ratio against the AL West is his lowest against any division in baseball, behind the National League West (3.69 K/BB), while his 11.14 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ranks first...his 7.77 hits-per-9.0 innings and 1.20 WHIP rank third.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In seven appearances (6 starts) at Target Field this season, is 3-2 with a 3.29 ERA (38.1 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, 11 walks and 49 strikeouts, compared to 4-1 with a 2.87 ERA (47.0 IP, 15 ER), six home runs, nine walks and 47 strikeouts over eight road starts...in 50 career home games (49 starts), is 22-14 with a 3.66 ERA (285.0 IP, 116 ER), 39 home runs, a 1.01 WHIP and a 4.87 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ☞ In his seven home games this season, opposing batters are slashing .180/.252/.331 in 133 at-bats...his 0.91 WHIP at home ranks 10th in baseball.
- ☞ In two career starts against Seattle at Target Field, is 0-2 with a 7.04 ERA (7.2 IP, 6 ER), three home runs, six walks and 11 strikeouts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .207/.272/.356 with eight doubles, four home runs, eight walks and 30 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .178/.251/.331 with eight doubles, six home runs, 12 walks and 66 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .207/.269/.361 with 70 walks and 239 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .229/.276/.434 with 59 walks and 382 strikeouts.

- ☞ Seattle's lefties are batting .179 (7-for-39) with one double, two RBI, four walks, eight strikeouts and a .461 OPS against Ryan, while righties are batting .351 (13-for-37) with three doubles, one triple, five home runs, nine RBI, three walks, 16 strikeouts and a 1.334 OPS against Ryan.

THE ARSENAL: Through 15 appearances (14 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ This season (1365 pitches), his chase rate is 25.9 percent and his whiff rate is 27.0 percent... his fastball run value of 11 ranks in baseball's 97th percentile...his 6.0 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 82nd percentile, and his 28.7 percent strikeout rate ranks in baseball's 85th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.1 mph while his hard-hit rate is 40.5 percent.
- ☞ Relies primarily on his four-seam fastball as his strikeout pitch...on 736 four-seamers thrown this season, has a 31.1 percent strikeout rate and a 27.2 percent whiff rate...31.1 percent strikeout rate ranks seventh in baseball (min. 500 4-seam FB).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2025: 2-4, 4.53 ERA // CAREER: 7-10, 4.53 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Mariners at Target Field...took the loss in his last outing on June 21 vs. Milwaukee, a 9-0 Minnesota shutout defeat; allowed four runs (3 ER) on four hits, with three walks and three strikeouts over 6.0 innings...lone career start against Seattle came on May 6, 2024 at Target Field; allowed one hit and one walk with eight strikeouts in 6.0 scoreless innings.
