**THE TWINS:** Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 2-5, getting swept in three games by the Brewers last weekend, followed by a four-game split with the Mariners earlier this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with the first of three against the Tigers over the weekend...after this series, they will fly to Miami to enjoy an off-day on Monday, then play the Marlins for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.  
 ☞ Twins are seeking their first three-game winning streak since June 2-4 when they took the first three of four in Sacramento against the A's.  
 ☞ Twins have gone 17-25 on the road, compared to 22-17 at home...they went 1-5 on their last roadtrip, going 0-3 at Houston (June 13-15) and 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19).

**A WIN WORTH WAITING AROUND FOR:** The Twins beat the Mariners yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 10-1...the game began at 4:32 pm, after a four hour and 22-minute rain delay, marking the second longest delay in Target Field history, behind June 22, 2017 (4:50)...Simeon Woods Richardson (3-4) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts...the offense scored all of their runs in the fifth and sixth innings, posting eight in the sixth inning (season-high)...of the 11 hits for Minnesota batters, three were home runs from Trevor Larnach (12), Brooks Lee (8) and Matt Wallner (7)...Larnach finished with three RBI.  
 ☞ Prior to the Twins 10 runs yesterday, they had scored 23 runs through the first six games on the homestand.

**GOOD BYE-RON TO YOU:** Over his last 41 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .310 (48-for-155) with six doubles, two triples, 12 home runs, 36 RBI, 31 runs scored, 21 walks, a .389 on-base percentage, a .606 slugging percentage and a .995 OPS.  
 ☞ He has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games.  
 ☞ In his last 13 road games, Buxton is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with two doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .362 on-base percentage, a .635 slugging percentage and a .997 OPS.

**CASTROWORLD:** In his last 34 games, Willi Castro is hitting .330 (37-for-112) with six doubles, one triple, six home runs, 14 RBI, 15 walks, 23 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .423 on-base percentage, a .563 slugging percentage and a .986 OPS...below are his first 25 games compared to his last 34 games this season:

**RIDE THE TIGER:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the fourth of 13 games this season...these two last met for three games at Target Field during Minnesota's second homestand as the Twins went 1-2, winning the third of three.  
 ☞ Twins are 499-451-1 all-time against the Tigers...a win tonight and Detroit will be the second team the Twins have reached 500 wins against...the other being Chicago-AL (544-472).  
 ☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 135, 25 ahead of Cleveland (110)...59 of those have come at Comerica Park.  
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (35-for-116) with eight doubles, six home runs, 17 RBI and an .893 OPS in his last 30 games vs. the Tigers.  
 ☞ Byron Buxton has a 1.074 OPS and a .706 slugging percentage in his last nine games against the Tigers, hitting five doubles and three home runs in 38 plate appearances.

**REAL COMERICAN HEROES:** Twins went 4-3 at Comerica Park last season...they split a four-game series from April 12-14 and won a three-game series from July 26-28.  
 ☞ Twins starter have gone 3-1, 1.38 ERA (39.0 IP, 6 ER) with six walks, 46 strikeouts and a .153 opponent batting average in their last six games at Comerica Park.  
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and an .874 OPS in his last 11 games at Comerica Park.  
 ☞ Ty France has reached base safely in all nine career games at Comerica Park, hitting .353 (12-for-34) with a .463 on-base percentage and a .993 OPS in this ballpark.  
 ☞ In Carlos Correa's last 19 games at Comerica Park, he is hitting .342 (26-for-76) with two doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 12 runs scored, a .378 on-base percentage and a 1.049 OPS in that span.

**HIGHS AND 'LOS:** Carlos Correa is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with one double, one home run, five RBI, two walks, five strikeouts, a .455 on-base percentage, a .548 slugging percentage and a 1.003 OPS in his last eight games...over that span, he has posted an average exit velocity of 95.8 mph, ninth-best in baseball (min. 1,000 pitches seen).  
 ☞ His career .305 June batting average and .921 June OPS are both the highest of any month in his career.

**CLEDGE HAMMER:** Since being acquired via trade with Philadelphia on April 26, Kody Clemens has hit nine home runs, with 19 RBI, a .508 slugging percentage and an .820 OPS in 136 plate appearances for Minnesota...in that span, he ranks second on the club in homers (Buxton - 11) and slugging percentage (Buxton - .585), and third in OPS (Buxton - .977 & Castro - .894).  
 ☞ Clemens was drafted by the Tigers in the third round (79th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft...he made his major league debut in this ballpark against the Twins on May 31, 2022...he recorded his first career hit here on June 13, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL, singling off Lance Lynn.

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** Over his last 22 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .298 (25-for-84) with five doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, a .536 slugging percentage and an .897 OPS...in that span, he ranks 13th in the AL in average exit velocity (91.8 mph).  
 ☞ In that span, against right-handed pitching, he is hitting .329 (23-for-70) with five doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .571 slugging percentage and a .956 OPS.

**ONE MORE TIME:** The Twins have gone 7-15 in one-run games this season, dropping each of their last nine; one at Kansas City (May 25), two in Seattle (May 31 & June 1), one vs. Toronto (June 7), two at Houston (June 14 & 15), one at Cincinnati (June 17), one vs. Milwaukee (June 22) and last night vs. Seattle...their last one-run win was on May 24 vs. Kansas City, a 5-4 victory at Target Field.

- ⚡ Took the loss in his last outing on June 22 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field, a 9-8 Twins defeat...entered the game in the second inning and worked 4.2 innings, allowing eight runs on 12 hits (2 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts.
- ⚡ Is facing Detroit for the third time in his career and the first time at Comerica Park...is 0-1 with a 6.52 ERA (9.2 IP, 7 ER), three home runs, one walk and 10 strikeouts.
- ⚡ In two road appearances this season, is 0-1 with a 12.27 ERA (7.1 IP, 10 ER), three home runs, five walks and 10 strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took the loss in his last outing on June 22 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field, opposite Quinn Priester, a 9-8 Twins defeat...entered the game in the second inning behind opener Danny Coulombe, Twins trailed 0-1...allowed a season-high-tying eight runs on a career-high 12 hits (2 HR), with a career-high-tying three walks and a season-low three strikeouts over 4.2 innings...home run allowed to Rhys Hoskins in the second inning was the second home run this season that Festa has given up in the first inning of an outing...allowed Joey Ortiz to score on a wild pitch in the fourth inning, Festa's first wild pitch of the season, the third of his career and his first since July 30, 2024...the first batter of every inning but the sixth reached base against Festa...exited the game with two outs in the sixth after Isaac Collins singled and stole second and Rhys Hoskins walked.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on June 17 in Cincinnati opposite Andrew Abbott but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 loss...allowed four run (2 earned) on two hits, with three walks and four strikeouts over 3.2 innings...retired first eight batters faced and carried a no-hitter into the fourth inning, the longest no-hit bid of his major league career...both hits allowed - a double by Will Benson and a single by Jake Fraley - came with two outs in the fourth inning and both drove in two runs...runs scored on Fraley's single were unearned after a passed ball on a third strike to Spencer Steer continued the inning...Festa plunked Matt McLain, his third hit batter of the season and fifth of his career, before giving way to Danny Coulombe in relief.

⚡ Marked the fourth time this season he has not allowed a run in the first three innings, then been unable to work into or finish the fifth inning.

**SLIM REAPER STRIKES:** In Minnesota Twins history (1961-present), only Joe Ryan (110) has recorded more strikeouts than Festa (109) through their first 21 career games...below are some of Festa's numbers compared to Twins pitchers with 100-or-more strikeouts through their first 21 career games:

**ADDITIONALLY:** Of the 72 major league pitchers who have recorded 109-or-more strikeouts in their first 21 career games since 2010, only four have done so in fewer innings than Festa.

**FACING DETROIT:** Is facing the Tigers for the third time in his career and for the first time at Comerica Park...in two career starts, is 0-1 with a 6.52 ERA (9.2 IP, 7 ER), three home runs (Carson Kelly, Riley Greene, Wenceel Pérez), one walk and 10 strikeouts...last faced Detroit earlier this season on April 11 at Target Field and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 loss; allowed one run (0 ER) on three hits, one walk and four strikeouts.

⚡ Detroit is batting .293 (12-for-41) with a .326 on-base percentage and a .935 OPS against Festa.  
⚡ In four career starts against the American League Central, is 0-1 with a 5.29 ERA (17.0 IP, 10 ER), four home runs, seven walks and 18 strikeouts.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In two starts on the road this season, is 0-1 with a 12.27 ERA (7.1 IP, 10 ER), three home runs, five walks and 10 strikeouts, compared to 1-1 with a 4.56 ERA (23.2 IP, 12 ER), three home runs, 10 walks and 22 strikeouts in five home appearances (four starts)...in eight career road starts, is 2-3 with a 5.30 ERA (37.1 IP, 22 ER), five home runs, 12 walks and 46 strikeouts.

⚡ Seeking first road win since August 5, 2024 at Chicago-NL.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, lefties are hitting .259 (15-for-58) with four doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, eight walks, 14 strikeouts and a .799 OPS, while righties are hitting .303 (20-for-66) with two doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, seven walks, 18 strikeouts and an .888 OPS...in his career, lefties are slashing .242/.332/.416 in 178 at-bats, with six home runs, 21 walks and 52 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .274/.335/.477 in 197 at-bats, with nine home runs, 17 walks and 57 strikeouts.

⚡ In his career, lefties in the American League Central are batting .238 (10-for-42) with two triples, three home runs, four RBI, four walks and 10 strikeouts, while AL Central righties are 9-for-27 (.333) with one double, one home run, four RBI, three walks and eight strikeouts.

⚡ So far this year (567 pitches), Festa has a 26.8 percent chase rate, a 27.5 percent whiff rate, a 44.1 percent hard-hit rate and an average exit velocity of 91.5 mph...batters are striking out 22.4 percent of the time and walking 10.5 percent of the time.
