THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 2-5 (0-3 vs. Milwaukee and 2-2 vs. Seattle), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a win over the Tigers last night...today, the Twins will play the second of three weekend games in Detroit...they will complete the series tomorrow night before flying to Miami to spend an off-day on Monday, then play the Marlins for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.
 ☞ After two wins against Seattle (Wednesday and Thursday) and a win last night, the Twins are seeking their first four-game winning streak since May 3-17, when they won 13-straight.

HOT AND READY, DAVID DELIVERS IN DETROIT: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 4-1, extending their winning streak to three games...it marked Minnesota's 500th win against the Tigers (since 1961)...David Festa (2-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.2 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts, while throwing 75 pitches...the offense recorded six hits and walked four times...Brooks Lee led the offense by going 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI...Byron Buxton hit his team-leading 18th home run...Matt Wallner went 1-for-2 with a double, a hit that registered at 113.3 mph exit velocity, the highest by a Twin this season.

VIDEO GAME BUCK: Over his last 42 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (49-for-159) with six doubles, two triples, 13 home runs, 37 RBI, 33 runs scored, 22 walks, a .389 on-base percentage, a .616 slugging percentage and a 1.006 OPS.
 ☞ He has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 games.
 ☞ In his last 14 road games, Buck is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with two doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI, a .365 on-base percentage, a .661 slugging percentage and a 1.026 OPS.

EARN YOUR STRIPES: The Twins and Tigers are playing the fifth of 13 games this season.
 ☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 136, 26 ahead of Cleveland (110)...60 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 11 times in their last seven games at Comerica.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (36-for-120) with eight doubles, six home runs, 17 RBI and an .880 OPS in his last 31 games vs. the Tigers.
 ☞ Byron Buxton has a 1.109 OPS and a .737 slugging percentage in his last 10 games against the Tigers, hitting five doubles and four home runs in 43 plate appearances.

MOTOR CITY MADNESS: Twins have won three of their last four at Comerica Park, dating back to July 4, 2024.
 ☞ Twins starter have gone 4-1, 1.21 ERA (44.2 IP, 6 ER) with six walks, 52 strikeouts and a .147 opponent batting average in their last seven games at Comerica Park.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and an .874 OPS in his last 11 games at Comerica Park.
 ☞ Ty France has reached base safely in all 10 career games at Comerica Park, hitting .343 (12-for-35) with a .465 on-base percentage and a .979 OPS in this ballpark.
 ☞ In Carlos Correa's last 20 games at Comerica Park, he is hitting .338 (27-for-80) with two doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 12 runs scored, a .372 on-base percentage and a 1.022 OPS in that span.

PITCHING ON THE POSITIVE: After posting a 6.73 ERA (191.1 IP, 143 ER) with a .283 opponent batting average (9.9 H/G) in the first 22 games of June (through Tuesday), the Twins pitching staff has posted a 0.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 2 ER) with a .156 opponent batting average (5.0 H/G) over their last three games.
 ☞ Twins starters enter today with a streak of 19.0 consecutive scoreless innings...the last runs allowed by a starter came in the third inning on Tuesday vs. Seattle (Paddack)...the starters' longest scoreless inning streak this season is 21.2, from May 14 (G2)-May 18.

BE-LEE-VE IT! Brooks Lee has hit safely in 25 of his last 26 games with an at-bat...in those last 25 games, he is hitting .350 (35-for-100) with four doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI and an .885 OPS.
 ☞ Last night's fourth-inning double extended Lee's road hitting streak to 15 games...during the 15 games, he is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with three doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and an .838 OPS...it's the longest road hitting streak for a Twin since Jorge Polanco hit in 20-straight from May 21-July 3, 2019.

THREE DAYS IN THE D: Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season today and their first since June 2-5, when they took three of four against the A's in Sacramento...Minnesota is 11-13-2 in series play, going 6-5-2 at home and 5-8-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 1-7-1 since May 26.
 ☞ Minnesota is looking for its second-straight series win in Detroit after taking two of three here from July 26-28, 2024...they haven't lost a series in Comerica since August of 2023.

FURY ROAD: Willi Castro is hitting .293 (29-for-99) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 13 RBI, 21 runs scored, a .402 on-base percentage, a .586 slugging percentage and a .988 OPS in 29 road games this season...in fact, over his last 14 away games, he is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with a .467 on-base percentage, a .694 slugging percentage and a 1.161 OPS.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis began his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul last night, going 0-for-3 with a strikeout...he has missed the club's last 13 games with a strained left hamstring.

THE WORLDWIDE LEADER: Tomorrow night's game will be broadcast on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball with first pitch at 7:00 pm (ET)...Sunday Night Baseball Presented by Capital One is available live on ESPN, ESPN Radio, ESPN Deportes and the ESPN App...Baseball Tonight: Sunday Night Countdown precedes Sunday Night Baseball with a one-hour pregame show, starting at 6:00 pm on ESPN.
 ☞ Last time the Twins were on Sunday Night Baseball was September 20, 2020 at Wrigley Field, a 4-0 Twins win in a José Berríos vs. Yu Darvish matchup.

- ☞ In 11 career starts vs. Detroit, Ober is 4-2, 3.39 ERA (61.0 IP, 23 ER) with six home runs, 12 walks and 67 strikeouts...last start vs. Detroit was July 28, 2024 at Comerica (8.0 shutout IP w/ one hit).
- ☞ Is 0-4, 8.51 ERA (24.1 IP, 23 ER) in his last four starts after going 4-0, 2.43 ERA (59.1 IP, 16 ER) in previous 11 starts from April 5-May 31.

GAME OBER: Last pitched on June 23 vs. Seattle opposite Bryan Woo, taking the loss in Minnesota's 2-11 defeat...allowed seven runs on seven hits (3 HR), no walks and a season-high seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings...permitted a sacrifice fly to J.P. Crawford, followed by a two-run homer to Julio Rodriguez and a three-run shut Luke Raley, all in the third, then retired eight-straight batters before giving up a solo home run to Dominic Canzone in the sixth...102 total pitches matched his season high (also April 28 at CLE and May 14 (1) at BAL)...plunked Luke Raley in the second inning, his fourth hit batter of the season...home run to Luke Raley in the third inning was the fifth longball Ober has allowed on an 0-0 count this season

☞ Ober was dealt his fifth loss of the season, and fourth consecutive loss; is the first time in his career he has been dealt four consecutive losses...also the first time a Twins pitcher has had four losses in a single month since Louis Varland was dealt four in a row in April 2024.

☞ Has allowed a home run in five-consecutive starts, his longest such streak in a single season since July 18-September 20, 2023 when he allowed a homer in 10-straight games

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on June 18 at Cincinnati, opposite Nick Lodolo, taking the loss in Minnesota's 2-4 defeat...allowed four runs on a season-high nine hits (1 HR), no walks and five strikeouts in a 5.2-inning, rain-shortened complete game, becoming his second career complete game...permitted a two-run homer to Spencer Steer in the first, an RBI single to Matt McLain in the second and an RBI single to Will Benson in the third.

☞ The 5.2-inning complete game is the shortest complete game recorded in Twins history since Bob Tewksbury threw a 5.0-inning complete game on June 18, 1998, exactly 27 years prior (W, 4-1).

☞ Ober retired nine of his last ten batters faced in the third through fifth before the game was delayed and ultimately called due to weather.

JUNE JACKS: Bailey has allowed 10 home runs so far in the month of June; marks the most homers allowed by a Twins pitcher in a single month since Héctor Santiago gave up 11 over a span of seven games (6 starts) in May 2017...Ober's homers have come in 24.1 innings, tying Scott Klinglebeck's total in August 1995 (7 games, 4 starts, 10 HR) for the least amount of innings in a month a Twins pitcher has thrown and allowed 10-plus homers.

MOTOWN OBER: Ober is 4-2 in 11 career starts against Detroit, posting a 3.39 ERA (61.0 IP, 23 ER) with 12 walks, 67 strikeouts and a .243 (57-for-235) opponent batting average.

☞ Faced the Tigers four times in 2024, going 3-0 (including two scoreless appearances) with a 0.69 ERA (26.0 IP, 2 ER), three walks and 28 strikeouts...0.69 was his lowest ERA among all opponents in 2024.

☞ Last started against the Tigers at Comerica Park on July 28, 2024 where he allowed just one hit, two walks and 11 strikeouts in 8.0 scoreless innings...Twins 5-0 victory.

☞ Enters today's start with 14.0-straight scoreless innings at Comerica Park.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-12 with a 4.04 ERA (281.0 IP, 126 ER), 9.05 K/9, 2.23 BB/9 and 1.72 HR/9 in 54 games (53 starts) at home compared to 13-15 with a 3.89 ERA (279.2 IP, 121 ER), 8.79 K/9, 1.74 BB/9 and 1.29 HR/9 in 52 road starts.

☞ Ober is 2-2, 4.91 ERA (36.2 IP, 20 ER) with nine walks and 27 strikeouts in seven road starts this season...is 0-1, 5.65 ERA (14.1 IP, 9 ER) in his last three road starts after going 2-0, 1.37 ERA (19.2 IP, 3 ER) in three road starts from April 10-May 3.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 16 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .264/.302/.444 in 178 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .292/.346/.532 in 171 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 21.4 compared to righties' 92.3 mph and 28.3 percent.

☞ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its lowest since 2022, 28.9 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 53.7 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 38.2% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

☞ His 7.4 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 98th percentile.

☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 sliders, Bailey has the sixth highest opponent batting average (.318), eighth highest slugging percentage (.530), 11th highest hard hit percentage (46.4) and seventh lowest strikeout percentage (13.5).

EXTENSION # 6-9: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is tied with Aaron Slegers (2017-18) and Alex Meyer (2015-16) as the second-tallest players to pitch for the Twins in franchise history (since 1901), trailing only Jon Rauch (6-11, 2009-10)...on average this season, Ober has released his pitches 7.4 feet off the mound, the 11th-longest extension in baseball, which puts him in the 98th percentile according to Baseball Savant...teammates Chris Paddack and Louis Varland also have one of the longest extensions in baseball (7.0 feet), both ranking in the 92nd percentile.
