THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 2-5 (0-3 vs. Milwaukee and 2-2 vs. Seattle), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games in Detroit this weekend...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale at Comerica Park...after today's game, they will fly to Miami to spend an off-day on Monday, then play the Marlins for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

MOTOWN LET DOWN: The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Comerica Park by a score of 10-5...Bailey Ober (4-6) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing seven runs on 11 hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk, five strikeouts and four home runs allowed...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Byron Buxton, who hit his team-leading 19th home run...Carlos Correa added a two-run homer, his seventh of the season.

I SAW A TIGER: The Twins and Tigers are playing the sixth of 13 games this season...the next series between these two will be three games at Comerica Park, from August 4-6.

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 138, 28 ahead of Cleveland (110)...62 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 13 times in their last eight games at Comerica.

☞ In his last 21 games at Comerica Park, Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (28-for-84) with two doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 21 RBI, 13 runs scored, a .367 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS in that span.

☞ Byron Buxton has a 1.214 OPS and an .810 slugging percentage in his last 11 games against the Tigers, hitting five doubles and five home runs in 47 plate appearances.

☞ Ty France has reached base safely in all 11 career games at Comerica Park, hitting .333 (13-for-39) with a .447 on-base percentage and a .934 OPS in this ballpark.

VIDEO GAME BUCK: Over his last 43 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .319 (52-for-163) with six doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, 39 RBI, 35 runs scored, 22 walks, a .397 on-base percentage, a .638 slugging percentage and a 1.035 OPS.

☞ He has reached base safely in 18 of his last 19 games.

☞ Buck stole his 15th base yesterday in his 15th chance...he is the only player in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum of 15 tries)...with 19 homers and 15 stolen bases, he is also now one of five players in baseball with at least 15 home runs and 15 steals, joining Elly De La Cruz (18 HR, 22 SB), Pete Crow-Armstrong (21 HR, 25 SB), Kyle Tucker (17 HR, 20 SB) and Fernando Tatis Jr. (15 HR, 16 SB).

☞ For the second time in his career (also 2017 - 16 HR, 29 SB) he has reached the 15-homer/15-stolen bases mark...13 different Twins (19 times now) have done this.

☞ Buck has nine home runs this month, tying his most for a single month in his career (also, Sept/Oct 2016, Sept/Oct 2021 and June 2022)...nine homers are tied for fifth in baseball.

BE-LEE-VIE IT! Brooks Lee has hit safely in 26 of his last 27 games with an at-bat...in those last 27 games, he is hitting .346 (36-for-104) with five doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI and an .880 OPS.

☞ He has hit safely in 16-straight road games...during the 16 games, he is hitting .328 (21-for-64) with four doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and an .833 OPS...it's the longest road hitting streak for a Twin since Jorge Polanco hit in 20-straight from May 21-July 3, 2019.

WINNER TAKE ALL: Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season tonight and their first since June 2-5, when they took three of four against the A's in Sacramento...Minnesota is 11-13-2 in series play, going 6-5-2 at home and 5-8-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 1-7-1 since May 26.

RIP, HOSKEN POWELL: Former Twins outfielder Hosken Powell passed away on Friday at the age of 70 in Pensacola, FL...Powell was the third overall pick by the Twins in the 1975 draft and played four seasons with Minnesota, from 1978-81.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Marco Raya and Low-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher John Klein as co-Twins Pitchers of the Week, and Double-A Pensacola outfielders Kala'i Rosario and Kyler Fedko as co-Players of the Week. ☞ Raya, 22, made one start for the Saints last Sunday vs. Toledo, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts...the Laredo, TX native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB draft out of United South HS.

☞ Klein, 23, made one start for the Kernels on Wednesday vs. Springfield, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings, with one walk and nine strikeouts...the Brooklyn Park, MN native was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in August of 2022.

☞ Rosario, 22, played in five games for the Wind Surge, hitting .438 (7-for-16) with a 1.466 OPS, including hitting for the cycle on Wednesday vs. Springfield...the Papaikou, HI native was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB draft out of Waiakea HS.

☞ Fedko, 25, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .391 (9-for-23) with five home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.527 OPS...the Gibsonia, PA native was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB draft out of UCONN.

ONCE UPON A TIME: Hall of Famer Harmon Killebrew was born on this date in 1938 in Payette, Idaho...Killebrew signed with the Senators at age 17 and made his MLB debut on June 23, 1954 and would finish his career with 2,086 hits, 573 home runs and 1,584 RBI...he was a 13-time All-Star, the AL MVP in 1969, a six-time home run champion and three-time RBI champ...Killebrew passed away in 2011...also, 30 years ago today in 1994: Manager Billy Heywood led a miraculous comeback as the Twins tied the Seattle Mariners, forcing a one-game playoff to decide the final Postseason berth in the American League, with the game to be played in the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome...Game No. 163 headed to extra innings, but the Mariners took the lead in the top of the 10th...with two outs in the bottom half, Lou Collins cracked a ball deep to centerfield, only to watch as Ken Griffey Jr. robbed the game-winning, potential walk-off home run, ending the Twins' season...Heywood would never manage again, as he decided to retire and return to junior high.

- ⚡ Last pitched on June 24 vs. Seattle but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 loss... allowed five runs (4 ER) on five hits, with one walk and four strikeouts over 5.0 innings
- ⚡ Is facing Detroit for the third time in his career, the second time this season and the first time at Comerica Park...in his two career starts, is 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks and 11 strikeouts.
- ⚡ In nine road starts this season, is 2-3 with a 5.48 ERA (47.2 IP, 29 ER), eight home runs, 11 walks and 34 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Last started on June 24 against the Mariners at Target Field opposite Luis Castillo... did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 loss...allowed five runs (4 ER) on five hits, with one walk and four strikeouts over 5.0 innings...all runs were given up in the third inning on four singles, a sacrifice fly and a bases-loaded hit by pitch, Paddack's second hit batter of the season; has not hit multiple batters in a season since 2020 (also 2)...retired the last eight batters he faced in order.

- ⚡ Five runs allowed in the third inning tied his career-high and were his most since he also allowed five runs in the third on March 20, 2021 vs. Milwaukee, a 6-0 San Diego loss.
- ⚡ Paddack's 6.00 ERA (48.0 IP, 32 ER) in the first-third inning this season is the fifth-highest among qualifying pitchers in baseball entering play today.
- ⚡ Marked the fifth consecutive start in which Paddack was not removed from the game in the middle of an inning...tied his season and career-high streak, done between April 12-May 4, 2025 and September 11, 2019-August 3, 2020.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on June 19 in Cincinnati opposite Nick Martinez...earned his third win of the season in Minnesota's 12-5 victory...allowed four runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...two runs scored in the first inning on an RBI single by Tyler Stephenson and an RBI double by Spencer Steer...Gavin Lux's two-run home run in the third inning scored the latter two runs.

FACING DETROIT: In two career starts against the Tigers, is 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks and 11 strikeouts...has not pitched at Comerica Park in his career...last faced Detroit earlier this season on April 12 and took the loss in Minnesota's 4-0 defeat...allowed two runs (1 ER) on two hits, with two walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

- ⚡ In his career, Detroit hitters are 7-for-35 (.200) with a .250 on-base percentage and a .507 OPS...five of their seven hits are singles, while the remaining two are doubles.

DIVISION WORK: Did not face the American League Central until joining the Twins pitching staff in 2022...in 11 starts against the division (CWS-4, CLE-3, KC-2, DET-2), Paddack is 1-5 with a 3.90 ERA (60.0 IP, 26 ER); Twins are 4-7...this season, is 0-4 with a 5.70 ERA (23.2 IP, 15 ER), five home runs, 13 walks and 16 strikeouts in five AL Central starts.

- ⚡ Since 2022, American League Central batters are slashing .230/.284/.383 in 222 at-bats against Paddack, while the rest of the American League is slashing .301/.340/.456 in 399 at-bats.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In nine road starts this season, is 2-3 with a 5.48 ERA (47.2 IP, 29 ER), eight home runs, 11 walks and 34 strikeouts, compared to 1-3 with a 3.58 ERA (37.2 IP, 15 ER), three home runs, 13 walks and 26 strikeouts in seven home starts...since 2022, is 5-6 with a 5.47 ERA (102.0 IP, 62 ER), 14 home runs, 24 walks and 76 strikeouts in 20 appearances (19 starts) away from Target Field.

- ⚡ This season, Paddack has a .262 (48-for-183) opponent batting average with a .762 OPS and a 3.09 strikeout-to-walk ratio on the road.
- ⚡ Has allowed a home run in six of his nine road starts this season, including one in each of his last three.
- ⚡ Is making his first career appearance at Comerica Park...in five career starts at American League Central ballparks, is 0-2 with a 5.47 ERA (26.1 IP, 16 ER), six home runs, a 2.43 strikeout-to-walk ratio, a .219 (21-for-96) opponent batting average and a .707 opponent OPS.

PLATOON SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters are batting .238 (39-for-164) with six home runs, 17 RBI, 11 walks and 24 strikeouts, while righties are batting .263 (42-for-160) with five home runs, 26 RBI, 13 walks and 36 strikeouts...in his career, lefties are slashing .244/.291/.417 with 39 home runs and a 3.37 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties are slashing .259/.297/.435 with 39 home runs and a 5.25 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ⚡ Paddack's .238 opponent batting average against lefties this season ranks third among Twins starters, while his .263 opponent batting average against righties ranks sixth.
- ⚡ In his career, Detroit's lefties are 3-for-19 (.158) with one double, two walks and six strikeouts, while Detroit's righties are 4-for-16 (.250) with one double, one walk and five strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In 2025, Paddack has relied on a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

- ⚡ With 1403 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has a 16.7 percent strikeout rate and a 6.7 percent walk rate...batters are chasing 31.9 percent of the time, which ranks in baseball's 86th percentile, whiffing 20.6 percent of the time and hitting the ball hard 43.2 percent of the time.
- ⚡ His fastball run value of 5 this season ranks in baseball's 84th percentile.
- ⚡ After averaging 86.9 mph on all pitches over his two starts on June 13 and 19, Paddack averaged 90.2 mph in his last outing on June 23...his four-seam fastball averaged 94.1 mph with a whiff rate of 18.2 percent on June 23, compared to 92.4 mph and 10.0 percent between June 13-19.

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 8-3, 2.86 ERA // CAREER: 41-29, 3.75 ERA)
