**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-4 through seven games on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay last week, 1-2 at Seattle over the weekend and 1-0 against the A's... tonight, they will play the second of four at Sutter Health Park with games three and four on Wednesday night and Thursday afternoon.

☞ Twins are 25-12 in their last 37 games since April 22, second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Detroit (26-12)... prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

☞ Twins have a run differential of +36 (243-207) on the season, fourth-best in the AL, trailing Detroit's +98 (309-211), New York-AL's +98 (310-221) and Tampa Bay's +41 (256-215).

**SAC-TOWN GOOD TO TWINS IN OPENER:** The Twins beat the Athletics last night at Sutter Health Park in Sacramento by a score of 10-4. Joe Ryan (6-2) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with a season-high three walks and four strikeouts — three of the four runs scored on a Lawrence Butler three-run homer in the fourth inning... the offense recorded 14 hits, walked five times and only struck out five times... Byron Buxton went 2-for-5 and tied his career-high with five RBI... Ty France went 3-for-5 and drove in two runs, while Brooks Lee went 2-for-5 and drove in two runs as well.

**VERY ATHLETIC:** The Twins and A's are playing the second of seven games this season.

☞ Twins are 7-1 in their last eight against the A's, 13-2 in their last 15 and 17-3 in their last 20, dating back to May of 2022.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .297 (11-for-37) with two doubles, one home run, three walks and a .782 OPS in 10 career games against the Athletics.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .330 (36-for-109) with eight doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, a .541 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS in his last 27 games vs. the Athletics.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .417 (10-for-24) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 11 RBI, a .750 slugging percentage and a 1.173 OPS in his last seven games against the A's.

☞ Harrison Bader is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBI, a .563 slugging percentage and a .945 OPS in 10 career games against the A's.

☞ Royce Lewis has hit safely in 10 of 11 career games against the A's... in those 11, he is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with four doubles, four home runs and a 1.132 OPS.

☞ Willi Castro is hitting .359 (14-for-39) with four doubles, one home run and a .995 OPS in his last 10 career games vs. the A's.

**CALIFORNIA LOVE:** The Twins have gone 7-0 against California teams this season, going 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL, from April 25-27, 3-0 vs. San Francisco, from May 9-11 and 1-0 against the Athletics... later this season, the Twins will play at the Dodgers (3 G, July 21-23), host the A's (3 G, August 19-21), host the Padres (3 G, August 29-31), and play in Anaheim (3 G, September 8-10).

**HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES:** The Twins have gone 10-5 in their last 15 road games, since May 3, after beginning the season 4-14 in their first 18, through May 2... below are their offensive (above) and pitching (below) comparisons this season:

**RETURN OF THE MACK:** In three games since coming off the 7-day Concussion IL, Byron Buxton is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with one double, eight RBI and a .745 OPS... in 16 games since May 1, he is hitting .323 (21-for-65) with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, 18 RBI, a .569 slugging percentage and a .948 OPS.

☞ Buck stole his 10th base of the season last night and has now been successful in all 10 attempts in 2025, one of four players in baseball with 10 perfect attempts, joining Xander Bogaerts (11/11), Matt McLain (11/11) and Geraldo Perdomo (11/11).

**C4, EXP-LOS-IVE:** Over his last 27 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .313 (31-for-99) with five doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .485 slugging percentage and a .828 OPS — Twins 18-9 in those games... in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .167 (14-for-84) with six doubles, one home run, five RBI, a .274 slugging percentage and a .496 OPS — Twins went 8-16 in those games.

☞ In 10 games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL, Correa is hitting .286 (10-for-35) with three doubles, three home runs, five RBI and a .971 OPS.

**WILL-TY CONSCIENCE:** In his last 14 games, Willi Castro is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with three doubles, three home runs, five RBI, seven walks, 11 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .434 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.034 OPS.

☞ Since the start of the Seattle series, May 30, he has gone 7-for-15 (.467) with one double, two home runs, three RBI, six runs scored and a 1.512 OPS.

**TWINS MiLB MONTHLYS:** Twins have named right-handed pitcher David Festa and outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez as the club's minor league Pitcher and Player of the Month for May.

☞ Festa, 25, started three games for the Saints, going 0-0, 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER), with two walks, 19 strikeouts, eight hits allowed, a .160 opponent batting average and a .412 opponent OPS... Festa started three games for the Twins in April, going 0-0, 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts.

☞ Gonzalez, who was promoted to Double-A Wichita on May 19, split the month between High-A Cedar Rapids and Wichita, hitting .364 (36-for-99) with seven doubles, three triples, three home runs, 18 RBI, 17 runs scored, nine walks, a .416 on-base percentage, a .586 slugging percentage and a 1.002 OPS.

**MY OHL MY:** Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, one walk and 10 strikeouts in two relief appearances for the Wind Surge against Tulsa... the Moorpark, California native was selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Grand Canyon University.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1967, Harmon Killebrew hit the longest home run by a Twin at an estimated 520 feet... Killebrew hit a three-run shot off California right-hander Lew Burdette, which landed in the sixth row of the upper deck at Metropolitan Stadium... the ball cracked the seat, and was later painted orange to commemorate the event... the seat is now located in the Mall of America — the former site of Met Stadium — bolted to a wall in the amusement park, marking the height and position where the ball would have landed in the upper deck.

☞ Making 11th start of the season and 169th career start...fifth career start against the Athletics.  
 ☞ López is 2-0 in four career starts against the Athletics, posting a 3.75 ERA (24.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks, 32 strikeouts and a .216 (19-for-88) opponent batting average.  
 ☞ Was dealt his third loss of the season in Minnesota's 5-0 defeat at Tampa Bay in his last start on May 28...allowed four runs (2 HR) on seven hits in 5.0 innings, with two walks and three strikeouts.

**LIFE OF PABLO:** Last pitched on May 28 at Tampa Bay, opposite Drew Rasmussen...was dealt his third loss of the season and first since April 30 in Minnesota's 5-0 shutout defeat...allowed a season-high-tying four runs off seven hits, two walks and a season-low-tying three strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...four runs allowed came off two home runs and an RBI single...allowed a single-game career-high-tying three stolen bases (also, July 15, 2023 at the Athletics).

☞ Allowed two home runs in the fourth inning to Brandon Lowe and Junior Caminero, his first multi-home run game of the season and first time allowing multiple home runs in a single inning since April 28, 2024, when he allowed back-to-back homers to Luis Rengifo and Nolan Schanuel in the fifth against the Los Angeles Angels.  
 ☞ In May, Pablo recorded his least runs (10) and home runs allowed (3), as well as his lowest opponent slugging (.353) and OPS (.642) percentages in a single May in his career.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on May 23 vs. Kansas City, opposite Noah Cameron; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 walk-off victory...allowed one run off seven hits, no walks and five strikeouts over 5.2 innings of work...sole run allowed came in the first inning on an RBI double from Cavan Biggio, scoring Jonathan India.

☞ Marked his eighth-straight outing with five-or-more strikeouts, the fourth time in his career accomplishing such a streak, and first time since May 21-August 18, 2023 where he recorded a career-high 16 consecutive games with five-plus strikeouts.  
 ☞ Recorded season-high pitches thrown (102) as well as his highest single-game strikeout percentage since August 12, 2024 (72.5%)...allowed just two hard-hit balls for a rate of 10.5 percent, his lowest this season by far (next lowest, 4/25, 21.4 percent).

**AGAINST THE ATHLETICS:** López is 2-0 in four career starts against the Athletics, posting a 3.75 ERA (24.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 32 strikeouts...has a .216 (19-for-88) opponent batting average...the A's are one of three teams Pablo has faced at least four times and never recorded a loss (also, the Rockies and the Dodgers).

☞ Faced the Athletics just once in 2024 on June 23 at the Coliseum, pitching a season-high 8.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits with one walk and a career-high-tying 14 strikeouts.  
 ☞ López is 2-0 in three games against the A's on the road, posting a 3.20 ERA (19.2 IP, 7 ER) with six walks, 26 strikeouts, a .200 (14-for-70) opponent batting average and a .588 OPS.

**ACE UP OUR SLEEVE:** Since joining the Twins, López has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2023:

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 15-8 with a 3.80 ERA (213.0 IP, 90 ER), 10.35 K/9, 1.94 BB/9 and 0.93 HR/9 in 36 starts at home, compared to 17-13 with a 3.49 ERA (234.2 IP, 91 ER), 9.74 K/9, 2.19 BB/9 and 1.27 HR/9 in 40 road starts.

☞ In his six starts on the road this season, López has gone 2-3, posting a 2.38 ERA (34.0 IP, 9 ER), with six walks and 29 strikeouts; compared to 2-0, 3.32 ERA (21.2 IP, 8 ER), with five walks and 28 strikeouts in his four home starts this season.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through 10 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .287/.320/.391 in 115 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .147/.212/.263 in 95 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 86.9 mph and a whiff rate of 23.7 percent compared to righties' 87.0 mph and 28.7 percent.

☞ He has an all-time low 25.8 percent hard hit rate against right-handed batters, compared to a 36.0 percent hard-hit rate against left-handed batters, his highest since 2019.

**A RAY OF SUNSHINE:** López has his highest winning percentage in the month of June at .647 percent (11-6), as well as his highest K/9 at 10.2...he has allowed a 4.10 ERA (145.0 IP, 66 ER), and his .230 opponent batting average, .391 slugging percentage and .675 OPS are all second only behind his March/April starts.

**THE ARSENAL:** López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 43% of the time, the highest of his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

☞ Currently ranks in the 93rd percentile for fastball run value and 89th for breaking run value; compared to seventh percentile for offspeed run value.

☞ Has a 7.1 extension, ranking in the 93rd percentile, a 31.6 hard-hit percentage, ranking in the 91st percentile, but ranks bottom four percent in max exit velocity at 116.5 mph.

☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sweepers, Pablo has the sixth lowest hard hit percentage at 15.4 percent and ranks fifth in slugging percentage (.150).

☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 sinkers, López is tied with Justin Lawrence for first in put away percentage (50.0) and is 10th in opponent batting average (.133).

**WALK THIS WAY:** Pablo's 4.9 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 89th percentile...he ranks third on the Twins pitching staff behind Danny Coulombe (3.3) and Joe Ryan (4.5)...his walk rate is at an all-time career low, with his average in the previous seven years being six percent.

**Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE:** This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund...with 57 strikeouts this season, he has donated \$57,000 so far.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP ZEBBY MATTHEWS (2025: 0-1, 6.43 ERA // CAREER: 1-5, 6.62 ERA)

Right-hander Zebby Matthews is scheduled to start tomorrow's game against the Athletics...last start came on May 30 at Seattle...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 12-6 extra-inning victory...allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts in a career-high 7.0 innings...Matthews has never faced the Athletics, they will become his 11th new opponent faced in 13 career major league starts...he is 0-3 in six career starts on the road, posting a 4.91 ERA (29.1 IP, 12 ER), 10 walks, 28 strikeouts and a .265 (31-for-117) opponent batting average.
