THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their six-game roadtrip, losing a series in Detroit over the weekend, winning game one on Friday night and dropping games two and three...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three against the Marlins at LoanDepot Park through Thursday afternoon.
 ☞ Twins have gone 18-27 on the road, compared to 22-17 at home...this month, the Twins have 15 home games and nine road games.

SUNDAY NIGHT SCARIES: The Twins were shut out by the Tigers on Sunday night at Comerica Park, losing by a score of 3-0, their sixth time being blanked this season, second time by Detroit...Chris Paddock (3-7) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing three runs on six hits (2 home runs) in 4.2 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded just two hits, walked once, struck out 14 times and never got a runner past first base...the two hits were from Ty France and Harrison Bader — both singles...two hits tied their season-low, previously done on March 31 at Chicago-AL.

ROYCE RETURNS: The Twins have returned infielder Royce Lewis from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Lewis, who has missed the club's last 15 games with a left hamstring strain, played in three games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-for-8 with one walk and two strikeouts...prior to being placed on the 10-day IL on June 15, Lewis hit .202 (20-for-99) with four doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, 11 walks, 10 runs scored and a .585 OPS in 30 games for the Twins...to make room for Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins designated infielder Jonah Bride for release or assignment...Bride, who was acquired in a trade with the Marlins on April 16, played in 33 games for the Twins, hitting .208 (15-for-72) with two doubles, three RBI, six walks and a .511 OPS.

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 44 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .311 (52-for-167) with six doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, 39 RBI, 35 runs scored, 22 walks, a .389 on-base percentage, a .623 slugging percentage and a 1.011 OPS.

☞ Buck stole his 15th base on Saturday in his 15th chance...he is the only player in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum of 15 tries)...with 19 homers and 15 stolen bases, he is also now one of five players in baseball with at least 15 home runs and 15 steals, joining Ely De La Cruz (18 HR, 22 SB), Pete Crow-Armstrong (21 HR, 25 SB), Kyle Tucker (17 HR, 20 SB), Fernando Tatis Jr. (15 HR, 17 SB) and Oneil Cruz (15 HR, 27 SB).

PARTY IN THE CITY WHERE THE HEAT IS ON: Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 23rd, 24th and 25th times in their history this week...Twins are 11-11 against the Marlins, going 6-5 in Minnesota (2-1 at Metrodome and 4-4 at Target Field) and 5-6 in Miami...these two last met for a three-game series at Target Field, from September 24-26, 2024, the penultimate series of last season as the Twins went 1-2...the last time these two met at LoanDepot Park came April 3-5, 2023 (2nd series of season) as the Twins won the first game but lost games two and three.

☞ 22 games against the Marlins are the fewest for Minnesota against any opponent in their history.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with a 1.022 OPS in eight career games against Miami.

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins have gone 8-13 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19) and 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22)...their next series against an NL opponent will be three games against the Cubs at Target Field next homestand, from July 8-10.

SUDDEN-LEE SUMMER: Brooks Lee finished the month of June hitting .348 (32-for-92) with five doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, a .375 on-base percentage, a .533 slugging percentage and a .908 OPS in 25 games...among AL players with a minimum of 50 plate appearances last month, he ranked tied for fifth in hits, seventh in batting average.

☞ For June, he hit .350 (14-for-40) with a .775 OPS as a right-handed batter and .346 (18-for-52) with a 1.008 OPS as a left-handed batter.

CULPEPPER GETS HIS ROLL ON: Twins number four prospect (MLB.com) infielder Kaelen Culpepper has been named to the 2025 All-Star Futures Game to be played at Truist Park in Atlanta on July 12...in 62 games between High-A Cedar Rapids and Double-A Wichita, Culpepper has hit .290 (72-for-248) with nine doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 38 RBI, a .382 on-base percentage and an .858 OPS...the following players have represented the Twins in the Futures Game since 2013: **Brooks Lee** in 2024; **David Festa** in 2023; Spencer Steer and **Matt Wallner** in 2022; Josh Winder in 2021; Jordan Balazovic and **Royce Lewis** in 2019; Alex Kirilloff and Lewis Thorpe in 2018; Nick Gordon in 2017; JT Chargois in 2016; José Berrios in 2015 & '14; Max Kepler in 2015; Trevor May, Alex Meyer and Kennys Vargas in 2014; and **Byron Buxton** and Miguel Sanó in 2013...bold indicates still in organization.

☞ Other Twins on the current roster to play in the game include: Carlos Correa (HOU - 2014) and Christian Vázquez (BOS - 2014).

I'M GOING TO WICHITA: Double-A Wichita outfielder Kyle Fedko and right-handed pitcher Mike Paredes yesterday were named Texas League Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Fedko, 25, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .391 (9-for-23) with two doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, a .462 on-base percentage and a 1.592 OPS...the Gibsonia, PA native was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB draft out of UCONN.
 ☞ Paredes, 24, appeared in two games for the Surge, allowing one unearned run on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the San Diego, CA native was selected by the Twins in the 18th round of the 2021 MLB draft.

- ☞ Earned his eighth win of the season in his last start on June 25 vs. Seattle, a 2-0 Twins victory...over 6.0 shutout innings, allowed three hits and no walks with eight strikeouts.
- ☞ Is facing the Marlins for the first time in his career...in four career starts against the National League East, is 1-2 with a 5.85 ERA (20.0 IP, 13 ER), eight home runs, five walks and 24 strikeouts.
- ☞ In eight road starts this season, is 4-1 with a 2.87 ERA (47.0 IP, 15 ER), six home runs, nine walks and 47 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 10th win of the season on June 25 vs. Seattle opposite George Kirby...Twins won 2-0, snapped a five-game losing streak...over 6.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits with no walks and eight strikeouts...all hits allowed were singles...recorded at least one strikeout in every inning pitched...plunked Julio Rodríguez in the first inning, Ryan's career-high-tying and American League-leading 10th hit batter of the season...two pitches later, Rodríguez swiped second, Ryan's career-high 12th stolen base allowed this year...became the second pitcher this season to strikeout Cal Raleigh three times in a single game (also, San Diego's Michael King on May 18).

- ☞ Has struck out five-or-more batters in 13 games this season (tied for the 11th most in baseball), including in four-straight since June 8 vs. Toronto.
- ☞ Three of his eight strikeouts were looking, his most in an outing this season; also his most in an outing since Game 1 on April 13, 2024 at Detroit (also 3).
- ☞ Surpassed 100 strikeouts for the fourth-straight season...is the 15th player in Twins history (1961-present) to record 100 strikeouts in four-or-more consecutive seasons; Jim Kaat holds the record with 11-straight 100-strikeout seasons from 1961-71.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on June 20 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field opposite Jacob Misiorowski...took his third loss of the season in Minnesota's 17-6 defeat...allowed three runs on three hits, with three walks and seven strikeouts over 5.1 innings...walked Jackson Chourio to start the fourth inning, who stole second base and scored on William Contreras's one-out sacrifice fly...first hit allowed was a single by Rhys Hoskins to start the fifth inning...exited the game in the sixth after Sal Frelick singled with one out and scored on Chourio's double; Chourio scored on Christian Yelich's single with Danny Coulombe pitching in relief.

41 FOR 41: Recorded his 41st career win in his last outing on June 25 vs. Seattle...joins Brad Radke (42-41) and Scott Erickson (46-33) as the only pitchers in Twins history (1961-present) to tally 41 wins in their first 100 career games...among the three pitchers, Ryan's 629 strikeouts are the most, with Radke's 402 being the next closest, while his 3.75 ERA (561.2 IP, 234 ER) ranks second behind Erickson's 3.60 ERA (635.1 IP, 254 ER).

WELCOME TO MIAMI: Is facing the Marlins for the first time in his career...other than the Twins, Miami is one of two teams Ryan has yet to pitch against in his career, the other being the Phillies.

AGAINST THE NL EAST: In four career starts against the National League East (2x Atlanta, 1x New York and Washington), is 1-2 with a 5.85 ERA (20.0 IP, 13 ER), eight home runs, five walks and 24 strikeouts...both losses and all eight home runs have come while facing the Braves; holds a 13.50 ERA (8.0 IP, 12 ER) in two starts, on June 27, 2023 and April 20, 2025, both in Atlanta.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In eight road starts this season, is 4-1 with a 2.87 ERA (47.0 IP, 15 ER), six home runs, nine walks and 47 strikeouts, compared to 4-2 with a 2.84 ERA (44.1 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, 11 walks and 57 strikeouts in eight home games (7 starts)...in 49 career road starts, is 18-15 with a 3.92 ERA (270.2 IP, 118 ER), 46 home runs, a 4.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio, a 1.09 WHIP and a .231 opponent batting average.

☞ In his eight road games this season, opposing batters are slashing .199/.267/.351 in 171 at-bats...his 0.91 WHIP on the road ranks seventh among all qualifying pitchers in baseball and his BAA ranks 13th.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .193/.253/.327 with eight doubles, four home runs, eight walks and 36 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .183/.258/.331 with eight doubles, six home runs, 12 walks and 68 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .204/.266/.356 with 70 walks and 245 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .230/.277/.433 with 59 walks and 384 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through 16 appearances (15 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

☞ This season (1458 pitches), his chase rate is 25.8 percent and his whiff rate is 27.0 percent...his fastball run value of 13 ranks in baseball's 98th percentile...his 5.6 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 86th percentile, and his 29.1 percent strikeout rate ranks in baseball's 87th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.2 mph while his hard-hit rate is 40.4 percent

FOUR-SEAM DREAMS: Ryan relies primarily on his four-seam fastball as his strikeout pitch...his 63 strikeouts via the four-seamer are the second most by any pitcher in baseball this season, trailing only San Francisco's Robbie Ray (68 K)...among pitchers with 500-or-more four-seamers thrown, his 31.3 strikeout rate on his four-seamer ranks tied for seventh-best, while his 27.0 whiff rate ranks tenth.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2025: 3-4, 4.63 ERA // CAREER: 8-10, 4.42 ERA)
