THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 through five games on their season-long nine-game homestand, winning a three-game series over the Rays last weekend, followed consecutive wins over the Cubs...today, they will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Cubs...they will wrap the homestand and pre-All-Star portion of their schedule this weekend with three against the Pirates.

☞ Twins have gone 8-5 in their last 13 games and have won four of their last five games.
☞ Twins have gone 11-15 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3) and 2-0 vs. Chicago.

TWINS FLY THE W: The Twins beat the Cubs last night at Target Field by a score of 4-2, winning their second-straight series...David Festa (3-3) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...Danny Coulombe (0.2), Brock Stewart (1.0), Louis Varland (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) combined to pitch 3.2 scoreless innings of relief, with one hit allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Carlos Correa and Matt Wallner, as Wallner hit his ninth home run of the season...the attendance was 33,470, the second-highest at Target Field this season (36,783 on Home Opener vs. Houston).

JOE-RGIA ON MY MIND: Joe Ryan was named an All-Star yesterday, the first of his career, joining Byron Buxton...Ryan has pitched 18 games (17 starts) for the Twins this season, going 8-4, 2.76 ERA (104.1 IP, 32 ER), 21 walks, 1126 strikeouts, a 0.89 WHIP and a .193 (72-for-373) opponent batting average, leading the team in starts and innings pitched...among all AL pitchers, he ranks second in strikeouts-per-walk (5.52), fourth in opponent batting average, fifth in opponent OPS (.589), sixth in strikeouts and lowest walk percentage (5.2%), and eighth in ERA...over his last 12 starts (13 games), since April 27, Ryan has gone 7-2, 2.33 ERA (77.1 IP, 20 ER) with 18 walks, 88 strikeouts and a .180 opponent batting average...below are his AL ranks since that date:

GO TWINS GO: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 46th time in their history today...the Twins are 22-23 all-time against the Cubs, going 7-6 at Target Field, 9-14 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...Minnesota has gone 7-3 in its last 10 against the Cubs (since '21).

☞ 45 games against the Cubs are tied with Pittsburgh for most against any National League opponent...list excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.

☞ Harrison Bader is hitting .359 (42-for-117) with a .992 OPS in his last 35 games against the Cubs...he has played 80 career games against the Cubs, his second-most against any opponent (Pittsburgh - 82).

☞ Carlos Correa has hit safely in all six career games against the Cubs, hitting .435 (10-for-23) with four doubles, one home run, six RBI and a 1.174 OPS.

MOST-WATCHED FINALES: Minnesota is seeking its fifth sweep of the season today...the other four came April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field, May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field, May 9-11 vs. San Francisco at Target Field and May 16-18 at Baltimore...Twins had five sweeps all of '24.

☞ The Twins' last sweep of the Cubs came in just two games, from September 21-22, 2021 at Wrigley Field...the last time the Twins swept the Cubs in three games came June 23-25, 2006 at the Metrodome - those are their only two sweeps over the Cubs, dating back to 1997.

☞ The Twins have nine times this season entered a series finale with a chance to sweep, going 4-5 in those instances...their five misses were the finales against Chicago-AL on April 24, at Milwaukee on May 18, vs. Kansas City on May 25, June 5 at the Athletics and Sunday vs. Tampa Bay.

FEELING MINNESOTA: Twins have gone 26-18 at home this season, winning six of their last seven at Target Field...after starting the season 2-5 at home, they have gone 24-13 since April 15.
☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .301 (22-for-73) with six doubles, four home runs, a .548 slugging percentage and an .898 OPS in his last 21 home games.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (42-for-139) in 39 home games this season...over his last 16 home games, he is slashing .361/.391/.492 (.882 OPS).

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with five doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, eight walks, 13 runs scored, a .426 on-base percentage, a .654 slugging percentage and a 1.080 OPS in his last 15 home games.

CARLOS COR-RAKING: Over his last 18 games, Carlos Correa is hitting .338 (23-for-68) with three doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, four walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .471 slugging percentage and an .846 OPS.

☞ From June 1 to the All-Star break last season, Correa slashed .360/.418/.598 (1.014 OPS).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2024, the Twins played a doubleheader against the White Sox at Rate Field, homering in both games to extend their club record to 28-straight games with a homer...the final two homers of the streak in game two were back-to-back by Brooks Lee and Carlos Correa in the sixth inning...Twins went homerless in their next game against the Giants on July 12, snapping the streak.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 100th career start on July 4 vs. Tampa Bay at Target Field opposite Zack Littell...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-3 walk-off win...allowed two runs on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings...retired the first 11 batters he faced in order...exited the game with no outs in the sixth after giving up a single to Josh Lowe and an RBI double to Yandy Diaz; Diaz scored on Junior Caminero's RBI single with Danny Coulombe pitching in relief.

- ☞ This season, relievers have inherited 12 runners from Paddack and have allowed six of them to score (50.0%)...since joining the Twins in 2022, relievers have inherited 27 of his runners and allowed 14 of them to score (51.8%).
- ☞ Has not walked a batter in back-to-back games for the sixth time in his career and the first time since May 19-25, 2024.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on June 29 in Detroit opposite Tarik Skubal, a 3-0 Twins defeat on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball...marked his seventh loss of the season, tied his career high (also 2019, 2021)...allowed three runs on six hits (2 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts over 4.2 innings...allowed solo home runs to Kerry Carpenter (1st inn.) and Riley Greene (4th inn.)...exited the game with two outs in the fifth after hitting Colt Keith – Paddack's third hit batter of the year – and allowing an RBI triple to Carpenter.

- ☞ Carpenter's first-inning home run was the second that Paddack has allowed in the opening frame of a game this season (also, Andrew Vaughn on March 31 at White Sox).
- ☞ Marked the second time this season and the fourth time in his career that he's allowed a single, a double, a triple and a home run in the same game (also June 13 at Houston and 2x in 2021).
