**HERE WE COME:** Have gone 4-2 through six games on their season-long nine-game homestand, winning a three-game series over the Rays last weekend, followed by winning a three-game series over the Cubs this week — losing both finales and missing two sweeps...today, they will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Pirates through the weekend.

**IT WAS ONLY JUST A DREAM:** The Twins lost to the Cubs yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 8-1, missing the three-game sweep...Chris Paddack (3-8) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing six runs on 11 hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits and walked three times...Royce Lewis had two of the hits, singling twice...the attendance was 34,391, putting the three-game series total at 98,245.

**ON THE 6(RYAN)D:** Joe Ryan was named an All-Star on Wednesday, the first of his career, joining Byron Buxton...over his last 12 starts (13 games), since April 27, Ryan has gone 7-2, 2.33 ERA (77.1 IP, 20 ER) with 18 walks, 88 strikeouts and a .180 opponent batting average...below are his AL ranks since that date:

**GREED HATE ENVY:** The Twins and Pirates are playing each other for the 46th, 47th and 48th time in their history this weekend...the Twins are 26-19 all-time against the Bucs, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 9-6 at PNC Park (2006-20) and 7-5 at Target Field (2015-23).

⊕ These two last met for three games at PNC Park from June 7-9, 2024 as the Twins won just the third of the three games.

⊕ These two last played at Target Field from August 18-20, 2023 as the Twins took the series 2-1, winning games one and three.

**DI-IL-EMMA:** Twins have gone 11-16 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3) and 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10).

**WILL-E.I. UH OHHHH!:** Despite going 4-for-his-last-23, Willi Castro is hitting .296 (45-for-152) with eight doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 16 RBI, 22 walks, 27 runs scored, seven stolen bases, a .399 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .899 OPS over his last 46 games...compared to his first 25 games, when he hit .213 (19-for-89) with just seven extra-base hits and a .600 OPS.

**NEVER LET 'EM C(4) U SWEAT:** Over his last 19 games, Carlos Correa is hitting .324 (23-for-71) with three doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, four walks, a .360 on-base percentage, a .451 slugging percentage and an .811 OPS.

⊕ From June 1 to the All-Star break last season, Correa slashed .360/.418/.598 (1.014 OPS).

**ST. LOU-NATICS:** Louis Varland enters today with 44 games on the season, tied with Boston's Greg Weissert for most in the AL...his 1.91 ERA is the third-best among AL relievers (min. 40 IP), trailing Jhoan Duran (1.52) and Bryan Abreu (1.52)...since May 4, 25 of Varland's 27 appearances have been scoreless, posting a 0.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 2 ER) with 0 home runs, six walks, 22 strikeouts and a .191 opponent batting average.

**BATTER BADER UP:** Harrison Bader has posted a 1.205 OPS with four home runs, seven RBI and an .857 slugging percentage over his last seven games...he now has 11 home runs on the season, tied with Kody Clemens for third-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (20) and Trevor Larnach (12)...he hit 12 last season for the Mets in 143 games...his career-high is 16, done in 2021 with St. Louis.

**WHAT DOES IT TAKE TO BE NUMBER ONE, TWO IS NOT A WINNER AND THREE NOBODY REMEMBERS:** The Twins have gone 10-15 in one-run games this season...they have won two consecutive one-run games after dropping nine-straight in such instances, from May 25-June 24...16 games have been decided by two runs (7-9) and 13 games have been decided by three runs (8-5).

**STEAL THE SHOW:** Byron Buxton is 17-for-17 in stolen base attempts this season, one of two players in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum 15 attempts), the other being Trevor Story (15-for-15)...he has gone 23-for-his-last-23 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen).

⊕ Buck is one of two players in baseball with at least 20 homers and at least 15 steals, the other being Pete Crow-Armstrong (25 HR/27 SB).  
 ⊕ Three more steals and Buck will become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hise (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).  
 ⊕ Buck joins two other players in club history with a 15/15 season before the All-Star break, the others were Brian Dozier (18 HR/16 SB) in 2014 and Larry Hise (21 HR/15 SB) in 1977.

**HERE COMES THE BOOM:** Major League Baseball announced the complete field of participants for the 2025 T-Mobile Home Run Derby yesterday...Byron Buxton will join Jazz Chisholm Jr., Ronald Acuna Jr., Junior Camineró, Oneil Cruz, Cal Raleigh, Brent Rooker and James Wood.  
 ⊕ Seven Twins have participated in the Home Run Derby: Tom Brunansky (1985), Gary Gaetti (1989), Torii Hunter (2002), Justin Morneau (2007 & 2008), Joe Mauer (2009), Brian Dozier (2014) and Miguel Sanó (2017)...Morneau in '08 was the only winner.

**PAYING CASH, FIRST CLASS, SITTING NEXT TO VANNA WHITE:** Nelly will perform a post-game concert, presented by TickPick, following tonight's game approximately 15 minutes after the final out...the three-time GRAMMY Award-winning rapper from St. Louis was named Co-MVP, along with country artist David Nail, at the 2014 All-Star Celebrity Softball Game at Target Field.

**WHERE THEY AT? WHERE THEY AT? WHERE THEY AT?:** Left-handed pitcher Joey Wentz was claimed off waivers from Atlanta today...Wentz was designated for release or assignment after Tuesday's game after appearing in six games for Minnesota.

**HOT IN HERRE:** Tonight's anticipated first pitch temperature looks to be 82 degrees (feels like 84°) — that's it, that's the note...

- ☞ Making his 19th appearance (18th start) of the season and the 103rd appearance (102nd start) of his career...earlier this week, he was named to his first career MLB All-Star Game.
- ☞ Last pitched on July 6 vs. Tampa Bay but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-5 10-inning loss...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR) over 6.0 innings, with one walk and eight strikeouts.
- ☞ Is facing the Pirates for the second time in his career...took the loss on June 7, 2024 at PNC Park, a 3-0 Twins defeat; allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR) over 7.0 innings, with two walks and eight strikeouts.
- ☞ In nine home games (8 starts) this season, is 4-2 with a 2.86 ERA (50.1 IP, 16 ER), five home runs allowed, 12 walks and 65 strikeouts

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched on July 6 vs. Tampa Bay opposite Drew Rasmussen but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-5 10-inning loss...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and eight strikeouts over 6.0 innings...struck out the first three batters of the game, the sixth time this season he's struck out the side in order and the second time he's done so in the first inning...allowed a solo home run to Taylor Walls to start the third inning, the 12th longball he's allowed this season and the fourth to the first batter of an inning...fourth-inning RBI single by Jonathan Aranda drove in José Caballero for the Rays' second and final run scored off Ryan.

- ☞ Three of his eight strikeouts were looking, tying his season high (also 6/25 vs. SEA); also his most in an outing since Game 1 on April 13, 2024 at Detroit (also 3).
- ☞ Surpassed 100 innings pitched for the fourth-straight season...is the 26th player in Twins history (1961-present) to throw 100-or-more innings in four-or-more consecutive seasons; Jim Kaat holds the record with 13-straight 100-inning seasons from 1961-73.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Took the loss on July 1 in Miami opposite Edward Cabrera; Twins lost 2-0, their second consecutive shutout loss...allowed one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts over 7.0 innings...lone run scored on Kyle Stowers' solo home run to start the second inning, the third home run this season that Ryan has allowed to the first batter of an inning...marked the 14th outing of his career in which his one run allowed came on a home run; was his third such outing this season...retired 16 of 17 batters faced from the second-seventh innings...leads the Twins pitching staff with nine outings of 6.0-or-more innings this season.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** Earlier this week, Joe Ryan was named to his first career MLB All-Star Game...he will join teammate Byron Buxton as the Twins' representatives on Tuesday, July 15 at Truist Park in Atlanta, GA...Ryan replaced Houston's Hunter Brown on the American League active roster.

**FACING PITTSBURGH:** Took the loss in his lone career start against the Bucs on June 7, 2024 at PNC Park; Twins were shut out 3-0 by Mitch Keller and the Pirate bullpen...allowed two runs on two hits, including a solo home run to Oneil Cruz in the second inning, with two walks and eight strikeouts; a fourth-inning sacrifice fly by Nick Gonzales drove in Bryan Reynolds, who doubled to start the inning.

**INTERLEAGUE EXPERIENCE:** In seven Interleague starts this season, is 2-3 with a 2.97 ERA (39.1 IP, 13 ER), five home runs allowed, seven walks and 45 strikeouts...in that span, National League hitters are batting .197 (28-for-142) with a .253 on-base percentage and a .591 OPS...in 26 career IL starts, is 8-11 with a 5.07 ERA (136.2 IP, 77 ER), 31 home runs allowed, 33 walks and 151 strikeouts.

☞ Is facing the National League Central for the 13th time in his career and the fourth time this season...this season, is 1-1 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP, 4 ER), four walks and 21 strikeouts (3/29 at STL, 5/16 at MIL, 6/20 vs. MIL).

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In nine home games (8 starts) this season, is 4-2 with a 2.86 ERA (50.1 IP, 16 ER), five home runs allowed, 12 walks and 65 strikeouts, compared to 4-2 with a 2.67 ERA (54.0 IP, 16 ER), seven home runs allowed, nine walks and 51 strikeouts in nine road starts...in 52 career home games (51 starts), is 23-14 with a 3.58 ERA (297.0 IP, 118 ER), 40 home runs, a 5.03 strikeout-to-walk ratio, a 1.00 WHIP and a .207 opponent batting average.

☞ At home this season, opposing batters are slashing .188/.259/.324 (.574 OPS) in 176 at-bats...his 0.89 WHIP at home is tied with Paul Skenes for the eighth best among all qualifying pitchers in baseball...his BAA ranks 12th.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, lefties have slashed .216/.270/.364 with eight doubles, six home runs, nine walks and 41 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .173/.241/.310 with nine doubles, six home runs, 12 walks and 75 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .208/.269/.362 with 71 walks and 250 strikeouts (3.52 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .227/.274/.427 with 59 walks and 391 strikeouts (6.63 K/BB).

☞ Both of Pittsburgh's hits off Ryan on June 7, 2024 were by lefties, who went 2-for-10 overall, with a walk and a strikeout, while the Pirates' righties went 0-for-12 with an RBI (sac fly), a walk and seven strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** Through 18 appearances (17 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

☞ This season (1643 pitches), his chase rate is 25.2 percent and his whiff rate is 27.6 percent...his 5.2 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 90th percentile, and his 28.6 percent strikeout rate ranks in baseball's 87th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.1 mph while his hard-hit rate is 40.2 percent.
