THE TWINS: Have gone 5-2 through seven games on their season-long nine-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Tampa Bay, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL and 1-0 vs. Pittsburgh...today, they will continue the homestand with the second of three against the Pirates through tomorrow afternoon.
 ☞ Twins are 27-19 at home this season, including a record of 7-2 in their last nine here.
 ☞ Twins have gone 12-16 in Interleague Play, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10) and 1-0 vs. Pittsburgh.

HOT IN HERRE: The Twins beat the Pirates last night at Target Field and in front of hip hop icon Nelly by a score of 2-1...Joe Ryan (9-4) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...Danny Coulombe (0-2), Brock Stewart (0.1), Louis Varland (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings of relief, with three hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Byron Buxton...Trevor Larnach drove in both Twins runs with a two-run homer in the fourth inning off Pirates starter Paul Skenes...Carlos Correa was removed from the game in the top of the seventh with a mild right ankle sprain...the attendance was announced at 40,100, the club's highest of the season and their first sellout of 2025.

TWINS AND BUCS: The Twins and Pirates are playing each other for the 46th, 47th and 48th time in their history this weekend...the Twins are 27-19 all-time against the Bucs, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 9-6 at PNC Park (2006-20) and 8-5 at Target Field (2015-23).
 ☞ 46 games against the Pirates are Minnesota's most against any National League opponent...list excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.

TWINS TRY MEATLOAF THE BUCS: A win tonight or tomorrow and the Twins will secure their 14th series win of the season...it will also mark their third consecutive series win for the first time since taking five-straight from May 2-18 (at Boston, vs. Baltimore, vs. San Francisco, at Baltimore and at Milwaukee)...Minnesota is 13-15-2 in series play, going 8-5-2 at home and 5-10-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 3-9-1 since May 26...results to the right >>>

☞ The Twins' last series win over the Pirates was August 18-20, 2023, taking two of three at Target Field...they are 9-6-2 all-time against Pittsburgh in series play.

ALSO: Since June 25, the Twins' bullpen has gone 2-1, 2.96 ERA (54.2 IP, 18 ER) with 17 walks, 46 strikeouts and a .691 opponent OPS...in that same span, starters have gone 7-5, 3.38 ERA (77.1 IP, 29 ER) with 14 walks, 71 strikeouts and a .659 opponent OPS.

GRAND THEFT: Byron Buxton is 17-for-17 in stolen base attempts this season, one of two players in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum 15 attempts), the other being Trevor Story (15-for-15)...he has gone 23-for-his last-23 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen).

TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has eight hits in his last 14 at-bats (.571) over his last five games...in that span, he has two doubles, one home run, four RBI, one hit by pitch, one walk and a 1.544 OPS.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW/LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched in his MLB debut on July 5 vs. Tampa Bay as the bulk pitcher, opposite Rays starter Taj Bradley...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 walkoff victory over the Rays; allowed five runs on nine hits, with no walks and one strikeout in 4.0 innings of relief...entered the game in the third inning, allowing an RBI double to Danny Jansen, followed by an RBI double in the fourth to Josh Lowe, two sacrifice flies to Yandy Diaz and Junior Camerino in the fifth, fanned Josh Lowe in the sixth for his first career MLB strikeout and finally allowed a sacrifice fly to Chandler Simpson, also in the sixth.

⌘ Became the fourth Twin and first pitcher, to make his major league debut this season, joining Luke Keaschall (April 18), Ryan Fitzgerald (May 16) and Carson McCusker (May 18).

TWO STARTS AGO (Triple-A): Pitched on July 1 at Gwinnett, where he did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 4-2 victory over the Stripers...allowed two runs on three hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in 2.2 innings...marked his least amount of innings pitched since June 1 (also 2.2)...left the game in the bottom of the third with the bases loaded and was replaced by Michael Tonkin who subsequently walked two consecutive batters, allowing two runs that were retroactively charged to Adams.

- ⌘ Was his fifth start of the season and his fourth in his last seven games.
- ⌘ Two of nine balls in play were hard-hit (22.2%)...induced four whiffs on 20 swings (20.0%).
- ⌘ Pitch breakdown: 13 sliders (85.5 mph avg.), 12 fastballs (93.9 mph avg.), 10 changeups (89.1 mph avg.), eight cutters (89.9 mph avg.), four curveballs (79.6 mph avg.) and two sinkers (94.6 mph avg.)...49 total pitches (88.9 mph avg. overall).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In nine games (2 starts) at home in Triple-A this season, Adams is 2-2 with a 4.05 ERA (33.1 IP, 15 ER), two home runs, 16 walks and 34 strikeouts, compared to 1-0 with a 3.26 ERA (30.1 IP, 11 ER), one home run, four walks and 24 strikeouts in 10 road appearances (3 starts).

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In his MLB debut on July 5, left-handed hitters slashed .538/.500/.692 in 13 at-bats vs. Adams, while righties slashed .500/.333/.750 in four at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 89.1 mph, a hard-hit percentage of 38.5 and a whiff rate of 15.4; compared to righties' 95.4 mph and 66.7 hard-hit percentage and 22.2 whiff rate.

⌘ In 19 Triple-A appearances (5 starts) this season, left-handed batters have hit .290 (29-for-100) with a .357 on-base percentage, .410 slugging percentage and .767 OPS...right-handed batters have hit .209 (29-for-139), with a .268 on-base percentage, a .295 slugging percentage and a .620 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Adams uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown from his MLB debut:
