- ☞ Making his 15th appearance (14th start) of the season and 45th career appearance (43rd start)... second career start against the Pirates.
- ☞ Earned his third consecutive win (a career high) during his last start in Minnesota's 8-1 victory on July 8 vs. Chicago-NL...allowed just two hits, with three walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 scoreless innings...his third scoreless start in his last five (also June 15 and June 26).
- ☞ In his sole start against Pittsburgh on June 8, 2024 he took the loss in Minnesota's 0-4 shutout defeat...allowed one run on six hits, with no walks and six strikeouts in 6.1 quality innings.

**BEAR WITNESS:** Last pitched on July 8 vs. Chicago-NL, opposite Shota Imanaga...earned his fifth win of the season and third consecutive win, a new career high...is the third pitcher this season to achieve a three-game win streak, joining Bailey Ober (4, April 15-May 3) and Joe Ryan (5, May 10-June 8)...allowed a single to Dansby Swanson in the second and a single to Kyle Tucker in the third.

- ☞ Marked his sixth career scoreless start, and third this season, all in his last five starts (also, June 15 at Houston and June 26 vs. Seattle)...over those five starts, has posted a 1.38 ERA and allowed just a .126 (11-for-87) opponent batting average, with five runs (1 HR), ten walks and 20 strikeouts over 26.0 innings of work.
- ☞ Sim has allowed just two hits in each of his last three starts, becoming the fourth starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to accomplish such a streak (min. 15.0 IP)...joining Bailey Ober (July 28-August 9 (1), 2024), Jake Odorizzi (March 30-April 10, 2019) and Ervin Santana (April 3-15, 2017).

**SIMEON SAYS:** Pitched on July 2 at Miami, opposite Janson Junk...earned his fourth win of the season and second consecutive win, tying his career high...is the first time he has achieved such a streak since August 16-21, 2024...allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...sole run allowed came on a Kyle Stowers home run in the second inning.

**X MARKS THE SPOT:** In his sole start against the Pirates on June 8, 2024 at PNC Park he dealt the loss in Minnesota's 0-3 shutout defeat...allowed one run on six hits, with no walks and six strikeouts in 6.1 quality innings of work.

☞ He is 4-5 in 15 career Interleague games (13 starts), posting a 4.59 ERA (68.2 IP, 35 ER) with 29 walks, 58 strikeouts and a .265 (70-for-264) opponent batting average.

**OUR NECK OF THE WOODS:** In his career, Sim has gone 5-4 with a 4.17 ERA (103.2 IP, 48 ER), 8.42 K/9, 3.39 BB/9 and 0.95 HR/9 in 21 games (20 starts) at home compared to 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA (108.0 IP, 52 ER), 7.25 K/9, 3.42 BB/9 and 1.33 HR/9 in 23 road games (22 starts).

☞ He is 4-2 in seven starts at home so far this season, posting a 3.28 ERA (35.2 IP, 13 ER) with three home runs, 11 walks and 30 strikeouts; compared to 1-2, 4.96 ERA (32.2 IP, 18 ER), six home runs, 16 walks and 29 strikeouts in seven appearances (6 starts) at home.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** Through 14 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .291/.361/.453 in 117 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .204/.278/.338 in 158 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.2 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 34.7 compared to righties' 91.7 mph and 48.1 percent.

☞ His whiff rate is at an all-time high with an average of 22.4 percent (lefties, 19.2 percent; righties, 24.7 percent)...compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

☞ He currently ranks in baseball's seventh percentile in GB% (31.0) eighth percentile in max exit velocity (115.3), and 12th percentile in barrel percentage (11.3)

☞ Between June 21 and today, SWR decreased his 4-seam fastball hard-hit rate from 60.3 percent to 47.4 percent, a decrease of 12.9, and lowering himself from the second highest hard-hit percentage among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 4-seam fastballs to the 72nd highest, dropping 60 spots.

☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 curveballs, Simeon has the lowest whiff rate (12.5) and is the only player to have a 0.0 percent strikeout rate and put away percentage.

**MAKE MY DAY:** In 22 career day games (21 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 3.69 ERA and a .235 opponent batting average, .378 slugging percentage, 14 home runs, 37 walks and 105 strikeouts; compared to a 4.85 ERA, .257 opponent batting average, .405 slugging percentage with 13 home runs, 43 walks and 79 strikeouts in 22 night games (21 starts).

☞ So far this season, SWR is 3-1 in six daytime starts, posting a 3.34 ERA (35.0 IP, 13 ER) with five home runs, 12 walks and 33 strikeouts; compared to 2-3 with a 4.86 ERA (33.1 IP, 18 ER), four home runs, 15 walks and 26 strikeouts in seven nighttime appearances (6 starts).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, pitched a career-high 147.0 professional innings (MiLB and MLB).
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
- Struck out 26 batters in June 2024, the most among AL rookies and tied for fifth most among all rookies in baseball...also ranked third among AL rookies in innings pitched (26.0).
- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berrios...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
- Made Team USA's roster for the 2021 Tokyo Olympics but didn't appear in a game for the silver medal-winning Americans.
- In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
- Finished 2019 with High-A Dunedin as the youngest pitcher in Florida State League, going 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in six starts.
- Made professional debut with GCL Mets on July 22, 2018, earning the save in a hitless, one-inning appearance.
- Selected by New York-NL in the second round of 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Kempner High School (TX).
