**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, losing a series 1-2 in Detroit over the weekend, followed by a loss in Miami last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three against the Marlins at loanDepot Park through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel home for a nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Rays (July 4-6), three against the Cubs (July 8-10) and three against the Pirates (July 11-13).

☞ Twins have gone 18-28 on the road, compared to 22-17 at home...this month, the Twins have 15 home games and nine road games.

**TWINS SHUT DOWN IN SOUTH FLA:** The Twins were shut out by the Marlins last night at loanDepot park, losing by a score of 2-0...it marked their seventh time being shut out this season and second time on this trip (Sunday night at DET)...first time suffering consecutive shutouts since June 7-8, 2024 at Pittsburgh...Joe Ryan (8-4) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing one run (Kyle Stowers solo HR) on five hits in 7.0 innings pitched, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded just two hits and walked once, their only hits being a Royce Lewis third-inning double and a Willi Castro seventh-inning infield single.

☞ The last run scored by the Twins was a ninth-inning sac fly from Matt Wallner on Saturday afternoon at Detroit.

**TWINS IL OBER:** The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober on the 15-day Injured List with a left hip impingement...Ober has made 17 starts for the Twins this season, going 4-6, 5.28 ERA (92.0 IP, 54 ER), 21 home runs allowed, 22 walks and 74 strikeouts, including a record of 0-5, 9.00 ERA (30.0 IP, 30 ER) and 14 homers allowed in his last five starts, since June 6...to replace Ober on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Cody Funderburk from Triple-A St. Paul...during his most recent stint with the Saints, Funderburk allowed one run on eight hits in 9.0 innings pitched, with three walks and eight strikeouts in six relief appearances, from June 10-29...in two previous stints with Minnesota earlier this season, he went 1-0, 7.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 10 ER), five walks and nine strikeouts.

☞ Additionally, infielder Jonah Bride has cleared outright waivers and has been outrighted to St. Paul...Bride was designated for assignment after Sunday night's game against the Detroit Tigers to make room for infielder Royce Lewis.

**MIAMI VICE AND MINNESOTA NICE:** Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 23rd, 24th and 25th times in their history this week...Twins are 11-12 against the Marlins, going 6-5 in Minnesota (2-1 at Metrodome and 4-4 at Target Field) and 5-7 in Miami (2-1 at Dolphin Stadium and 3-6 at loanDepot park).

☞ 23 games against Miami are the fewest for Minnesota against any opponent in their history.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with three doubles, one home run, five RBI, seven walks and a .939 OPS in nine career games against Miami.

☞ Seven Twins all-time have homered in this ballpark: Max Kepler (3), Byron Buxton (1), Joey Gallo (1), Mitch Garver (1), Ryan Jeffers (1), Trevor Larnach (1) and Eddie Rosario (1).

**BUCK UP:** Over his last 45 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .304 (52-for-171) with six doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, 39 RBI, 35 runs scored, 22 walks, a .381 on-base percentage, a .608 slugging percentage and a .989 OPS.

☞ Buxton stole his 15th base on Saturday in his 15th chance...he is the only player in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum of 15 tries)...his last caught stealing was May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee, Chris Flexen).

**NATIONAL NEWS:** Twins have gone 8-14 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22) and 0-1 at Miami...their next series against an NL opponent will be three games against the Cubs at Target Field next homestand, from July 8-10.

**WALKING DEAD:** Twins pitchers have walked just 13 batters in their last eight games, since June 23, compared to 68 strikeouts, posting a 5.23 strikeouts-per-walk ratio in that span - second-best in baseball since that date (Milwaukee — 5.92)...on the season, Twins pitchers have walked 224 batters, the fewest in baseball.

**SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES:** Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow afternoon to win their first series since June 2-5 in Sacramento...Minnesota is 11-14-2 in series play, going 6-5-2 at home and 5-9-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 1-8-1 since May 26.

**UNLOCKING LEWIS:** Over his last 10 games, Royce Lewis is hitting .387 (12-for-31) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, five walks, a .472 on-base percentage, a .581 slugging percentage and a 1.053 OPS...he has hit safely in each of his last five games, matching his season-high (also, 5/15-19), a streak that dates back to June 8 (IL stint from 6/15-7/1).

**READY AND WILLING:** In his last 38 games, Willi Castro is hitting .304 (38-for-125) with six doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI, 16 walks, 24 runs scored, four stolen bases, a .396 on-base percentage, a .512 slugging percentage and a .908 OPS.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2012, the Twins beat the Tigers by a score of 6-4 at Comerica Park to give Ron Gardenhire his 900th career managerial victory...Twins TV and radio analyst Glen Perkins earned the save with a scoreless ninth...Twins TV analyst Denard Span drew a walk in five plate appearances and scored a run.

- ☞ Making his 13th appearance (12th start) of the season and 43rd career appearance (41st start)...second career start against Miami.
- ☞ Earned the win in Minnesota's 10-1 victory in his last start on June 26 vs. Seattle...allowed two hits with no walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 scoreless innings.
- ☞ In one start against Miami on September 25, 2024, Woods Richardson threw just 1.0 inning, allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR), one walk and two strikeouts.
- ☞ Seeking first major league win on the road since August 21, 2024 (18 total appearances/8 road appearances)...is T-4th for longest active streak without a win on the road.

**SIMEON SAYS:** Last pitched on June 26 vs. Seattle, opposite Emerson Hancock...earned his third win of the season and first since April 26 in Minnesota's 10-1 victory...allowed two hits with no walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 scoreless innings...retired nine-straight batters in the first through fourth innings.

- ☞ Reached 200 career innings pitched in his major league career.
- ☞ Marked his fifth career scoreless start, and second this season (also, June 15 at HOU).
- ☞ Has not allowed a home run in four-straight major league starts, tied for the longest streak of his career (also 4, April 13, 2024 (2)-May 6, 2024).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on June 21 vs. Milwaukee in his first career start against the Brewers, opposite José Quintana...was dealt the loss in Minnesota's 0-9, shutout defeat...allowed four runs (3 earned) off four hits with three walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...allowed a sacrifice fly to Brice Turang in the first, a sac fly to Jack Chourio in the second, followed by an RBI single to Christian Yelich...then retired 13 of his last 14 batters faced in the second through sixth innings.

- ☞ He is now 6-5 when facing opponents for the first time, and 2-2 when facing opponents for the first time at home.
- ☞ Marked his first 6.0-plus inning game of the season, and first since his 7.0-inning quality start on August 10, 2024 vs. Cleveland.
- ☞ Allowed five hard hit balls and had a hard-hit percentage of 25.0, tied for his lowest on the season (also 25.0%, 6/15).

**GOING FISHING:** Is facing the Marlins for the second time in his career...sole start came on September 25, 2024 where he did not factor into Minnesota's 8-3 victory...allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR) with one walk and two strikeouts in 1.0 inning (plus 2 batters in the second), the shortest outing of his career...allowed all three of Miami's runs on the third plate appearance of the game, a homer to Jake Burger, scoring Xavier Edwards and Connor Norby.

- ☞ SWR is 2-5 in 13 career Interleague games (11 starts)...has posted a 5.22 ERA (58.2 IP, 34 ER), with seven home runs, 24 walks and 51 strikeouts...Interleague batters have a .286 (66-for-231) against him.

**THEIR NECK OF THE WOODS:** In his career, Sim has gone 4-4 with a 4.38 ERA (98.2 IP, 48 ER), 8.48 K/9, 3.28 BB/9 and 1.00 HR/9 in 20 games (19 starts) at home compared to 4-6 with a 4.46 ERA (103.0 IP, 51 ER), 7.34 K/9, 3.41 BB/9 and 1.31 HR/9 in 22 road games (21 starts).

- ☞ He is 0-2 in six appearances (5 starts) on the road so far this season, posting a 5.53 ERA (27.2 IP, 17 ER) with five home runs, 14 walks and 26 strikeouts; compared to 3-2, 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER), three home runs, eight walks and 26 strikeouts in six starts at home.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** Through 12 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .314/.374/.471 in 102 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .218/.290/.371 in 124 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.2 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 35.7 compared to righties' 92.6 mph and 50.5 percent.

- ☞ His whiff rate is at an all-time high of 22.5 percent (lefties, 19.1 percent; righties, 25.0 percent)...compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He currently ranks in baseball's eighth percentile in max exit velocity (115.3), ninth percentile in GB% (32.2) and sixth percentile in barrel percentage (12.4)
- ☞ Between June 21 and today, SWR decreased his 4-seam fastball hard-hit rate from 60.3 percent to 51.2 percent, a decrease of 9.1, and lowering himself from the second highest hard-hit percentage among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 4-seam fastballs to the 33rd highest, dropping 31 spots.
- ☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 curveballs, Simeon is tied with Sugano Tomoyuki for the lowest whiff rate (11.8) and is the only player to have a 0.0 percent strikeout rate and put away percentage.

**NIGHTMARES:** So far this season, Simeon is 0-3 in five nighttime appearances (4 starts), posting a 6.56 ERA (23.1 IP, 17 ER) with three home runs, 10 walks and 19 strikeouts; compared to 3-1 with a 3.34 ERA (35.0 IP, 13 ER), five home runs, 12 walks and 33 strikeouts in seven daytime starts.

- ☞ SWR is 3-6 in 20 career night games (19 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 5.28 ERA and a .269 opponent batting average, .764 OPS, 12 home runs, 38 walks and 72 strikeouts; compared to a 5-4 with a 3.69 ERA, .235 opponent batting average, .674 OPS, 14 home runs, 37 walks and 105 strikeouts in 22 day games (21 starts)
