THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game roadtrip, losing a series 1-2 in Detroit over the weekend, followed by a split of the first two games in Miami the last two nights...today, the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale against the Marlins at loanDepot park...after today's game, the Twins will travel home for a nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Rays this weekend, an off-day on Monday, three against the Cubs (July 8-10) and three against the Pirates (July 11-13).
 ☞ Twins have gone 19-28 on the road, compared to 22-17 at home...this month, the Twins have 15 home games and nine road games (7 road games remaining).
 ☞ Twins have gone 3-5 in rubber games this season...they have dropped each of their last four rubber games, their last win coming on May 4 at Boston.

MIAMI NICE: The Twins beat the Marlins last night at loanDepot park by a score of 2-1, their eighth one-run win (8-15) of the season...Simeon Woods Richardson (4-4) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits (Stowers HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...Brock Stewart (1.0), Louis Varland (0.2), Danny Coulombe (0.1), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Willi Castro, who singled twice and doubled...Carlos Correa also recorded two hits with one RBI.

GONE FISHIN': Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 25th time in their history today...Twins are 12-12 against the Marlins, going 6-5 in Minnesota (2-1 at Metrodome and 4-4 at Target Field) and 6-7 in Miami (2-1 at Dolphin Stadium and 4-6 at loanDepot park).
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, seven walks, a .444 on-base percentage and a .944 OPS in 10 career games against Miami.
 ☞ Seven Twins all-time have homered in this ballpark: Max Kepler (3), Byron Buxton (1), Joey Gallo (1), Mitch Garver (1), Ryan Jeffers (1), Trevor Larnach (1) and Eddie Rosario (1).

YOU CAN ALWAYS COME HOME: Baxley, Georgia native Byron Buxton is looking to make his second All-Star team (also 2022)...starters for both squads were announced last night...the pitchers and reserves for both teams - totaling 23 for each side - will be determined through a combination of player ballot choices and selections made by the Commissioner's Office...the balance of the All-Star rosters will be announced during the MLB All-Star Selection Show presented by PRO SPIRIT on Sunday, July 6 at 4:00 pm (CT) on ESPN...below is where Buxton ranks among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories this season:

READY AND WILLING: In his last 39 games, Willi Castro is hitting .318 (41-for-129) with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI, 16 walks, 25 runs scored, five stolen bases, a .405 on-base percentage, a .527 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS.

A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN: Twins have gone 9-14 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22) and 1-1 at Miami...their next series against an NL opponent will be three games against the Cubs at Target Field next homestand, from July 8-10.

CLOSE CALLS: The Twins have gone 8-15 in one-run games this season...last night's 2-1 win, snapped a nine-game losing streak for the Twins in one-run games...it was their first one-run win since May 24 vs. Kansas City, a 5-4 victory at Target Field.

TWINS TRY TO MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD) THE MARLINS: With a win today, the Twins will win their 12th series of the season and first since taking three of four in Sacramento vs. the A's (June 2-5)...Minnesota is 11-14-2 in series play, going 6-5-2 at home and 5-9-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 1-8-1 since May 26.
 ☞ Twins last series win vs. Miami came July 30-August 1, 2019 at loanDepot park, taking two of three.
 ☞ Twins last series win vs. an NL team was May 16-18 at Milwaukee, taking two of three.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2020, the Twins officially began Summer Camp at Target Field...it served as the club's "second spring training"...the Twins originally played 19 spring training games from February 21-March 11, going 7-8-4, prior to leaving camp due to the COVID-19 pandemic and flew home to Minnesota on March 15...the Twins held Summer Camp from July 3-21 and played Intrasquad scrimmages near the back half, with Team Polanco (white tops) vs. Team Kepler (blue tops)...they opened the 2020 regular season at Chicago-AL on July 24...in 2010, Jim Thome hit career home runs 573 and 574 at Target Field vs. Tampa Bay, both off Wade Davis...his 574th moved him past Harmon Killebrew and into sole possession of 10th on baseball's all-time home run list.

- ⚔ In three road starts this season, is 1-1 with a 6.29 ERA (13.0 IP, 10 ER), three home runs, five walks and 16 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the season in his last start on June 27 in Detroit opposite Sawyer Gipson-Long...Twins won 4-1...pitched 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with no walks and six strikeouts...two hits ties his career low, done four times...marked the first scoreless outing of his career with no walks allowed...plunked Spencer Torkelson in the second inning, Festa's fifth hit batter of the season...Torkelson advanced to third on Dillon Dingler's two-out single, the only Detroit runner in scoring position against Festa...marked the fourth outing of his career without an extra-base hit allowed; was his second such outing this season, the first coming vs. Detroit at Target Field on April 11...marked his first road win since August 5, 2024 at Chicago-NL.

- ⚔ Was just the second time this season he's pitched into the sixth inning (also June 11 vs. Texas).
- ⚔ Was his second career outing allowing three-or-fewer baserunners (also August 28, 2024 vs. Atlanta).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss in his last outing on June 22 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field, opposite Quinn Priester, a 9-8 Twins defeat...entered the game in the second inning behind opener Danny Coulombe; Twins trailed 0-1...allowed a season-high-tying eight runs on a career-high 12 hits (2 HR), with a career-high-tying three walks and a season-low three strikeouts over 4.2 innings...home run allowed to Rhys Hoskins in the second inning was the second home run this season that Festa has given up in the first inning of an outing...allowed Joey Ortiz to score on a wild pitch in the fourth inning, Festa's first wild pitch of the season, the third of his career and his first since July 30, 2024...the first batter of every inning but the sixth reached base against Festa...exited the game with two outs in the sixth after Isaac Collins singled and stole second and Rhys Hoskins walked.

SLIM REAPER STRIKES: In Twins history (1961-present), only Joe Ryan (119) has recorded more strikeouts than Festa (115) through their first 22 career games...below are some of Festa's numbers compared to Twins pitchers with 110-or-more strikeouts through their first 22 career games:

FACING MIAMI: Is facing the Marlins for the second time in his career and first at loanDepot park...lone career start came on September 26, 2024 at Target Field, Festa's final outing of the season...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-6 loss in 13 innings, allowing four runs (3 ER) on seven hits, with one walk and five strikeouts over 4.1 innings.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: In 11 career appearances (9 starts) against the National League, is 2-4 with a 5.07 ERA (49.2 IP, 28 ER), six home runs, 20 walks and 58 strikeouts...in three Interleague games (2 starts) this season, is 0-1 with a 7.11 ERA (12.2 IP, 10 ER), two home runs, seven walks and 13 strikeouts...National League batters are hitting .345 (19-for-55) with a .431 on-base percentage and a .940 OPS against Festa this season.

- ⚔ In his career, is 0-2 with a 3.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 8 ER), three home runs, six walks and 31 strikeouts in five games (4 starts) against the NL East (2x New York; 1x Philadelphia, Atlanta and Miami).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In three starts on the road this season, is 1-1 with a 6.92 ERA (13.1 IP, 10 ER), three home runs, five walks and 16 strikeouts, compared to 1-1 with a 4.56 ERA (23.2 IP, 12 ER), three home runs, 10 walks and 22 strikeouts in five home appearances (4 starts)...in nine career road starts, is 3-3 with a 4.60 ERA (43.0 IP, 22 ER), five home runs, 12 walks and 52 strikeouts.

- ⚔ In four career starts at National League ballparks, is 2-1 with a 4.34 ERA (18.2 IP, 9 ER), two home runs, seven walks and 21 strikeouts...is pitching in Miami for the first time in his career.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties are hitting .217 (15-for-69) with four doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, eight walks and 18 strikeouts against Festa, while righties are hitting .297 (22-for-74) with two doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, seven walks and 20 strikeouts...in his career, lefties are slashing .228/.315/.392 with six home runs, 21 walks and 56 strikeouts in 189 at-bats, while righties are slashing .273/.335/.468 with nine home runs, 17 walks and 59 strikeouts in 205 at-bats.

- ⚔ In his three Interleague games (2 starts) this season, lefties are hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles, one home run, nine RBI, three walks and six strikeouts against Festa, while righties are hitting .346 (9-for-26) with one double, one home run, two RBI, four walks and seven strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through eight major league appearances (7 starts) in 2025, Festa has relied on a four-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:
