**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 at Detroit and 1-2 at Miami...tonight, the Twins will begin a season-long nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Rays this weekend, an off-day on Monday, three against the Cubs (Tuesday-Thursday) and three against the Pirates (next weekend).  
 ☞ Twins have gone 22-17 at home, compared to 19-29 on the road...this month, the Twins have 15 home games and six road games remaining.  
 ☞ Twins left Minnesota last homestand with two wins vs. the Mariners on June 25 and 26...a win today would give them their first three-game winning streak at home since winning nine-straight at Target Field, from April 25-May 19.

**TWINS DROP SERIES IN MIAMI:** The Twins lost to the Marlins yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-1 at loanDepot park, dropping the three-game series 2-1...David Festa (2-3) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, two from Trevor Larnach, who doubled and singled...Matt Wallner provided all of Minnesota's scoring with a solo home run in the seventh inning...the Twins finished the trip averaging 2.0 runs-per-game.

**JUST PEACHY:** Baxley, Georgia native Byron Buxton is looking to make his second All-Star team (also 2022)...starters for both squads were announced on Wednesday night...the pitchers and reserves for both teams - totaling 23 for each side - will be determined through a combination of player ballot choices and selections made by the Commissioner's Office...the balance of the All-Star rosters will be announced during the MLB All-Star Selection Show presented by PRO SPIRIT on Sunday at 4:00 pm (CT) on ESPN...below is where Buxton ranks among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories this season:

**RAY MATTER:** The Twins and Rays are playing the fourth of six games this season...these two last met for three games at George M. Steinbrenner field in Tampa (May 26-28) as the Twins went 1-2, winning the middle of the three games...the Twins last hosted the Rays for three games from June 18-20, 2024, going 1-2, their one win coming on a Carlos Santana walk-off single.  
 ☞ Twins are 92-98 all-time against the Rays...they were 44-29 against Tampa from 1998-2006, but have since gone 48-69 since 2007.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 17-18 against the Rays, including a record of 8-9 at Tropicana Field, 8-7 at Target Field and 1-2 at Steinbrenner Field.

☞ In his last 16 games against the Rays (since 2022), Carlos Correa is hitting .381 (24-for-63) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .587 slugging percentage and a .996 OPS...in 39 career games against the Rays, he has hit .297 (44-for-148) with an .849 OPS.

☞ Notable individuals last series in Tampa Bay: Correa went 5-for-12 (.417) with a double and a home run...Ty France went 3-for-10 (.300)...Kody Clemens homered once in 10 plate appearances.

**SOLID 'PENMANSHIP:** Over their last nine games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 7 ER) with 0 home runs allowed, 11 walks and 25 strikeouts...in their last four games, they have allowed one earned run in 10.1 innings pitched (0.87 ERA).

**UNLOCKING LEWIS:** Royce Lewis has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games, dating back to June 3 (IL stint 6/15-7/1)...over those 12 games, Lewis is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, six walks, a .463 on-base percentage, a .543 slugging percentage and a 1.006 OPS.

**ROSIES ARE RED HOT:** Double-A Wichita outfielder Kala'i Rosario yesterday was named Texas League Player of Month for June...the 23-year-old slashed .282/.419/.529 and led the league in RBI (23) and was second in runs (18)...he finished third in doubles (8), triples (2), walks (18) and OPS (.948) and was fourth in total bases (45) and fifth in stolen bases (8)...he hit safely in eight straight games June 17-26 and hit for the cycle on June 25 against Springfield as he tied his career-high with four hits...the Papaikou, Hawaii native was selected by Minnesota in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Waiakea High School in Hilo, Hawaii.

- ⚔ Making his 18th start of the season and the 100th of his career (103rd career appearance)...18 starts will be his most in a single season since 2021 (23 games/22 starts).
- ⚔ Was dealt his career-high-tying seventh loss of the year in his last outing on June 29 at Detroit, a 3-0 Twins defeat...allowed three runs on six hits (2 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts over 4.2 innings.
- ⚔ Is facing Tampa Bay for the second time in his career...took the loss in his lone outing, which came earlier this season on May 26 in Tampa Bay; allowed two runs on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings.
- ⚔ In seven home starts this season, is 1-3 with a 3.58 ERA (37.2 IP, 15 ER), three home runs, 13 walks and 26 strikeouts; Twins are 1-6.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took the loss in his last outing on June 29 in Detroit opposite Tarik Skubal, a 3-0 Twins defeat on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball...marked his seventh loss of the season, ties his career high (also 2019, 2021)...allowed three runs on six hits (2 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts over 4.2 innings...allowed solo home runs to Kerry Carpenter (1st inn.) and Riley Greene (4th inn.)...removed from the game with two outs in the fifth after hitting Colt Keith - Paddack's third hit batter of the year - and allowing an RBI triple to Carpenter.

- ⚔ Snapped his career-high-tying streak of five-straight starts without being removed from the game in the middle of an inning.
- ⚔ Carpenter's first-inning home run was the second that Paddack has allowed in the opening frame of a game this season (also, Andrew Vaughn on March 31 at White Sox).
- ⚔ Marked the second time this season and the fourth time in his career that he's allowed a single, a double, a triple and a home run in the same game (also June 13 at Houston and 2x in 2021).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on June 24 against the Mariners at Target Field opposite Luis Castillo...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 loss...allowed five runs (4 ER) on five hits, with one walk and four strikeouts over 5.0 innings...all runs were given up in the third inning via four singles, a sacrifice fly and a bases-loaded hit by pitch...retired the last eight batters he faced in order.

⚔ Five runs allowed in the third inning tied his career-high for a single inning and were his most since he allowed five runs in the third on March 20, 2021 vs. Milwaukee, a 6-0 San Diego loss.

**FACING TAMPA BAY:** Is facing the Rays for the second time in his career...lone start came earlier this season on May 26 in Tampa Bay; took the loss in Minnesota's 7-2 defeat, allowing two runs on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings...Junior Caminero's double in the sixth was the only extra-base hit allowed by Paddack...both runs scored on Jonathan Aranda's sixth-inning three-run home run after Paddack exited the game.

**EAST BOUND AND DOWN:** Paddack is making his 13th career start against the American League East...below are some of his career numbers against the American League East compared to the AL Central and AL West divisions:

**ADDITIONALLY:** In three starts against the AL East this season, Paddack is 1-1 with a 2.70 ERA (23.1 IP, 7 ER), five walks and 12 strikeouts (2x TB; 1x BOS, BAL).

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In seven starts at home this season, is 1-3 with a 3.58 ERA (37.2 IP, 15 ER), three home runs, 13 walks and 26 strikeouts, compared to 2-4 with a 5.50 ERA (52.1 IP, 32 ER), 10 home runs, 11 walks and 37 strikeouts in 10 road starts...since 2022, is 5-5 with a 4.00 ERA (99.0 IP, 44 ER), 12 HR, 24 walks and 91 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) at Target Field; Twins are 13-8.

⚔ This season, Paddack has a .234 (33-for-141) opponent batting average with a .296 on-base percentage, a .615 OPS and a 2.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio at home.

⚔ All three home runs allowed at Target Field this season have been solo shots, compared to two three-run, two two-run and six solo home runs on the road.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters are batting .240 (42-for-175) with eight home runs, 20 RBI, 11 walks and 26 strikeouts, while righties are batting .266 (45-for-169) with five home runs, 26 RBI, 13 walks and 37 strikeouts...in his career, lefties are slashing .244/.291/.423 with 41 home runs and a 3.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties are slashing .260/.297/.435 with 39 home runs and a 5.27 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

⚔ His eight home runs allowed to lefties this season are his most since 2020, when he also allowed eight, the second most in his career; his career high is 12, done in 2019.

**THE ARSENAL:** In 2025, Paddack has relied on a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

- ⚔ With 1494 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and a 6.3 percent walk rate...batters are chasing 32.2 percent of the time, which is in baseball's 87th percentile, are whiffing 20.6 percent of the time and hitting the ball hard 43.8 percent of the time.
- ⚔ His fastball run value of 5 this season ranks in baseball's 81st percentile.
- ⚔ After averaging 86.9 mph on all pitches over his two starts on June 13 and 19, Paddack has averaged 89.9 mph over his last two outings, from June 24-29...his four-seam fastball averaged 94.7 mph with a whiff rate of 16.3 percent from June 24-29, compared to 92.4 mph and 10.0 percent between June 13-19.
