**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Detroit and 1-2 at Miami), the Twins began their season-long nine-game homestand with a win over the Rays yesterday afternoon...today, they will play the second of three against Tampa and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, they will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then host the Cubs for three games from Tuesday-Thursday and the Pirates for three next weekend.

**BADER SETS OFF THE FIREWORKS:** The Twins beat the Rays yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-3, making them 9-15 in one-run games, their second-straight one-run victory...Harrison Bader hit a walk-off home run to lead off the top of the ninth inning, his second career walk-off hit, first home run...it was the sixth walk-off victory for the Twins this season...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Louis Varland held the game at 3-3 for 2.0 perfect innings of relief...for Bader, he homered in the fifth inning in addition to his walk-off shot, the third multi-homer game of his career.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams from Triple-A St. Paul...Adams appeared in 19 games (5 starts) for the Saints this season, going 3-2 with a 3.68 ERA (63.2 IP, 26 ER), 20 walks, 58 strikeouts and a 1.23 WHIP...this marks Adams' second stint with the Twins after being recalled for three days from June 6-9 (did not pitch)...to make room for Adams on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk to the Saints...Funderburk appeared in one game during his most recent stint with the Twins, working 1.0 scoreless inning with one hit allowed on Thursday in Miami.

**SEND HIM HOME:** Baxley, Georgia native Byron Buxton is looking to make his second All-Star team (also 2022)...starters have already been announced, but the pitchers and reserves for both teams will be determined through a combination of player ballot choices and selections made by the Commissioner's Office...they will be announced during the MLB All-Star Selection Show presented by PRO SPIRIT tomorrow at 4:00 pm (CT) on ESPN...below is where Buxton ranks among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories this season:

**FLORIDA MEN:** The Twins and Rays are playing the fifth of six games this season...Twins have gone 2-2 against the Rays this season, going 1-2 at George M. Steinbrenner Field, from May 26-28, followed by a win yesterday afternoon.

☞ In his last 17 games against the Rays (since 2022), Carlos Correa is hitting .358 (24-for-67) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .552 slugging percentage and a .938 OPS.

**SERIES STUFF:** The Twins need a win today or tomorrow to win their 12th series of the season and first since taking three of four in Sacramento vs. the A's (June 2-5)...Minnesota is 11-15-2 in series play, going 6-5-2 at home and 5-10-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 1-9-1 since May 26...results to the right >>>

☞ Twins seeking their first series win over the Rays since taking two of three from June 10-12, 2022 at Target Field...they have gone 0-4-1 head-to-head since.

**GOOD WILL:** In his last 41 games, Willi Castro is hitting .313 (42-for-134) with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI, 18 walks, 25 runs scored, seven stolen bases, a .410 on-base percentage, a .515 slugging percentage and a .925 OPS.

**ROYCE MAKING NOISE:** Royce Lewis has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games, dating back to June 3 (IL stint 6/15-7/1)...over those 13 games, Lewis is hitting .359 (14-for-39) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, six walks, a .444 on-base percentage, a .513 slugging percentage and a .957 OPS.

**TWINS MILB MONTHLYS:** Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul first baseman Aaron Sabato and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper as the club's minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for June.

☞ Sabato, 26, played in 24 games between St. Paul and Wichita, combining to hit .337 (29-for-86) with nine doubles, six home runs, 21 RBI, 12 walks, a .418 on-base percentage and a 1.070 OPS...the Rye, NY native was selected by the Twins in the first round (27th overall) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of North Carolina.

☞ Culpepper, 23, made four starts between Wichita and Low-A Fort Myers, combining to post a 0.66 ERA (13.2 IP, 1 ER) with five walks, 15 strikeouts, a .208 opponent batting average and no home runs allowed...the Upland, CA native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of California Baptist University in Riverside, CA.
