THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Detroit and 1-2 at Miami), the Twins began their season-long nine-game homestand with two wins in the first two games against the Rays on Friday and Saturday...

CLEMENS CRUSHES AND LEE LAYS ONE DOWN: The Twins walked-off the Rays yesterday afternoon at Target Field, winning by a score of 6-5, their seventh walk-off victory of the season...

RAY AREA: The Twins and Rays are playing for the sixth and final time this season... Twins have gone 3-2 against the Rays this season, going 1-2 at George M. Steinbrenner Field from May 26-28, followed by two wins this weekend.

SEND HIM HOME: Baxley, Georgia native Byron Buxton is looking to make his second All-Star team (also 2022)... starters have already been announced (OFs are Aaron Judge, Javier Baez and Riley Greene)...

CLOSE CALLS: The Twins have gone 10-15 in one-run games this season... they have now won two consecutive one-run games (4-3 on Friday, 6-5 on Saturday) after dropping nine-straight in such instances, from May 25-June 24.

- ☞ Took the loss in his last outing on July 1 at Miami, a 2-0 Minnesota defeat...allowed one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts over 7.0 innings.
- ☞ In three career starts against Tampa Bay, including two at Target Field, is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (16.2 IP, 4 ER), two home runs, four walks and 17 strikeouts.
- ☞ Is 4-2 with a 2.84 ERA (44.1 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, 11 walks and 57 strikeouts in eight home games (7 starts) at Target Field this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss in his last outing on July 1 in Miami opposite Edward Cabrera; Twins lost 2-0, their second consecutive shutout loss...allowed one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts over 7.0 innings...lone run scored on Kyle Stowers' solo home run to start the second inning, the third home run this season that Ryan has allowed to the first batter of an inning...marked the 14th outing of his career in which his one run allowed came on a home run; was his third such outing this season...retired 16 of 17 batters faced from the second-seventh innings...leads the Twins pitching staff with nine outings of 6.0-or-more innings this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his 10th win of the season on June 25 vs. Seattle opposite George Kirby...Twins won 2-0, snapped a five-game losing streak...over 6.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits with no walks and eight strikeouts...all hits allowed were singles...recorded at least one strikeout in every inning pitched...plunked Julio Rodriguez in the first inning, Ryan's career-high-tying and American League-lead-tying 10th hit batter of the season (also Luis Severino)...two pitches later, Rodriguez swiped second, Ryan's career-high 12th stolen base allowed this year...became the second pitcher this season to strike out Cal Raleigh three times in a game (also, San Diego's Michael King on May 18).

- ☞ Three of his eight strikeouts were looking, his most in an outing this season; also his most in an outing since Game 1 on April 13, 2024 at Detroit (also 3).
- ☞ Surpassed 100 strikeouts for the fourth-straight season...is the 15th player in Twins history (1961-present) to record 100 strikeouts in four-or-more consecutive seasons; Jim Kaat holds the record with 11-straight 100-strikeout seasons from 1961-71.

FACING TAMPA BAY: Is making his fourth career start against Tampa Bay and his third at Target Field...in three career starts, is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (16.2 IP, 4 ER), two home runs, four walks and 17 strikeouts...last faced Tampa Bay earlier this season on May 27 in Tampa, earning the win and allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings; Twins won 4-2.

- ☞ Was selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft and traded to the Twins in July 2021, along with pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for Nelson Cruz.

AL EAST BEAST: In 19 career starts against the American League East, Ryan is 8-5 with a 3.29 ERA (112.0 IP, 41 ER), 21 walks and 119 strikeouts...12 of his 19 starts against the AL East have been quality, and the Twins own a 12-7 record when he pitches against the division.

- ☞ In three starts against the AL East this season (5/2 at BOS, 5/27 at TB, 6/8 vs. TOR), is 2-0 with a 2.12 ERA (17.0 IP, 4 ER), one home run, five walks and 19 strikeouts.
- ☞ Owns a .222 (13-for-62) career opponent batting average vs. the AL East, the second lowest by a Twins pitcher against the division since it was formed in 1969 (minimum 15 GS)...among such pitchers, Ryan's 1.03 WHIP and 5.67 strikeout-to-walk ratio rank second.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In eight home games (7 starts) this season, is 4-2 with a 2.84 ERA (44.1 IP, 14 ER), four home runs allowed, 11 walks and 57 strikeouts, compared to 4-2 with a 2.67 ERA (54.0 IP, 16 ER), seven home runs allowed, nine walks and 51 strikeouts in nine road starts...in 51 career home games (50 starts), is 23-14 with a 3.59 ERA (291.0 IP, 116 ER), 39 home runs, a 4.99 strikeout-to-walk ratio, a 1.00 WHIP and a .206 opponent batting average.

- ☞ In his eight home games (7 starts) this season, opposing batters are slashing .175/.243/.305 (.548 OPS) in 154 at-bats...his 0.86 WHIP at home ranks fifth among all qualifying pitchers in baseball and his BAA ranks tied for fifth.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .210/.264/.352 with eight doubles, five home runs, eight walks and 38 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .169/.240/.307 with eight doubles, six home runs, 12 walks and 70 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .207/.268/.360 with 70 walks and 247 strikeouts (3.53 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .227/.274/.428 with 59 walks and 386 strikeouts (6.54 K/BB).

- ☞ Tampa Bay's lefties are 8-for-36 (.222) with four doubles, two RBI, two walks and 10 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are 8-for-26 (.308) with one double, two home runs, two RBI, two walks and seven strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through 17 appearances (16 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ This season (1546 pitches), his chase rate is 25.3 percent and his whiff rate is 26.8 percent...his 5.2 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 90th percentile, and his 28.2 percent strikeout rate ranks in baseball's 85th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.4 mph while his hard-hit rate is 40.8 percent...his fastball run value of 16 ranks in baseball's 99th percentile.

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2025: 4-4, 4.41 ERA // CAREER: 9-10, 4.35 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start Tuesday night's series opener against the Cubs at Target Field...earned the win in his last start on July 2 at Miami, a 2-1 Twins victory; allowed one run on two hits (1 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts over 5.0 innings...is facing the Cubs for the first time in his career...in 14 career Interleague appearances (12 starts), is 3-5 with a 4.95 ERA (63.2 IP, 35 ER), eight home runs, 26 walks and 54 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive season in the Twins' opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-American teams...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.
