TWINS GETS STUNG LATE BY RAYS IN FINALE: The Twins lost to the Rays on Sunday afternoon by a score of 7-5 in 10 innings, making them 3-6 in extra innings this season...

LOAD UP THE TRUCK TO ATLANTA: Baxley, Georgia native Byron Buxton was named to his second All-Star team on Sunday...Buck was an All-Star in 2022 at Dodger Stadium...

FRIENDLY CONFINES MINNESOTA NICE: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 44th, 45th and 46th time in their history this week...the Twins are 20-23 all-time against the Cubs...

43 games against the Cubs are the Twins' second-most against any National League opponent, trailing Pittsburgh (45)...that excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.

Last time these two met was for a three-game series at Wrigley Field from August 5-7, 2024 as Minnesota won the opener and lost games two and three.

Last time the Twins hosted the Cubs was from May 12-14, 2023 as the Twins won games two and three...the Twins won by scores of 11-1 in game two and 16-3 in game three...they outscored the Cubs 29-10 over the three-game series; 29 runs scored in the series marked a Target Field high over a three-game series.

Harrison Bader is hitting .364 (40-for-110) with a .991 OPS in his last 33 games against the Cubs...he has played 78 career games against the Cubs, tied with Milwaukee for his second-most against any opponent (Pittsburgh - 82).

THE LEFTORIUM: Today marks the 17th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-11 against lefty starters...they lost their last seven games started by left-handers: May 25 vs. Kansas City (Kris Bubic), June 12 vs. Texas (Patrick Corbin), June 15 at Houston (Brandon Walter), June 17 at Cincinnati (Andrew Abbott), June 18 at Cincinnati (Nick Lodolo), June 21 vs. Milwaukee (Jose Quintana) and June 29 at Detroit (Tarik Skubal)...

MINOR MATTERS: A pair of Twins minor leaguers earned weekly honors yesterday: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Adrian Bohorquez was named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week...Bohorquez retired the first 13 Marauders batters he faced last Wednesday...

Double-A Wichita catcher/outfielder Ricardo Olivar was named Texas League Player of the Week...Olivar hit .412 (7-for-17) with two home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.345 OPS, including a single-game career-high seven RBI on Sunday vs. Tulsa.

SIMEON SAYS: Last pitched on July 2 at Miami, opposite Janson Junk...earned his fourth win of the season and second consecutive win, tying his career high...is the first time he has achieved such a streak since August 16-21, 2024...allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...sole run allowed came on a Kyle Stowers home run in the second inning.

☞ Over his last four outings, Woods Richardson has allowed just four earned runs on nine hits over 21.0 innings...his 1.71 ERA over that span is the best of any four-game stretch of his career, and his nine hits allowed are by far the fewest he's allowed over a four-game span (next lowest, 13 hits allowed over a four-game streak from May 17-June 2, 2024).

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on June 26 vs. Seattle, opposite Emerson Hancock...earned his third win of the season and first since April 26 in Minnesota's 10-1 victory...allowed two hits with no walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 scoreless innings...retired nine-straight batters in the first through fourth innings.

☞ Reached 200 career innings pitched in his major league career.

☞ Marked his fifth career scoreless start, and second this season (also, June 15 at HOU).

☞ Had not allowed a home run in four-straight major league starts, tied for the longest streak of his career (also 4, April 13, 2024 (2)-May 6, 2024).

BEAR WITNESS, A NEW OPPONENT: Woods Richardson is facing the Cubs for the first time in his career...this is his 24th new opponent of his career, and fourth new opponent faced his season (also, Baltimore, Los Angeles-AL and Milwaukee)...he is 1-1 in those three starts.

☞ SWR is 6-5 when facing opponents for the first time, and 2-2 when facing opponents for the first time at home

☞ He is 3-5 in 14 career Interleague games (10 starts), posting a 4.95 ERA (63.2 IP, 35 ER) with 26 walks, 54 strikeouts and a .274 (68-for-248) opponent batting average.

OUR NECK OF THE WOODS: In his career, Sim has gone 4-4 with a 4.38 ERA (98.2 IP, 48 ER), 8.48 K/9, 3.28 BB/9 and 1.00 HR/9 in 20 games (19 starts) at home compared to 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA (108.0 IP, 52 ER), 7.25 K/9, 3.42 BB/9 and 1.33 HR/9 in 23 road games (22 starts).

☞ He is 3-2 in six starts at home so far this season, posting a 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER) with three home runs, eight walks and 26 strikeouts; compared to 1-2, 4.96 ERA (32.2 IP, 18 ER), six home runs, 16 walks and 29 strikeouts in seven appearances (6 starts) at home.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 13 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .303/.371/.477 in 109 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .209/.277/.351 in 134 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.2 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 35.6 compared to righties' 92.4 mph and 48.5 percent.

☞ His whiff rate is tied at an all-time high with his 2024 average of 22.3 percent (lefties, 18.6 percent; righties, 25.1 percent)...compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

☞ He currently ranks in baseball's eighth percentile in max exit velocity (115.3), ninth percentile in GB% (31.9) and 10th percentile in barrel percentage (11.5)

☞ Between June 21 and today, SWR decreased his 4-seam fastball hard-hit rate from 60.3 percent to 48.9 percent, a decrease of 11.4, and lowering himself from the second highest hard-hit percentage among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 4-seam fastballs to the 62nd highest, dropping 60 spots.

☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 curveballs, Simeon has the second-lowest whiff rate (13.0) and is the only player to have a 0.0 percent strikeout rate and put away percentage.

NIGHTMARES: So far this season, Simeon is 1-3 in six nighttime appearances (5 starts), posting a 5.72 ERA (28.1 IP, 18 ER) with four home runs, 12 walks and 22 strikeouts; compared to 3-1 with a 3.34 ERA (35.0 IP, 13 ER), five home runs, 12 walks and 33 strikeouts in seven daytime starts.

☞ SWR is 4-6 in 21 career night games (20 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 5.10 ERA and a .263 opponent batting average, .752 OPS, 13 home runs, 40 walks and 75 strikeouts; compared to a 5-4 with a 3.69 ERA, .235 opponent batting average, .674 OPS, 14 home runs, 37 walks and 105 strikeouts in 22 day games (21 starts)

☞ Earned his first night game win of the 2025 season in his last outing on July 1 at Miami.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DAVID FESTA (2025: 2-3, 5.48 ERA // CAREER: 4-9, 5.13 ERA)

Right-hander David Festa is set to start tomorrow night's game vs. Chicago-NL...last started on July 3 at Miami...was dealt his third loss of the season in Minnesota's 1-4 defeat...allowed four runs on five hits, with one walk and a season-high seven strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...in his sole start against the Cubs on August 5, 2024, took the win in Minnesota's 3-0 shutout victory...allowed two hits, with two walks and a career-high nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings...he is 1-1 in five appearances (4 starts) at home so far this season, posting a 4.56 ERA (23.2 IP, 12 ER) with 10 walks, 22 strikeouts and a .290 (27-for-93) opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, pitched a career-high 147.0 professional innings (MiLB and MLB).
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
- Struck out 26 batters in June 2024, the most among AL rookies and tied for fifth most among all rookies in baseball...also ranked third among AL rookies in innings pitched (26.0).
- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berrios...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
- Made Team USA's roster for the 2021 Tokyo Olympics but didn't appear in a game for the silver medal-winning Americans.
- In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
- Finished 2019 with High-A Dunedin as the youngest pitcher in Florida State League, going 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in six starts.
- Made professional debut with GCL Mets on July 22, 2018, earning the save in a hitless, one-inning appearance.
- Selected by New York-NL in the second round of 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Kempner High School (TX).
