THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four games on their season-long nine-game homestand, winning a three-game series over the Rays last weekend, followed by a win over the Cubs last night...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the second of three against the Cubs and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...they will wrap the homestand and pre-All-Star portion of their schedule this weekend with three against the Pirates.
 ⚡ Twins have gone 7-5 in their last 12 games and have won three of their last four games.
 ⚡ Twins have gone 10-15 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3) and 1-0 vs. Chicago.

GO TWINS GO: The Twins beat the Cubs last night at Target Field by a score of 8-1, scoring two runs in the first inning and six in their last at-bats in the bottom of the eighth...Simeon Woods Richardson (5-4) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, three walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits and were led by Ryan Jeffers, who went 3-for-4 with a double (16), a home run (7) and three RBI...Willi Castro hit his eighth home run and Harrison Bader hit his 11th...for Bader, it was his fourth in his last four games...the attendance was announced at 30,384.

I'M THE MIZ, AND I'M AWESOME: The Twins have selected the contract of left-handed pitcher Anthony Misiewicz from Triple-A St. Paul...Misiewicz (pronounced mi-SEV-ich), 30, made 26 relief appearances for the Saints this season, going 2-2, 4.02 ERA (31.1 IP, 14 ER) with eight saves, 10 walks, 29 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .213 opponent batting average...the southpaw has held left-handed batters to a .161 (5-for-31) opponent batting average, while right-handed batters have hit .234 (18-for-77) this season...the Detroit, Michigan native has pitched in parts of five major league seasons with Seattle (2020-22), Kansas City (2022), Arizona (2023), Detroit (2023) and New York-AL (2023-24), going 8-9, 4.67 ERA (115.2 IP, 60 ER), with 38 walks and 114 strikeouts in 131 games.

⚡ To make room on the 26-man and 40-man rosters, the Twins designated left-handed pitcher Joey Wentz for release or assignment following last night's game...Wentz, who was claimed off waivers from Pittsburgh on June 11, appeared in six games for the Twins, allowing 14 runs on 17 hits in 8.0 innings pitched.

DEEP DISH: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 44th, 45th and 46th times in their history this week...the Twins are 21-23 all-time against the Cubs, going 6-6 at Target Field, 9-14 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...Minnesota has gone 6-3 in its last nine against the Cubs (since '21).

⚡ 44 games against the Cubs are the Twins' second-most against any National League opponent, trailing Pittsburgh (45)...that excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.

⚡ Harrison Bader is hitting .368 (42-for-114) with a 1.018 OPS in his last 34 games against the Cubs...he has played 79 career games against the Cubs, his second-most against any opponent (Pittsburgh - 82).

NATIONAL TREASURE: In his last 18 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .306 (22-for-72) with three doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.044 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

TWINS TRY MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD) THE CUBS: A win tonight or tomorrow and the Twins will secure their 13th series win of the season...it will also mark their second consecutive series win in their first time since taking back-to-back series' at Baltimore and Milwaukee, from May 14-18...Minnesota is 12-15-2 in series play, going 7-5-2 at home and 5-10-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 2-9-1 since May 26...results to the right >>

⚡ The Twins last series win over the Cubs was May 12-14, 2023, taking two of three at Target Field...Twins are 7-8-0 all-time in series play vs. Chicago.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Twins have gone 25-18 at home this season, winning five of their last six at Target Field...after starting the season 2-5 at home, they have gone 23-13 since April 15.

⚡ Trevor Larnach is hitting .314 (22-for-70) with six doubles, four home runs, a .571 slugging percentage and a .927 OPS in his last 20 home games.

⚡ Carlos Correa is hitting .296 (40-for-135) in 38 home games this season...over his last 15 home games, he is slashing .351/.383/.474 (.857 OPS).

⚡ Byron Buxton is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with five doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, eight walks, 13 runs scored, a .417 on-base percentage, a .654 slugging percentage and a 1.071 OPS in his last 14 home games.

WHO'S CALLIN' MY PHONE: Harrison Bader hit his 11th home run last night, giving him four in his last four games...he is one home run away from matching his 2024 total of 12 with the Mets in 143 games...his career-high is 16, done in 2021 with St. Louis...his .443 slugging percentage is tied for the second-highest of his career (also .443 in 2020), his career-best being .460 in 2021.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002 at Miller Park in Milwaukee, Torii Hunter (starting centerfielder), Eddie Guardado and A.J. Pierzynski represented the Twins in the All-Star Game...Pierzynski went 0-for-3, Guardado struck out both batters he faced, and Hunter went 0-for-2, but robbed a home run from Barry Bonds in the bottom of the first inning.

- Is making his second career start against the Cubs...earned his second big league win in his previous outing on August 5, 2024 at Wrigley Field, a 3-0 Twins win...threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits and two walks while striking out nine.
- In five home appearances (four starts) this season, is 1-1 with a 4.56 ERA (23.2 IP, 12 ER), three home runs, 10 walks and 22 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss in his last start on July 3 at Miami opposite Eury Pérez, a 4-1 Twins defeat...allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work...seven strikeouts tied his professional season high and set a new major league season high...6.0 innings tied his season and career high...allowed back-to-back singles to start the first inning, followed by an RBI groundout by Otto Lopez and a two-run home run by Agustín Ramírez...in the third, Xavier Edwards singled, stole second and scored on Jesús Sánchez's RBI single...one pitch later, Sánchez stole second; was then thrown out by Festa trying to steal third.

Was his fourth career game and second this season allowing multiple stolen bases...of the four games, was the only in which he also caught a runner stealing...marked the first time in his career throwing out a runner at third base (3 career CS).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his second win of the season on June 27 in Detroit opposite Sawyer Gipson-Long...Twins won 4-1...pitched 5.2 shutout innings, allowing two hits with no walks and six strikeouts...two hits ties his career low, done four times...marked the first scoreless outing of his career with no walks allowed...plunked Spencer Torkelson in the second inning, Festa's fifth hit batter of the season...Torkelson advanced to third on Dillon Dingler's two-out single, the only Detroit runner in scoring position against Festa...marked the fourth outing of his career without an extra-base hit allowed; was his second such outing this season, the first coming vs. Detroit at Target Field on April 11...marked his first road win since August 5, 2024 at Chicago-NL.

Was his second career game allowing three-or-fewer baserunners (also August 28, 2024 vs. Atlanta).

FACING THE CUBS: Is facing the Cubs for the second time in his career and first at Target Field...lone career start came on August 8, 2024 at Wrigley Field...earned his second win of his major league career in Minnesota's 3-0 shutout victory...pitched 5.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits (a Dansby Swanson single and a Pete Crow-Armstrong double) and two walks while striking out a career-high nine batters.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: In 12 career appearances (10 starts) against the National League, is 2-5 with a 5.17 ERA (55.2 IP, 32 ER), seven home runs, 21 walks and 65 strikeouts...in four Interleague games (3 starts) this season, is 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (18.2 IP, 14 ER), three home runs, eight walks and 20 strikeouts...NL batters are hitting .312 (24-for-77) with a .386 on-base percentage and an .854 OPS against Festa this season.

In his career, is 1-2 with a 6.53 ERA (20.2 IP, 15 ER), two home runs allowed, 13 walks and 25 strikeouts against the NL Central (2x Cincinnati; 1x Chicago, St. Louis and Milwaukee)

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In five appearances (four starts) at Target Field this season, is 1-1 with a 4.56 ERA (23.2 IP, 12 ER), three home runs allowed, 10 walks and 22 strikeouts, compared to 1-2 with a 6.63 ERA (19.0 IP, 14 ER), four home runs allowed, six walks and 23 strikeouts in four road starts...in 13 career appearances (11 starts) at Target Field, is 1-5 with a 5.43 ERA (58.0 IP, 35 ER), 10 home runs allowed, 25 walks and 63 strikeouts; Twins are 5-8...tonight's game is Festa's first at home since June 22 vs. Milwaukee and his first home start since June 11 vs. Texas.

Is facing the NL Central at Target Field for the fourth time (started vs. St. Louis and Cincinnati in 2024 and was bulk reliever vs. Milwaukee in 2025)...is 0-2 with a 9.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 13), two home runs, eight walks and 12 strikeouts in those three games (two starts).

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties are hitting .241 (19-for-79) with four doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, nine walks and 22 strikeouts against Festa, while righties are hitting .267 (23-for-86) with two doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks and 23 strikeouts...in his career, lefties are slashing .236/.321/.392 with six home runs, 22 walks and 60 strikeouts in 199 at-bats, while righties are slashing .263/.322/.461 with ten home runs, 17 walks and 62 strikeouts in 217 at-bats.

THE ARSENAL: Through nine major league appearances (8 starts) in 2025, Festa has relied on a four-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

So far this year (729 pitches), Festa has a 29.4 percent chase rate, a 27.4 percent whiff rate, a 40.5 percent hard-hit rate and an average exit velocity of 90.1 mph...batters are striking out 24.2 percent of the time and walking 8.6 percent of the time.
