THE TWINS: Have gone 1-1 through two games on their six-game roadtrip, winning game one of their series against the White Sox on Friday, followed by a loss on the Southside last night...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale at Rate Field...after the game, Minnesota will fly to Toronto for a three-game series at Rogers Centre, from Monday-Wednesday. ☞ The Twins enter today 5-9 in rubber games...they have won each of their last two rubber matches, coming on August 6 at Detroit and August 10 vs. Kansas City.

SECOND INNING UNKIND TO ABEL, TWINS: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Rate Field by a score of 7-3...Mick Abel (2-3) made his Twins debut as the club's starter, allowing six runs (all in the 2nd inning) on seven hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts...Thomas Hatch pitched 5.0 innings of relief, allowing one run on three hits, with no walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, three being solo home runs from Matt Wallner, Kody Clemens and Royce Lewis.

TAJ TIME: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Taj Bradley from Triple-A St. Paul... Bradley, who was acquired in the Griffin Jax trade with Tampa Bay over the trade deadline, recently made three starts for the Saints, allowing 12 runs on 21 hits in 14.1 innings pitched, with just two walks and 18 strikeouts...prior to joining the Twins organization, he made 21 starts for the Rays this season, going 6-6 with a 4.61 ERA (111.1 IP, 57 ER), 44 walks, 95 strikeouts, a 1.28 WHIP and a .236 opponent batting average...the 24-year-old was originally selected by Tampa Bay in the fifth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft and has appeared in 69 career games (67 starts) all with the Rays, going 19-25 with a 4.70 ERA (354.0 IP, 185 ER), 130 walks, 378 strikeouts, a .129 WHIP and a .242 opponent batting average.

☞ To make room for Bradley on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Erasmo Ramirez for release or assignment...Ramirez made nine appearances for the Twins, going 0-1 with a 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER), one save, two walks and five strikeouts.

MIDWEST MASHUP: The Twins are playing the White Sox tonight for the ninth of 13 scheduled games in 2025...after dropping their first game on March 31 at Rate Field, the Twins have gone 5-2 in their last seven vs. the Sox.

☞ These two teams will meet for a final series from September 1-4 at Target Field.

☞ Twins have gone 12-4 in their last 16 here at Rate Field.

☞ Minnesota has gone 24-5 in its last 29 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-73 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

☞ Since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs at Rate Field than the Twins, hitting 95 home runs (next: Cleveland with 62)...in that same span, no team has hit more homers against the Sox overall (home or away) than the Twins with 155 (next is KC with 117).

☞ The start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .363 (29-for-80) with a .991 OPS in 24 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 20-straight starts against CWS.

☞ Matt Wallner is hitting .316 (24-for-76) with five doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.024 OPS in 26 career games against the White Sox...in 15 career games at Rate Field, he is slashing .370/.473/.630 (1.103 OPS).

☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .424 (14-for-33) with six home runs, 19 RBI, nine walks, a .548 on-base percentage, a 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.548 OPS in nine career games vs. the White Sox...he is 10-for-23 (.435) lifetime at Rate Field, hitting safely in all six here...in those six, he has homered in four, recorded three hits twice and hit a grand slam twice.

☞ Byron Buxton's 23 career home runs and 53 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...11 home runs and 21 RBI at Rate Field his most in an opposing ballpark.

UNLOCKING LEWIS: Royce Lewis has hit safely in five of his last six games, hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI, two walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .773 slugging percentage and a 1.148 OPS in that span.

☞ In his last 15 road games, Lewis is hitting .339 (19-for-56) with five doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .696 slugging percentage and a 1.080 OPS.

LUUUUUUUUUKE!!!: After going 1-for-4 with a single last night, Luke Keaschall has now reached safely in 22 of 24 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .424, reaching base 42 times (29 hits, 11 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch) in 99 plate appearances...in the right margin are Twins all-time OBPs through their first 24 career games.

POWER AND SPEED: Since June 17, Byron Buxton has homered nine times in 19 road games, tied for 10th-most in baseball during that span...since that date, he has homered in five of six road series: four homers at Cincinnati (June 17-19), two homers at Detroit (June 27-29), none at Miami (July 1-3), one homer at Colorado (July 18-21), one homer at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23) and one homer at New York-AL (August 11-13).

☞ At 25 home runs and 19 stolen bases, Buck needs one more steal to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hisle (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

☞ Buxton is 19-for-19 in stolen base attempts this season, one of two players in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum 15 attempts), the other being Trevor Story (22-for-22)...he has gone 25-for-his-last-25 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 in this ballpark (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen).

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: A win today and the Twins will earn their 17th series of the season... Minnesota is 16-23-2 in series play, going 10-8-2 at home and 6-15-0 on the road.

☞ Twins are 2-0-0 in series play vs. the White Sox this season...they have gone 8-0-0 in series play vs. Chicago-AL, dating back to July of 2023.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Garrett Horn and Triple-A St. Paul infielder Tyler Fedko have been named Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week. ☞ Horn, 22, made two starts for the Kernels, combining to allow just one run on one hit in 8.0 innings pitched, with six walks and 13 strikeouts...Horn was acquired by the Twins at the trade deadline from Texas, in exchange for Danny Coulombe...the Greensboro, NC native was selected by the Rangers in the sixth round of the 2024 Draft out of Liberty University.

☞ Fedko, 25, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .407 (11-for-27) with two doubles, three home runs, four RBI, seven runs scored, four walks and a 1.299 OPS...on Tuesday against Round Rock, he tied a Saints franchise record with five hits...the Gibsonsia, PA native was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2021 Draft out of the UCONN.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1981, in his first major league game, Kent Hrbek hit a 12th-inning home run, giving the Twins a 3-2 victory over the Yankees...Hrbek finished his career with 293 home runs, second most in Twins history trailing only Harmon Killebrew (475).

- ⚡ Acquired by Minnesota from Tampa Bay on July 31 in exchange for RHP Griffin Jax.
- ⚡ In three starts with Triple-A St. Paul, went 0-0 and posted a 7.53 ERA (14.1 IP, 12 ER), with four home runs allowed, 18 strikeouts and two walks.
- ⚡ Lone career start against the White Sox came on July 23 vs. Chicago-AL, his last outing for Tampa Bay this season...did not factor into the decision of the Rays' 9-11 loss, allowing four runs on four hits (1 HR) over 1.2 innings, with three walks and no strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT (MINORS): Last started for the Saints on August 17 at Omaha but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 11-12 defeat...allowed five runs on five hits (2 HR) over 3.2 innings, with two walks and eight strikeouts...gave up a solo home run in the first inning...in the second, hit a batter, walked two and allowed three doubles, shrinking the Saints' 5-1 lead to 5-4...gave up his second solo home run of the day in the fourth inning before exiting the game...eight strikeouts were his most in a professional outing since fanning 10 on June 1 in Houston.

- ⚡ In three starts with Triple-A St. Paul, went 0-0 and posted a 7.53 ERA (14.1 IP, 12 ER), with four home runs allowed, 18 strikeouts and two walks.

LAST TIME OUT (MLB): Last started in the majors on July 23 vs. the White Sox, opposite Jonathan Cannon, in a 9-11 Rays defeat; was his first career outing against Chicago...allowed four runs on four hits (1 HR) over 1.2 innings of work, with three walks and no strikeouts...allowed three consecutive walks to start the second inning before giving up a three-run home run to Colson Montgomery...walked three of the next four batters he faced before exiting the game.

- ⚡ Marked the second-fewest innings he's pitched in a start in his career (1.1 IP on June 18, 2025 vs. BAL).
- ⚡ Was just the second outing of his career without recording a strikeout (also October 1, 2023 at TOR).

WHERE WERE WE?: Below are some notes about Bradley's performance in the majors so far this season:

- ⚡ Among pitchers with 20-or-more starts this season, Bradley's .167 (20-for-120) opponent batting average with two outs ranks third...also, his .231 opponent on-base percentage and his .200 BABIP with two outs rank second.
- ⚡ After allowing a first-inning run in nine of his first 12 starts of the season, he has not allowed a first-inning run in nine straight starts, tying his career-best streak, done from June 8-July 31, 2024.
- ⚡ Between June 24 and July 23, he allowed just one home run, tied for the fewest by an American League pitcher with five-or-more starts in that span, and a .214 BAA, which ranked 10th...marked just the second time in his career allowing one home run over a six-game stretch (also June 24-July 25, 2024).

A NEW CENTER: In 12 career starts against the American League Central, is 2-4 with a 3.22 ERA (67.0 IP, 24 ER), 28 walks and 64 strikeouts...has faced Minnesota five times, Cleveland and Kansas City three times apiece and Chicago once...batters in the division are hitting .215 (53-for-247) with seven home runs, a .295 on-base percentage, a .340 slugging percentage and a .635 OPS.

- ⚡ His ERA and his WHIP (1.21) vs. the AL Central are his second-best among all divisions (2.20 ERA and 1.05 WHIP vs. NL Central)...his 2.29 strikeout-to-walk ratio vs. AL Central teams is his lowest among all divisions.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 10 road starts with Tampa Bay this season, went 2-3 with a 3.76 ERA (55.0 IP, 23 ER), 24 walks and 48 strikeouts, compared to 4-3 with a 5.43 ERA (56.1 IP, 34 ER), 20 walks and 47 strikeouts in 11 home starts...in 35 career road games (33 starts), is 8-11 with a 4.50 ERA (174.0 IP, 87 ER), 73 walks and 177 strikeouts.

- ⚡ On the road this season, he has posted a .210 (43-for-205) opponent batting average and a 1.22 WHIP while allowing nine doubles and four home runs.
- ⚡ In six career road starts in American League Central ballparks, is 1-1 with a 3.34 ERA (32.1 IP, 12 ER), three home runs allowed, 15 walks and 32 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed batters have slashed .222/.319/.399 with nine doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 28 RBI and a 1.70 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 198 at-bats against Bradley...right-handed batters have slashed .249/.306/.353 with eight doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI and a 2.88 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 221 at-bats against Bradley.

- ⚡ In his careers, lefties have slashed .236/.311/.407 with a 2.80 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties have slashed .247/.307/.443 with a 3.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Bradley.

THE ARSENAL: Through 22 starts in 2025, Bradley has relied on a four pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:
