THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their six-game roadtrip, dropping a series on the Southside over the weekend, winning the opener on Friday night, followed by consecutive losses on Saturday and Sunday...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three in Canada against the Blue Jays...they will conclude the series on Wednesday night then travel home for an off-day on Thursday, followed by a seven-game homestand, hosting the Padres (August 29-31) and White Sox (September 1-4).

SUNDAY NOT-SO-FUNDAY: The Twins were shut out by the White Sox on Sunday afternoon at Rate Field, losing by a score of 8-0...it marked their 10th time being shut out this season and second time by the White Sox in Chicago this season (also March 31, 9-0)...Taj Bradley (6-7) made his Twins debut, allowing seven runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout...all seven runs allowed came in the first two innings, three in the first and four in the second...the offense recorded five hits and walked four times...Luke Keaschall was the only Twin to reach multiple times, recording a double and drawing a walk.

LAKES AND LEAFS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing the fourth of six games this season...these two met for three games at Target Field from June 6-8 as the Twins lost the first two games and salvaged game three.

☞ Twins have gone 19-17 in the regular season against Toronto under Rocco Baldelli, including a record of 10-5 at Rogers Centre.

☞ In nine career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner has posted an .846 OPS with two home runs, four RBI and four walks...he has never played at Rogers Centre.

☞ In 10 career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .515 (17-for-33) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .590 on-base percentage, an .848 slugging percentage and a 1.438 OPS...he has reached safely in all 10.

☞ Byron Buxton has posted an .899 OPS with nine doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and a .548 slugging percentage in 31 career regular season games against the Blue Jays...Buck hit three home runs in his third game at the Rogers Centre on August 27, 2017, homering off Joe Biagini, Matt Dermody and Tim Lincecum...in 11 career games here, he is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with four doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.051 OPS.

☞ Québec City native Edouard Julien is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with four doubles, one home run, seven walks, a .474 on-base percentage, a .581 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS in 11 career regular season games against Toronto...at Rogers Centre, he is 7-for-15 (.467) with two doubles, three walks and three stolen bases.

☞ Manager Rocco Baldelli homered in his first career game at Rogers Centre on May 13, 2003, a solo shot off Trevor Miller, while playing for the Devil Rays...he hit safely in each of his first 11 games at the Rogers Centre from May 13, 2003-June 22, 2004.

POUTINE POP: Twins have homered in 20-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 40 total homers in those 20...below are the longest homer streaks in an opposing park in Twins history (since 1961):

PITCH 22: Over their last 11 games, since August 13, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.37 ERA (49.1 IP, 13 ER) with three home runs allowed, 19 walks, 42 strikeouts and a .198 opponent batting average...below are the bullpen comparisons 22 games leading up to the trade deadline and 22 games since:

UNLOCKING LEWIS: Over his last seven games, Royce Lewis has posted a 1.037 OPS (.357 OBP/.680 SLG) with one double, three home runs, three walks, seven hits and seven RBI.
☞ In his last 16 road games, Lewis is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with five doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .661 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS.

LUKE WHO'S ON BASE AGAIN: After going 1-for-3 with a double and a walk yesterday, Luke Keaschall has now reached safely in 23 of 25 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .427, reaching base 44 times (30 hits, 12 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch) in 103 plate appearances...in the right margin are Twins all-time OBPs through their first 25 career games.

AIR AND GROUND: Since June 17, Byron Buxton has homered nine times in 20 road games, tied for seventh-most in the AL during that span...since that date, he has homered in five of seven road series: four homers at Cincinnati (June 17-19), two homers at Detroit (June 27-29), none at Miami (July 1-3), one homer at Colorado (July 18-21), one homer at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23), one homer at New York-AL (August 11-13) and none this last series in Chicago-AL.

☞ At 25 home runs and 19 stolen bases, Buck needs one more steal to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hise (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

☞ Buxton is 19-for-19 in stolen base attempts this season, one of two players in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum 15 attempts), the other being Trevor Story (22-for-22)...he has gone 25-for-his-last-25 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen).

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Over his last 35 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .320 (40-for-125) with eight doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 12 walks, a .393 on-base percentage, a .456 slugging percentage and an .849 OPS...he has reached base safely in 19 of his last 20 games.
☞ Jeffers has reached base in 10-straight games...his season-long is 12, from July 25-August 10...career-long is 16, from April 22-May 9, 2024.

WALK-UP SONG: Twins number one prospect (MLB.com's 14th in baseball), outfielder Walker Jenkins has been promoted to Triple-A St. Paul after slashing .309/.425/.487 (.913 OPS) in 52 games for Double-A Wichita...St. Paul (off today) plays in Toledo tomorrow night at 5:35 (CT).

LAST TIME OUT: Took his sixth loss of the season on August 19 vs. the Athletics, opposite Jacob Lopez, in Minnesota's 3-6 defeat...allowed five runs on a seven hits (1 HR) in 4.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...4.0 innings were his fewest in any outing since his injury-shortened 2.0 IP outing on August 7, 2024; marked just the 12th time in his career working 4.0-or-fewer innings...after allowing a leadoff double to Nick Kurtz, retired the next eight batters in order...walked Kurtz with two outs in the third, followed by a home run to Shea Langeliers...in the fourth, allowed three runs on three singles, two doubles and a sacrifice fly.

☞ Became the third pitcher in baseball this season to strike out four-or-more batters in each of their first 25 games of the season (also Sonny Gray and Garrett Crochet)...his 98 career games with four-or-more strikeouts rank 15th in Twins history, behind Kevin Tapani (100 games).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his 12th win of the season - one shy of his career high (13 in 2022) - on August 13 at Yankee Stadium, opposite Cam Schlichter, in Minnesota's 4-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts over 6.2 innings of work...lone run scored came on a third-inning solo home run by Cody Bellinger...marked his 13th quality start of the season, one shy of his career high of 14 (2023)...threw a season-high 102 pitches.

☞ Worked 5.0-plus innings in his first 24 games of the season, becoming the fifth pitcher (9x) in Twins history (1961-) to do so to start the season and the first since Johan Santana did so in 32-straight in 2007.

FACING THE BLUE JAYS: Making his second start of the season against Toronto...in three career starts, is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 6 ER), four walks and 17 strikeouts...earned the win in his last start vs. the Jays on June 8 at Target Field, allowing three runs (2 ER) on four hits over 5.0 innings, with three walks and six strikeouts.

☞ In his career, Blue Jays batters are hitting .235 (16-for-68) with four doubles, one home run, a .284 on-base percentage, a .338 slugging percentage and a .622 OPS against Ryan.

RYAN ON THE ROAD: In 12 road starts this season, is 6-2 with a 2.44 ERA (73.2 IP, 20 ER), nine home runs, 12 walks and 73 strikeouts, compared to 6-4 with a 3.12 ERA (69.1 IP, 24 ER), eight home runs allowed, 16 walks and 86 strikeouts in 12 home starts (13 games)...in 53 career road starts, is 20-16 with a 3.72 ERA, a 4.94 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .228 opponent batting average.

☞ Among pitchers in baseball with 12-or-more road starts this season, Ryan's 6.08 strikeout-to-walk ratio on the road ranks first, his 0.88 WHIP ranks second, his ERA ranks fourth and his .198 BAA ranks seventh.

☞ In two career starts at Rogers Centre, he is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP, 4 ER), one home run allowed, one walk, 11 strikeouts and a .245 (12-for-49) opponent batting average.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .234/.285/.400 with 14 doubles, 10 home runs, 14 walks and 65 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .180/.237/.305 with 11 doubles, seven home runs, 14 walks and 94 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .213/.272/.371 with 76 walks and 274 strikeouts (3.61 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .226/.271/.420 with 61 walks and 410 strikeouts (6.72 K/BB).

☞ His .180 BAA against righties ranks third among all qualified pitchers in baseball this season and his .542 opponent OPS vs. righties ranks seventh.

THE ARSENAL: Through 25 appearances (24 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

☞ This season (227 pitches), his chase rate is 25.4 percent and his whiff rate is 26.4 percent...his 5.0 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 94th percentile and his 28.2 percent strikeout rate ranks in the 86th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.2 mph and his hard-hit rate is 41.6 percent.

☞ His overall pitching run value of 17 ranks in baseball's 93rd percentile.
