THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, dropping a series 1-2 on the Southside over the weekend, followed by a loss in Toronto last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three in Canada against the Blue Jays...they will conclude the series tomorrow night then travel home for an off-day on Thursday, followed by a seven-game homestand, hosting the Padres (August 29-31) and White Sox (September 1-4).

NO CANADA: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays last night at Rogers Centre by a score of 10-4...Joe Ryan (12-7) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing a season-high tying six runs on seven hits (2 home runs), with one walk and seven strikeouts...Génesis Cabrera pitched 2.0 scoreless inning of relief, appearing in his 300th career game...the offense recorded just five hits but struck out just six times...Matt Wallner led the offense with two hits, both being home runs, his second career multi-homer game...he hit a solo homer off Max Scherzer in the fourth inning and a two-run homer off Scherzer in the sixth.

ROGER THAT: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing the fifth of six games this season.

☞ Twins have gone 19-18 in the regular season against Toronto under Rocco Baldelli, including a record of 10-6 at Rogers Centre.

☞ In 10 career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with four home runs, seven RBI, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.045 OPS.

☞ In 11 career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .459 (17-for-37) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .535 on-base percentage, a .757 slugging percentage and a 1.292 OPS.

☞ Byron Buxton has posted an .882 OPS with nine doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and a .534 slugging percentage in 32 career regular season games against the Blue Jays...in 12 career games here, he is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with four doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI and a .999 OPS.

☞ Québec City native Edouard Julien is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with four doubles, one home run, seven walks, a .429 on-base percentage, a .514 slugging percentage and a .943 OPS in 12 career regular season games against Toronto...at Rogers Centre, he is 7-for-19 (.368) with two doubles, three walks and three stolen bases.

CN POWER: Twins have homered in 21-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 42 total homers in those 21...it's tied with their streak at Kauffman Stadium (1998-2001) for the longest in club history...below are the longest homer streaks in an opposing park in Minnesota's history (since 1961):

DINOSAUR BONES: Matt Wallner hit two home runs last night, marking his second career multi-homer game, the other was on July 26, 2023 vs. Seattle...since July 1, he has homered 12 times in 40 games, tied for 12th-most home runs in the AL since that date.

☞ Since August 2, he has posted a .788 slugging percentage and a 1.188 OPS in 10 road games.

☞ Since July 27, Wallner has posted a 1.159 OPS against right-handed pitching, posting a .383 on-base percentage and a .776 slugging percentage.

☞ Since 2023, Wallner has posted an .862 OPS, eighth-best in the AL (minimum of 775 plate appearances).

MEET ME AT FIRST BASE: After going 1-for-3 with a double and a walk on Sunday at Chicago-AL, Luke Keaschall has now reached safely in 23 of 25 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .427, reaching base 44 times (30 hits, 12 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch) in 103 plate appearances...of his 25 games, he has reached multiple times in 14 of those...in the right margin are Twins all-time OBPs through their first 25 career games.

BUCK TRUCK HITS THE ROAD: Since June 17, Byron Buxton has homered nine times in 21 road games...since that date, he has homered in five of seven road series: four homers at Cincinnati (June 17-19), two homers at Detroit (June 27-29), none at Miami (July 1-3), one homer at Colorado (July 18-21), one homer at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23), one homer at New York-AL (August 11-13) and none this last series in Chicago-AL.

☞ Over his last 31 road games, since May 14, Bux has posted an .867 OPS with a .537 slugging percentage.

☞ At 25 home runs and 19 stolen bases, Buck needs one more steal to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hise (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Minnesota needs a win tonight and tomorrow night to earn their 17th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 16-24-2 in series play, going 10-8-2 at home and 6-16-0 on the road...Twins are looking to avoid dropping their fifth-straight series tonight...results >>>

☞ After losing a series 1-2 vs. Toronto at Target Field from June 6-8, the Twins are looking to avoid losing both of their series against the Jays in one season since 2016.

PABLO DAY IN TOLEDO: Pablo López will be making his second start on rehab assignment tonight for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo with first pitch at 6:35 PM (ET), opposite Randy Dobnak...he made his first rehab start on Thursday vs. Round Rock in St. Paul, allowing one run on four hits in 1.2 innings pitched, throwing 45 pitches...he was placed on the IL on June 5 with a right shoulder strain.

2026 IS A REAL YEAR: The Twins, in conjunction with MLB, announced their preliminary schedule for the 2026, the club's 66th campaign in Twins Territory...for the second consecutive season, the Twins will play their earliest Opening Day game ever, beginning the 2026 campaign with a Thursday, March 26 game against the Baltimore Orioles at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...the Twins host Tampa Bay at Target Field on Friday, April 3 for the club's second Home Opener against the Rays (also in 2000 at the Metrodome)...Minnesota will conclude the regular season at home, welcoming the Texas Rangers from September 25-27, additional notes:

☞ Minnesota opens a season in Baltimore for the fifth time (also 1967, 2012, 2016 and 2018)...Twins are starting on the road for the third-straight season and 12th time in the last 16 seasons.

☞ Twins have a pair of nine-game homestands at Target Field, first from May 12-20 (3-game series vs. Miami, Milwaukee and Houston) and then again from August 10-20 (3-game sets vs. Baltimore, Philadelphia and Atlanta).

☞ Minnesota has a season-long 10-game roadtrip from May 22-31 (3 G at BOS, 4 G at CWS and 3 G at PIT).

☞ The Twins' three-game set at the Texas Rangers will have a rare mid-series off day on Wednesday, June 17, due to a scheduled FIFA World Cup match that day at AT&T Stadium in Arlington.

- ⌘ Ober is 2-3 with a 3.48 ERA (33.2 IP, 13 ER), seven walks, 38 strikeouts and a .167 (20-for-120) opponent batting average in six career starts against the Blue Jays.

- A-MINUS:** Last pitched on August 20 vs. the Athletics, opposite J.T. Ginn; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-4, 10-inning defeat...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and a season-high-tying seven strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work...has allowed a home run in nine of his last 10 starts...allowed a sacrifice fly to Darell Hernaiz in the second and a solo home run to Tyler Soderstrom in the fourth...was pulled in the sixth with two outs and replaced by Kody Funderburk.
- ⌘ Generated a season-high-tying 18 total swing and misses for a whiff rate of 40.0 percent, a new season high (18 whiffs, 36.0 percent, May 3 at Boston).
- ⌘ Became the only pitcher in baseball with 115-or-fewer innings pitched and 25 home runs allowed this season.

- EYE OF THE TIGER:** Pitched on August 14 vs. Detroit, opposite Tarik Skubal; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-4, 11-inning defeat...allowed three runs on four hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work...was perfect through 3.2 innings, retiring 11-straight batters before allowing a two-out double to Kerry Carpenter, followed by a home run to Riley Greene.
- ⌘ Generated 14 total swing and misses for a whiff rate of 30.4 percent, tied for his third most on the season (highest, 18 whiffs, 36.0 percent, May 3 at Boston).

- BIRDS ON THE BRAIN:** Ober is 2-3 in six career starts against Toronto...has posted a 3.48 ERA (33.2 IP, 13 ER) with seven walks, 38 strikeouts and a .167 (20-for-120) opponent batting average...last faced the Blue Jays on June 6 where he was dealt the loss in Minnesota's 4-6 defeat...allowed five runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 7.0 innings.
- ⌘ Faced the Blue Jays twice in 2024, posting a 0.73 ERA (12.1 IP, 1 ER) with three walks, 18 strikeouts and a .050 (2-for-40) opponent batting average, his lowest BAA among all opponents faced last season.
- ⌘ His career .167 opponent batting average is his lowest among teams he has faced at least three times, and T-5th lowest among all opponents.

- HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-13 with a 4.06 ERA (299.1 IP, 135 ER), 8.99 K/9, 2.16 BB/9 and 1.68 HR/9 in 57 games (56 starts) at home compared to 13-16 with a 4.09 ERA (290.1 IP, 132 ER), 8.74 K/9, 1.74 BB/9 and 1.43 HR/9 in 54 road starts.
- ⌘ Ober is 2-3, 5.89 ERA (47.1 IP, 31 ER) with 11 home runs, 11 walks, 36 strikeouts and a .310 (62-for-200) opponent batting average in nine road starts this season.
- ⌘ Has two starts against Toronto at Rogers Centre where he's gone 1-1 with a 3.48 ERA (10.1 IP, 4 ER) with two walks, 13 strikeouts and a .139 (5-for-36) opponent batting average.

- LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through 21 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .286/.317/.521 in 238 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .263/.311/.479 in 217 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.1 mph and a whiff rate of 21.2 compared to righties' 91.4 mph and 28.1 percent.
- ⌘ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 31.3 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 50.6 percent.

- THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 37.7% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- Slider (83.6)17.0% (312 pitches, 188/124)..... 310 (27-for-87), 5 2B, 6 HR, 13 K
- Sweeper (78.7)10.0% (183 pitches, 148/35)..... 286 (10-for-35), 4 2B, 3 HR, 13 K
- Curveball (75.4)4.4% (81 pitches, 23/58)..... 600 (3-for-5), 1 2B, 1 HR, 1 K
- Sinker (90.6)3.2% (58 pitches, 55/3)..... 421 (8-for-19), 2 2B, 2 HR, 0 K
- ⌘ His 7.4 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 98th percentile...he ranks in the bottom one percent in breaking run value (-13) and bottom seventh percent in pitching run value (-14).
- ⌘ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 sliders, Bailey has the second highest opponent batting average (.310), the highest slugging percentage (.575), eighth highest hard hit percentage (47.3) and sixth lowest strikeout percentage (13.7).
- ⌘ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 curveballs, Bailey has the highest opponent batting average (.600) and slugging percentage (1.400)...recorded his first strikeout off his curveball in his last start against the Athletics.
