THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game roadtrip, dropping a series 1-2 in Chicago-AL last weekend, followed by a split of the first two games in Toronto this week... tonight, the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series final at Rogers Centre... after tonight's game, they will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow... on Friday night, they will begin a seven-game homestand, with the first of three against the Padres over the weekend... after that series, they will host the White Sox for four games, from September 1-4.
 ☞ The Twins enter today 5-10 in rubber games.

STARTED WITH A GASP, ENDED WITH A BLAST: The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Rogers Centre by a score of 7-5, coming back from a 0-4 deficit after the fifth inning and a 3-4 deficit entering the ninth inning... it marked Minnesota's fourth win (4-54) this season when trailing after seven innings and second win (2-57) when trailing after eight... Mickey Gasper tied the game with a solo home run in the ninth inning, while five batters later, Matt Wallner hit the go-ahead three-run homer... Gasper finished with a career-high three hits as the home run marked the first of his career.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List... Woods Richardson, who was placed on the 15-day IL on August 4 with an illness, recently made two appearances (1 start) on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, allowing four runs (3 earned) on six hits (1HR) in 5.1 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts.

☞ To make room for Woods Richardson on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl to St. Paul... Ohl, who made his major league debut on July 29 vs. Boston, appeared in seven games (3 starts) for the Twins, going 0-3, 5.66 ERA (20.2 IP, 13 ER), with five walks and 16 strikeouts.

☞ Additionally, right-handed pitcher Erasmo Ramirez has accepted his assignment to Triple-A St. Paul... he was designated for release or assignment on Sunday.

LAKES AND LEAFS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the sixth and final time in 2025... Minnesota has gone 2-3 against the Jays, going 1-2 at Target Field, from June 6-8 and splitting the first two games this week at Rogers Centre.

☞ These two teams will meet for six games in 2026, three at Rogers Centre, from April 10-12 and three at Target Field, from May 1-3.

☞ Byron Buxton has posted an .882 OPS with nine doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and a .534 slugging percentage in 32 career regular season games against the Blue Jays... in 12 career games here, he is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with four doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI and a .999 OPS.

MEASURE 'EM IN METRES: With three home runs last night, the Twins have now homered in 22-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 45 total homers in those 22... it marks their longest streak in an opposing ballpark in club history (since 1961):

THE MOOSE IS ON THE LOOSE IN CANADA: In 11 career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner is hitting .297 (11-for-37) with five home runs, 10 RBI, a .703 slugging percentage and a 1.084 OPS.

☞ Wally has three home runs this series... just two other Twins have homered at least three times in a series this season: Byron Buxton hit four at Cincinnati (3 games - June 17-19) and Harrison Bader hit three vs. Tampa Bay (3 games - July 4-6)... no Twin has ever homered four times in a series against Toronto.

☞ Since July 1, he has homered 13 times in 41 games, tied for 10th-most home runs in the AL since that date.

☞ Last night's homer gave Wallner 20 homers for the season, becoming the fourth different Minnesota native in Twins history (since 1961) to reach 20 in a season, joining Kent Hrbek (10x), Dave Winfield (1x) and Joe Mauer (1x).

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Tonight marks the 26th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season... Minnesota is 8-17 against lefty starters... they have lost their last four games vs. a left-handed starter, including their last try on August 19 vs. Jacob Lopez and the Athletics... their last win against a lefty starter was a 5-4 victory on August 3 at Cleveland over Joey Cantillo.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .396 (19-for-48) with a 1.065 OPS in his last 30 games vs. lefties.

☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .313 (26-for-83) with a .794 OPS in his last 46 games vs. lefties.

☞ Matt Wallner has posted a .946 OPS in his last 25 games against left-handed pitching... he has 13 hits against lefties this season... he entered 2025 with 14 career hits off lefties, from 2022-24... had a .510 OPS vs. LHP entering 2025, but has a .798 OPS in 2025.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .313 (21-for-67) with a 1.072 OPS over his last 38 games vs. lefties.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: A win tonight and Minnesota will earn their 17th series victory of the season... Minnesota is 16-24-2 in series play, going 10-9-2 at home and 6-15-0 on the road... Twins are looking to win their first series since August 8-10 vs. Kansas City at Target Field.

☞ Twins last series win over the Jays was August 30-September 1, 2024 at Target Field... their last series win at Rogers was May 10-12, 2024.

PABLO DAY IN TOLEDO: Pablo López made his second start on rehab assignment last night for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo, allowing three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts... he threw 68 pitches and averaged 93.8 mph on his fastball (95.2 mph max)... he was placed on the IL on June 5 with a right shoulder strain.

A PAUL BUNYAN-SIZED BIRTHDAY: Hall of Famer Jim Thome is celebrating his 55th birthday today.

MINNESOTA TWINS, SCULPTED IN BUTTER: The Minnesota Twins Experience is currently at the Minnesota State Fair through Monday September 1... the Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am-9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration.

☞ Kody Clemens and Luke Keaschall are planning to visit the fair tomorrow afternoon.

- ☞ Making his 18th appearance (17th start) of the season and 48th career appearance (46th start)... second career start against the Blue Jays.
- ☞ In his last start in the majors on July 28 vs. Boston, he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4, walk-off victory...allowed three runs on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.2 innings.
- ☞ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List on August 4 (retroactive to August 1) with an illness... pitched two games on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints on August 15 and 21 where he posted a 5.06 ERA (5.1 IP, 3 ER) with five walks and five strikeouts.
- ☞ In his sole career start against the Blue Jays on May 11, 2024, Woods Richardson did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-10 defeat...allowed five runs on eight hits (2 HR) with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.1 innings.

OVER THE RIVER AND THROUGH THE WOODS: Woods Richardson was placed on the 15-day Injured List on August 4 (retroactive to August 1) with an illness...pitched two games on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints...started on August 15 at Omaha, opposite Stephen Kolek, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 10-2 victory...allowed one hit, one walk and four strikeouts in 2.0 shutout innings of work...walked the leadoff man then retired five in a row, including four-straight strikeouts...appeared as the bulk pitcher on August 21 vs. the Round Rock Express, following Pablo López and Trent Baker...allowed four runs (3 earned) on five hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 3.1 innings.

☞ Was his 38th and 39th career appearances at the Triple-A level, surpassing Louis Varland for second most starts in Saints' franchise history.

KNOCKED THEIR SOX OFF: Last pitched in the majors on July 28 vs. Boston, opposite Richard Fitts, where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 walk-off victory...allowed three runs on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.2 innings...all three runs allowed came on an Alex Bregman home run in the fifth inning, scoring Abraham Toro and Roman Anthony.

☞ Marked his most pitches thrown since his career-high of 107 thrown on April 7 at Kansas City.

SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING NEW, SOMETHING BORROWED, SOMETHING BLUE: Woods Richardson is facing Toronto for the second time in his career...lone start against the Blue Jays was May 11, 2024 where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-10 defeat...allowed five runs on eight hits (2 HR) with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work...at the time, marked his first home runs allowed since September 7, 2023 at the Triple-A level.

THEIR NECK OF THE WOODS: In his career, Sim has gone 5-4 with a 4.14 ERA (113.0 IP, 52 ER), 8.36 K/9, 3.35 BB/9 and 1.04 HR/9 in 23 games (22 starts) at home compared to 5-6 with a 4.46 ERA (111.0 IP, 55 ER), 7.22 K/9, 3.73 BB/9 and 1.38 HR/9 in 24 road games (23 starts).

☞ He is 1-2 in eight games (7 starts) on the road so far this season, posting a 5.30 ERA (35.2 IP, 21 ER) with seven home runs, 21 walks and 31 strikeouts in eight appearances (7 starts) on the road; compared to 4-2 in nine starts at home with a 3.40 ERA (45.0 IP, 17 ER) with five home runs, 14 walks and 38 strikeouts.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 17 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .291/.366/.440 in 141 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .220/.298/.387 in 168 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.6 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 36.3 compared to righties' 91.5 mph and 46.2 percent.

☞ His whiff rate is .1 below his 2024 whiff rate for an average of 22.2 percent (lefties, 19.3 percent; righties, 24.5 percent)...compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

NIGHTMARES: So far this season, Simeon is 2-3 in nine nighttime appearances (8 starts), posting a 5.27 ERA (41.0 IP, 24 ER) with six home runs, 22 walks and 33 strikeouts; compared to 3-1 with a 3.18 ERA (39.2 IP, 14 ER), six home runs, 13 walks and 36 strikeouts in eight daytime starts.

☞ SWR is 15-6 in 24 career night games (23 starts), and has posted a 5.01 ERA, a .260 opponent batting average and a .754 OPS with 15 home runs, 50 walks and 86 strikeouts; compared to 5-4 with a 3.62 ERA, a .238 opponent batting average, a .681 OPS, 15 home runs, 38 walks and 108 strikeouts in 23 day games (22 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

☞ He currently ranks in baseball's seventh percentile in ground ball percentage (32.1), ninth percentile in max exit velocity (115.3) and ninth percentile in barrel percentage (11.1).

☞ Between June 21 and today, SWR decreased his 4-seam fastball hard-hit rate from 60.3 percent to 46.1 percent, a decrease of 14.2, and lowering himself from the second highest hard-hit percentage among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 4-seam fastballs to the 113th highest, dropping 111 spots.
