THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 at Chicago-AL last weekend and 1-2 at Toronto this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game homestand, with the first of three against the Padres through the weekend...after this series, Minnesota will host the White Sox for four games, from Monday-Thursday.
 ☞ Twins are returning home where they are 33-31...their last homestand was August 14-21, where they went 1-6, going 1-3 vs. Detroit and 0-3 vs. the Athletics.

TWINS GO METRE (YARD) FOUR TIMES IN TORONTO BUT FALL: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays on Wednesday night at Rogers Centre by a score of 8-9, losing an 8-6 lead in the eighth inning...Simeon Woods Richardson made his return from the IL (illness) and allowed five runs on five hits in 3.2 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts, while allowing three home runs...Génesis Cabrera (2 R) and Michael Tonkin (1 R) allowed the game-tying and go-ahead runs in the eighth inning...the offense recorded 12 hits, four being home runs, tying their season-high...Brooks Lee (14) and Luke Keaschall (4) each homered, while Byron Buxton (26, 27) hit two homers, including a leadoff shot...for Buck it was the 16th multi-homer game of his career, tying Kent Hrbek for fourth-most in club history (Killebrew - 35, Morneau - 20, Oliva 18).

ONE-NOTHING: Byron Buxton hit his 16th career leadoff home run on Wednesday in Toronto...he has seven leadoff home runs on the season, fourth-most in baseball (Ohtani - 11, Neto - 9, Lindor - 8)...the homer passed Max Kepler and moved him into sole possession of third-most leadoff homers in Twins history (since 1961):

THEY NAMED IT SAAAN DIEAAAAGO: The Twins are playing the Padres for the 30th, 31st and 32nd times in their history this weekend...Minnesota is 19-10 all-time against San Diego...the Twins are 8-5 all-time at Petco Park, 8-2 at Target Field, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium and 1-2 at Metrodome.

☞ These two last met for three games from August 19-21, 2024 at Petco Park as the Padres won games one and two, while the Twins salvaged the third game with an 11-4 victory.
 ☞ Target Field last hosted the Padres for three games from May 9-11, 2023, taking two of three.
 ☞ Twins are 16-7 against the Padres in their last 23 games, dating back to June of 2008.

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins have gone 16-23 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13), 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20), 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23) and 1-2 vs. Washington (July 25-27).
 ☞ After this series, the Twins have two NL teams still to play: D-Backs (September 12-14) and Phillies (September 26-28).

HE'S OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: In his last 29 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .327 (37-for-113) with five doubles, three triples, 10 home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.058 OPS...below are Buxton's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

FOREST RAKE: Matt Wallner has hit safely in five-straight games, two short of his season-long of seven, done from April 13-June 5...over the five games, Wallner has gone 6-for-21 (.286) with four home runs, seven RBI, an .857 slugging percentage and a 1.205 OPS.
 ☞ Since July 1, he has homered 13 times in 42 games, tied for 12th-most home runs in the AL since that date.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Tonight marks the 27th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 8-18 against lefty starters...they have lost their last five games vs. a left-handed starter, including their last try on Wednesday at Toronto (Eric Lauer)...their last win against a lefty starter was a 5-4 victory on August 3 at Cleveland over Joey Cantillo.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .392 (20-for-51) with a 1.043 OPS in his last 31 games vs. lefties.
 ☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .310 (27-for-87) with an .815 OPS in his last 47 games vs. lefties.
 ☞ Matt Wallner has posted a .902 OPS in his last 26 games against left-handed pitching...he has 14 hits against lefties this season...he entered 2025 with 14 career hits off lefties, from 2022-24...had a .510 OPS vs. LHP entering 2025, but has a .780 OPS in 2025.
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .329 (23-for-70) with a 1.167 OPS over his last 39 games vs. lefties.

GAMES GONE BYRON: Byron Buxton played in his 100th game of the season on Wednesday night, marking the second consecutive season in which he has reached the 100 games played mark (102 in 2024) and third time in career (140 in 2017).
 ☞ Over his last 162 games, Buck is hitting .280 (171-for-610) with 34 doubles, five triples, 42 home runs, 105 RBI, 122 runs scored, 24 stolen bases, a .341 on-base percentage, a .559 slugging percentage and a .900 OPS.

FESTA REHAB: Right-handed pitcher David Festa made his first rehab start last night for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo, pitching 2.2 scoreless innings, with no hits allowed, three walks and five strikeouts, while throwing 48 pitches...Festa was placed on the IL on July 23 with right shoulder inflammation.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Minnesota Twins Experience is currently at the Minnesota State Fair through Monday September 1...the Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am-9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration.

☞ Kody Clemens and Luke Keaschall visited the fair yesterday...they went on the giant slide, ate cheese curds, fried alligator, giant pork chops, etc...Clemens was mistaken for Vikings WR Adam Thielen...a fan approached Kody, extended for a handshake and said, "welcome back, Adam!"...Kody then later saw a fair-goer with a Thielen jersey on and asked if he could take a picture with him — and did.

KNOCK THEIR SOX OFF: Last pitched on August 22 at Chicago-AL, opposite Aaron Civale...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 9-7 victory...allowed four runs on a season-high-tying eight hits (1 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings...permitted an RBI single to Lenyn Sosa in the first, an RBI single to Edgar Quero in the fourth and a two-run shot to Colson Montgomery in the fifth, before being replaced by Kody Funderburk.

☞ Has allowed nine walks so far in the month of August, including seven in his last two games...marks his most walks allowed in a single month in his career.

MOTOWN MATTHEWS: Pitched on August 16 vs. Detroit, opposite Casey Mize...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-8 defeat...allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with a career-high four walks and six strikeouts in 4.0 innings...permitted an RBI single to Spencer Torkelson in the first, scoring Colt Keith, and a solo home run to Kerry Carpenter in the third.

☞ Marked his shortest outing since July 19 when he threw 4.0 innings at Colorado.
☞ Just 51 of Zebby's 92 pitches thrown were strikes, for a rate of 55.4 percent, a career low.

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 110 strikeouts through his first 20 career major league games, the most in Twins history (1961)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 20 career games:

☞ Matthews' 67 strikeouts so far in 2025 are the second most by a Twins pitcher in their first 11 games this season, behind Joe Ryan (72).

☞ Became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to reach 100 strikeouts in his first 18 career games.

SEEING SAN DIEGO: Matthews is facing the Padres for the second time in his career...his lone start against the Padres was on August 19, 2024, where he was dealt his first career loss in Minnesota's 3-5 defeat...allowed five runs (2 earned) on four hits, with two walks and a career-low one strikeout in 5.0 innings of work...was his second career game and first on the road.

☞ Is his only major league outing in which he has fanned less than four batters.

TWO-OUT TRAFFIC: Here are Matthews' career opponent batting numbers with zero, one and two outs:

☞ With two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents have gone 10-for-43 (.233) with two doubles, one home run, four walks, 15 RBI and 13 strikeouts.

☞ Four of his eight hits allowed in his start against the White Sox came with two outs.

HOME SWEET HOME: Zebby has gone 2-3 with an 7.12 ERA (36.2 IP, 29 ER), 10 walks, 53 strikeouts and a .319 (51-for-160) opponent batting average in nine career major league starts at home; compared to 2-5, 5.03 ERA (53.2 IP, 30 ER) with 19 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .283 (62-for-219) opponent batting average in 11 career major league starts on the road.

☞ In four major league starts at home this season, Matthews has gone 1-1, posting a 4.42 ERA (18.1 IP, 9 ER) with five walks, 26 strikeouts and a .270 (20-for-74) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through his first 11 major league starts this season, left-handed hitters have slashed .286/.347/.500 in 112 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties have slashed .291/.336/.427 in 103 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 89.2 mph and a whiff rate of 31.4 compared to righties' 89.8 mph and 27.3 percent.

☞ His hard-hit rate against lefties is 40.0 percent, compared to 44.9 percent in 2024; and his hard-hit rate against righties is 41.3 percent, compared to 38.5 percent in 2024.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 40% of the time...primarily uses his sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring is changeup and cutter against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown:

☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 sliders, Zebby ranks fourth in strikeout percentage at 47.6 percent and tied for 30th in opponent batting average (.165).

☞ Holds the second-highest average fastball velocity among all Twins starters this season at 95.4 mph, trailing Mick Abel (96.1).

☞ His 11.45 SO/9 leads Twins starters...followed by Joe Ryan (10.09), Pablo López (9.05), David Festa (8.94) and Simeon Woods Richardson (7.58).
