YOU READ MY NEWS!: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Chicago-AL and 1-2 at Toronto), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a win over the Padres last night...tonight, they will play the second of three against San Diego at Target Field...Minnesota will play the finale against the Padres tomorrow afternoon, then host the White Sox for four games, from Monday-Thursday.

DON'T ACT LIKE YOU'RE NOT IMPRESSED: The Twins beat the Padres last night at Target Field by a score of 7-4...Zebby Matthews (4-4) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs (2 earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...Kody Funderburk recorded his second career save and first of the season with a scoreless ninth inning...the offense recorded 12 hits and drew seven walks, compared to just four strikeouts...Austin Martin reached base four times with a single, a double and two walks...Trevor Larnach recorded three hits, all off lefties...Royce Lewis hit his ninth home run and second at Target Field.

STAY CLASSY SAN DIEGO: The Twins are playing the Padres for the 30th, 31st and 32nd times in their history this weekend...Minnesota is 20-10 all-time against San Diego...the Twins are 10-4 all-time in Minnesota (9-2 at Target Field, 1-2 at Metrodome) and 10-6 all-time in San Diego (8-5 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium).

☞ Minnesota's .667 winning percentage all-time against San Diego is their best against any opponent.

☞ Twins are 17-7 against the Padres in their last 24 games, dating back to June of 2008.

☞ Edouard Julien has five hits in eight career at-bats against the Padres, including one walk.

THAT'S HOW I(L) ROLL: Twins have gone 17-23 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13), 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20), 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23), 1-2 vs. Washington (July 25-27) and 1-0 vs. San Diego.

☞ After this series, the Twins have two NL teams still to play: D-Backs (September 12-14) and Phillies (September 26-28).

☞ In his last 30 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .322 (38-for-118) with five doubles, three triples, 10 home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.031 OPS.

MADE WITH BITS OF REAL PANTHER, SO YOU KNOW IT'S GOOD: Matt Wallner has hit safely in six-straight games, one short of his season-long of seven, done from April 13-June 5...his career-high is eight, from August 4-13, 2024...over the current six-game stretch, Wallner has gone 7-for-25 (.280) with four home runs, seven RBI, a .760 slugging percentage and a 1.117 OPS.

60% OF THE TIME IT WORKS EVERY TIME: A win tonight and Minnesota will earn their 17th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 16-25-2 in series play, going 10-9-2 at home and 6-16-0 on the road...Twins are looking to win their first series since August 8-10 vs. Kansas City at Target Field and snap a five series loss streak.

☞ Twins last series win over the Padres was May 9-11, 2023 at Target Field, taking two of three...they lost their last try from August 19-21, 2024 at Petco Park, losing two of three.

☞ They have gone 5-8-0 in series play against NL opponents this season.

I BELIEVE IT'S JOGGING OR YOGGING, IT MIGHT BE A SOFT 'J': The Twins have stolen 10 bases in their last three games and have gone 14-for-15 in stolen base attempts in their last eight games...they have 21 steals this month (6 caught), their most of any month this season and tied for seventh-most in baseball for August...they had two in March, 16 in April, 13 in May, nine in June and 15 in July...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 76 this season.

☞ Last night, Buxton stole third base for the first time in his career and it made him 21-for-21 in stolen base attempts this season...he has gone 27-for-his-last-27 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen).

☞ Last night, he became the seventh different Twin (8th different time) to reach the 20/20 mark...list in right margin above.

☞ Became the fifth player in AL/NL history with 20-plus home runs, 20-plus steals and no caught stealings, joining Kevin McReynolds (1988), Chase Utley (2009), Trea Turner (2023) and Trevor Story (2025).

HEY EVERYONE! COME AND SEE HOW GOOD I LUKE!: Despite going 0-for-4 last night, Luke Keaschall drew a walk, extending his on-base streak to 14 games...has now reached safely in 26 of 28 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .415 on the season, reaching base 44 times (33 hits, 14 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch) in 118 plate appearances...he leads all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage (minimum of 100 plate appearances).

I'M A MAN WHO DISCOVERED THE WHEEL AND BUILT THE EIFFEL TOWER OUT OF METAL AND BRAWN: The first 10,000 fans through the gates tonight will receive a Joe Mauer Replica Statue presented by Delta Air Lines.

I'M KIND OF A BIG DEAL, PEOPLE KNOW ME: On this day in 1987, Kirby Puckett set a club record with six hits at Milwaukee, recording two home runs, two doubles and two singles...Puckett tied his own record May 23, 1991 in 11 innings vs. Texas...in 2007, the Twins held a ceremony to break ground on Target Field...Target Field's first official game was on April 12, 2010 vs. Boston (5-4 win).

THIS BURRITO IS GOOD, BUT IT IS FILLING: The Minnesota Twins Experience is currently at the Minnesota State Fair through Monday September 1...the Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am-9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration.

LAST TIME OUT (MLB): Took the loss in his last start on August 24 at Rate Field in Chicago, opposite Yoendrys Gómez, in Minnesota's 0-8 shutout loss...allowed seven runs on nine hits (1 HR), with one walk and one strikeout over 5.0 innings of work...tied career high in hits allowed and tied season high in runs...gave up four consecutive singles to start a three-run first inning (5 total base hits in the inn.)...in the second, allowed an RBI single to Kyle Teel, a run-scoring groundout to Luis Robert Jr. and a two-run home run to Colson Montgomery...faced the minimum from the third-fifth innings. ☞ Prior to the game, he had not allowed a first-inning run in nine-straight starts, tying his career-best streak, done from June 8-July 31, 2024.

TWO STARTS AGO (MINORS): Last started for the Saints on August 17 at Omaha but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 11-12 defeat...allowed five runs on five hits (2 HR) over 3.2 innings, with two walks and eight strikeouts...gave up a solo home run in the first inning...in the second, hit a batter, walked two and allowed three doubles, shrinking the Saints' 5-1 lead to 5-4...gave up his second solo home run of the day in the fourth inning before exiting the game...eight strikeouts were his most in a professional outing since fanning 10 on June 1 in Houston. ☞ In three starts with Triple-A St. Paul, went 0-0 and posted a 7.53 ERA (14.1 IP, 12 ER), with four home runs allowed, 18 strikeouts and two walks.

FRIAR FRUSTRATIONS: Lone career start against San Diego came on August 30, 2024 at Tropicana Field...took the loss in the Rays' 5-13 defeat...allowed eight runs on eight hits, including a three-run home run to Manny Machado, with two walks and two strikeouts over 2.1 innings of work. ☞ In five career starts against the National League West, is 1-2 with a 9.25 ERA (24.1 IP, 25 ER), five walks and 19 strikeouts...NL West batters are hitting .333 (34-for-102) with six doubles and eight home runs.

☞ In 19 career Interleague starts, is 5-7 with a 5.34 ERA (97.2 IP, 58 ER), 33 walks and 106 strikeouts...National League batters are hitting .258 (98-for-380) with 21 doubles and 17 home runs.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 11 major league home games this season, is 4-3 with a 5.43 ERA (56.1 IP, 34 ER), 20 walks and 47 strikeouts, compared to 2-4 with a 4.50 ERA (60.0 IP, 30 ER), 25 walks and 49 strikeouts in 11 away games...in 34 career home games, is 11-14 with a 4.90 ERA (180.0 IP, 98 ER), 57 walks and 201 strikeouts.

☞ At home this season, has posted a .262 (56-for-214) opponent batting average and a 1.35 WHIP while allowing eight doubles, one triple and nine home runs. ☞ In three career starts at Target Field as a visitor, including on July 5, went 0-0 with a 4.96 ERA (16.1 IP, 9 ER), three home runs allowed, six walks and 15 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed batters have slashed .241/.329/.420 with nine doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 34 RBI and a 1.74 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 212 at-bats against Bradley...right-handed batters have slashed .248/.306/.348 with eight doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI and a 2.72 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 230 at-bats against Bradley.

☞ In his careers, lefties have slashed .241/.315/.413 with a 2.81 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties have slashed .247/.307/.440 with a 3.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Bradley.

TWO-OUT TITAN: Among pitchers with 20-or-more starts this season, Bradley's .167 (21-for-126) opponent batting average with two outs ranks third, behind Carlos Rodón (.154) and Framber Valdez (.165)...under those same criteria, his .189 BABIP ranks first, his .228 opponent on-base percentage ranks fifth and his .545 OPS ranks seventh...also, his nine walks allowed with two outs are tied for the eighth fewest.

THE ARSENAL: Through 23 starts in 2025, Bradley has relied on a four pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

☞ This season (1876 pitches), his chase rate is 26.1 percent and his whiff rate is 22.2 percent...his walk rate is 9.1 and his strikeout rate is 19.4 percent...his average exit velocity is 89.3 mph and his hard-hit rate is 39.6 percent.

☞ In his last outing on August 24, he averaged 91.1 mph on all of his pitches, his fourth lowest mark in any outing this season and his lowest since June 29 when he averaged 90.0 mph...his four-seam fastball averaged 95.7 mph; seven of his nine starts this season in which his four-seamer has averaged below 96.0 mph have come since June 7.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 12-7, 3.22 ERA // CAREER: 45-33, 3.76 ERA)
