THE TWINS: Have gone 1-1 through two games on their seven-game homestand, winning game one against the Padres on Friday night, followed by a loss last night...today, they will play the three-game series finale against San Diego...starting tomorrow afternoon, Minnesota will begin a four-game series with the White Sox at Target Field through Thursday.

WE WILL, WE WILL, ROKU!: Today's game will be streamed live and free on The Roku Channel, as part of Major League Baseball's Sunday Leadoff deal with Roku...Minnesota's last Roku game was on August 10 vs. Kansas City as the Twins won 5-3 in 11 innings on a walk-off, two-run homer by Luke Keaschall.

THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY: The Twins lost to the Padres last night at Target Field by a score of 12-3, as the pitching staff allowed 11 runs to score from innings 6-8...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on one hit, with three walks and six strikeouts...the bullpen (Mick Abel, Brooks Kriske and Génesis Cabrera) combined to allow 11 runs on 13 hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded six hits, two apiece from Trevor Larnach and James Outman...Byron Buxton hit his 28th home run of the season, driving in two of Minnesota's runs.

STAY CLASSY SAN DIEGO: The Twins are playing the Padres for the 32nd time in their history today...Minnesota is 20-11 all-time against San Diego...the Twins are 10-5 all-time in Minnesota (9-3 at Target Field, 1-2 at Metrodome) and 10-6 all-time in San Diego (8-5 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium).

Edouard Julien has five hits in nine career at-bats (.556) against the Padres, including one walk. Trevor Larnach has nine hits in 16 career at-bats (.563) against the Padres, including one walk and four RBI.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: A win today and Minnesota will earn their 17th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 16-25-2 in series play, going 10-9-2 at home and 6-16-0 on the road...Twins are looking to win their first series since August 8-10 vs. Kansas City at Target Field and snap a five series loss streak. Twins last series win over the Padres was May 9-11, 2023 at Target Field, taking two of three...they lost their last try from August 19-21, 2024 at Petco Park, losing two of three. They have gone 5-8-0 in series play against NL opponents this season.

FOUR-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton's home run last night gave him 161 for his career, tying Max Kepler for 12th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961).

ALSO: Last night was Buck's 28th of the season, tying his single-season career-high, previously done in 2022...he is on pace to finish with 33 home runs on the season.

DISCOUNT BASES: The Twins have stolen 12 bases in their last four games and have gone 16-for-17 in stolen base attempts in their last nine games...they have 23 steals this month (6 caught), their most of any month this season, seventh-most in baseball for August...they stole two in March, 16 in April, 13 in May, nine in June and 15 in July...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 78 this season.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris as their minor league Pitcher of the Week, and have named Double-A outfielder Kala'i Rosario and Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez as co-Players of the Week.

Morris, 23, made one appearance in relief on Thursday at Toledo, allowing one run on one hit in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a season-high tying eight strikeouts...the New York, NY native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2022 MLB Draft and is ranked by MLB.com as the club's 21st-best prospect. Rosario, 23, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .333 (9-for-27) with three doubles, one triple, three home runs and 10 RBI...the Papaikou, HI native was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Waiakea High School. Gonzalez, 21, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .333 (8-for-24) with three home runs, eight RBI, a .708 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS...the Carupano, VZ native was acquired by the Twins from Seattle in the Jorge Polanco trade of January, 2024...he is ranked as the club's 10th-best prospect by MLB.com.

PABLO DAY: Right-handed pitcher Pablo López will be making his third start on his current rehab assignment tonight for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo with first pitch at 5:05 pm (CT)...in his previous two rehab starts combined, he has allowed four runs on 10 hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...he was placed on the IL on June 4 with a right shoulder strain.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his seventh loss of the season on August 25 at Toronto, opposite Max Scherzer, in Minnesota's 4-10 loss...has lost back-to-back starts for the fifth time in his career and the first time since June 1-7, 2024...allowed a season-high-tying six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...gave up four runs in the first inning on two singles, a double and a two-run home run by Alejandro Kirk...other runs scored on a second-inning solo shot by Andrés Giménez and a fourth-inning RBI single by George Springer.

☞ Became the third pitcher in baseball this season to strike out four-or-more batters in each of their first 26 games of the season (also Sonny Gray and Garrett Crochet)...his 99 career games with four-or-more strikeouts rank 15th in Twins history, behind Kevin Tapani (100 games).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on August 19 vs. the Athletics, opposite Jacob Lopez, in Minnesota's 3-6 defeat...allowed five runs on a seven hits (1 HR) in 4.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...4.0 innings were his fewest in any outing since his injury-shortened 2.0 IP outing on August 7, 2024; marked just the 12th time in his career working 4.0-or-fewer innings...after allowing a leadoff double to Nick Kurtz, retired the next eight batters in order...walked Kurtz with two outs in the third, followed by a home run to Shea Langeliers...in the fourth, allowed three runs on three singles, two doubles and a sacrifice fly.

FACING THE FRIARS: Is making his second career start against the Padres and his first at Target Field...took the loss in his lone start on July 29, 2022 at Petco Park, a 1-10 Twins defeat...allowed a career-high 10 runs on eight hits, including a career-high five homers, with two walks and seven strikeouts over 4.2 innings.

☞ In 10 career starts against the National League West, is 5-3 with a 5.89 ERA (55.0 IP, 36 ER), 12 walks, 59 strikeouts and a .271 opponent batting average...in two starts against the NL West this season, is 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER), no walks, 18 strikeouts and a .159 (7-for-44) opponent batting average.

BACK JOE'EM AGAIN: In 13 home games (12 starts) this season, is 6-4 with a 3.50 ERA (69.1 IP, 27 ER), eight home runs allowed, 16 walks and 86 strikeouts, compared to 6-3 with a 2.97 ERA (78.2 IP, 26 ER), 11 home runs allowed, 13 walks and 80 strikeouts in 13 road starts...in 56 career home appearances (55 starts), is 25-16 with a 3.67 ERA, a 5.04 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .212 opponent batting average.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .239/.288/.415 with 15 doubles, 11 home runs, 14 walks and 68 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .186/.246/.316 with 11 doubles, eight home runs, 15 walks and 98 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .214/.273/.375 with 76 walks and 277 strikeouts (3.64 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .227/.273/.422 with 62 walks and 414 strikeouts (6.68 K/BB).

☞ His .186 BAA against righties ranks fourth among all qualified pitchers in baseball this season...among the same pitchers, his 6.53 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks fifth and his .562 opponent OPS vs. righties ranks 10th.

THE ARSENAL: Through 26 appearances (25 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

☞ This season (2371 pitches), his chase rate is 25.4 percent and his whiff rate is 26.1 percent...his 4.9 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 94th percentile and his 28.3 percent strikeout rate ranks in the 86th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.5 mph and his hard-hit rate is 42.5 percent.

☞ His overall pitching run value of 14 ranks in baseball's 89th percentile.
 ☞ His fastball run value of 15 ranks in baseball's 95th percentile...his 93 strikeouts via the four-seamer are tied for the most in the majors with San Francisco's Robbie Ray.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2025: 4-7, 5.14 ERA // CAREER: 29-28, 4.04 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's Labor Day matchup against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field...had no part in the decision in his last start on August 26 at Toronto, a 7-5 Twins win...allowed four runs on 10 hits (2 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts...due to face the White Sox for the second time this season; earned the win in his prior start on April 22 at Target Field, tossing a quality start with 6.0 innings pitched, eight hits, one run, one walk and six strikeouts...career 6-2, 3.43 ERA (76.0 IP, 29 ER) with 14 walks and 78 strikeouts in 14 starts against Chicago-AL.

- In 2025, made first career MLB All-Star Game appearance, throwing a 10-pitch perfect fourth inning with two strikeouts (SD Manny Machado and CHC Kyle Tucker).
- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive year in the Twins' season-opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
