THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their seven-game homestand, winning a three-game series against the Padres over the weekend, taking games one and three...today, they will continue the homestand with the first of four against the White Sox through Thursday.

YOU STAY CLASSY SAN DIEGO: The Twins beat the Padres yesterday afternoon at Target Field, winning by a score of 7-2...Joe Ryan (13-7) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with five hits, one walk and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Byron Buxton and Royce Lewis...Buck drove in two runs on a two-run homer in the third inning, his 29th of the season, a new single-season best...Lewis also recorded two RBI on the day...twins went 5-for-12 with RISP.

SEPTEMBER EXPANSION: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams, Noah Davis and outfielder DaShawn Keirsej Jr. from Triple-A St. Paul as part of September roster expansion. Adams, who will be making his fifth stint with the Twins in 2025, appeared in eight games (2 starts) for Minnesota earlier this season, going 1-2 with a 7.71 ERA (23.1 IP, 20 ER), 12 walks and 21 strikeouts...in 23 games (5 starts) for the Saints this season, he has gone 4-4 with a 3.93 ERA (68.2 IP, 30 ER), 23 walks and 64 strikeouts.

Davis, who will be making his second stint with the Twins this season after being acquired from Los Angeles-NL on July 14, appeared in two games for Minnesota between July 30 and August 4, going 0-1 and allowing five runs on six hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 3.0 innings...he also went 1-0 with a 3.97 ERA (11.1 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, seven walks and 11 strikeouts in 10 relief appearances for the Saints since joining the organization.

Keirsej Jr., who will be making his third stint with the Twins in 2025, played in 67 games for Minnesota earlier this season, hitting .110 (9-for-82) with two home runs, six RBI, 10 runs scored and eight stolen bases...in 29 games for the Saints this season, he has hit .257 (29-for-113) with eight doubles, three triples, three home runs, 20 RBI, 21 runs scored, 12 walks, four stolen bases and a .796 OPS.

Additionally, to make room for Davis on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned right-handed pitcher Mick Abel to St. Paul after yesterday's game against San Diego...Abel was recalled on August 23 and pitched in two games for the Twins, including one start, allowing 12 runs (1 earned) on 14 hits (1 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work.

FOUR-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton's home run yesterday gave him 162 for his career, passing Max Kepler and tying Miguel Sanó for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

ADDITIONALLY: The homer set a new single-season career-high, passing his previous total of 28, done in 2022...he is on pace to finish with 34 home runs on the season.

WINDY CITY MEETS TWIN CITIES: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the 10th of 13 scheduled games in 2025...Twins have gone 5-4 this season (2-1 at Target Field and 3-3 at Rate Field).

These two last played a three-game series in Chicago to begin their last roadtrip as Minnesota won game one but dropped games two and three.

Twins last hosted the Sox at Target Field for three games from April 22-24 as Minnesota won the first two games and dropped game three.

Twins have gone 14-1 against the Sox at Target Field, dating back to April 11, 2023...they won 14-straight until the three-game series finale earlier this season on April 24.

Minnesota has gone 24-6 in its last 30 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-74 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .361 (30-for-83) with a .992 OPS in 25 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 25-straight starts against CWS.

Matt Wallner is hitting .316 (24-for-76) with five doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.024 OPS in 26 career games against the White Sox.

Royce Lewis is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with six home runs, 19 RBI, 10 walks, a .522 on-base percentage, a .917 slugging percentage and a 1.438 OPS in 10 career games vs. the White Sox.

Byron Buxton is hitting .327 (52-for-159) with a .717 slugging percentage and a 1.119 OPS in his last 45 games against the White Sox...Buxton's 23 career home runs and 54 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.

BUCK PRODUCTIONS: Byron Buxton has driven in two runs in each of the last four games, marking a career-high for a multi-RBI streak...the last Twin with multiple RBI in four-straight was Ryan Doumit, who did it in four-straight from May 27-30, 2013...the club record is five-straight, held by Paul Molitor (July 23-27, 1996) and Harmon Killebrew (July 13-18, 1962).

At 29 home runs and 21 stolen bases, one more home run and he will join Kirby Puckett (1986 - 31 HR, 20 SB) as the only players in club history with a 30/20 season.

GRAND THEFT: The Twins have stolen 12 bases in their last five games and have gone 16-for-17 in stolen base attempts in their last 10 games...they had 23 steals in August (6 caught), their most of any month this season, seventh-most in baseball for August...they stole two in March, 16 in April, 13 in May, nine in June and 15 in July...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 78 this season.

PABLO DAY: Right-handed pitcher Pablo López made his third start on his current rehab assignment last night for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo, pitching 5.2 scoreless innings, with four hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts...he was placed on the IL on June 4 with a right shoulder strain.

DOING MAJOR WORK ON LABOR DAY: The Twins are 45-26 on Labor Day since 1961, including a 21-13 record at home and 24-13 record on the road...the Twins have won five of their last six Labor Day games and are 8-4 in their last 12...last season, they beat the Rays at Tropicana Field, by a score of 5-4.

BIRDS ON THE BRAIN: Last pitched on August 26 at Toronto, opposite Chris Bassitt; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-5 victory...allowed four runs on 10 hits (2 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...allowed a sacrifice fly to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and an RBI single to Alejandro Kirk in the first, a solo homer to George Springer in the second, and a solo homer to Springer in the fifth...his second longball to Springer marked his 100th career home run allowed.

- ☞ Became the only pitcher in baseball with 120-or-fewer innings pitched and 25-or-more home runs allowed this season.
- ☞ Is one of five pitchers to have eight-plus multi-homer games this season; also, Seth Lugo (10), Jake Irvin (9), Tyler Anderson (8) and Ryan Pepiot (8)...is the only one of those five to have done so in less than 25 games.

A-MINUS: Pitched on August 20 vs. the Athletics, opposite J.T. Ginn; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-4, 10-inning defeat...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and a season-high-tying seven strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work...has allowed a home run in nine of his last 10 starts...allowed a sacrifice fly to Darelle Hernaiz in the second and a solo home run to Tyler Soderstrom in the fourth...was pulled in the sixth with two outs and replaced by Kody Funderburk.

- ☞ Generated a season-high-tying 18 total swing and misses for a whiff rate of 40.0 percent, a new season high (18 whiffs, 36.0 percent, May 3 at Boston).

ROCK 'EM SOCK 'EM: Ober is 6-2 in 14 career starts against Chicago-AL (his most starts against any opponent)...has posted a 3.43 ERA (76.0 IP, 29 ER) with 14 walks, 78 strikeouts and a .216 (61-for-282) opponent batting average...last faced the White Sox on April 22 where he earned the win in Minnesota's 4-2 victory...allowed one run on eight hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings of work.

- ☞ Ober is undefeated against the White Sox at Target Field...has gone 4-0 in eight starts, posting a 1.97 ERA (45.2 IP, 10 ER), with nine walks, 52 strikeouts and a .210 (35-for-167) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Made his MLB debut against the White Sox on May 18, 2021 at Target Field where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4, walk-off victory...allowed four runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Ober has gone 16-13 with a 4.06 ERA (299.1 IP, 135 ER), 8.99 K/9, 2.16 BB/9 and 1.68 HR/9 in 57 games (56 starts) at home compared to 13-16 with a 4.14 ERA (295.1 IP, 136 ER), 8.69 K/9, 1.71 BB/9 and 1.46 HR/9 in 55 road starts.

- ☞ Ober is 2-4, 4.46 ERA (66.2 IP, 33 ER) with 14 home runs, 14 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .247 (63-for-255) opponent batting average in 12 home starts this season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 22 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .289/.319/.520 in 246 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .277/.320/.506 in 231 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 20.8 compared to righties' 92.1 mph and 27.3 percent.

- ☞ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 30.4 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 51.6 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 37.7% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ His 7.4 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 98th percentile...he ranks in the bottom one percentile in breaking run value (-14) and bottom fourth percentile in pitching run value (-18).
- ☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 sliders, Bailey has the second highest opponent batting average (.315) and slugging percentage (.565), 12th highest hard hit percentage (45.6) and sixth lowest strikeout percentage (13.0).
- ☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 curveballs, Bailey has the second highest opponent batting average (.600) and the highest slugging percentage (1.400)...recorded his first strikeout off his curveball in his start against the Athletics on August 20.

THRILL OF THE CHASE: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 33.6 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 93rd percentile; ranks first on the Twins pitching staff, followed by Pablo López (32.3), David Festa (29.8) and Justin Topa (29.7).
