**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-3 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Kansas City, followed by a split of the first two games in Anaheim...today, they will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Angel Stadium...after the game, they will travel home to spend an off-day on Thursday...on Friday night, Minnesota will begin their final homestand of the season with a three-game series against the Diamondbacks...after that, they will host the Yankees for three games (Monday-Wednesday) and the Guardians for four games (Friday-Sunday) — which includes a doubleheader on Saturday, the 20th.

**THE PROFESSOR HOLDS NIGHT CLASS FOR TWINS:** The Twins lost to Kyle Hendricks and the Angels last night by a score of 12-2...the defeat snapped a six-game winning streak for the Twins over the Halos...Zebby Matthews (4-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...Twins batters recorded six hits, two from Byron Buxton — both singles...Ryan Fitzgerald hit a two-run homer as the pitcher, becoming the first to accomplish that feat since catcher Chris Gimenez homered as a pitcher on September 2, 2018 at Texas...the last actual Twins pitcher to homer was Jim Kaat on June 11, 1972 at Cleveland.

**L.A. FINALE:** The Twins and Angels are playing for the sixth and final time in 2025...these two are scheduled to play seven times in 2026 with three games at Target Field, from July 10-12 and four games at Angel Stadium, from September 17-20.

☞ Minnesota has gone 10-2 in their last 12 against the Angels, dating back to September of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +43 (94-51).

☞ Since the start of last season, the Twins are hitting .309 (119-for-385) with 7.7 runs-per-game and an .897 OPS in 11 games against Los Angeles-AL.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with nine RBI, seven walks and a .975 OPS in his last nine games against the Angels.

**FOUR POINT BUCK:** Byron Buxton enters today's game with 163 career home runs, tied with Tom Brunansky for 10th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

**NOTE:** Buxton has a 14.10 at-bat-per-home run ratio, fifth-best in the AL, trailing Cal Raleigh (10.06), Aaron Judge (10.98), Junior Caminero (13.27) and Jo Adell (13.40).

**GRAND THEFT:** Since August 12, the Twins have stolen 34 bases in 40 attempts, second-most in baseball, trailing New York-NL (37)...they already have 91 this season, their most under a Rocco Baldelli-led team (since 2019)...they have 24 steals in their last 13 games; below are the game-by-game stolen bases over the last 13 games:

**NOTHING RUNS LIKE A DEER BUCK:** Byron Buxton stole his 22nd base last night making him 22-for-22 in stolen base attempts this season...he has gone 28-for-his-last-28 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen)...Buxton and Trevor Story (28-for-28) are the only two players in baseball yet to be caught stealing (min. 20 steals)...last night marked the 115th of his career...he is now one away from tying Dan Gladden for sixth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

**BY(RON) THE WAY:** Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (14-for-42) with three doubles, three triples, five home runs, 12 RBI, a .905 slugging percentage and a 1.274 OPS in his last 11 games.

☞ With two hits last night, Buck now has 116 on the season, one short of his single-season career-high of 117, done in 2017.

☞ Over his last 162 games, Buck is hitting .285 (174-for-610) with 37 doubles, eight triples, 44 home runs, 109 RBI, 124 runs scored, 26 stolen bases, a .344 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a .932 OPS.

**AUSTIN MARTIN. INTENSITY. DRIVEN.:** Over his last 14 games, Austin Martin has reached base 26 times (16 hits, 10 walks) in 50 plate appearances for an on-base percentage of .531 in that span...over those 14 games, his batting average is .410 (16-for-39) with three doubles, 10 runs scored, just six strikeouts and a 1.018 OPS.

**TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD):** Twins need a win today to secure their 18th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 17-27-2 in series play, going 11-10-2 at home and 6-17-0 on the road.

☞ Twins have won four-straight series over the Angels, dating back to September of 2023.

☞ Twins have won just one Series (August 29-31 vs. SD) in their last eight tries (chart in right margin).

☞ Minnesota's last road series win was August 4-6, taking two of three at Detroit.

☞ Twins have gone 6-11 in rubber games this season...they won their last rubber match on August 31 vs. San Diego...their last defeat was August 27 at Toronto.

**OH LDER AND WISER:** Right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl is celebrating his 26th birthday today...he has never appeared in a professional game on his birthday.

**FALL BALL:** Major League Baseball announced the rosters for the 2025 Arizona Fall League (AFL) season today...the season begins with AFL Opening Night on October 6, as the Peoria Javelinas take on the Scottsdale Scorpions at Scottsdale Stadium...Twins minor leaguers will play for the Peoria Javelinas this season...players represented will include: RHP Miguel Boadas, RHP Jakob Hall, RHP Hunter Hoopes, RHP Dylan Questad, LHP Zander Sechrist, INF Billy Amick, INF Brandon Winokur and OF Hendry Mendez...also representing the Twins will be hitting coach Danny Marcuzzo and athletic trainer Taylor Carpenter.

**PALM TREES AND PLOUFFE:** Hometown hero Trevor Plouffe homered in his second career game at Angel Stadium on September 2, 2011, a solo shot off Tyler Chatwood...it was the first of three home runs in this ballpark, the other two came in back-to-back games here on July 23, 2015 (off Garrett Richards) and June 13, 2016 (off Jered Weaver).

- ⚔ Last started on September 4 vs. the White Sox but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-11 loss...allowed four runs on eight hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings.
- ⚔ Lone career start against the Angels came on September 19, 2023 at Tropicana Field where he did not factor into the decision of Tampa Bay's 6-2 win...allowed one run on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work.
- ⚔ In 11 road starts this season, is 2-4 with a 4.50 ERA (60.0 IP, 30 ER), 25 walks and 49 strikeouts.
- ⚔ Is seeking his first MLB win since July 18...his team has not won one of his starts since July 18.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last started on September 4 vs. the White Sox, opposite Fraser Ellard and Chicago's bullpen, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-11 loss; game was delayed 90 minutes prior to the start due to rain...allowed four runs on eight hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings...in the third inning, allowed a one-out double to Edgar Quero, who scored on Kyle Teel's single, then allowed a two-run double to Curtis Mead...Teel started the fifth with a ground-rule double, scoring on Colson Montgomery's sacrifice fly.

- ⚔ Extended his career-high streak of allowing a walk to 23-straight games (previous high was 15-straight done in 2024)...is tied for the fourth-longest streak in the majors this season.
- ⚔ Tied his single-outing career high with four doubles allowed; also did so on July 2, 2023 at Seattle and August 7, 2024 at St. Louis.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on August 30 vs. the Padres, opposite Nick Pivetta, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-12 loss...allowed one run on one hit, a solo home run by Elias Diaz in the fifth inning, with three walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...retired nine straight batters from the second-fifth innings...marked the third one-hit outing of his career and his first since July 20, 2024 at Yankee Stadium...has now struck out five-or-more batters in all but two of his 20 career one-run starts, and has struck out four-or-more in all 20.

**FACING THE ANGELS:** Is facing the Angels for the second time in his career and the first time at Angel Stadium...lone career start came on September 19, 2023 at Tropicana Field where he did not factor into the decision of Tampa Bay's 6-2 win; allowed one run on three hits (1 HR - O'Hoppe), with one walk and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work.

- ⚔ Will be his fourth start against the American League West division this season (also TEX and 2x HOU), going 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 6 ER), three home runs allowed, eight walks and 24 strikeouts in his previous three starts.

**CALIFORNIA DREAMIN':** In six career starts against California teams (2x ATH and SD, 1x LAA and LAD), he has gone 0-2 with a 6.28 ERA (28.2 IP, 20 ER), 12 walks and 32 strikeouts...batters for California teams have hit .259 (28-for-108) with a .328 on-base percentage, a .463 slugging percentage and a .791 OPS against Bradley.

- ⚔ Has made three career starts in California (2x at the Oakland Coliseum, 1x at Dodger Stadium), going 0-1 with a 5.51 ERA (16.1 IP, 10 ER), six walks and 18 strikeouts in those starts.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In 11 major league road games this season, is 2-4 with a 4.50 ERA (60.0 IP, 30 ER), 25 walks and 49 strikeouts, compared to 4-3 with a 5.29 ERA (66.1 IP, 39 ER), 34 walks and 60 strikeouts in 13 home games...in 36 career road games (34 starts), is 8-12 with a 4.73 ERA (179.0 IP, 94 ER), 74 walks and 178 strikeouts.

- ⚔ On the road this season, he has posted a .228 (52-for-228) opponent batting average and a 1.28 WHIP while allowing nine doubles and five home runs.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed batters have slashed .245/.331/.419 with 11 doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 36 RBI and a 1.76 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 229 at-bats against Bradley...right-handed batters have slashed .245/.304/.357 with 10 doubles, six home runs, 27 RBI and a 2.90 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 249 at-bats against Bradley.

- ⚔ In his career, lefties have slashed .242/.315/.413 with a 2.79 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties have slashed .246/.306/.441 with a 3.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Bradley.

**THE ARSENAL:** Through 24 starts in 2025, Bradley has relied on a four pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:
