THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 at Kansas City and 1-2 at Los Angeles-AL...tonight, Minnesota will begin their final homestand of the season with the first of three against the Diamondback through the weekend...after this series, the Twins will host the Yankees for three games, from Monday-Wednesday, then the Guardians for four games next weekend — which includes a doubleheader on Saturday 20.

UNHAPPY HOLLYWOOD ENDING: The Twins lost to the Angels in Anaheim on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 4-3...Taj Bradley made his fourth start as a Twin, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...two of his three runs allowed came on a Zach Neto two-run homer in the third inning...Cole Sands (3-4) was issued the loss, allowing a run in the eighth inning on a Mike Trout sac fly...the offense recorded six hits and scored all three runs on homers from Byron Buxton (2-run) and James Outman (solo).

LAWYER UP: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Justin Topa on the 15-day Injured List with a left oblique strain (retroactive to September 9)...Topa has appeared in 54 games this season, the second-most of his career, going 1-5 with a 3.90 ERA (60.0 IP, 26 ER), 18 walks, 49 strikeouts, four saves and four holds.

To replace Topa on the 28-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson (pronounced LAW-ry-son) from Triple-A St. Paul...the 27-year-old has split the 2025 season between St. Paul and Double-A Wichita, combining to go 2-4 with a 2.86 ERA (44.0 IP, 14 ER), six saves, 14 walks and 45 strikeouts in 34 games...since being promoted to St. Paul in early June, the right-hander has gone 2-1 with a 2.84 ERA (25.1 IP, 8 ER), 10 walks, 25 strikeouts and a .229 opponent batting average in 17 appearances...the Bingham, Maine native was originally selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2019 Draft out of the University of Maine and has spent six seasons in the Twins' system, going 16-16 with a 3.39 ERA (327.0 IP, 123 ER), 11 saves, 107 walks and 376 strikeouts.

TWINS AND SNAKES: The Twins and D-backs are playing each other for the 31st, 32nd and 33rd times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 19-11 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 8-1 at Target Field (2014-23) and 7-8 at Chase Field (2004-24).

Twins and D-backs last faced off for three games at Chase Field from June 25-28, 2024 as the Twins won games two and three...they outscored the Snakes 25-14 in the series.

The Twins last hosted the Diamondbacks from August 4-6, 2023 and swept in three games...they have won eight-straight home games against Arizona.

Twins are 11-3 in their last 14 against the D-backs, dating back to September of 2014.

Minnesota's .633 winning percentage against the D-backs is their second-highest all-time against an NL opponent... .636 (21-11) vs. San Diego is their highest.

Byron Buxton is hitting .438 (14-for-32) with three doubles, two triples, four home runs, eight RBI, a 1.031 slugging percentage and a 1.503 OPS in eight career games vs. the D-backs...he homered twice in the three-game series at Chase Field in 2024.

NOTHING RUNS LIKE A BEER BUCK: Byron Buxton enters tonight 22-for-22 in stolen base attempts this season...he has gone 28-for-his-last-28 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen)...Buxton and Trevor Story (28-for-28) are the only two players in baseball yet to be caught stealing (min. 20 steals)...he has 115 steals in his career, one away from tying Dan Gladden for sixth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone 18-24 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13), 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20), 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23), 1-2 vs. Washington (July 25-27) and 2-1 vs. San Diego. After this series, Philadelphia (September 26-28 at Citizens Bank Park) will be their only remaining NL team to play.

DAYS GONE BYRON: Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with three doubles, three triples, six home runs, 14 RBI, a .933 slugging percentage and a 1.325 OPS in his last 12 games.

With another hit on Wednesday afternoon, Buck now has 117 on the season, tying his single-season career-high of 117, done in 2017. Over his last 162 games, Buck is hitting .286 (174-for-609) with 37 doubles, seven triples, 45 home runs, 110 RBI, 125 runs scored, 26 stolen bases, a .346 on-base percentage, a .591 slugging percentage and a .937 OPS.

AUSTIN MARTIN. INTENSITY. DRIVEN.: Over his last 15 games, Austin Martin has reached base 27 times (16 hits, 11 walks) in 55 plate appearances for an on-base percentage of .500 in that span...over those 15 games, his batting average is .372 (16-for-43) with three doubles, 10 runs scored, just eight strikeouts and a .942 OPS.

ERASERS OUT: The play in the eighth inning on Monday night in Anaheim, where Royce Lewis reached on what was originally ruled an error on third baseman Yoán Moncada, has been changed to a hit for Lewis (+1 RBI)...on the play, Moncada ranged back and to his left just missing the bouncer in the hole.

- ⚔ Making 13th major league start of the season and 171st career start...second start back in the majors and first start back at Target Field since being placed on the Injured List...fifth career start against Arizona.
- ⚔ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 5 (retroactive to June 4), then transferred to the 60-day Injured List on June 11 due to a grade 2 right teres major strain...pitched three games on rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints...went 0-1 with a 3.18 ERA (11.1 IP, 4 ER), two walks, 14 strikeouts and a .304 (14-for-46) opponent batting average.
- ⚔ Made his return to the majors in his last start on September 5 at Kansas City where he dealt his fourth loss of the season in Minnesota's 1-2 defeat...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings.
- ⚔ In four career starts against the Diamondbacks, López has gone 0-2, posting a 5.40 ERA (20.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks, 22 strikeouts and a .273 (21-for-77) opponent batting average.

A ROYAL RETURN: Made his return to the major leagues on September 5 at Kansas City where he dealt his fourth loss of the season in Minnesota's 1-2 defeat...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...went scoreless through 3.2 innings before allowing a two-run homer to Maikel Garcia in the third, scoring Vinnie Pasquantino...marked just his second hit allowed to a right-handed batter off his sweeper all season.

⚔ Was his fifth 6.0-plus-inning start this season and fourth quality start.

DO YOU REMEMBER... THE VERY FIRST START OF SEPTEMBER: López missed 80 games and spent 92 days on the Injured List, the longest IL stint of his major league career...second longest of his professional career (missed entirety of 2014 minor league season with the Mariners due to Tommy John surgery)...pitched three games on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints:

- ⚔ First start was on August 21 vs. the Round Rock Express, opposite Carl Edwards Jr., where he was dealt the loss in St. Paul's 0-6, shutout defeat...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in 1.2 innings...his fastball averaged 94.3 and topped out and 95.3...recorded a 32 pitch first inning, then exited in the second after two outs with a runner on first.
- ⚔ Second start on August 26 at Toledo, opposite former Twin Randy Dobnak, where he did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 5-4 victory over the Mud Hens...allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts over 4.0 innings...permitted three consecutive hits to start the game, a double to Hao-Yu Lee, an RBI triple to Akil Baddoo and an RBI single to Justyn-Henry Malloy...also allowed a solo home run to Gage Workman in the second...his fastball averaged 93.8 and topped out at 95.2
- ⚔ Returned to Toledo for his third and final rehab start in the Saints' series finale against the Mud Hens, once again opposite Randy Dobnak...he did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 1-2, walk-off defeat...allowed four hits with one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.2 shutout innings...went hitless through 2.0 innings to start the game before giving up a single to Kevin Newman...his fastball averaged 93.9 and topped out at 95.6.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: Pablo is 0-2 in four career starts against the Diamondbacks, posting a 5.40 ERA (20.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks, 22 strikeouts and a .273 (21-for-77) opponent batting average...has not faced Arizona since May 2, 2022 where he was dealt the loss in Miami's 4-5 defeat...allowed four runs (3 earned) on six hits (2 HR) with two walks and seven strikeouts in 4.2 innings.

- ⚔ Arizona is one of four teams López has faced at least four times and never recorded a win...the others being the New York Yankees (0-3), Texas Rangers (0-2) and San Francisco Giants (0-1).
- ⚔ Has allowed his third highest OPS to the D-backs (.847) behind only the Texas Rangers (.961) and the Washington Nationals (.866).

HOME SWEET HOME: Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 15-8 with a 3.80 ERA (213.0 IP, 90 ER), 10.35 K/9, 1.94 BB/9 and 0.93 HR/9 in 36 starts at home, compared to 18-14 with a 3.48 ERA (245.2 IP, 95 ER), 9.60 K/9, 2.23 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 in 42 road starts.

- ⚔ In his four starts at home this season, López is 2-0, posting a 3.32 ERA (21.2 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 28 strikeouts; compared to 3-4, 2.60 ERA (45.0 IP, 13 ER), with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts in eight road starts.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 12 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .281/.318/.396 in 139 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .161/.226/.295 in 112 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 88.3 mph and a whiff rate of 23.6 compared to righties' 87.6 mph and 29.0 percent.

- ⚔ He has an all-time low 28.4 percent hard hit rate against right-handed batters, compared to a all-time high 40.7 percent hard hit rate against left-handed batters.

THE ARSENAL: López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer almost 43% of the time...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ⚔ Has a 7.0 foot extension, ranking in the 93rd percentile and a 5.5 walk percentage, ranking in the 90th percentile, but ranks bottom four percentile in max exit velocity at 116.5 mph.
- ⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 curveballs, Pablo ranks eighth in strikeout percentage (50.0), 20th in whiff percentage (42.4) and 20th in opponent batting average (.143).
- ⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 sinkers, López is tied for second in put away percentage (50.0) and is 28th in opponent batting average (.176).

SEPTEMBER BLUES: Through his 28 career September/October starts, López has allowed his highest ERA (4.61), opponent batting average (.267), on-base percentage (.324) and OPS (.743), as well as his second highest slugging percentage (.420) and number of home runs (19).

Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE: This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund...with 65 strikeouts this season, he has donated \$65,000 so far.
