THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Kansas City and 1-2 at Los Angeles-AL), the Twins began their final homestand of 2025 with a win against Arizona last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the 10-game, 10-day homestand with the second of three against the D-backs...after the finale tomorrow, they will host the Yankees for three games, from Monday-Wednesday, then the Guardians for four games next weekend — which includes a doubleheader on Saturday, September 20.

KEASCHALL KALLS GAME: The Twins walked-off the Diamondbacks last night at Target Field, winning by a score of 9-8, earning their 10th walk-off victory of the season — tied for second-most in baseball this season (SF - 11; BOS, MIL & SEA - 10)...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two unearned runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and six strikeouts...the offense scored three runs in the bottom of the ninth, capped off by a Luke Keaschall game-winning sac fly...Kody Clemens hit three home runs on the night and added a double (more below)...he also drove in five of the nine runs.

HAT TRICKS: Last night Kody Clemens became the 11th different Twin (14th time) to hit three home runs in a game (list below)...he also became one of 16 players in baseball this season to accomplish the feat.

ALSO: Clemens added a double last night, giving him 14 total bases in the game, tying a club record set by Kirby Puckett on August 30, 1987 at Milwaukee...Puckett had two home runs, two doubles and two singles.

TWINS AND SNAKES: The Twins and D-backs are playing each other for the 31st, 32nd and 33rd times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 20-11 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 9-1 at Target Field (2014-23) and 7-8 at Chase Field (2004-24).

☞ Twins are 12-3 in their last 15 against the D-backs, dating back to September of 2014.
☞ Minnesota's .645 winning percentage against the D-backs is their highest all-time against an NL opponent... .636 (21-11) vs. San Diego is their second-highest.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .417 (15-for-36) with three doubles, two triples, four home runs, eight RBI, a .944 slugging percentage and a 1.408 OPS in nine career games vs. the D-backs.

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): Twins need a win tonight or tomorrow to secure their 18th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 17-28-2 in series play, going 11-10-2 at home and 6-18-0 on the road.

☞ Twins are 7-3-0 all-time in series play against the D-backs...at home vs. Arizona, they are 4-1-0 in series play, their only loss coming in June of 2003.

☞ Twins have won just one series (August 29-31 vs. SD) in their last nine tries.

NOTHING RUNS LIKE A BEER BUCK: Byron Buxton enters tonight 22-for-22 in stolen base attempts this season...he has gone 28-for-his-last-28 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen)...Buxton and Trevor Story (28-for-28) are the only two players in baseball yet to be caught stealing (min. 20 steals)...Buck has 115 steals in his career, one away from tying Dan Gladden for sixth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

AUSTIN POWER: Over his last 16 games, Austin Martin has reached base 30 times (17 hits, 13 walks) in 60 plate appearances for an on-base percentage of .508 in that span...over those 16 games, his batting average is .370 (17-for-46) with four doubles, 11 runs scored, just nine strikeouts and a .965 OPS.

TOUCH 'EM ALL BRAINER!: KUAL 103.5 in Brainerd has been named the winner of the 2025 John Gordon Award as Twins Radio Affiliate of the Year...Cool 103.5 FM (KUAL-FM) in Brainerd hasn't just been a cornerstone for the Twins Radio Network in the Northern Lakes area, beyond broadcasting, they've also been stewardess of the growth of baseball and softball in the community...community outreach throughout the cluster of Hubbard owned stations has annually exceeded over 700 hours of volunteer time including initiatives like a Brainerd Police Vs Fire Department softball game, the Elks Batter Up competition and a re-grand opening of Jaycee Field, right in their backyard...as the winner of the 2025 John Gordon Radio Affiliate of the Year, KUAL will receive a \$5,000 Grant from the Twins Community Fund that will be used to support their ongoing efforts in providing the Brainerd Baxter Baseball Association opportunities to play ball.

THE NEXT ONE IS FOR ALL THE CORN: High-A Cedar Rapids beat Beloit last night by a score of 7-1, clinching the Midwest League Division title and will move on to the championship series...it marks the Kernels' third time in the Midwest League Championship in five years...game one in the best of three series against West Michigan starts tomorrow afternoon with first pitch at 1:00 pm (CT).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2022, rookies Joe Ryan and Jovani Moran kept the Royals hitless until one out in the ninth inning, before Moran allowed a double to Bobby Witt Jr...Ryan went 7.0 hitless innings but was removed after 106 pitches.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his eighth loss of the season on September 6 at Kansas City, opposite Stephen Kolek, in Minnesota's 2-11 defeat...allowed five runs on four hits (1 HR), with a season-high four walks and two strikeouts over 2.0 innings...walked the first two batters of the game before allowing four runs on an RBI double by Vinnie Pasquantino and a three-run home run by Salvador Perez...then, walked Adam Frazier, who scored on Nick Loftin's one-out RBI double...his strikeout of Jac Caglianone in the first was the 700th of Ryan's career.

- ☞ Marked the third time in his career recording two-or-fewer strikeouts (1 K on June 26, 2022 vs. Colorado and 2 K on August 7, 2024 at Chicago-NL) and the second time working 2.0-or-fewer innings (2.0 IP on August 7, 2024).
- ☞ Snapped his streak of 27-straight outings with four-or-more strikeouts recorded...was tied with Pablo López (2023) for the third-longest streak in Twins history (1961-).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his career-high-tying 13th win of the season on August 31 vs. San Diego, opposite David Morgan, in a 7-2 Twins victory...threw 7.0 scoreless innings with five hits and one walk allowed, while striking out eight batters...marked his first outing since July 11 vs. Pittsburgh in which he did not allow a run through the first three innings...marked his fifth scoreless outing and his career-high-tying 14th quality start of the season...104 pitches set a season-high and were his most in an outing since he threw 110 on July 6, 2024 vs. Houston.

FACING ARIZONA: Is facing the Diamondbacks for the second time in his career...lone career start came on June 25, 2024 at Chase Field; did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-5 loss, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work.

- ☞ Will be his fourth start against the National League West this season (also SF, COL, SD), he has gone 3-0 with a 0.90 ERA (20.0 IP, 2 ER), one walk and 26 strikeouts in his previous three starts...in that span, batters in the division are hitting .169 (12-for-71) with two home runs allowed and a .181 on-base percentage.
- ☞ In 11 Interleague starts this season, has gone 5-4 with a 2.70 ERA (63.1 IP, 19 ER), seven home runs allowed, 11 walks and 74 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET JOE-ME: In 14 home appearances (13 starts) this season, Ryan is 7-4 with a 3.18 ERA (76.1 IP, 27 ER), 17 walks and 94 strikeouts, compared to 6-4 with a 3.46 ERA (80.2 IP, 31 ER), 17 walks and 82 strikeouts in 14 road starts...in his career (57 G/56 GS), has gone 26-16 with a 3.59 ERA, a 5.08 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .211 opponent batting average at Target Field.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .241/.294/.417 with 18 doubles, 11 home runs, 17 walks and 71 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .188/.248/.323 with 12 doubles, nine home runs, 17 walks and 105 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .215/.275/.376 with 79 walks and 280 strikeouts (3.54 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .226/.273/.422 with 64 walks and 421 strikeouts (6.58 K/BB).

- ☞ His .188 BAA against righties ranks fourth among all qualified pitchers in baseball this season... among the same pitchers, his 6.18 strikeout-to-walk ratio vs. righties ranks eighth and his .571 opponent OPS ranks 10th.

THE ARSENAL: Through 28 appearances (27 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:
