THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Kansas City and 1-2 at Los Angeles-AL), the Twins began their final homestand of 2025 with a split of the first two games against the D-backs...today, Minnesota will continue the 10-game, 10-day homestand with the three-game series finale against Arizona...tomorrow night, the Twins will begin a three-game series against the Yankees through Wednesday...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Guardians for four games next weekend — which includes a doubleheader on Saturday, September 20.

DIAMONDBACKS SNEAK UP ON SANDS: The Twins lost to the Diamondbacks last night by a score of 5-2 in 10 innings, making them 4-10 in extras this season...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Cody Laweryson made his major league debut with 2.0 scoreless innings and two strikeouts...Cole Sands was issued the loss, allowing three runs (2 earned) to score in the 10th...the offense recorded 10 hits as Austin Martin reached three times with two hits (double) and a walk.

TWINS AND SNAKES: The Twins and D-backs are playing each other for the 33rd time in their history today...the Twins have gone 20-12 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 9-2 at Target Field (2014-25) and 7-8 at Chase Field (2004-24).
- Twins are 12-4 in their last 16 against the D-backs, dating back to September of 2014.
- Minnesota's .625 winning percentage against the D-backs is their second-highest all-time against an NL opponent... .636 (21-11) vs. San Diego is the highest.
- Byron Buxton is hitting .390 (16-for-41) with three doubles, two triples, four home runs, eight RBI, an .854 slugging percentage and a 1.288 OPS in 10 career games vs. the D-backs.

MY OTHER HALF: Twins have gone 19-25 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis, 2-1 vs. New York, 0-3 at Atlanta, 3-0 vs. San Francisco, 2-1 at Milwaukee, 1-2 at Cincinnati, 0-3 vs. Milwaukee, 1-2 at Miami, 2-1 vs. Chicago, 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 1-2 at Colorado, 1-2 at Los Angeles, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego and 1-1 vs. Arizona.
- Philadelphia is the only remaining NL team the Twins have yet to play, with three games at Citizens Bank Park, from September 26-28 to finish the season.

NOTHING RUNS LIKE A BEER BUCK: Byron Buxton enters today 22-for-22 in stolen base attempts this season...he has gone 28-for-his-last-28 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen)...Buxton and Trevor Story (28-for-28) are the only two players in baseball yet to be caught stealing (min. 20 steals)...Buck has 115 steals in his career, one away from tying Dan Gladden for sixth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

AUSTIN 3:16: Over his last 17 games, Austin Martin has reached base 33 times (19 hits, 14 walks) in 65 plate appearances for an on-base percentage of .516 in that span...over those 17 games, his batting average is .380 (19-for-50) with five doubles, 12 runs scored, just nine strikeouts and a .996 OPS.

- Martin has posted a .478 on-base percentage in 12 games this month, the third-best in the AL and fifth-best in baseball.
- His walk percentage of 19.1 is the seventh-best in baseball for September.
- This month, Martin is hitting .455 (5-for-11) off breaking pitches, fourth-best in baseball (minimum of 45 pitches).

KODE RED: Kody Clemens has six hits in nine at-bats this series, including a double, three home runs, seven RBI and a stolen base...since April 28 (acquired by MIN on April 26), he has posted a .467 slugging percentage, second-best on the team (Buxton - .577)...his 100 games played in that same span rank third (Lee - 114, Larnach 105).

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF: With a win today the Twins will earn their 18th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 17-28-2 in series play, going 11-10-2 at home and 6-18-0 on the road.
- Twins are 7-3-0 all-time in series play against the D-backs...at home vs. Arizona, they are 4-1-0 in series play, their only loss coming in June of 2003.
- Twins have won just one series (August 29-31 vs. SD) in their last nine tries. >>>

THIS ONE IS FOR ALL THE CORN: High-A Cedar Rapids is playing in the Midwest League Championship Series for the third time in five years...game one at West Michigan is at 1:00 pm (CT) today...game two will be in Cedar Rapids on Tuesday with game three (if necessary) Wednesday.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill and Double-A Wichita outfielder Hendry Mendez as the club's minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

- Hill, 19, made the start on Thursday vs. Beloit, allowing two runs on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...the Grapevine, TX native is ranked as the club's eighth-best (3rd pitcher) prospect by MLB.com.
- Mendez, 21, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .316 (6-for-19) with one triple, one home run, three RBI, eight walks and a .536 on-base percentage...he was acquired by the Twins in the Harrison Bader trade with Philadelphia and is ranked as the club's 25th-best prospect by MLB.com.

- ☞ Making 25th start of the season and 113th career start...second career start against Arizona.
- ☞ Last started on September 7 at Kansas City, where he earned his fifth win of the season in Minnesota's 5-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings...marked his first career win against the Royals...snapped a six-decision loss streak.
- ☞ In his lone start against the Diamondbacks on August 4, 2023 at Target Field, Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 victory...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work.

**THE ROYAL TREATMENT:** Last pitched on September 7 at Kansas City, opposite Michael Lorenzen, where he earned his fifth win of the season in Minnesota's 5-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings...only run allowed was an RBI single to Vinnie Pasquantino in the sixth, scoring Maikel Garcia...was just his second homerless game in his last 13.

- ☞ Marked his first career win against Kansas City...also his first win since May 3 (17 games), snapping a six-decision loss streak.
- ☞ Reached 600 career innings pitched and 100 strikeouts on the season...is his third-straight season reaching 100-or-more strikeouts.

**ROCK 'EM SOX 'EM:** Pitched on September 1 vs. Chicago-AL, opposite Fraser Ellard; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-6 defeat...allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...allowed a solo home run to Colson Montgomery and a two-run homer to Chase Meidroth in the second...marked his third time this season with a multi-homer inning (also, June 12 vs. Texas and June 23 vs. Seattle).

- ☞ Was the only pitcher in Twins history (1961-) with 125-or-fewer innings pitched and 24-or-more home runs allowed in a single season.
- ☞ Is one of four pitchers to have nine-plus multi-homer games this season; also, Jake Irvin (11), Seth Lugo (10), and Zack Littell (9)...is the only one of those four to have done so in less than 25 games.

**SNAKE OIL:** In his lone start against the Diamondbacks on August 4, 2023 at Target Field, Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 victory...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...in three starts against National League opponents this season, he is 1-2 with a 9.20 ERA (14.2 IP, 15 ER), three walks, 13 strikeouts and a .338 (22-for-65) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Bailey is 5-6 in 21 career Interleague starts...has posted a 5.42 ERA (109.2 IP, 66 ER) with 21 home runs, 31 walks, 100 strikeouts and a .256 (108-for-422) opponent batting average.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In his career, Ober has gone 16-13 with a 4.11 ERA (304.1 IP, 139 ER), 8.93 K/9, 2.16 BB/9 and 1.72 HR/9 in 58 games (57 starts) at home compared to 14-16 with a 4.10 ERA (300.2 IP, 137 ER), 8.71 K/9, 1.71 BB/9 and 1.44 HR/9 in 56 road starts.

- ☞ Ober is 2-4, 4.65 ERA (71.2 IP, 37 ER) with 16 home runs, 16 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .251 (69-for-275) opponent batting average in 13 home starts this season.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through 24 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .287/.323/.522 in 268 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .273/.314/.506 in 272 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.0 mph and a whiff rate of 20.3 compared to righties' 92.1 mph and 26.8 percent.

- ☞ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 31.3 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 50.5 percent.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 36.3% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ His 7.3 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 97th percentile...he ranks in the bottom one percentile in breaking run value (-17) and bottom fourth percentile in pitching run value (-19).

- ☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 sliders, Bailey has the second-highest opponent batting average (.320, highest slugging percentage (.590), 14th highest hard hit percentage (44.8) and fourth-lowest strikeout percentage (11.9).

- ☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 curveballs, Bailey has the second highest opponent batting average (.714) and the highest slugging percentage (1.857)...recorded his first strikeout off his curveball in his start against the Athletics on August 20.

**THRILL OF THE CHASE:** Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 33.5 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 93rd percentile; ranks first on the Twins pitching staff, followed by Pablo López (32.4) and Justin Topa (29.8).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2025: 6-4, 4.58 ERA // CAREER: 11-10, 4.43 ERA

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start tomorrow's series opener vs. New York-AL...last started on September 8 at Los Angeles-AL, where he earned his single-season career-high sixth win in Minnesota's 12-3 victory...allowed three runs on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...has never faced the Yankees, making them his 27th new opponent faced and seventh new opponent this season...Woods Richardson is 4-2 in 10 starts at home this season, posting a 3.42 ERA (50.0 IP, 19 ER) with 17 walks, 45 strikeouts and a .233 (45-for-193) opponent batting average.
