**THE TWINS:** Began their final homestand of 2025 with a 1-2 series loss to Arizona over the weekend, their only win coming on Friday night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the 10-game, 10-day homestand with the first of three games against New York-AL, one of three-straight night games against the Yankees...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Guardians for four games this upcoming weekend — which includes a doubleheader on Saturday (make-up of May 20).  
 ☞ Twins have 13 games remaining, seven at home and six on the road.

**SUNDAY NOT SO FUNDAY:** The Twins lost to the Diamondbacks yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-4, losing the series, making them 17-29-2 in series play this season... Bailey Ober (5-8) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a season-high nine strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by home runs from Matt Wallner (22) and Mickey Gasper (2)...Minnesota left 10 men on base and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position.

**EMPIRE STATE OF MIND:** The Twins and Yankees are playing the fourth of six games in 2025. ☞ These two last met for a three-game series in the Bronx, from August 11-13 as the Yankees won games one and two, with the Twins salvaging game three...that win snapped a nine-game losing streak to the Yankees.

☞ Twins last hosted the Yankees for three games, from May 14-16, 2024 as Twins were swept in three games...their last home win over New York was on April 25, 2023.

☞ Over that three-game series in the Bronx, Byron Buxton went 3-for-10 (.300) with one double, one home run and two walks...Buck has a 1.006 OPS in his last 17 games against the Yankees, including five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI and a .644 slugging percentage.

**RUN THE JEWELS:** The Twins stole three more bases yesterday (Lewis - 2, Keaschall - 1), giving them 96 on the season, their most under a Rocco Baldelli-led team (since 1961)...96 is their most since stealing 99 in 2014...the last time they stole at least 100 was in 2012 (135)... since August 1, they have stolen 41 bases (49 attempts), fifth-most in baseball, trailing New York-NL (47), New York-AL (47), Arizona (44) and Seattle (43)...prior to August 1, the Twins stole 55 bases, sixth-fewest in baseball.

**THE RUNNING MEN:** Over their last 25 games, since August 18, the Twins have posted a 4.5 BsR (base running runs above average), which is the best in baseball...in 108 games leading up to the trade deadline (July 31), the Twins posted a -6.5 BsR, ranking 29th in baseball (lower left)...in 41 games since, they have posted a BsR of 3.2, fourth-best in baseball (lower right):

**AUSTIN MARTIN. INTENSITY. DRIVEN.:** Over his last 18 games, Austin Martin has reached base 34 times (20 hits, 14 walks) in 70 plate appearances for an on-base percentage of .493 in that span...over those 18 games, his batting average is .364 (20-for-55) with five doubles, 12 runs scored, just 11 strikeouts and a .947 OPS.

☞ Martin has posted a .451 on-base percentage in 13 games this month, the fourth-best in the AL and ninth-best in baseball.

☞ His walk percentage of 17.3 is sixth-best in the AL and 11th-best in baseball for September.

**LUUUUUUUUKE!** Luke Keaschall has reached safely in 38 of 42 games to start his career... he has posted an on-base percentage of .399 on the season, reaching base 73 times (50 hits, 18 walks, 5 hit-by-pitch) in 183 plate appearances...marks the second-most times on base in Twins history (1961-) through a player's first 42 career games (Luis Arraez - 74 in 2019). ☞ He leads all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage (minimum of 150 plate appearances).

**LEFT SIDE STORIES:** Twins are hitting .310 (57-for-184) with an .891 OPS over their last 18 games against left-handed pitching.

☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .310 (27-for-87) with an .829 OPS in his last 52 games vs. lefties.

☞ Matt Wallner has 18 hits against lefties this season...he entered 2025 with 14 career hits off lefties, from 2022-24...had a .510 OPS vs. LHP entering 2025, but has a .784 OPS in 2025.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .307 (27-for-88) with nine home runs, a .705 slugging percentage and a 1.081 OPS against left-handed pitching on the season — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career.

**IS THIS HEAVEN? NO, IT'S IOWA:** High-A Cedar Rapids is playing in the Midwest League Championship Series for the third time in five years...the Kernels lost game one yesterday at West Michigan by a score of 5-3...they have the day off today, but the decisive game two will be tomorrow night in Cedar Rapids at 6:35 pm (CT)...game three (if necessary) will be played on Wednesday night.

**ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD:** Major League Baseball today announced that right-handed pitcher Pablo López has been named the Minnesota Twins' 2025 nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award presented by Capital One, baseball's most prestigious individual honor for major leaguers...this is López's second-consecutive nomination with the Twins and third of his eight-year career, as he was also the Miami Marlins' nominee in 2022...the Roberto Clemente Award presented by Capital One is the annual recognition of a major league player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field...as part of the annual program, each MLB Club nominates one player to be considered for the league-wide Award in tribute to Clemente's achievements and character.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2002, the Twins clinched the AL Central Division title with a 5-0 win over Cleveland at then-Jacobs Field, marking the Twins' first playoff appearance since 1991...they also won the division in the next two seasons...in 2017, the Twins celebrated Big Sexy Night as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colón made the start...Colón allowed four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings as the Twins lost to the Blue Jays by a score of 4-3...in 2023, after hitting a grand slam off Jesse Scholtens of the White Sox, Royce Lewis became the first player with five grand slams among his first 16 career homers and the first in Twins history with four in one season.
