THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-1 against San Diego over the weekend, followed by a loss last night to Chicago-AL...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the second of four against the White Sox through Thursday night...after the finale, they will travel to Kansas City to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Royals over the weekend, followed by three in Anaheim, from September 8-10.

TWINS OUT-WORKED ON LABOR DAY: The Twins lost to the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-5, dropping a 5-4 lead entering the eighth inning...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...Kody Funderburk pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief, extending his career-high scoreless innings streak to 12.1...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Trevor Larnach...Royce Lewis hit his 10th home run of the season and second on the homestand.

WE DO TALK ABOUT BRUNO: Byron Buxton's home run on Sunday afternoon gave him 162 for his career, passing Max Kepler and tying Miguel Sanó for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...one more will pass Sanó and tie Tom Brunansky:

ADDITIONALLY: Buck has 84 career home runs at Target Field, tied with Max Kepler for most in the ballpark's history (since 2010)...lower right is a list of Target Field's all-time home run leaders.

DEEP DISH: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the 11th of 13 scheduled games in 2025...Twins have gone 5-5 this season (2-2 at Target Field and 3-3 at Rate Field).

- Two wins for the Twins in these next three games and they will secure the season-series for the fourth consecutive season (list lower right).
Twins have gone 14-2 against the Sox at Target Field, dating back to April 11, 2023.
Minnesota has gone 24-7 in its last 31 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.
Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-75 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.
Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .349 (30-for-86) with a .971 OPS in 26 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 26-straight starts against CWS.
Matt Wallner is hitting .313 (25-for-80) with six doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .450 on-base percentage and a 1.013 OPS in 27 career games against the White Sox.
Royce Lewis is hitting .375 (15-for-40) with seven home runs, 20 RBI, 10 walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a .925 slugging percentage and a 1.425 OPS in 11 career games vs. the White Sox.
Byron Buxton is hitting .327 (53-for-162) with a .716 slugging percentage and a 1.118 OPS in his last 46 games against the White Sox...Buxton's 23 career home runs and 56 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.

BUCK PRODUCTIONS: Byron Buxton drove in two runs yesterday, giving him a team-high 72 RBI and extending his single-season career-high (56 in 2024)...has driven in two runs in each of the last five games, marking a career-high for a multi-RBI streak...it ties a club record for a multiple RBI streak:

ALSO: Buck's streak marks the longest in baseball this season...Lourdes Gurriel Jr., Shohei Ohtani, Taylor Ward, Pete Alonso and Jorge Polanco each had a four-game streak this season...it marks the longest streak in baseball since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. did it in seven-straight, from June 23-29, 2024.

STEAL THE SHOW: The Twins have stolen 13 bases in their last six games...since August 12, they have stolen 22 bases in 26 chances...in that span, they rank tied with Tampa Bay for fourth in baseball, trailing New York-NL (27), New York-AL (25) and Arizona (24)...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 79 this season.

In lower right margin are stolen bases by year under Rocco Baldelli...DaShawn Keirse Jr.'s stolen base in the sixth inning yesterday was the 105th attempt for the Twins this season, already the most under a Baldelli-led team.

TREVOLUTION: Trevor Larnach is 7-for-11 (.636) over his last three games, with three RBI and just three strikeouts...over his last 12 games overall, he is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with three doubles, five RBI, six walks, a .429 on-base percentage and an .847 OPS.

He has multiple hits in three-straight, matching a season-best, previously done from May 10-14 (G1)...his career-best is four-straight, from April 23-30, 2024...the long for a Twin this season is four-straight multi-hit games, from Byron Buxton (2x) and Ryan Jeffers.
Larnach has already set single-season career-highs in games (122), hits (109), doubles (19), home runs (16), RBI (54) and walks (45).

ROYCE ROLLS: Royce Lewis has homered two times in his last four games, four times in his last 10 games and five times in his last 14 games.

Yesterday afternoon's homer was his 10th of the season, giving him double-digit home run totals for the third-straight season (15 in 2023, 16 in 2024).
Over his last six home games, Lewis is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, a .636 slugging percentage and a .984 OPS.
Tonight will mark his 83rd game of the season, which will mark a single-season career-high (82 in 2024).

PITCH PERFECT: Twins pitchers have struck out 1,142 batters this season, already 10th-most in club history (since 1961)...next is the 2006 team in ninth-place, that struck out 1,164 hitters...the club record is 1,560, held by the 2023 team...the current team is on pace to strike out 1,350, which would land fifth-most in Twins history.

Twins relievers have struck out 497 batters this season, needing three more to reach 500, which would mark the ninth time in club history...the club record for strikeouts among relievers is 675, done by the 2022 team...last season, they had 627.

- ☞ Making his 19th appearance (18th start) of the season and 49th career appearance (47th start)... fifth career start against the White Sox.
- ☞ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List on August 4 (retroactive to August 1) with an illness... pitched two games on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints on August 15 and 21 where he posted a 5.06 ERA (5.1 IP, 3 ER) with five walks and five strikeouts.
- ☞ Last started on August 27 at Toronto where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-9 defeat...allowed five runs on five hits (career-high 3 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 3.2 innings of work.
- ☞ In four career starts against Chicago-AL, Woods Richardson has gone 0-0, posting a 4.32 ERA (16.2 IP, 8 ER), with seven walks, 19 strikeouts and a .352 (25-for-71) opponent batting average.

**SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING NEW, SOMETHING BORROWED, SOMETHING BLUE:** Last pitched on August 27 at Toronto, opposite Eric Lauer, where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-9 defeat...allowed five runs on five hits (career-high 3 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 3.2 innings...permitted a solo homer to Davis Schneider in the second, a two-run single to Bo Bichette in the third, and solo homers to Schneider and Andrés Giménez in the fourth before being replaced by Thomas Hatch.

☞ Has pitched 5.0-or-less innings in his last nine starts, dating back to June 26 vs. Seattle.

**OVER THE RIVER AND THROUGH THE WOODS:** Woods Richardson was placed on the 15-day Injured List on August 4 (retroactive to August 1) with an illness...pitched two games on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints...started on August 15 at Omaha, opposite Stephen Kolek, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 10-2 victory...allowed one hit, one walk and four strikeouts in 2.0 shutout innings of work...walked the leadoff man then retired five in a row, including four-straight strikeouts...appeared as the bulk pitcher on August 21 vs. the Round Rock Express, following Pablo López and Trent Baker...allowed four runs (3 earned) on five hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 3.1 innings.

☞ Was his 38th and 39th career appearances at the Triple-A level, surpassing Louis Varland for second most starts in Saints' franchise history.

**ROCK 'EM, SOX 'EM:** Woods Richardson has faced Chicago-AL four times in his career...has gone 0-0, posting a 4.32 ERA (16.2 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks, 19 strikeouts and a .352 (25-for-71) opponent batting average...last faced the Sox in his first start this season on April 1 where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-3 victory...allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings.

☞ He is 1-1 in four starts against division opponents this season (1x each)...has posted a 4.19 ERA (19.1 IP, 9 ER), 10 walks, 20 strikeouts and a .270 (20-for-74) opponent batting average.

**OUR NECK OF THE WOODS:** In his career, Sim has gone 5-4 with a 4.14 ERA (113.0 IP, 52 ER), 8.36 K/9, 3.35 BB/9 and 1.04 HR/9 in 23 games (22 starts) at home compared to 5-6 with a 4.71 ERA (114.2 IP, 60 ER), 7.14 K/9, 3.77 BB/9 and 1.57 HR/9 in 25 road games (24 starts).

☞ He is 4-2 in nine starts at home so far this season, posting a 3.40 ERA (45.0 IP, 17 ER) with 14 walks, 38 strikeouts and a .246 (43-for-175) opponent batting average.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** Through 18 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .280/.357/.440 in 150 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .234/.311/.429 in 175 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.5 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 35.0 compared to righties' 91.5 mph and 46.7 percent.

☞ His whiff rate is 0.3 below his 2024 whiff rate for an average of 22.0 percent (lefties, 19.2 percent; righties, 24.2 percent)...compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

**NIGHTMARES:** So far this season, Simeon is 2-3 in 10 nighttime appearances (9 starts), posting a 5.84 ERA (44.2 IP, 29 ER) with nine home runs, 24 walks and 35 strikeouts; compared to 3-1 with a 3.18 ERA (39.2 IP, 14 ER), six home runs, 13 walks and 36 strikeouts in eight daytime starts.

☞ SWR is 5-6 in 25 career night games (24 starts), and has posted a 5.24 ERA, a .262 opponent batting average and a .773 OPS with 18 home runs, 52 walks and 88 strikeouts; compared to 5-4 with a 3.62 ERA, a .238 opponent batting average, a .681 OPS, 15 home runs, 38 walks and 108 strikeouts in 23 day games (22 starts).

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider and curveball against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup and split finger against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

☞ He currently ranks in baseball's seventh percentile in ground ball percentage (31.9), eighth percentile in barrel percentage (11.3) and ninth percentile in max exit velocity (115.3).

☞ Between June 21 and today, SWR decreased his 4-seam fastball hard-hit rate from 60.3 percent to 45.8 percent, a decrease of 14.5, and lowering himself from the second highest hard-hit percentage among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 4-seam fastballs to the 121st highest, dropping 119 spots.
