THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-1 against San Diego over the weekend, followed by consecutive losses to Chicago-AL over the last two days...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the third of four against the White Sox...after tomorrow night's game, Minnesota will travel to Kansas City to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Royals over the weekend, followed by three in Anaheim against the Angels, from September 8-10.

TWINS LOSE IN FRONT OF ALL THE GOOD BOYS AND GIRLS: The Twins lost to the White Sox on Bark at the Park Night by a score of 12-3...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs (2 earned) on two hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Trevor Larnach, who singled, doubled and drove in his 55th run of the season.

WE DO TALK ABOUT BRUNO: Byron Buxton's home run on Sunday afternoon gave him 162 for his career, passing Max Kepler and tying Miguel Sanó for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...one more will pass Sanó and tie Tom Brunansky:

ADDITIONALLY: Buck has 84 career home runs at Target Field, tied with Max Kepler for most in the ballpark's history (since 2010)...lower right is a list of Target Field's all-time home run leaders.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the 12th of 13 scheduled games in 2025...Twins have gone 5-6 this season (2-3 at Target Field and 3-3 at Rate Field).

☞ Twins have gone 14-3 against the Sox at Target Field, dating back to April 11, 2023.

☞ Minnesota has gone 24-8 in its last 32 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-76 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

☞ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .349 (30-for-86) with a .971 OPS in 26 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 26-straight starts against CWS.

☞ Matt Wallner is hitting .298 (25-for-84) with six doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .433 on-base percentage and a .968 OPS in 28 career games against the White Sox.

☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .375 (15-for-40) with seven home runs, 20 RBI, 10 walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a .925 slugging percentage and a 1.425 OPS in 11 career games vs. the White Sox.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .325 (54-for-166) with a .717 slugging percentage and a 1.116 OPS in his last 47 games against the White Sox...Buxton's 23 career home runs and 56 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.

THICK AS THIEVES: The Twins have stolen 14 bases in their last seven games...since August 12, they have stolen 23 bases in 27 chances...in that span, they rank fifth in baseball, trailing New York-NL (31), New York-AL (27), Arizona (24) and Tampa Bay (24)...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 80 this season.

☞ In lower right margin are stolen bases by year under Rocco Baldelli...Mickey Gasper's stolen base in the second inning yesterday was the 106th attempt for the Twins this season, already the most under a Baldelli-led team.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach is 9-for-15 (.600) over his last four games, with four RBI and just three strikeouts...over his last 13 games overall, he is hitting .362 (17-for-47) with four doubles, six RBI, six walks, a .434 on-base percentage and an .881 OPS.

☞ He has multiple hits in four-straight, matching a career-best, previously done from April 23-30, 2024...the other Twins with four-straight multi-hit games this season, were Byron Buxton (2x) and Ryan Jeffers...the last Twins with multiple hits in five-straight was Luis Arraez (5, September 29-October 3, 2021).

☞ He has reached base safely in 13-straight, matching his career-high, previously done from July 6-26, 2024.

☞ Larnach has already set single-season career-highs in games (123), hits (111), doubles (20), home runs (16), RBI (55) and walks (45).

ROUND TRIP ROYCE: Royce Lewis has homered two times in his last four games, four times in his last 10 games and five times in his last 14 games.

☞ Monday afternoon's homer was his 10th of the season, giving him double-digit home run totals for the third-straight season (15 in 2023, 16 in 2024).

☞ Over his last six home games, Lewis is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, a .636 slugging percentage and a .984 OPS.

☞ Tonight will mark his 83rd game of the season, which will mark a single-season career-high (82 in 2024).

PITCH PERFECT: After 15 strikeouts last night, Twins pitchers have struck out 1,157 batters this season, already 10th-most in club history (since 1961)...next is the 2006 team in ninth-place, that struck out 1,164 hitters...the club record is 1,560, held by the 2023 team...the current team is on pace to strike out 1,358, which would land fifth-most in Twins history.

☞ Twins relievers have struck out 505 batters this season, the ninth time in club history for relievers to strikeout 500-plus...the club record for strikeouts among relievers is 675, done by the 2022 team...last season, they had 627.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to draw a split of the four-game series with the White Sox...Minnesota is 17-25-2 in series play, going 11-9-2 at home and 6-16-0 on the road.

☞ Twins need wins in their next two to avoid losing a consecutive series to the White Sox for the first time since 2022...their last series loss at home to the Sox was July 14-17, 2022.

TWINS MILB MONTHLYS: Double-A Wichita outfielder Kala'i Rosario and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for August.

☞ Rosario, 23, played in 27 games for the Wind Surge, hitting .305 (32-for-105) with six doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 23 RBI, 27 runs scored, 20 walks, a .421 on-base percentage, a .714 slugging percentage and a 1.135 OPS...the Papaikou, HI native was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Waiakea High School.

☞ Morris, 24, appeared in four games (2 starts) for the Saints in August, going 2-0, 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER) with one walk and 16 strikeouts...the New York, NY native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech University.

SEEING SAN DIEGO: Last pitched on August 29 vs. San Diego, opposite Nestor Cortes, where he earned his fourth win of the season and fifth of his career in Minnesota's 7-4 victory...allowed three runs (2 earned) on seven hits, with no walks and a season-low three strikeouts...gave up a sacrifice fly to Luis Arraez in the third, scoring Jake Cronenworth (unearned) and an RBI single to Jose Iglesias in the fourth...permitted a single to Gavin Sheets in the seventh (who subsequently scored) before being replaced by Justin Tapa.

☞ Marked just the second time Matthews has fanned less than four batters in a single game, the first time coming in his first start against San Diego on August 19, 2024 when he struck out just one.

KNOCK THEIR SOX OFF: Pitched on August 22 at Chicago-AL, opposite Aaron Civale...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 9-7 victory...allowed four runs on a season-high-tying eight hits (1 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings...permitted an RBI single to Lenyn Sosa in the first, an RBI single to Edgar Quero in the fourth and a two-run shot to Colson Montgomery in the fifth, before being replaced by Kody Funderburk.

☞ Had allowed nine walks in the month of August, including seven in his previous two games...marked his most walks allowed in a single month in his career.

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 113 strikeouts through his first 21 career major league games, the most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 21 career games:

☞ Matthews' 70 strikeouts so far in 2025 are the second most by a Twins pitcher in their first 12 games this season, behind Joe Ryan (76).

☞ Became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to reach 100 strikeouts in his first 18 career games.

ROCK 'EM SOX 'EM: Matthews is facing Chicago-AL for the second time in his career...his lone start against the White Sox was two starts ago on August 22...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 9-7 victory...allowed four runs on a season-high-tying eight hits (1 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings.

☞ With two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents have gone 13-for-48 (.271) with two doubles, one home run, four walks, 17 RBI and 14 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Zebby has gone 3-3 with a 6.54 ERA (42.2 IP, 31 ER), 10 walks, 56 strikeouts and a .317 (58-for-183) opponent batting average in 10 career major league starts at home; compared to 2-5, 5.03 ERA (53.2 IP, 30 ER) with 19 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .283 (62-for-219) opponent batting average in 11 career major league starts on the road.

☞ In five major league starts at home this season, Matthews has gone 2-1, posting a 4.07 ERA (24.1 IP, 9 ER) with five walks, 29 strikeouts and a .278 (27-for-97) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through his first 12 major league starts this season, left-handed hitters have slashed .303/.356/.508 in 122 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties have slashed .276/.317/.397 in 116 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 89.6 mph and a whiff rate of 29.3 compared to righties' 90.2 mph and 26.6 percent.

☞ His hard-hit rate against lefties is 38.8 percent, compared to 44.9 percent in 2024; and his hard-hit rate against righties is 41.9 percent, compared to 38.5 percent in 2024.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer almost 40% of the time...primarily uses his sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring is changeup and cutter against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown:

☞ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 sliders, Zebby ranks eighth in strikeout percentage at 44.4 percent and tied for 30th in opponent batting average (.167).

☞ Holds the highest average fastball velocity among all Twins starters this season at 96.3 mph, followed by Taj Bradley (96.1) and Pablo López (94.4).

☞ His 10.74 SO/9 leads Twins starters...followed by Joe Ryan (10.10), Pablo López (9.05), David Festa (8.94) and Simeon Woods Richardson (7.58).

☞ Added a sinker to his pitch arsenal in his start against Detroit on August 5.
