THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-1 against San Diego over the weekend, followed by three consecutive losses to Chicago-AL over the last three days...tonight, they will complete the homestand with the four-game series finale against the White Sox...after tonight's game, Minnesota will travel to Kansas City to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Royals over the weekend, followed by three in Anaheim against the Angels, from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ After tonight's game, the Twins will have 22 games remaining, 12 on the road and 10 at home.

TWINS LOSE LATE AGAINST SOX: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of 4-3, blowing a 3-1 lead entering the ninth inning...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run (Quero solo HR) on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...Kody Funderburk and Justin Topa combined to allow the three ninth inning runs...the offense recorded 11 hits, three apiece from Ryan Jeffers and Royce Lewis...Lewis also stole two bases and drove in one run.

WE DO TALK ABOUT BRUNO: Byron Buxton's home run on Sunday afternoon gave him 162 for his career, passing Max Kepler and tying Miguel Sanó for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...one more will pass Sanó and tie Tom Brunansky:

ADDITIONALLY: Buck has 84 career home runs at Target Field, tied with Max Kepler for most in the ballpark's history (since 2010)...lower right is a list of Target Field's all-time home run leaders.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins are playing the White Sox tonight for the 13th and final time in 2025...Twins have gone 5-7 this season (2-4 at Target Field and 3-3 at Rate Field).

☞ These two will meet next for a four-game series at Rate Field, from May 25-28, 2026...Twins will host the Sox for the first time in 2026 for three games, from June 1-3.

☞ Twins have gone 14-4 against the Sox at Target Field, dating back to April 11, 2023.

☞ Minnesota has gone 24-9 in its last 33 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-77 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

☞ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .363 (33-for-91) with a .982 OPS in 27 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 27-straight starts against CWS.

☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .409 (18-for-44) with seven home runs, 21 RBI, 10 walks, a .519 on-base percentage, a .909 slugging percentage and a 1.428 OPS in 12 career games vs. the White Sox.

BUCK WEARING OUT THE SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .283 (96-for-339) with 30 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs, 56 RBI, 69 runs scored and a .939 OPS in 99 career games vs. the White Sox...below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 51 (June 30, 2019-present):

ALSO: Buxton's 23 career home runs and 56 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.

BASEPATH BANTER: The Twins have stolen 16 bases in their last eight games...since August 12, they have stolen 25 bases in 30 attempts...in that span, they rank third in baseball, trailing New York-NL (32) and New York-AL (27)...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 82 this season...in lower right margin are stolen bases by year under Rocco Baldelli.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis is hitting .421 (8-for-19) with two home runs, five RBI and 1.187 OPS in his last five games...over his last 13 games, he is hitting .300 (15-for-50) with four home runs, 12 RBI, a .560 slugging percentage and an .887 OPS.

☞ Royce is sitting at 68 hits, tied with his 2024 total...one more hit will mark a new single-season career-high...last night was his 83rd game of the season, marking a new career-high.

☞ Over his last seven home games, Lewis is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, a .654 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS.

PITCH PALS: Twins pitchers have struck out 30 Sox hitters this series, giving them 1,167 strikeouts on the season, now eighth-most in club history (since 1961)...the current team is on pace to strike out 1,360, which would land fifth-most in Twins history.

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the sixth time this season...the other five were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15), three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22) and three games vs. the Athletics (August 19-21).

☞ Other than those five sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep seven times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto, June 19 at Cincinnati, July 20 at Colorado, August 3 at Cleveland, August 13 at New York-AL and August 17 vs. Detroit.

☞ The last time the Twins were swept by the White Sox was June 29-July 1, 2021 in three games at Rate Field.

☞ Last time they were swept by the White Sox in four games was June 6-9, 2008 at Rate Field...they have never been swept by the Sox in four games at Minnesota.

☞ Last time they were swept by any team in four games was April 23-26, 2018 at Yankee Stadium...last time they were swept in four games at home was June 16-18, 2017 by Cleveland.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a career-high 14-straight games...the long for a Twin this season was 24 by Ty France, from May 16-June 13...during the streak, Larnach is hitting .353 (18-for-51) with four doubles, six RBI, seven walks, a .431 on-base percentage and an .862 OPS.

HEY EVERYONE! COME AND SEE HOW GOOD I LUKE!: Luke Keaschall reached safely in 29 of 32 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .404 on the season, reaching base 55 times (36 hits, 16 walks, 3 hit-by-pitch) in 136 plate appearances...he ranks second among all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage (minimum of 125 plate appearances), trailing Miami's Jakob Marsee (.410).

LAST TIME OUT: Last started on August 30 vs. the Padres, opposite Nick Pivetta, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-12 loss...allowed one run on one hit, a solo home run by Elias Díaz in the fifth inning, with three walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...retired nine-straight batters from the second-fifth innings...marked the third one-hit outing of his career and his first since July 20, 2024 at Yankee Stadium...has now struck out five-or-more batters in all but two of his 20 career one-run starts, and has struck out four-or-more in all 20.

⚡ Since the third inning on August 24 (8.0 IP), has faced just four batters over the minimum (2 H, 3 BB, 1 GIDP).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on August 24 at Rate Field in Chicago, opposite Yoendrys Gómez, in Minnesota's 0-8 shutout loss...allowed seven runs on nine hits (1 HR), with one walk and one strikeout over 5.0 innings of work...tied career high in hits allowed and tied season high in runs...gave up four consecutive singles to start a three-run first inning (5 total base hits in the inn.)...in the second, allowed an RBI single to Kyle Teel, a run-scoring groundout to Luis Robert Jr. and a two-run home run to Colson Montgomery...faced the minimum from the third-fifth innings.

⚡ Prior to the game, he had not allowed a first-inning run in nine-straight starts, tying his career-best streak, done from June 8-July 31, 2024.

FACING THE WHITE SOX: Is facing the South Siders for the third time in his career and this season, and the second time in the last 12 days...in his career, is 0-1 with a 14.85 ERA (6.2 IP, 11 ER), four walks, one strikeout and a .406 (13-for-32) opponent batting average.

A NEW CENTER: In 13 career starts against the American League Central, is 2-5 with a 3.88 ERA (72.0 IP, 31 ER), 29 walks and 65 strikeouts...has faced Minnesota five times, Cleveland and Kansas City three times apiece, and Chicago twice...batters in the division are hitting .230 with eight home runs, a .305 on-base percentage, a .356 slugging percentage and a .660 OPS.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 12 major league home games this season, is 4-3 with a 5.14 ERA (61.1 IP, 35 ER), 23 walks and 53 strikeouts, compared to 2-4 with a 4.50 ERA (60.0 IP, 30 ER), 25 walks and 49 strikeouts in 11 road games...in 35 career home starts, is 11-14 with a 4.82 ERA (185.0 IP, 99 ER), 60 walks and 207 strikeouts.

⚡ At home this season, he has posted a .249 (57-for-229) opponent batting average and a 1.30 WHIP while allowing eight doubles, one triple and 10 home runs.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed batters have slashed .234/.324/.408 with nine doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 34 RBI and a 1.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 218 at-bats against Bradley...right-handed batters have slashed .243/.304/.351 with eight doubles, six home runs, 25 RBI and a 2.65 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 239 at-bats against Bradley.

⚡ In his careers, lefties have slashed .239/.313/.410 with a 2.80 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties have slashed .245/.306/.440 with a 2.97 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Bradley.

TWO-OUT TITAN: Among all pitchers with 20-or-more starts this season, Bradley's .167 (22-for-132) opponent batting average with two outs ranks second behind Carlos Rodón (.154)...under those same criteria, his .183 BABIP ranks first and his .231 opponent on-base percentage ranks fifth.

⚡ In 2024 (25 starts), Bradley posted a .210 BAA, a .297 BABIP and a .290 on-base percentage with two outs.

THE ARSENAL: Through 24 starts in 2025, Bradley has relied on a four pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

⚡ This season (1959 pitches), his chase rate is 26.4 percent and his whiff rate is 22.7 percent...his walk rate is 9.3 and his strikeout rate is 19.8 percent...his average exit velocity is 88.9 mph and his hard-hit rate is 38.8 percent.

⚡ In his last outing on August 30, his four-seamer averaged 97.2 mph, his best mark in any outing this season and 1.5 mph faster than two starts ago (95.7 mph)...his 14 total whiffs induced in his last start were his most since June 1, when he got a season-best 18 swing-and-misses...average exit velocity was 75.5 mph with a hard-hit rate of 11.1 percent, the lowest hard hit rate in any of his starts this season (next lowest is 20.0 percent, done on April 5).
